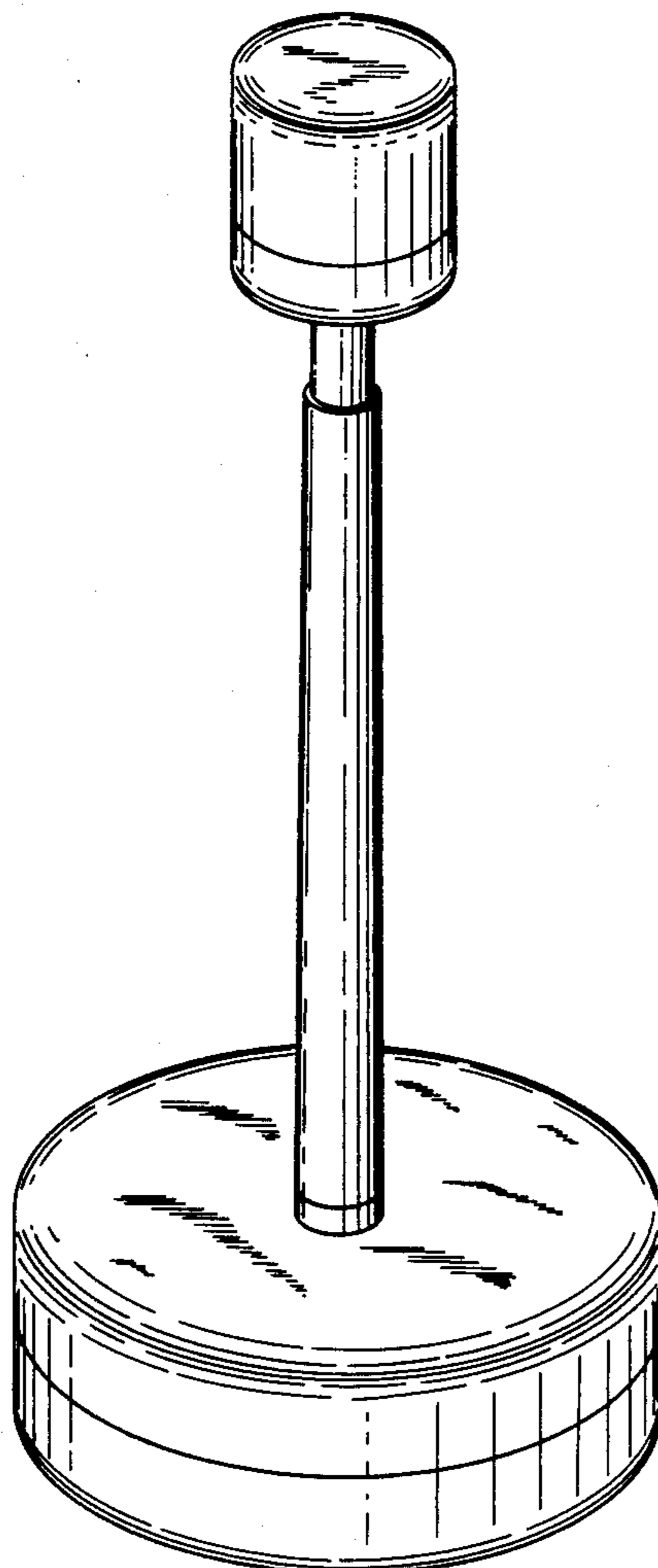
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof; and FIG. 3 is an exploded perspective view thereof.



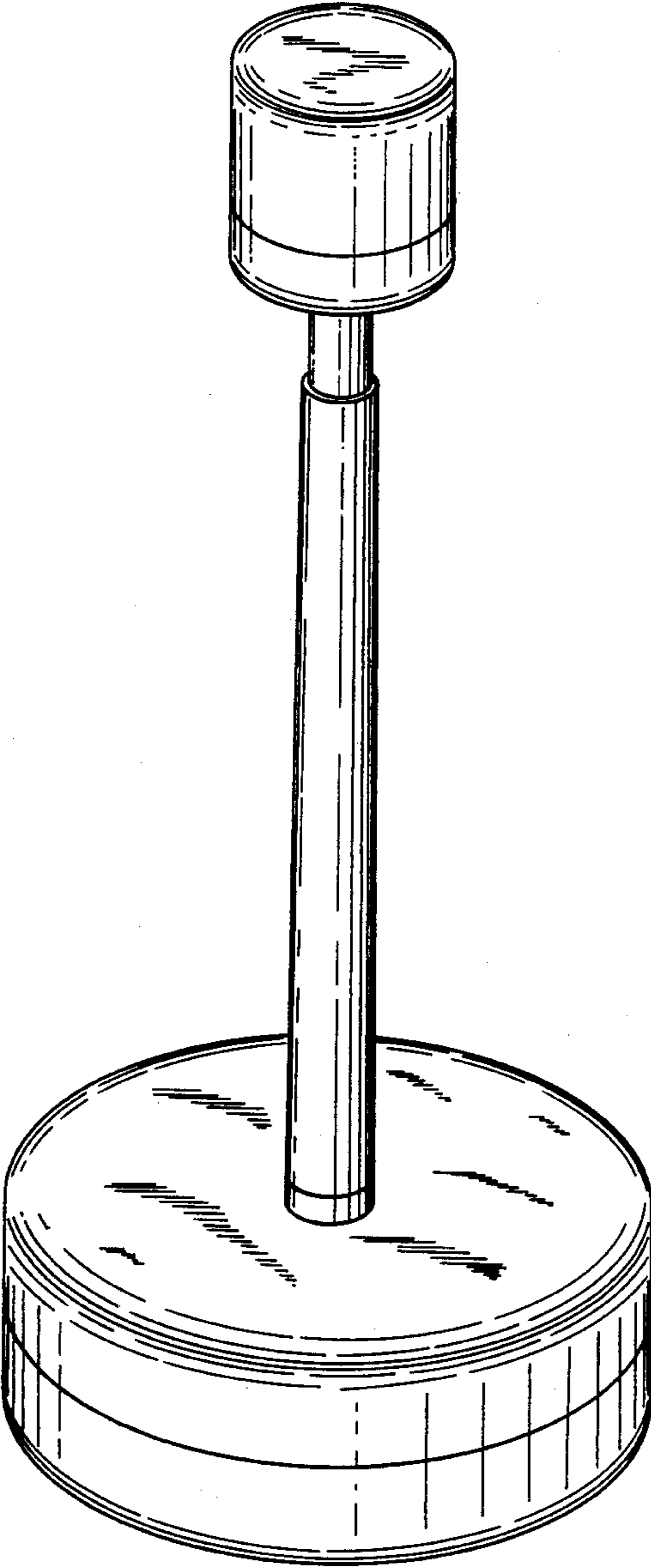

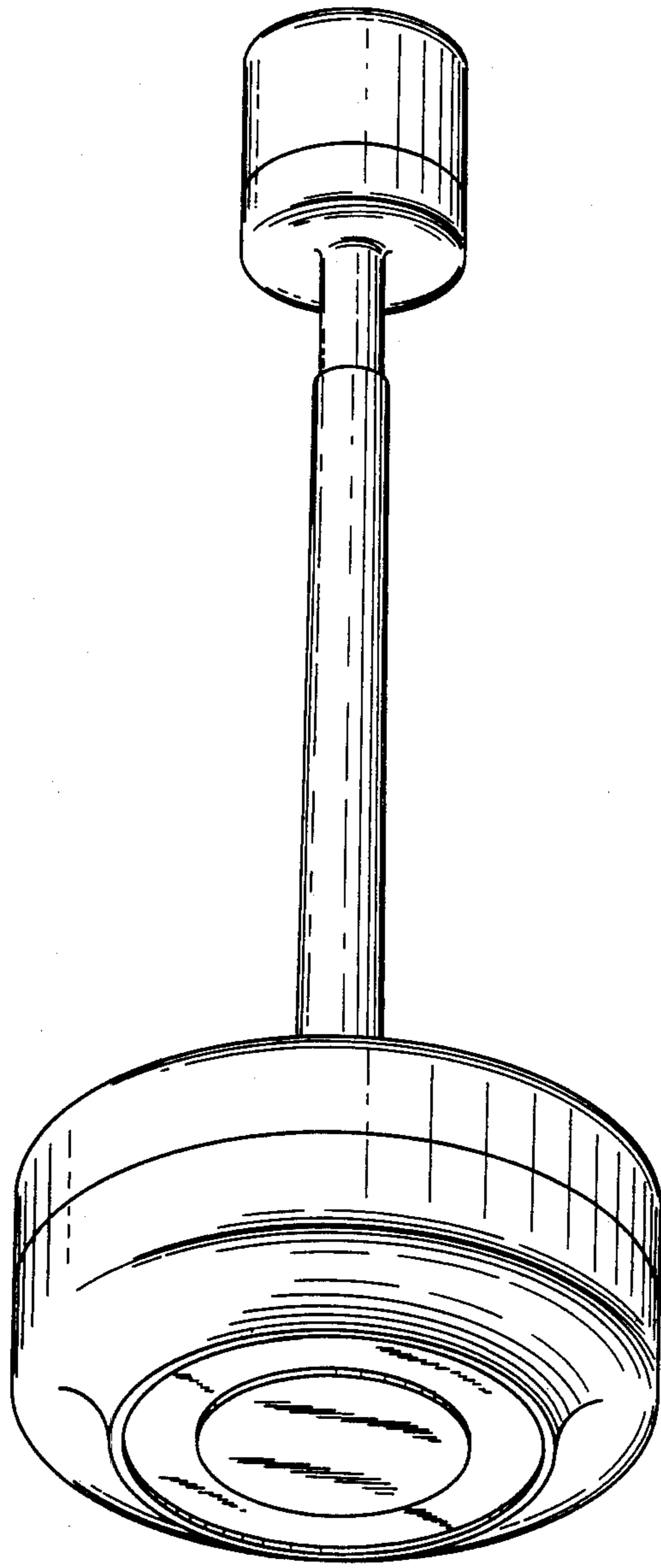

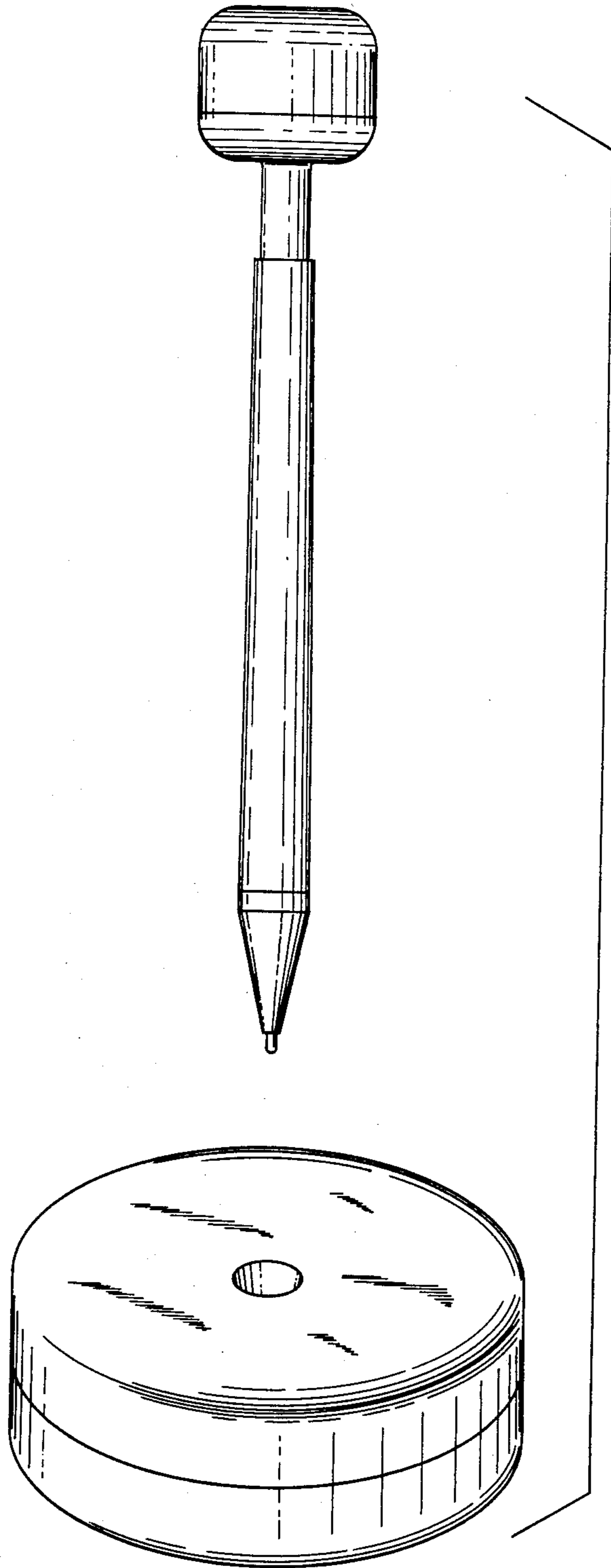
