concealed identification tag or similar article, as shown
and described.

tag in an open position.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view.

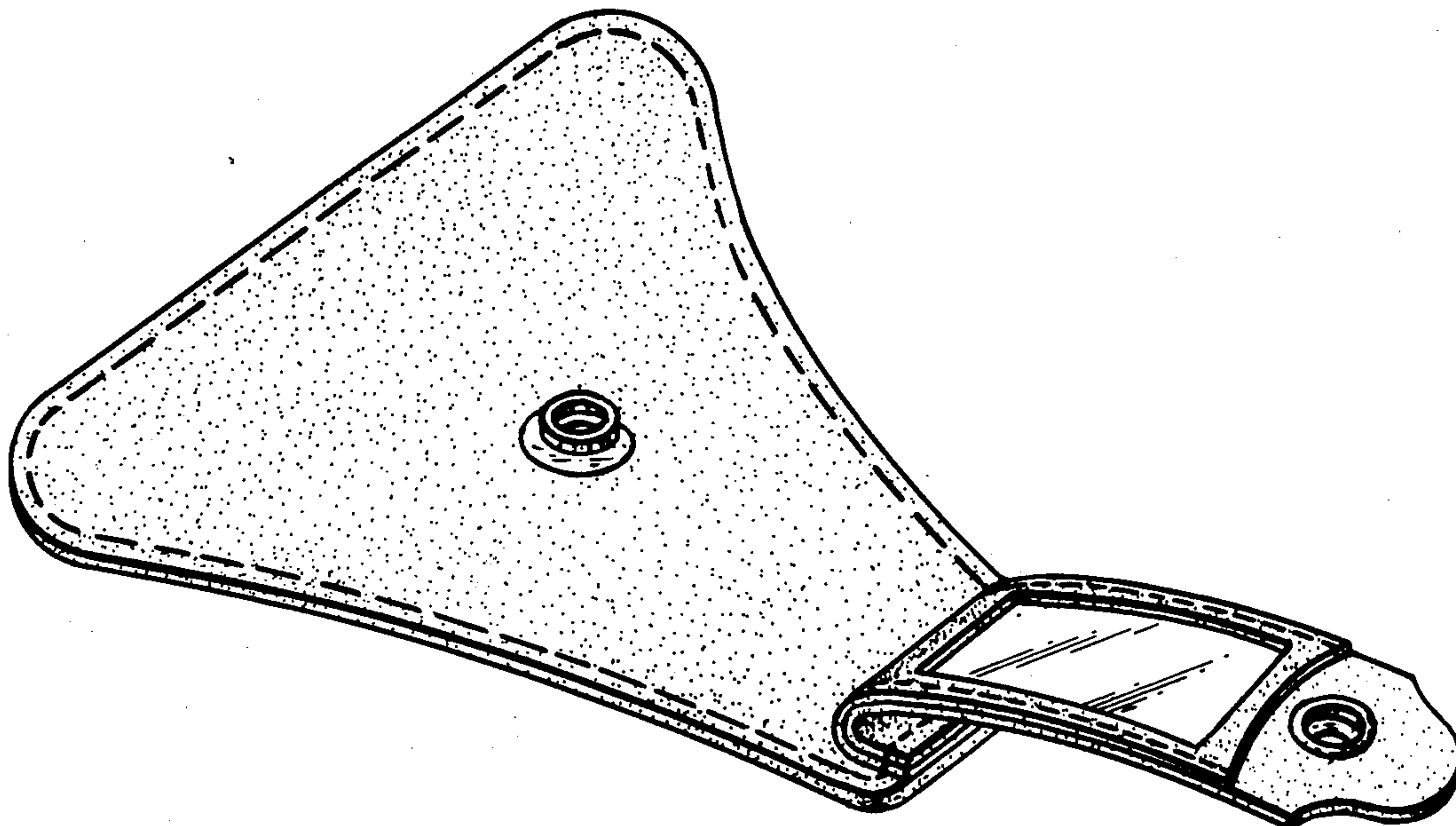

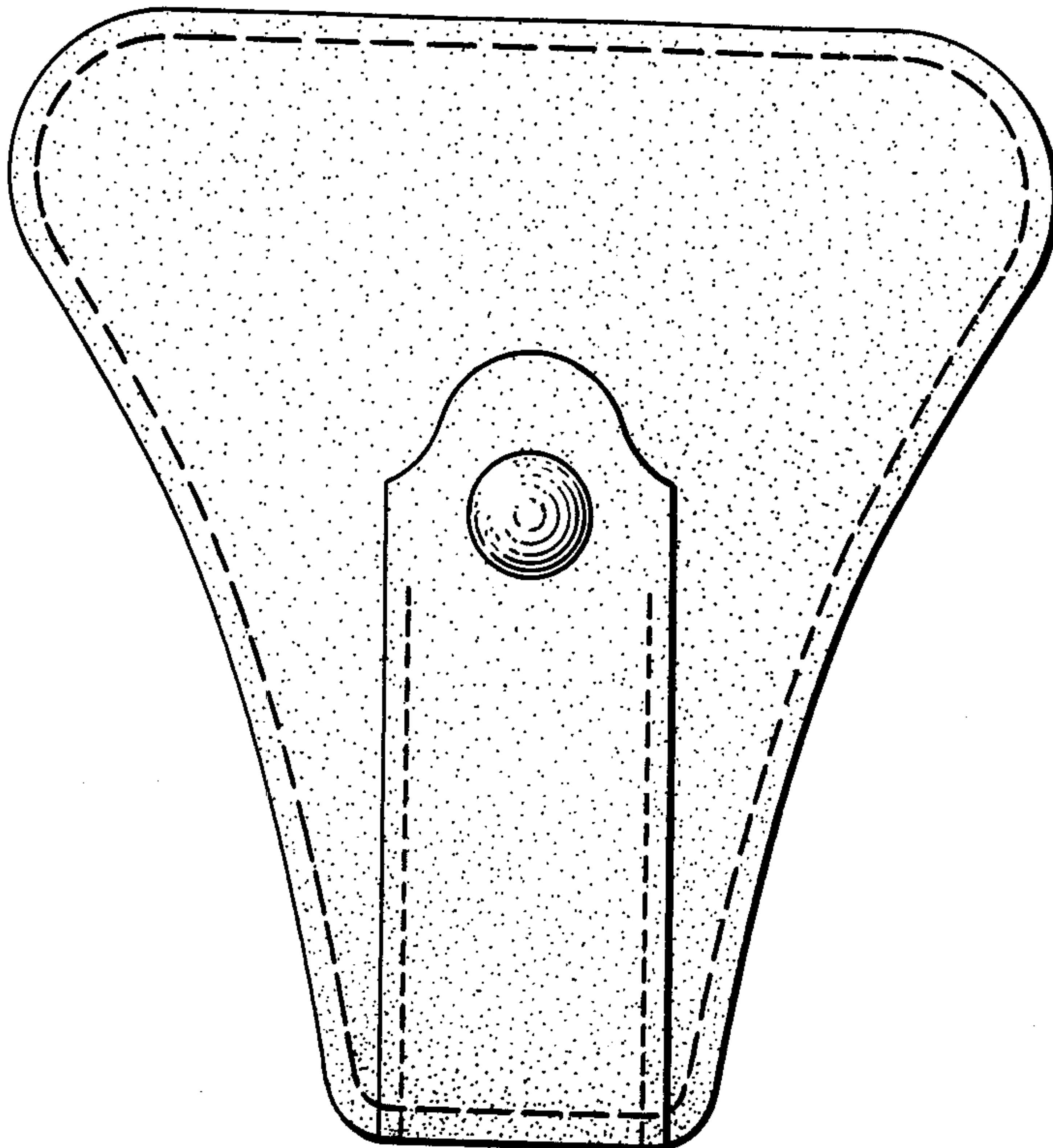

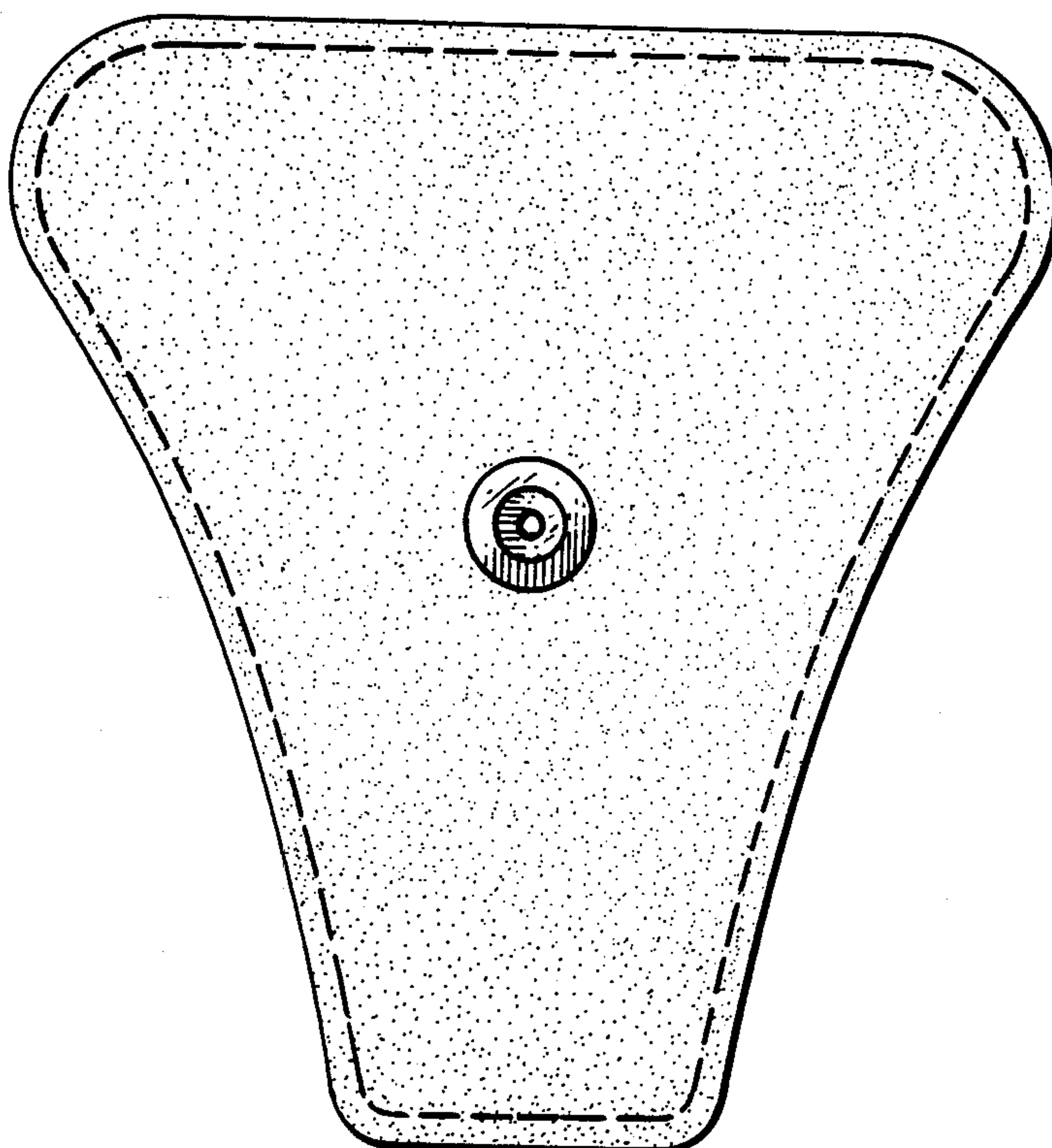

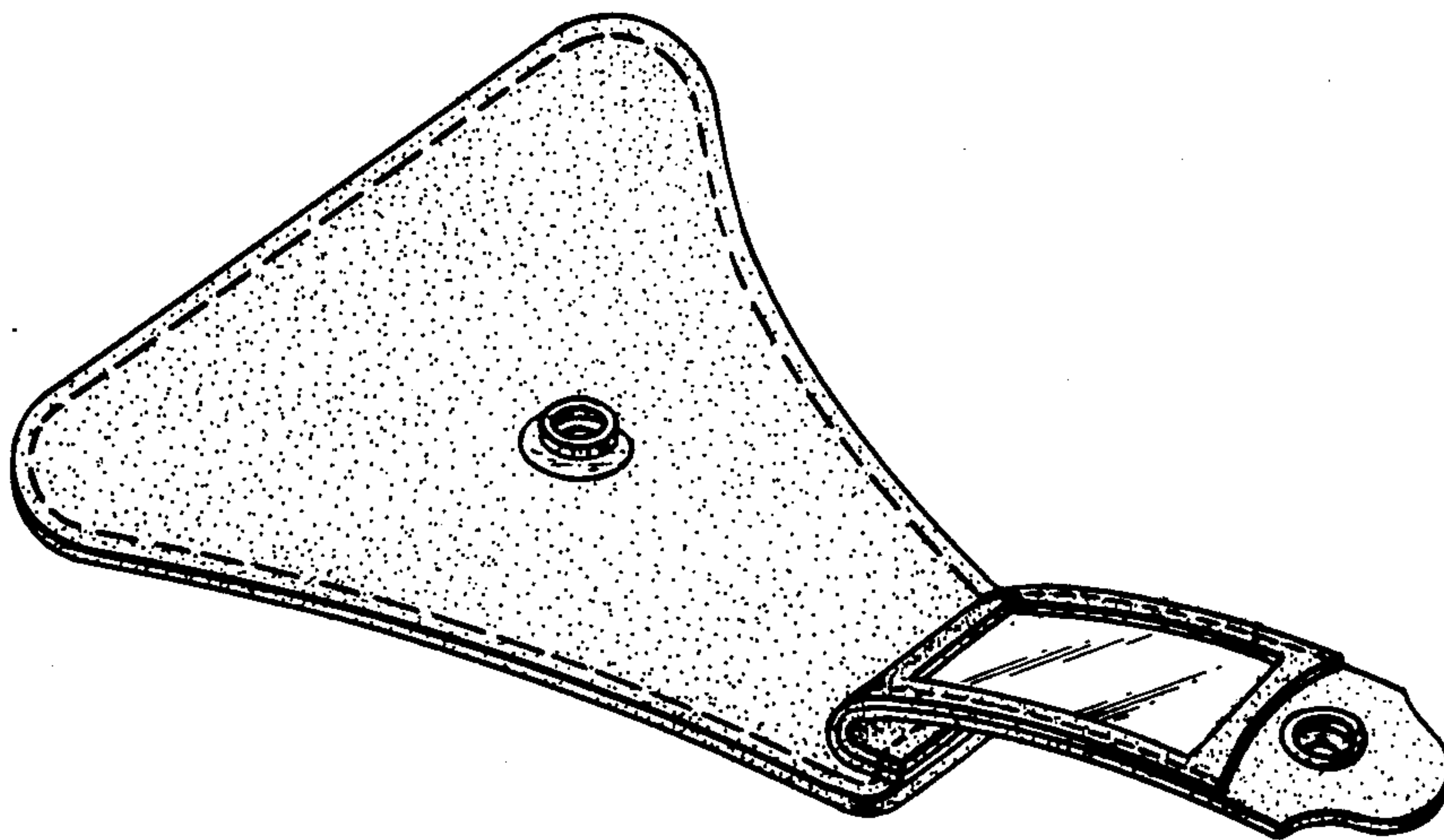
