[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bathtub, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a bathtub showing
my new design.

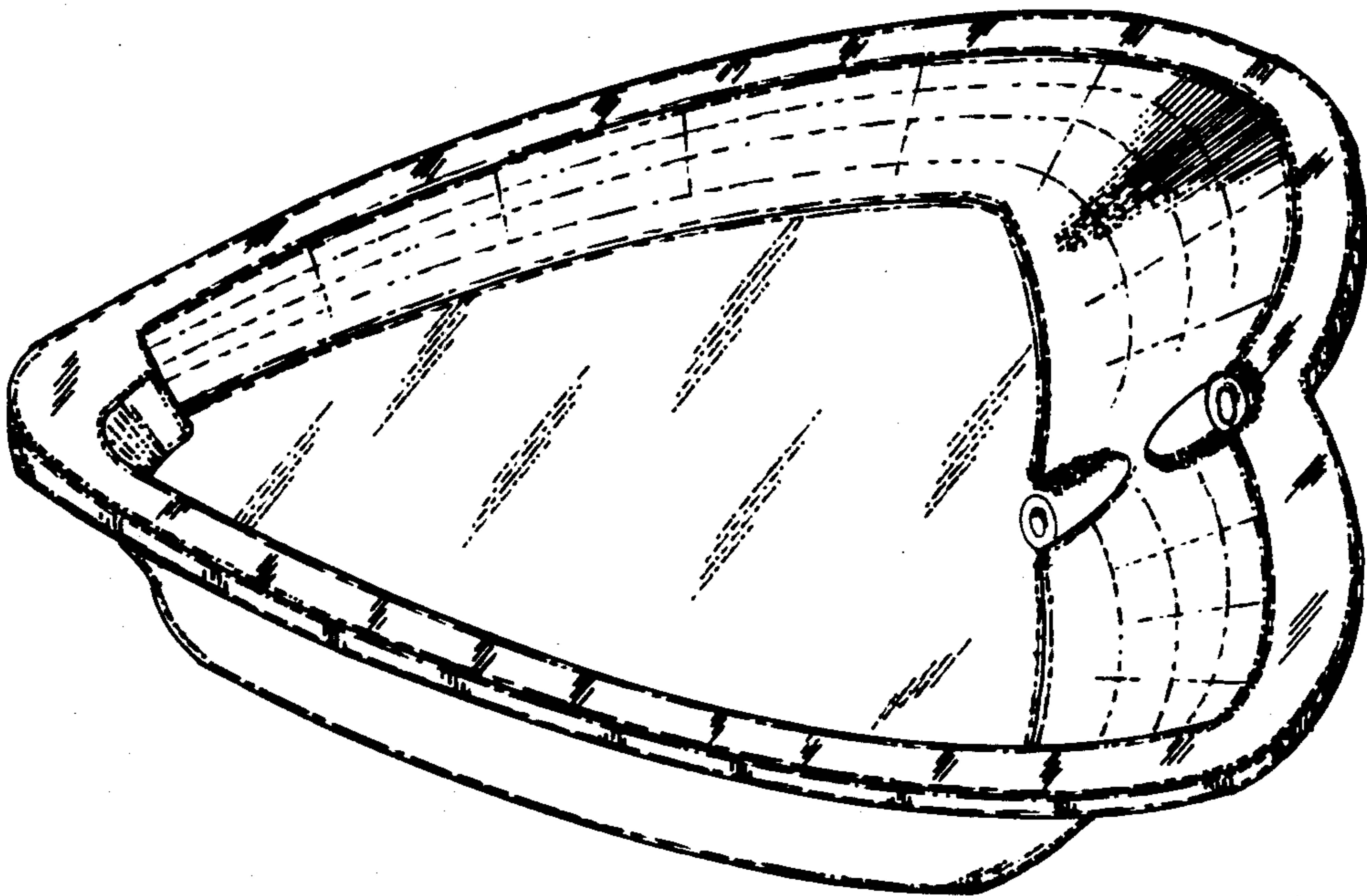
FIG. 2 is a left end elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite
side being a mirror image of the side shown.

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view.

The characteristic features of my design reside in the
inward protrusion at the narrow end of the bathtub
together with the appearance of the drain and overflow-
outlets associated with the wide inclined end of the
bathtub.



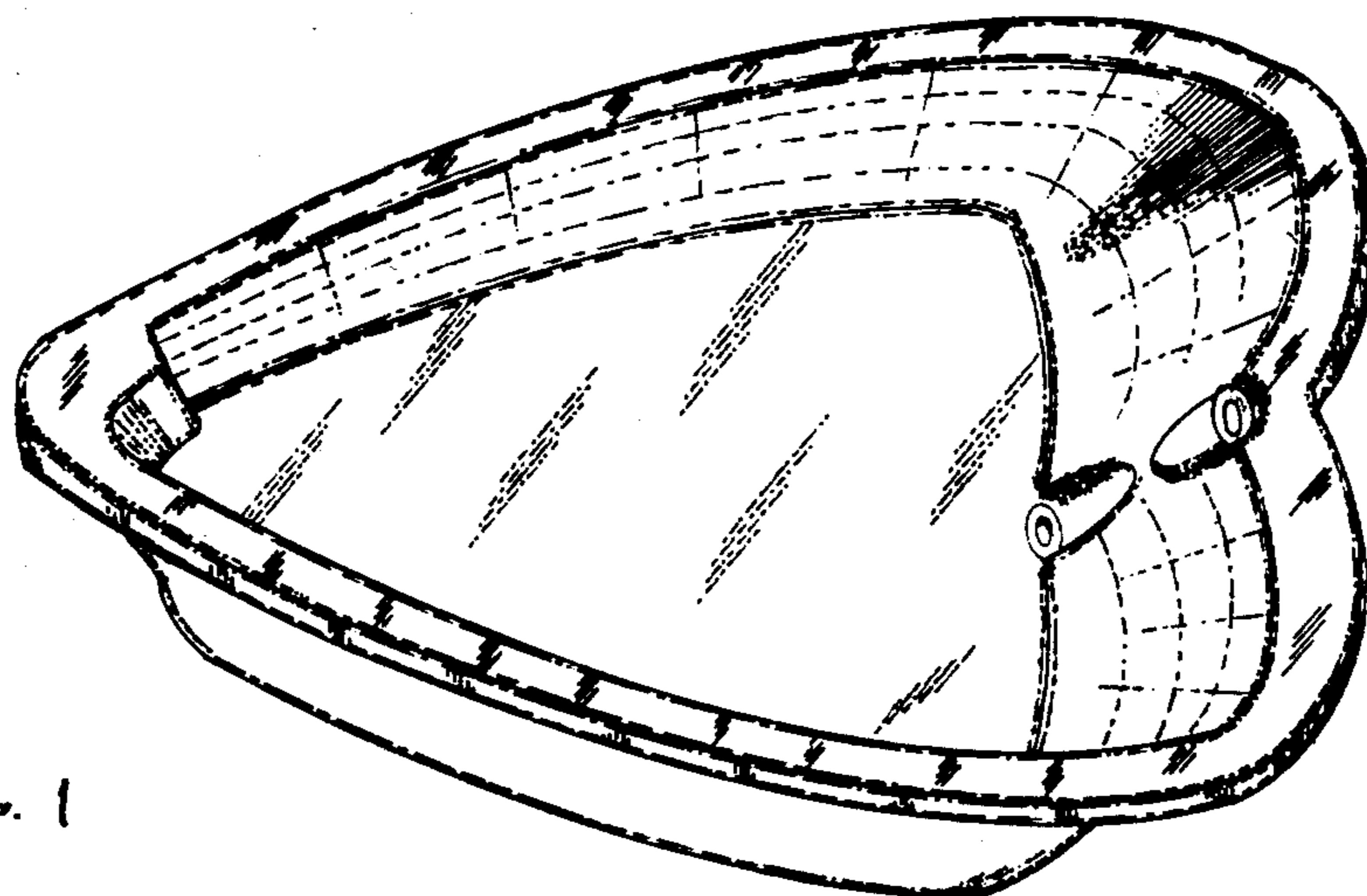

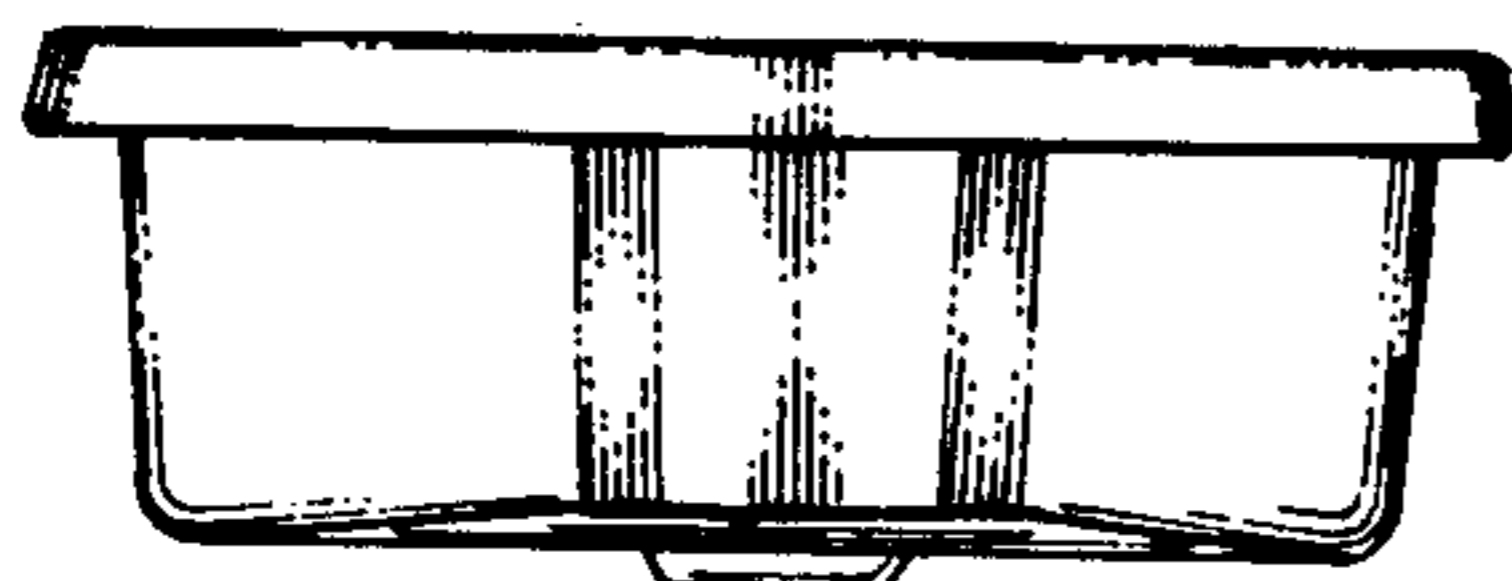

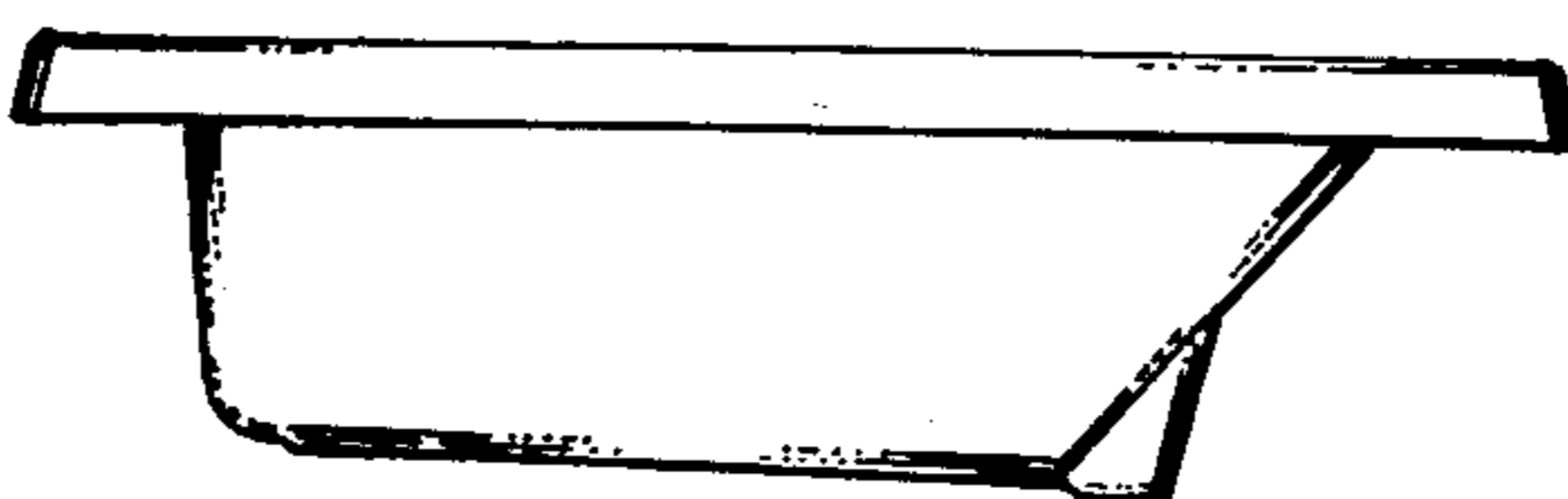

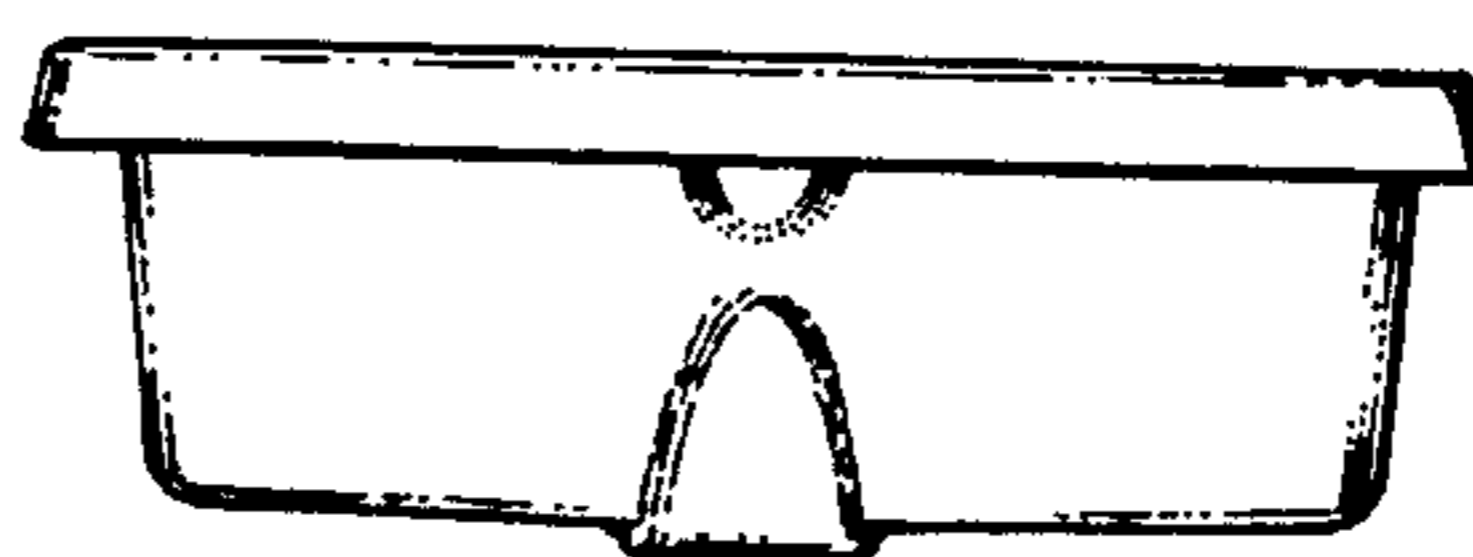

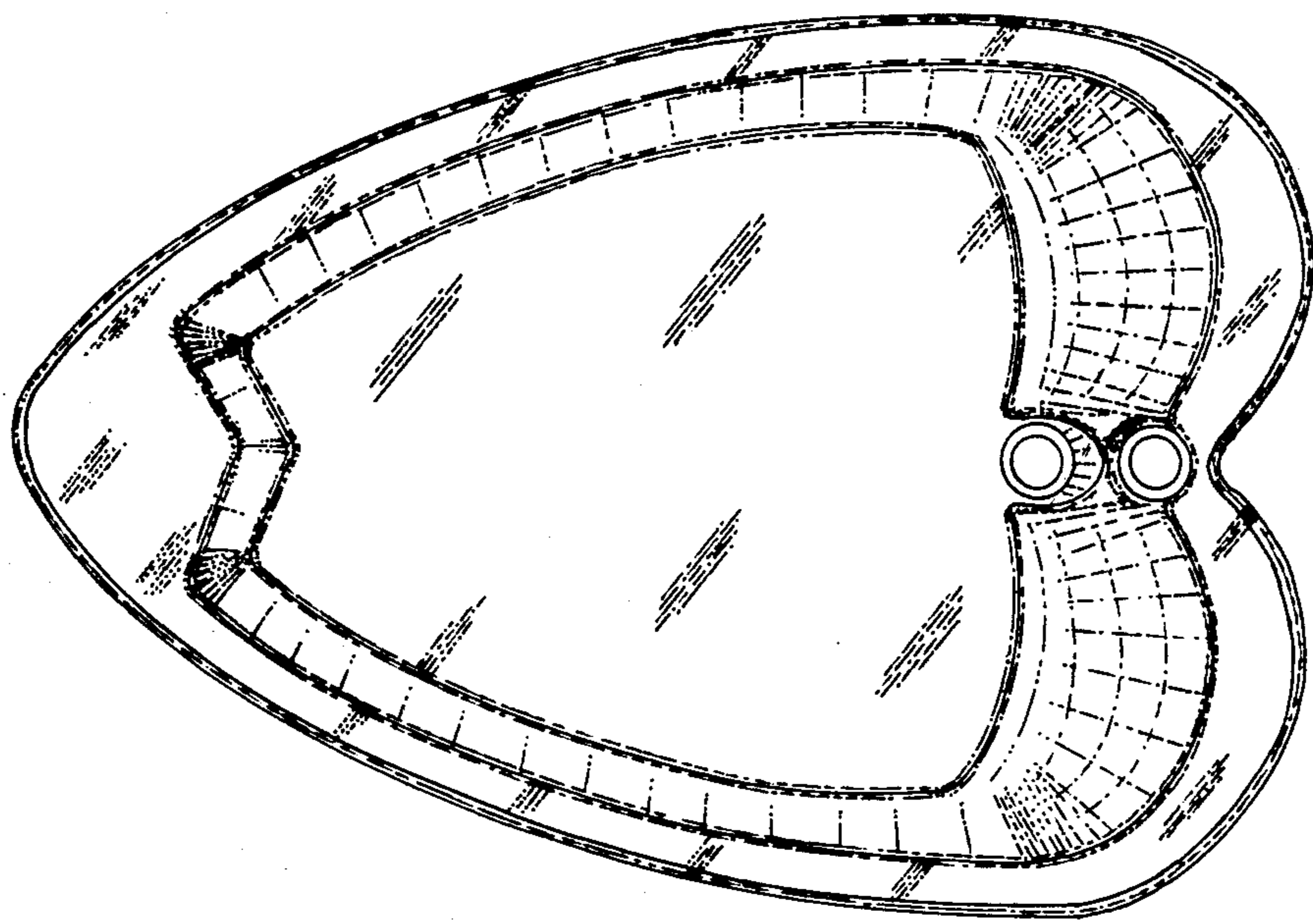
