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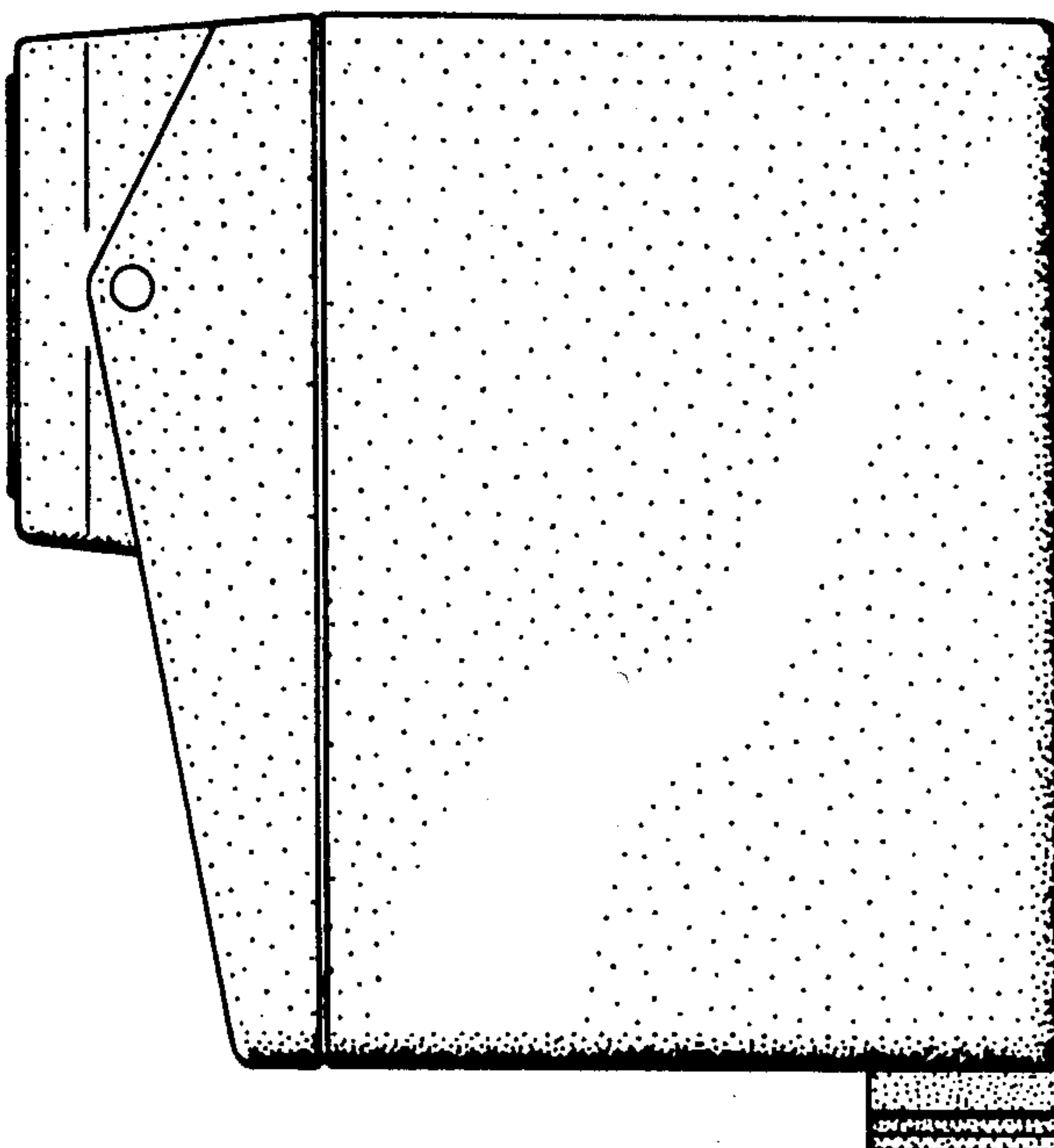
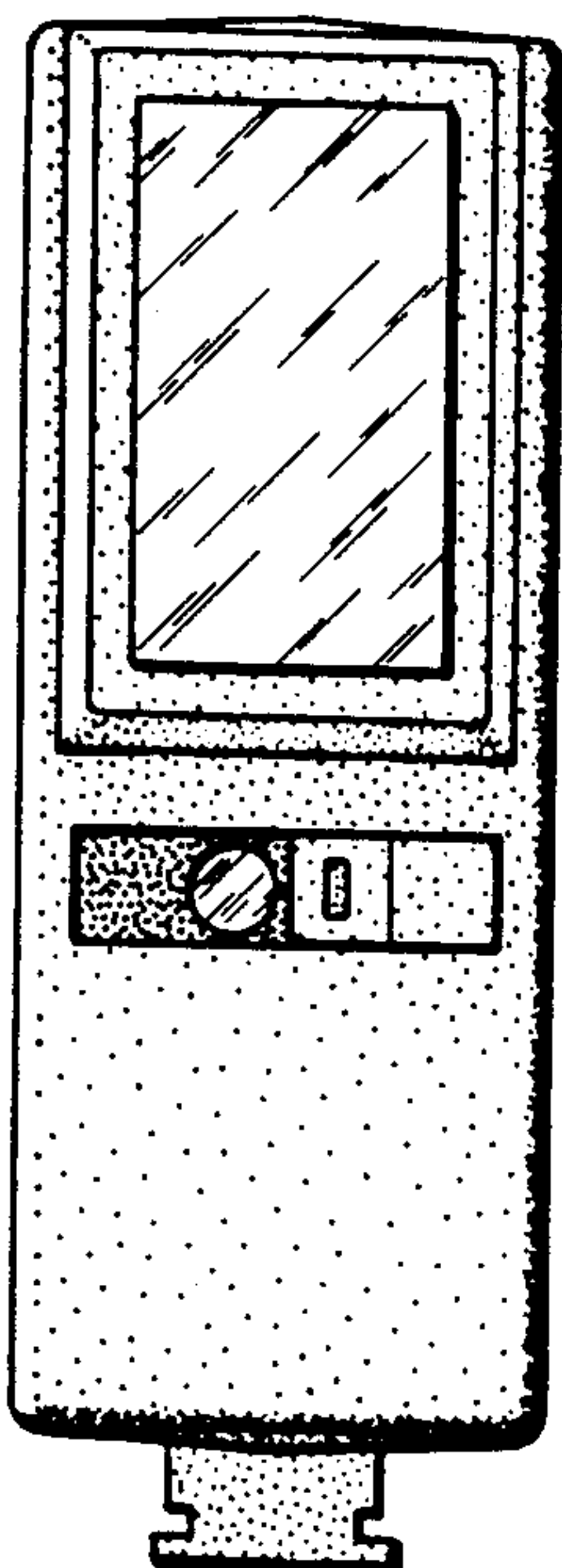

CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic flash unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electronic flash unit, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof with the lamp head shown in upwardly adjusted position.



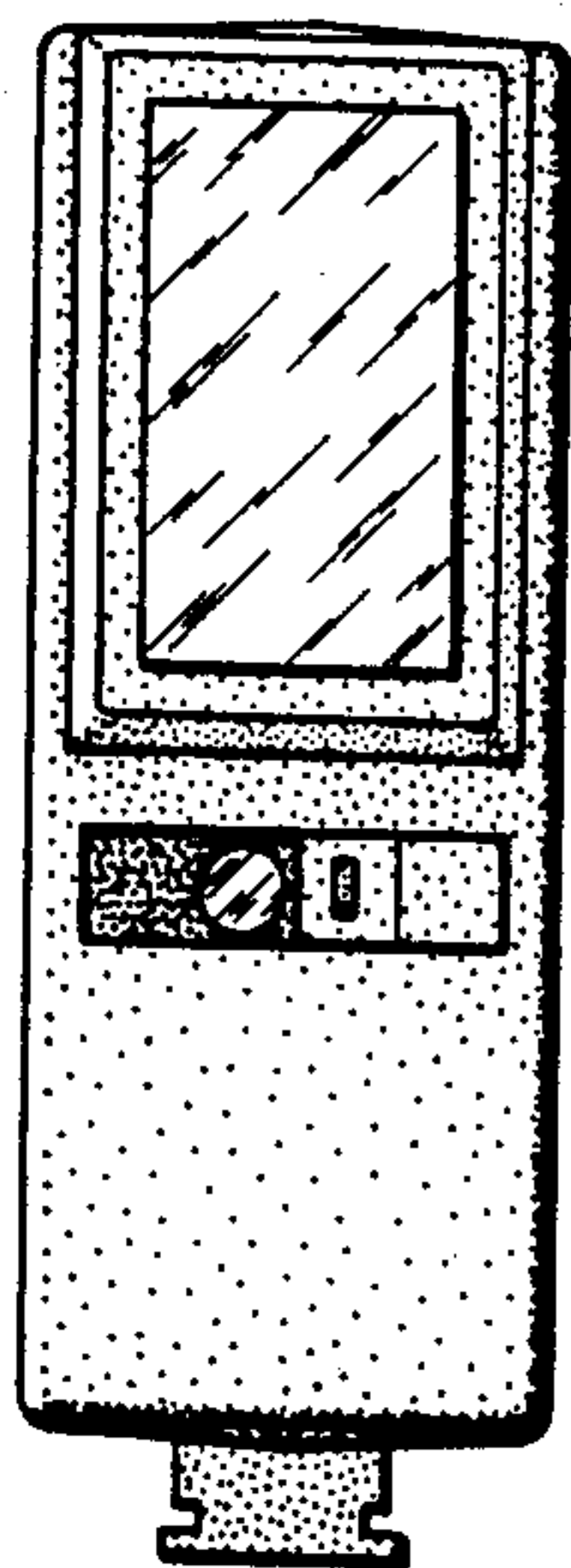

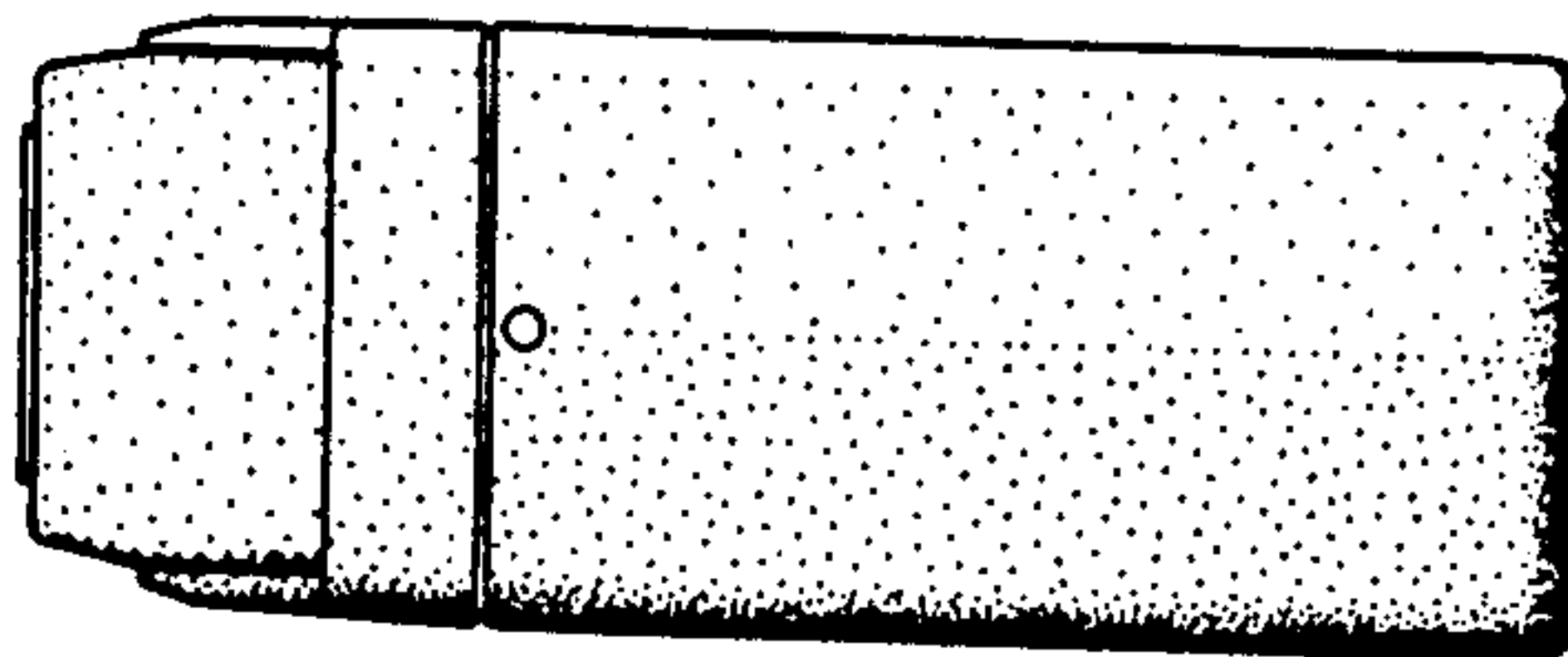

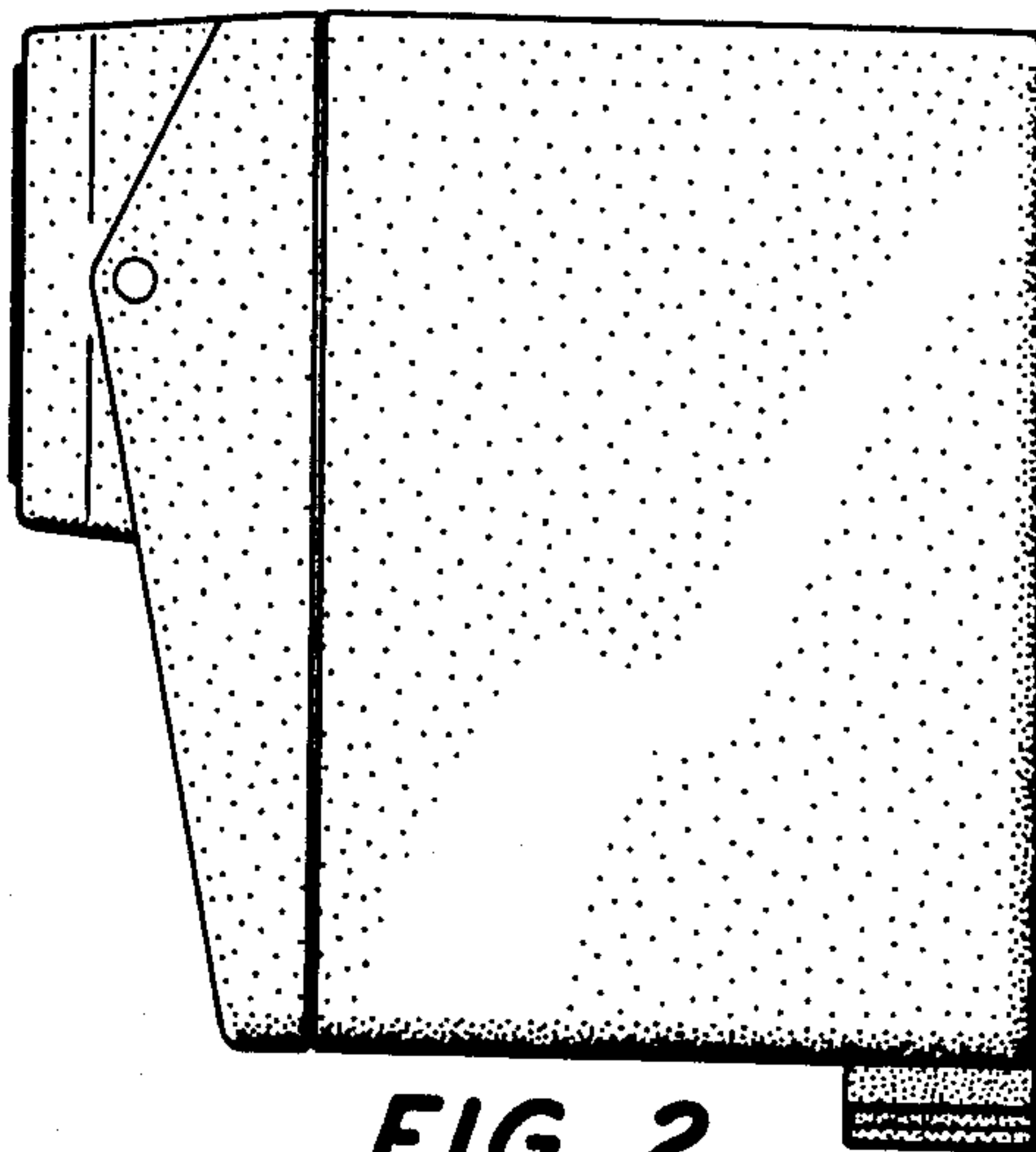

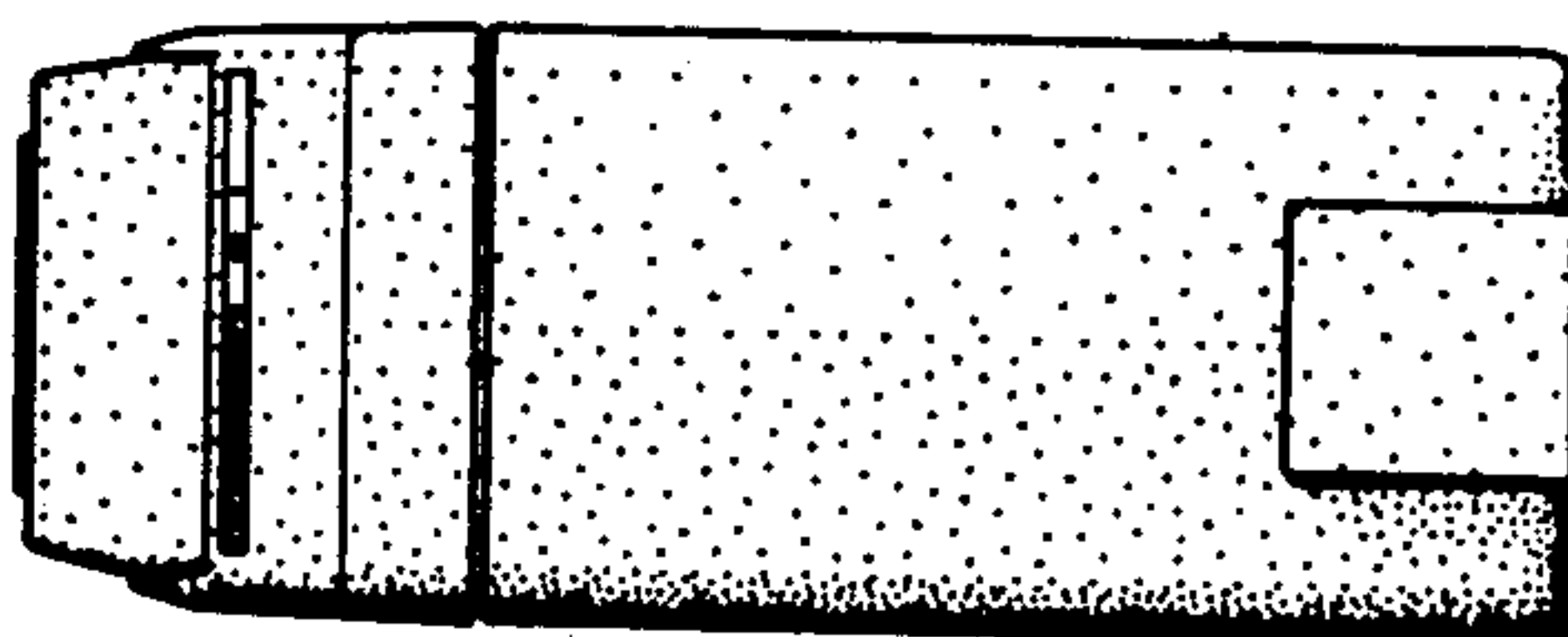

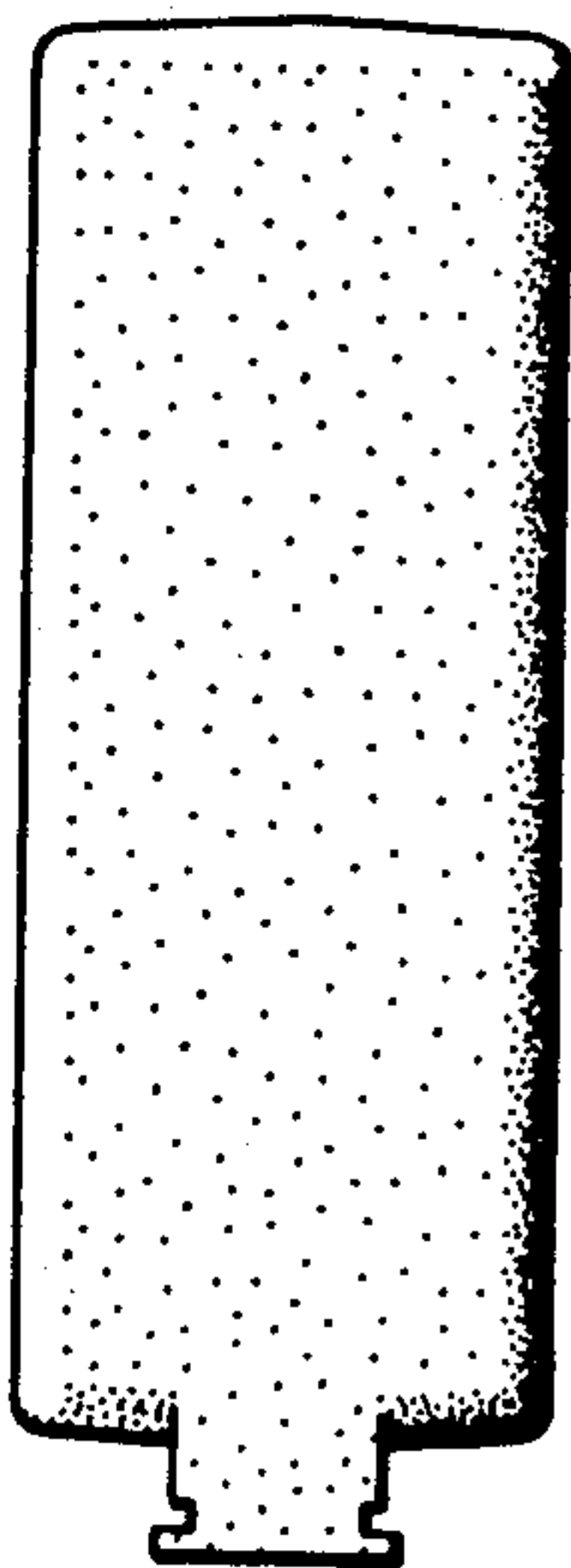

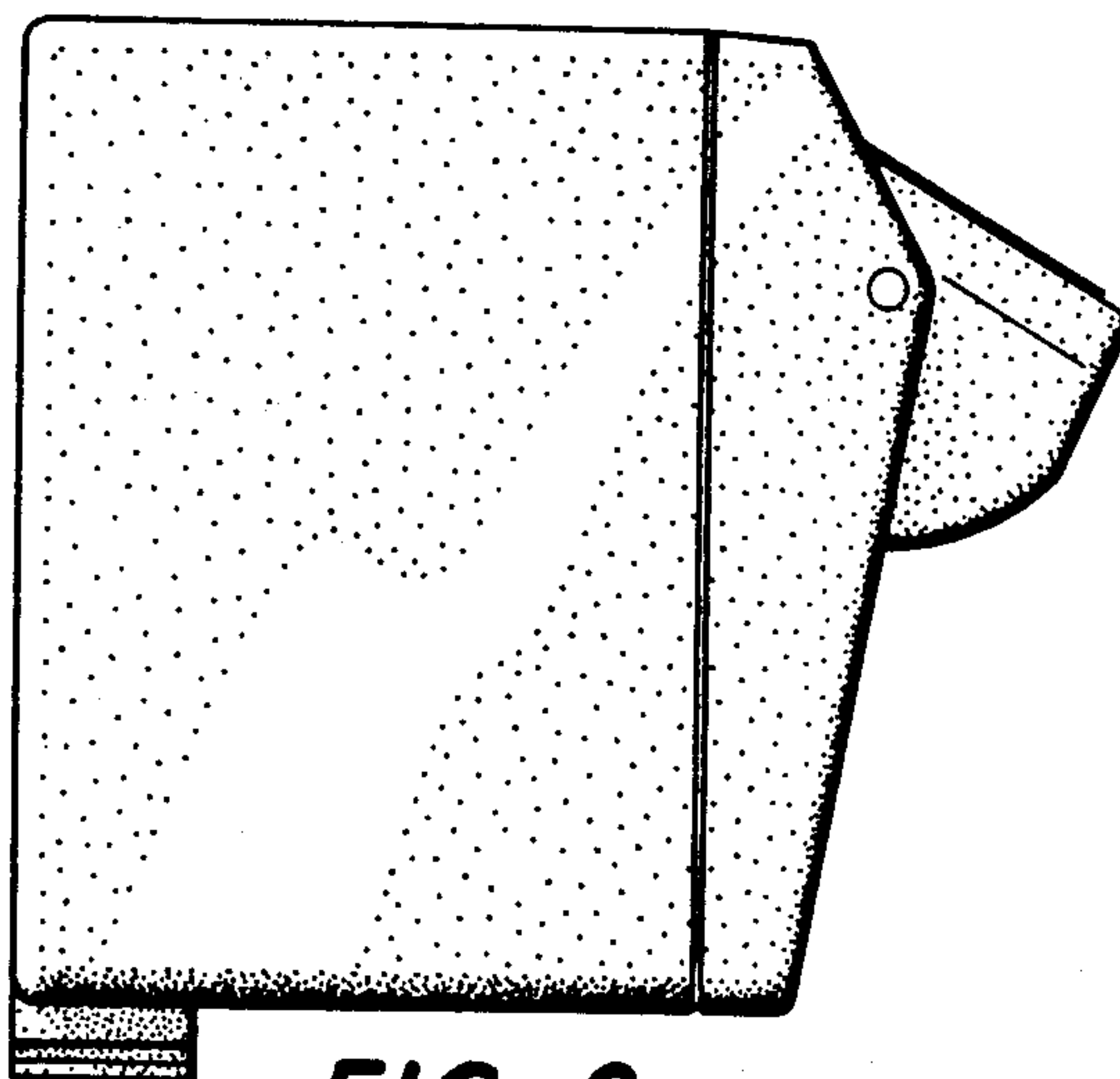
