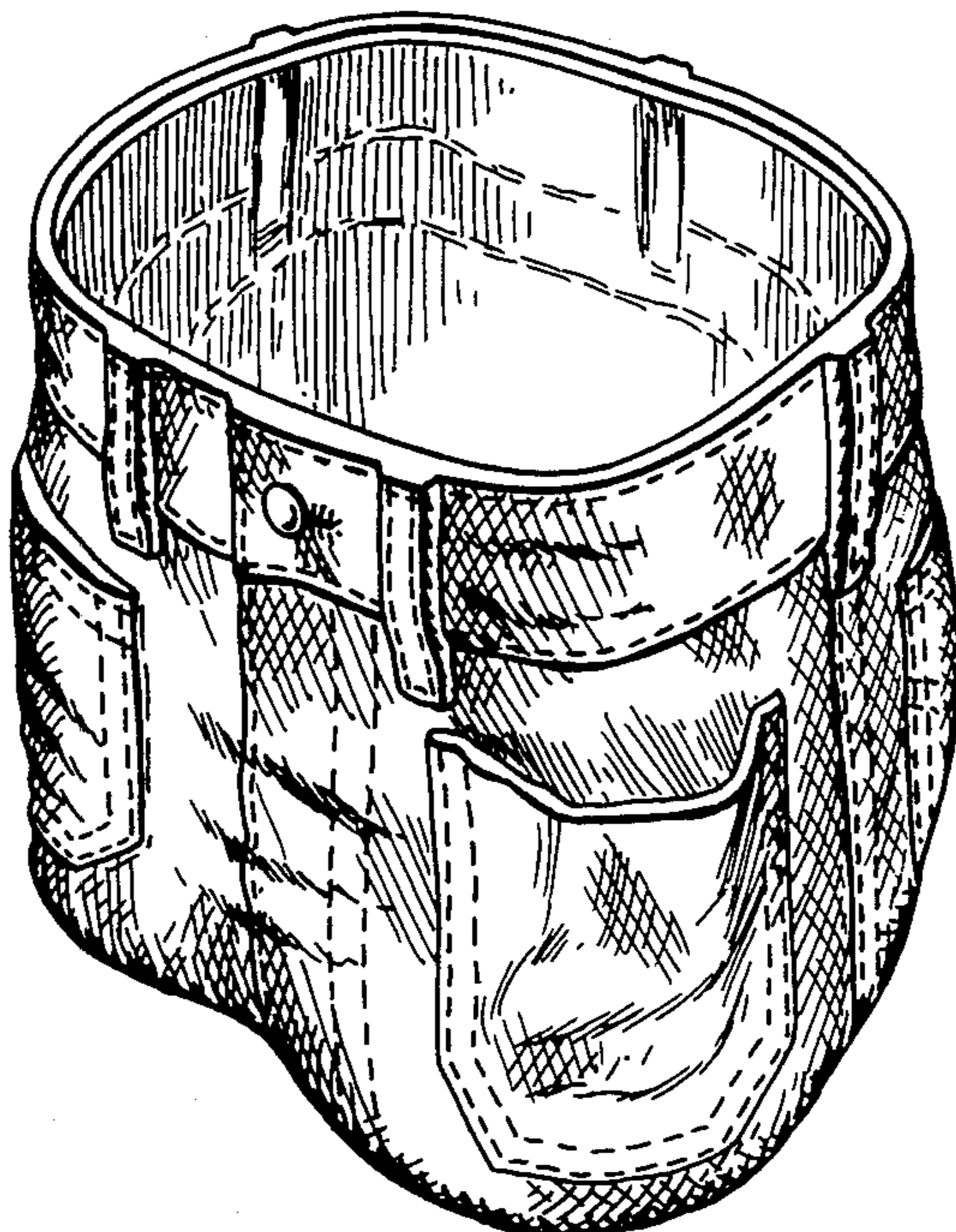
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container to be used as a

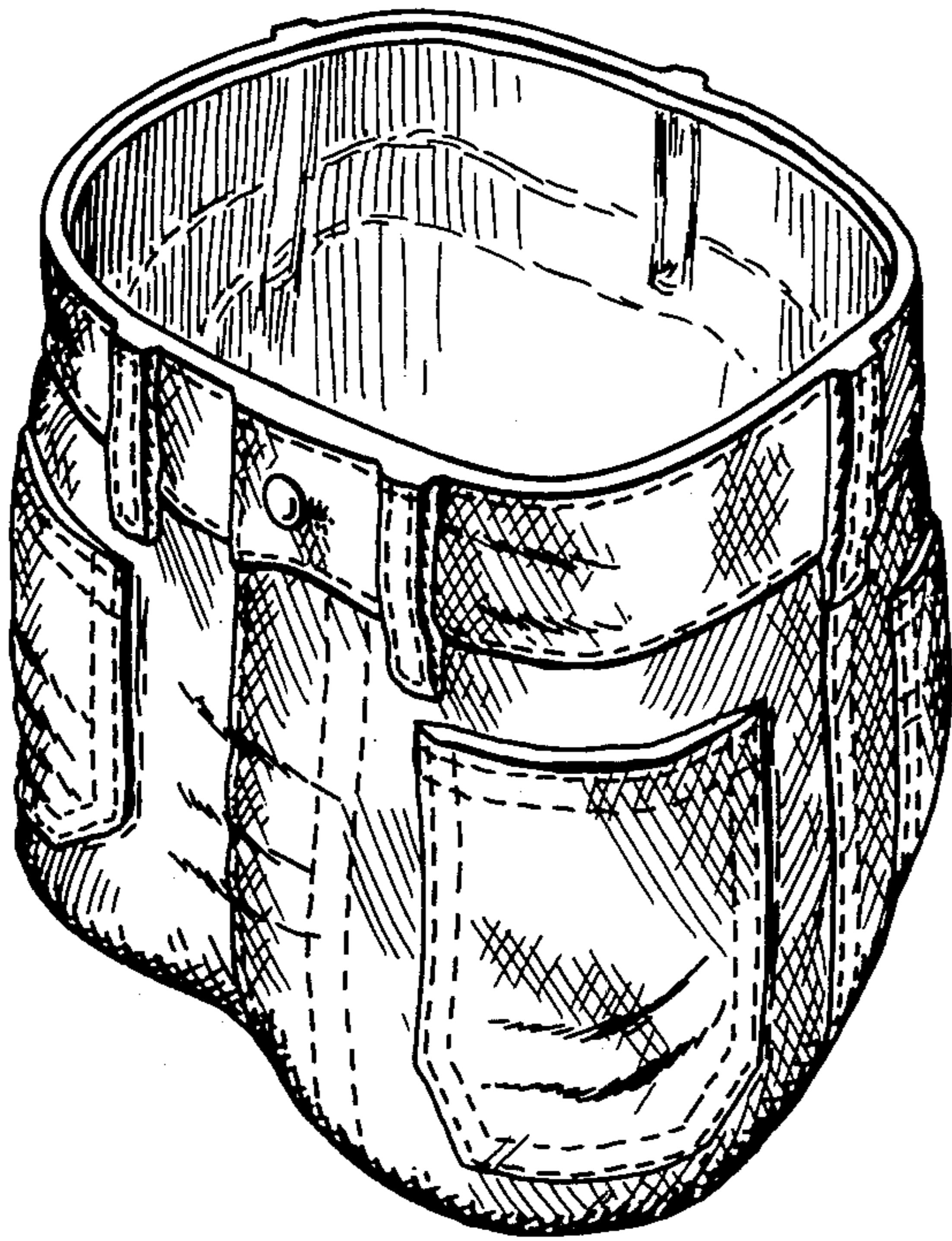
vase, mug or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

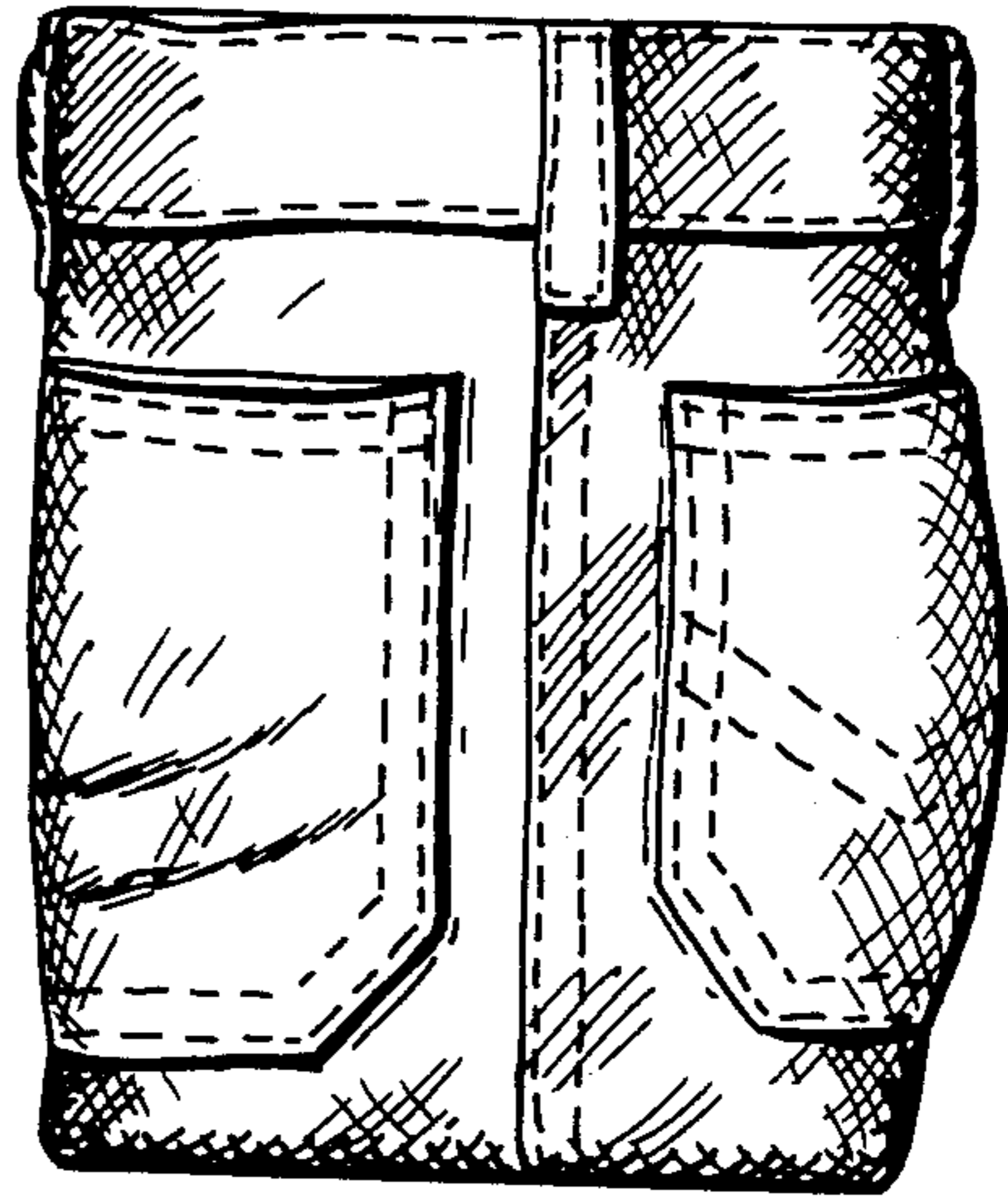
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a container to be used as a vase, mug, or the like illustrating my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1; FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1; FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 8, the rear is identical to that shown in FIG. 5; FIG. 10 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 8, the opposite side is identical to that shown in FIG. 4; FIG. 11 is a top plan view of FIG. 8; FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 8; FIG. 13 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of FIG. 13, the rear being identical to that shown in FIG. 5 with the exception of the handle; FIG. 15 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 13, the opposite side is identical to that shown in FIG. 4; FIG. 16 is a top plan view of FIG. 13; FIG. 17 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 13. The cross-line shading on the outer surfaces of the container represents simulated denim fabric.



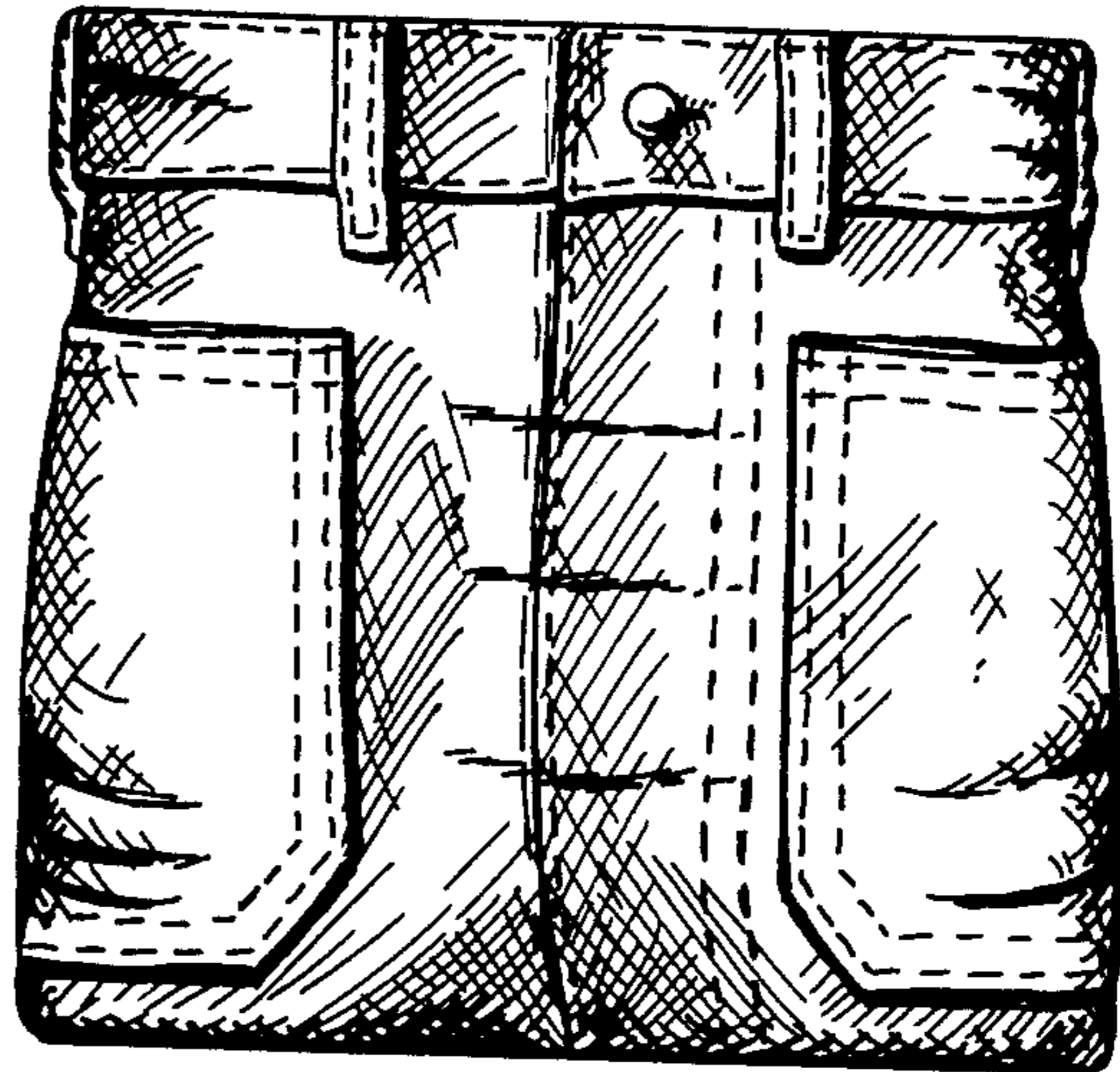

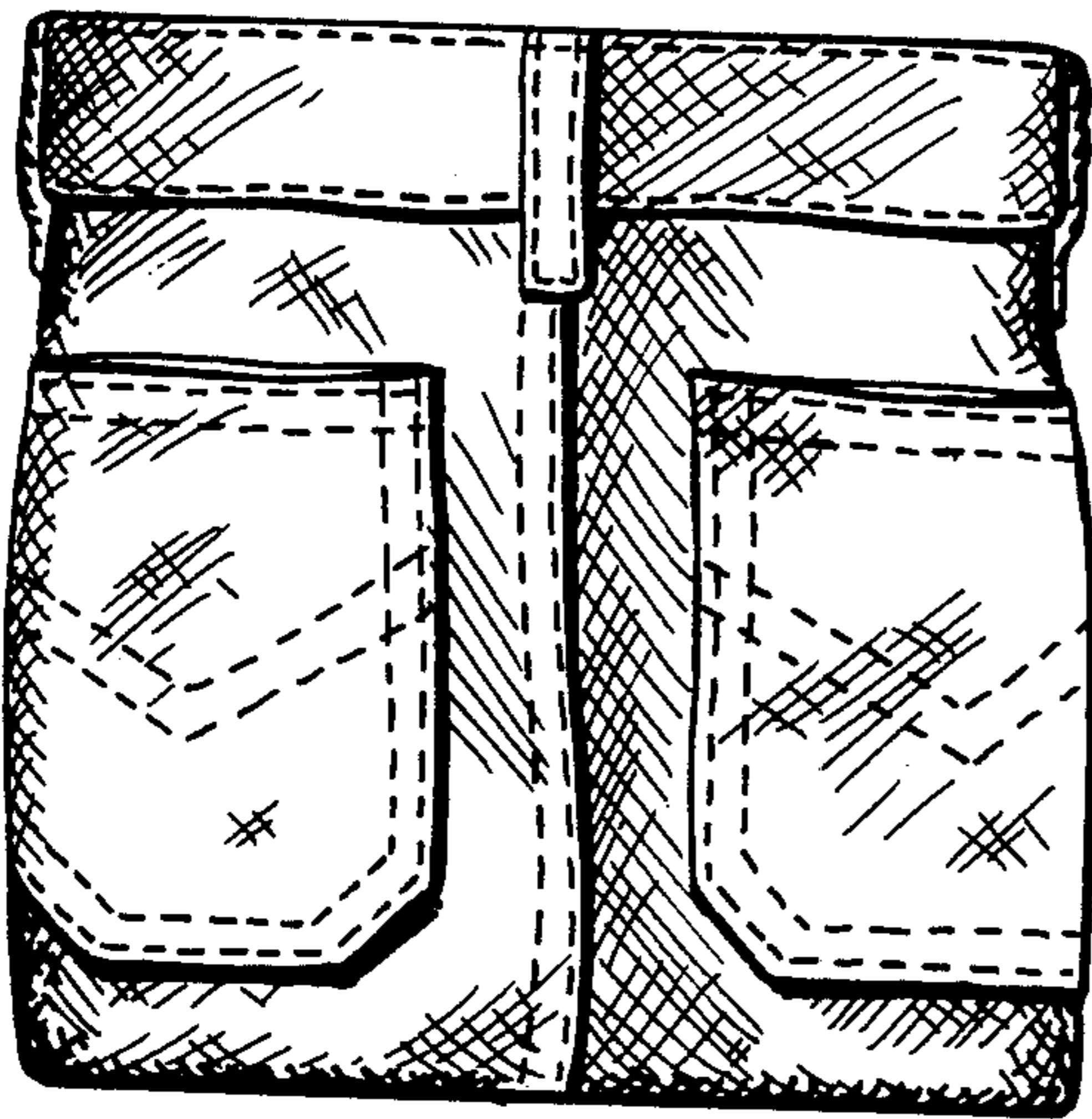

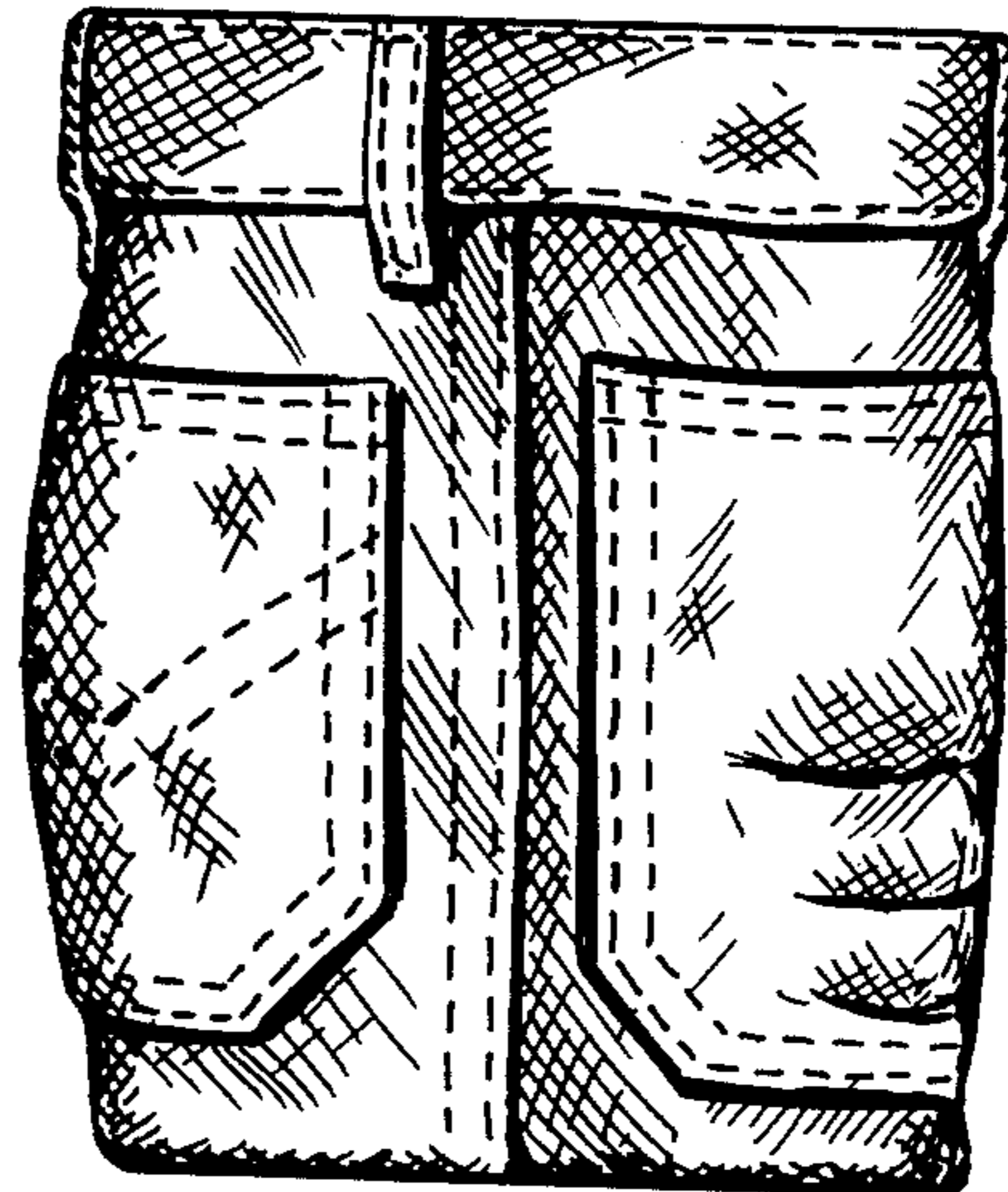

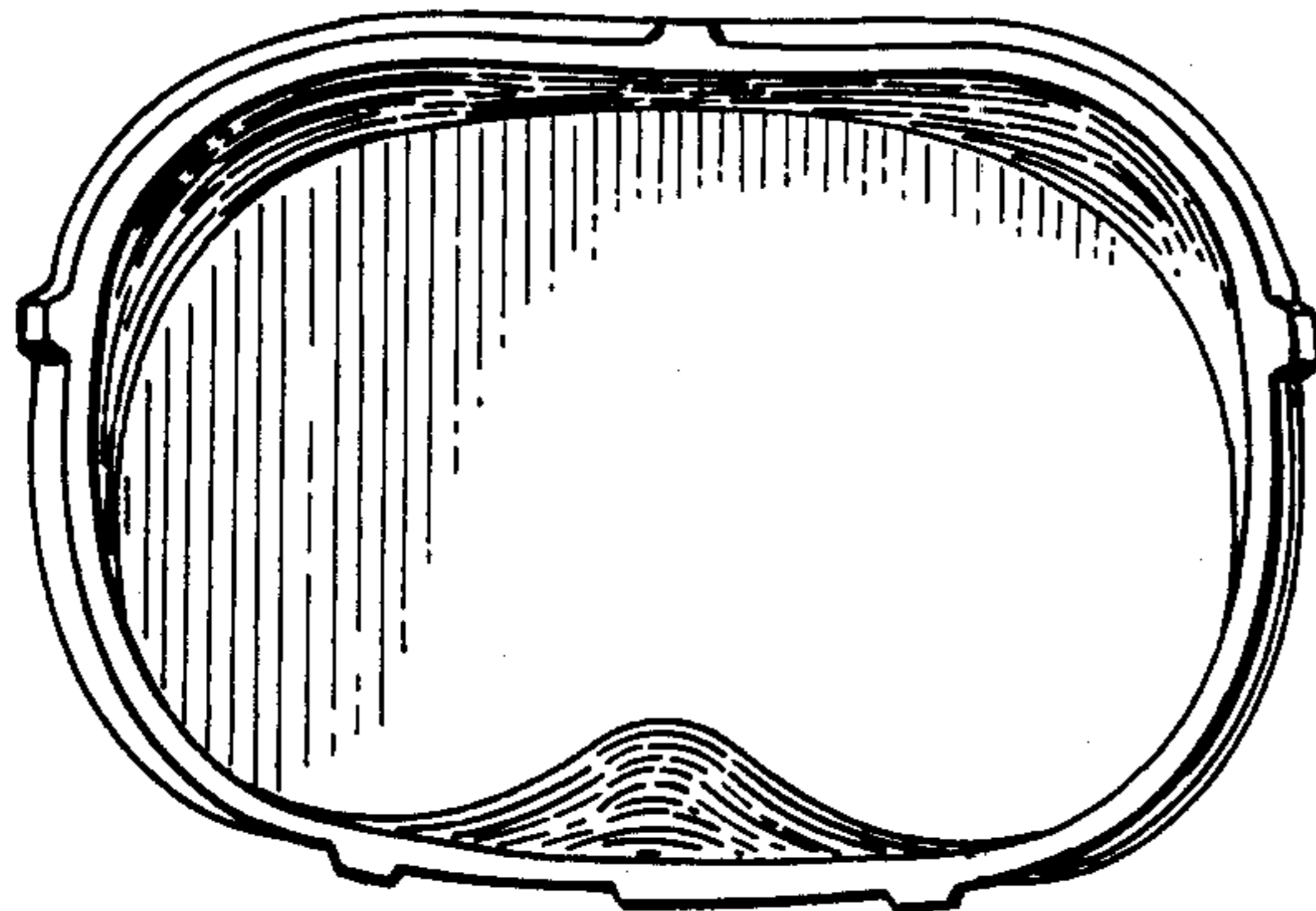

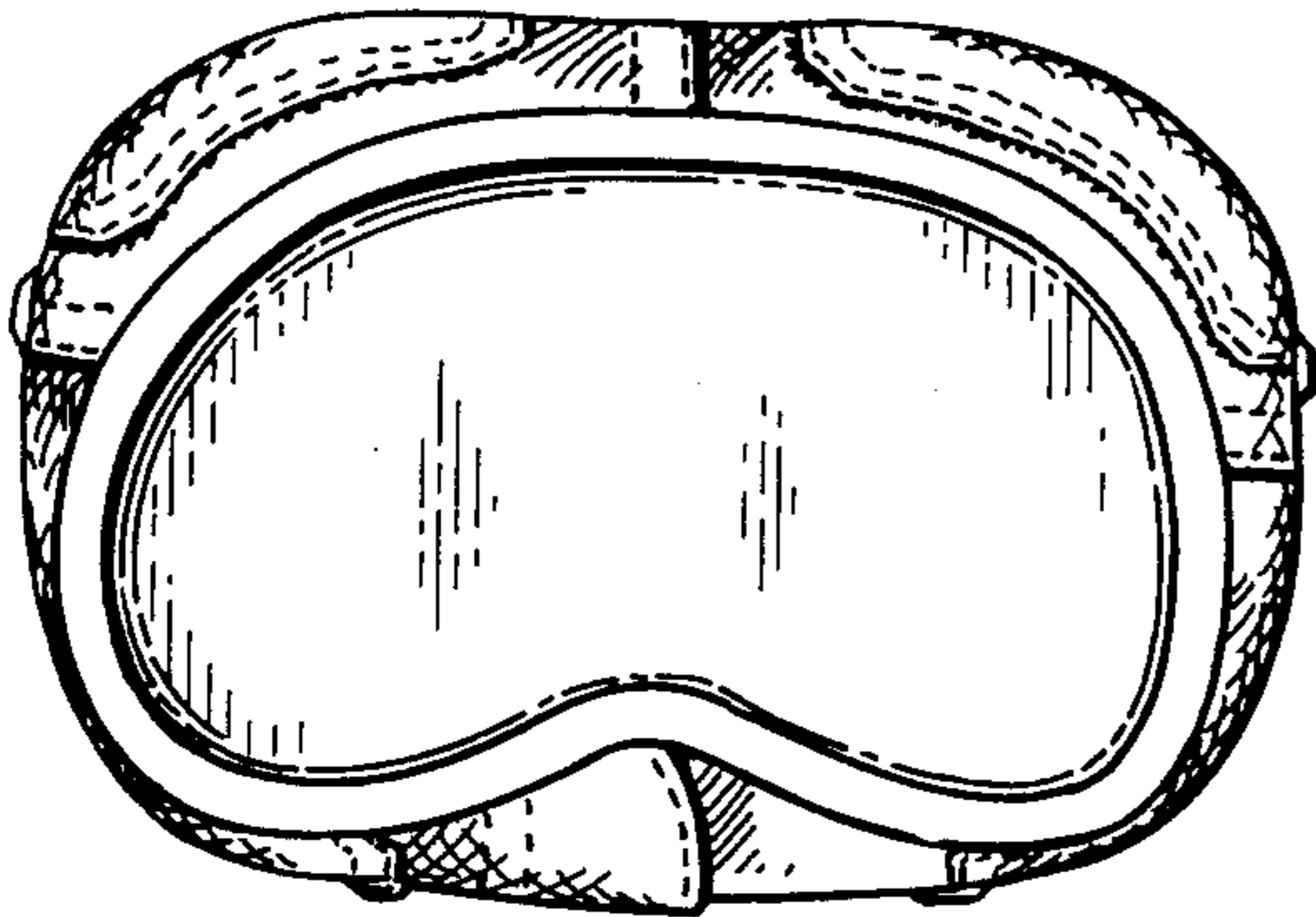

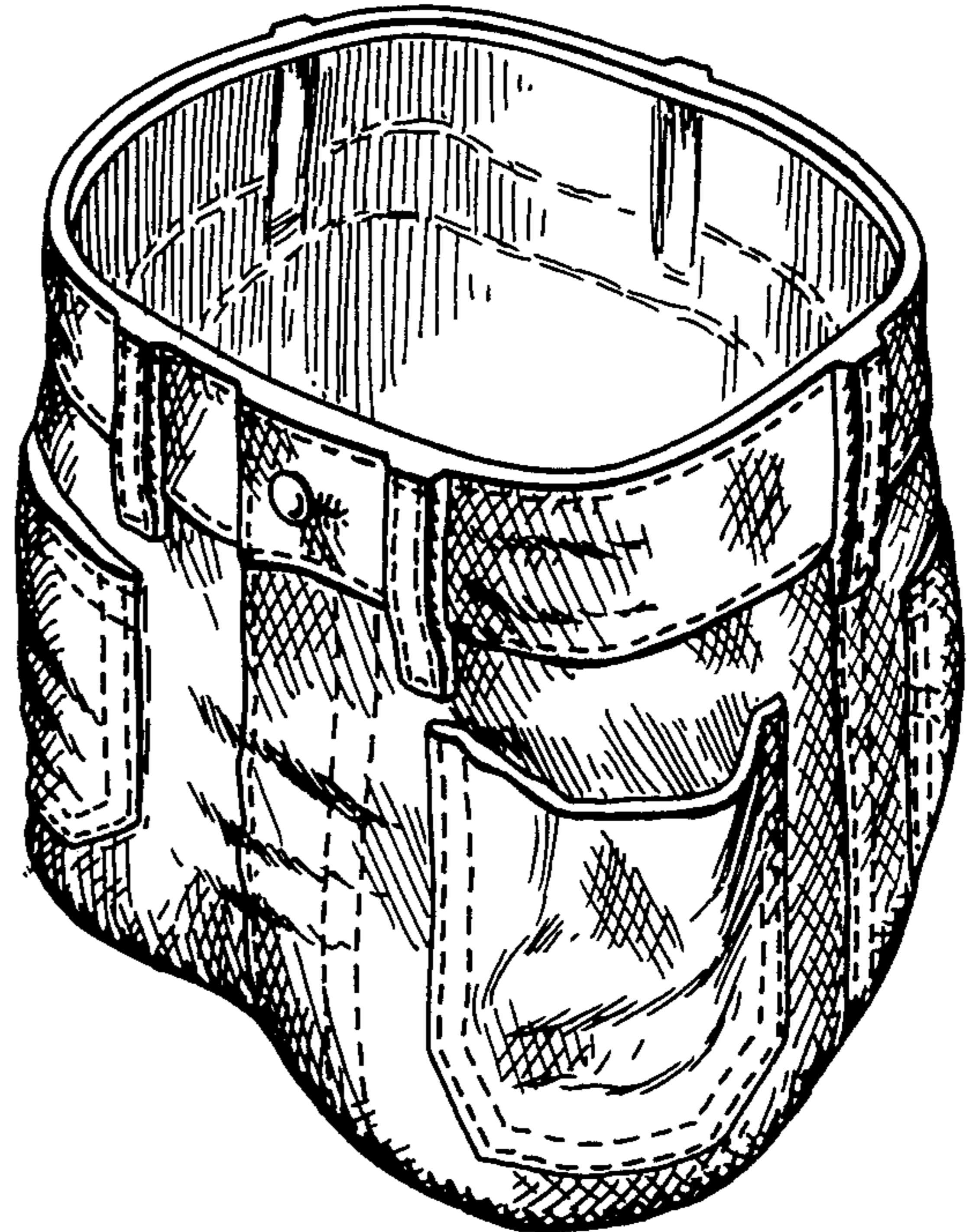

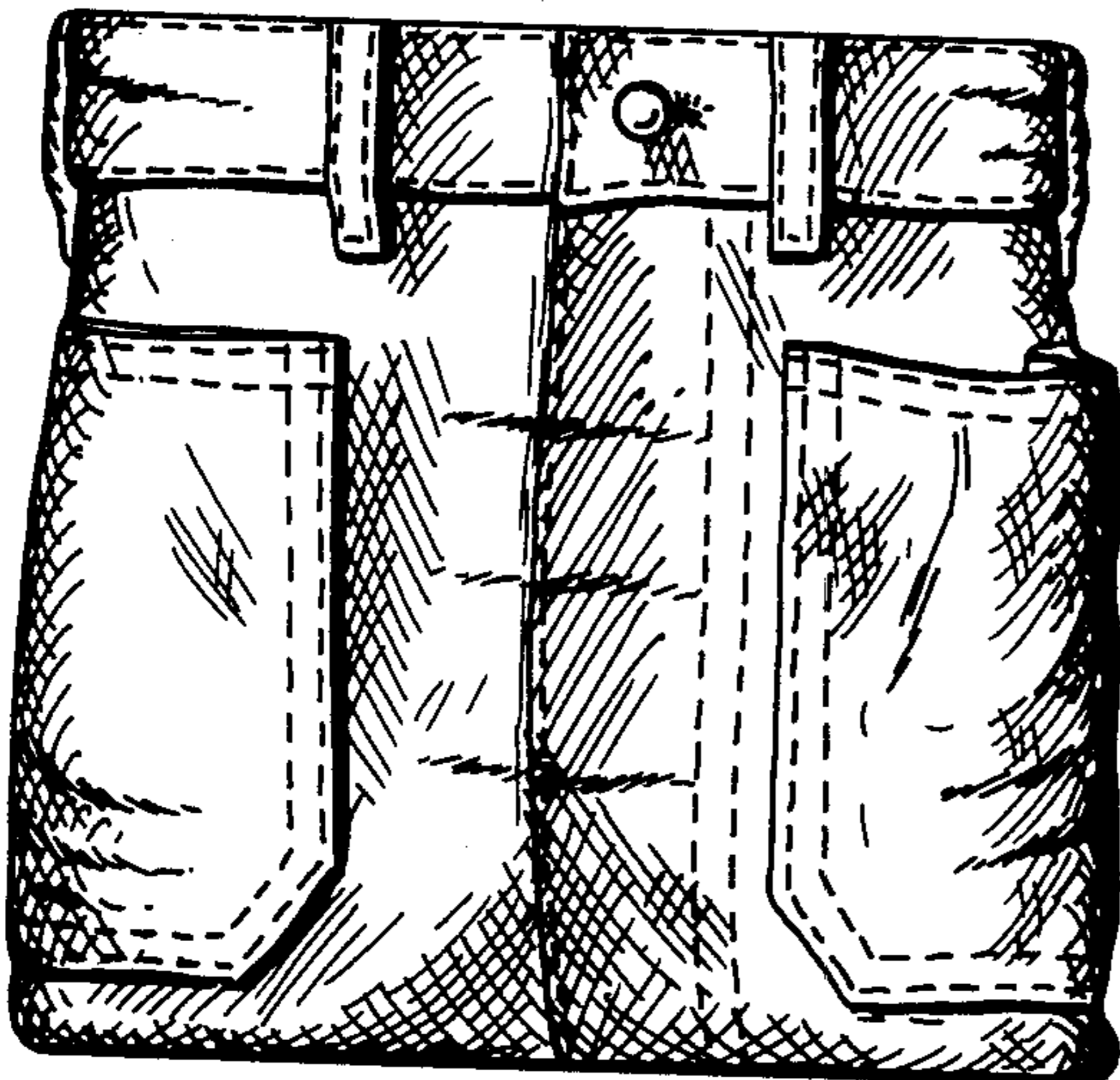

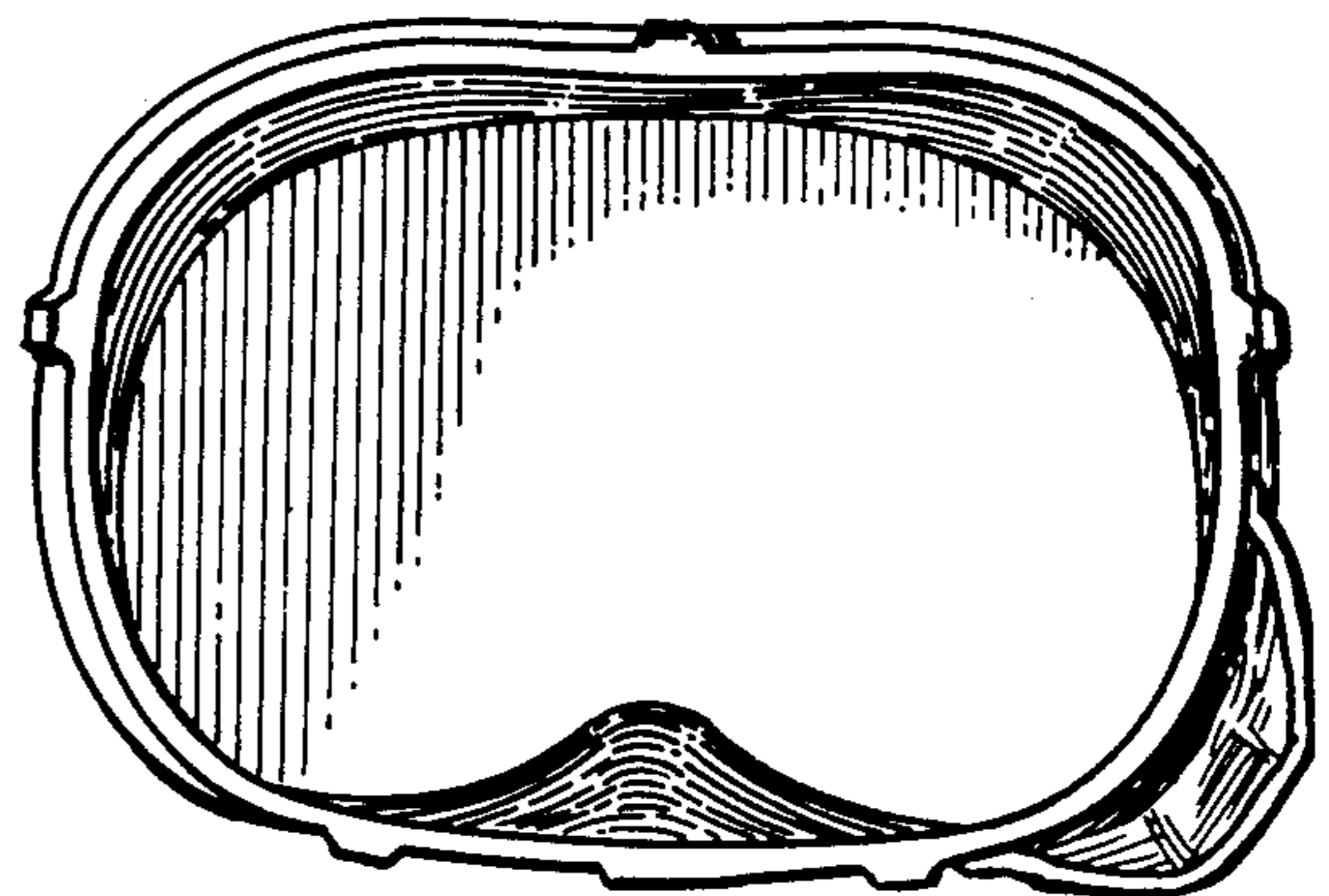

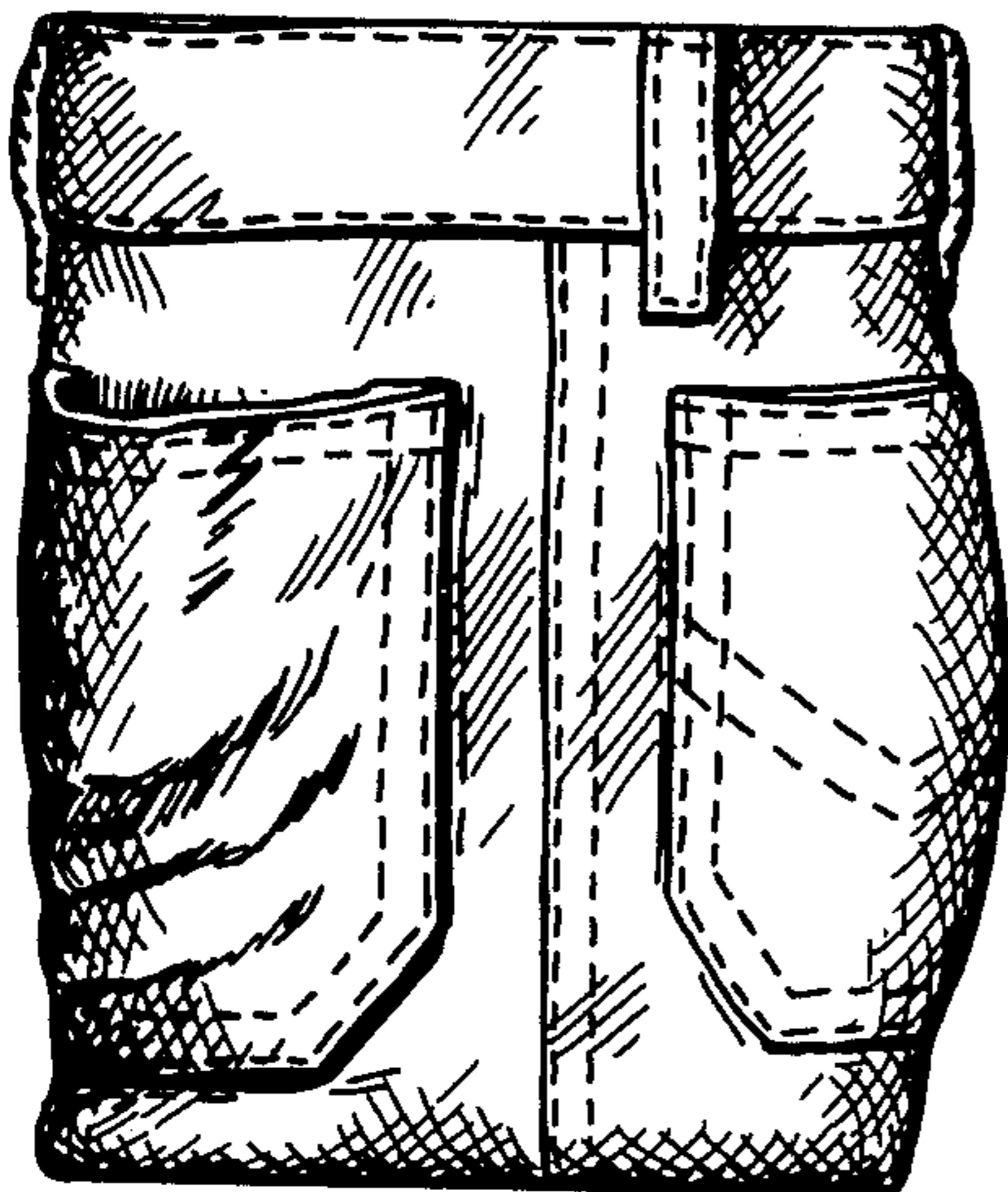

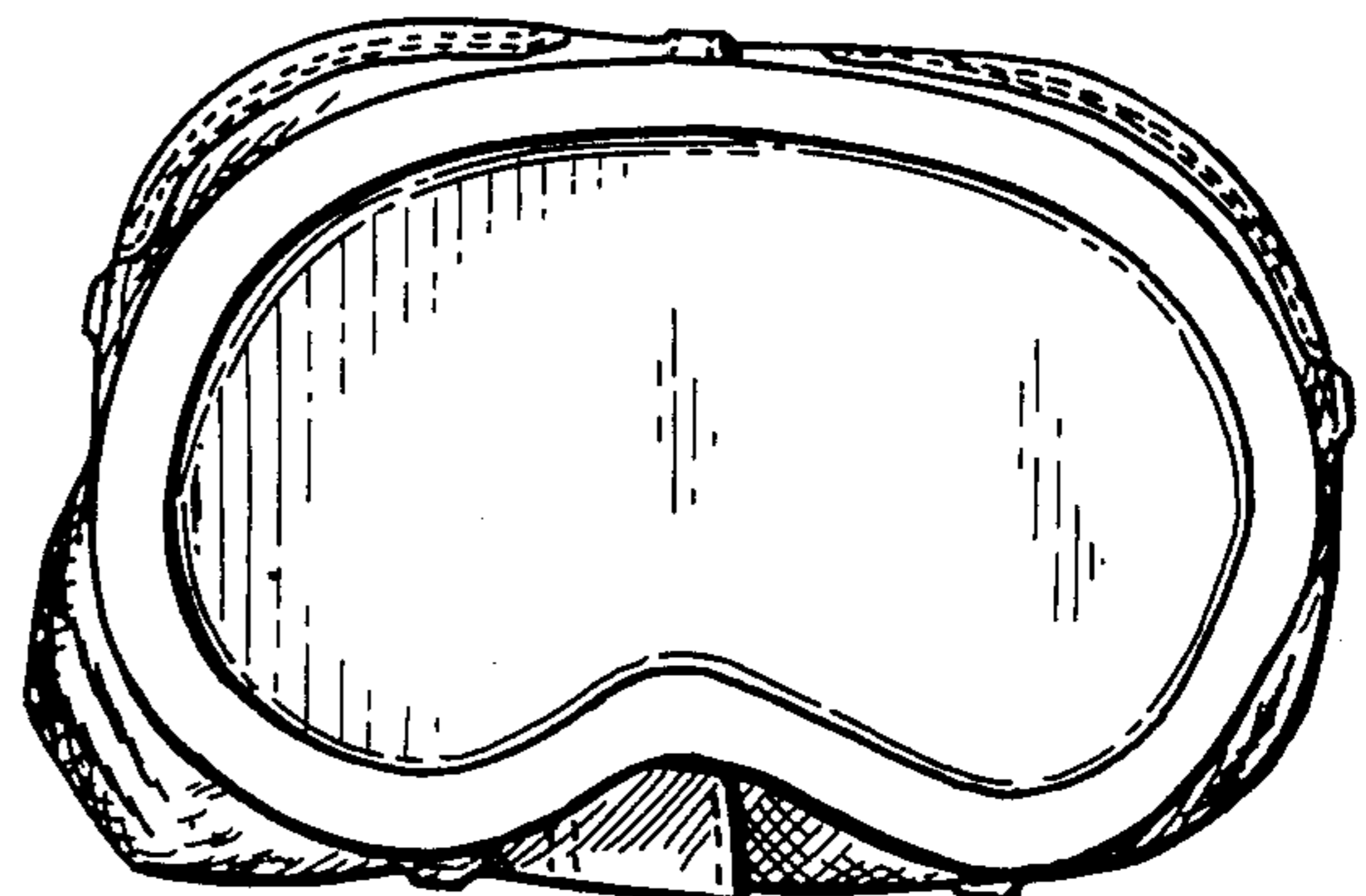

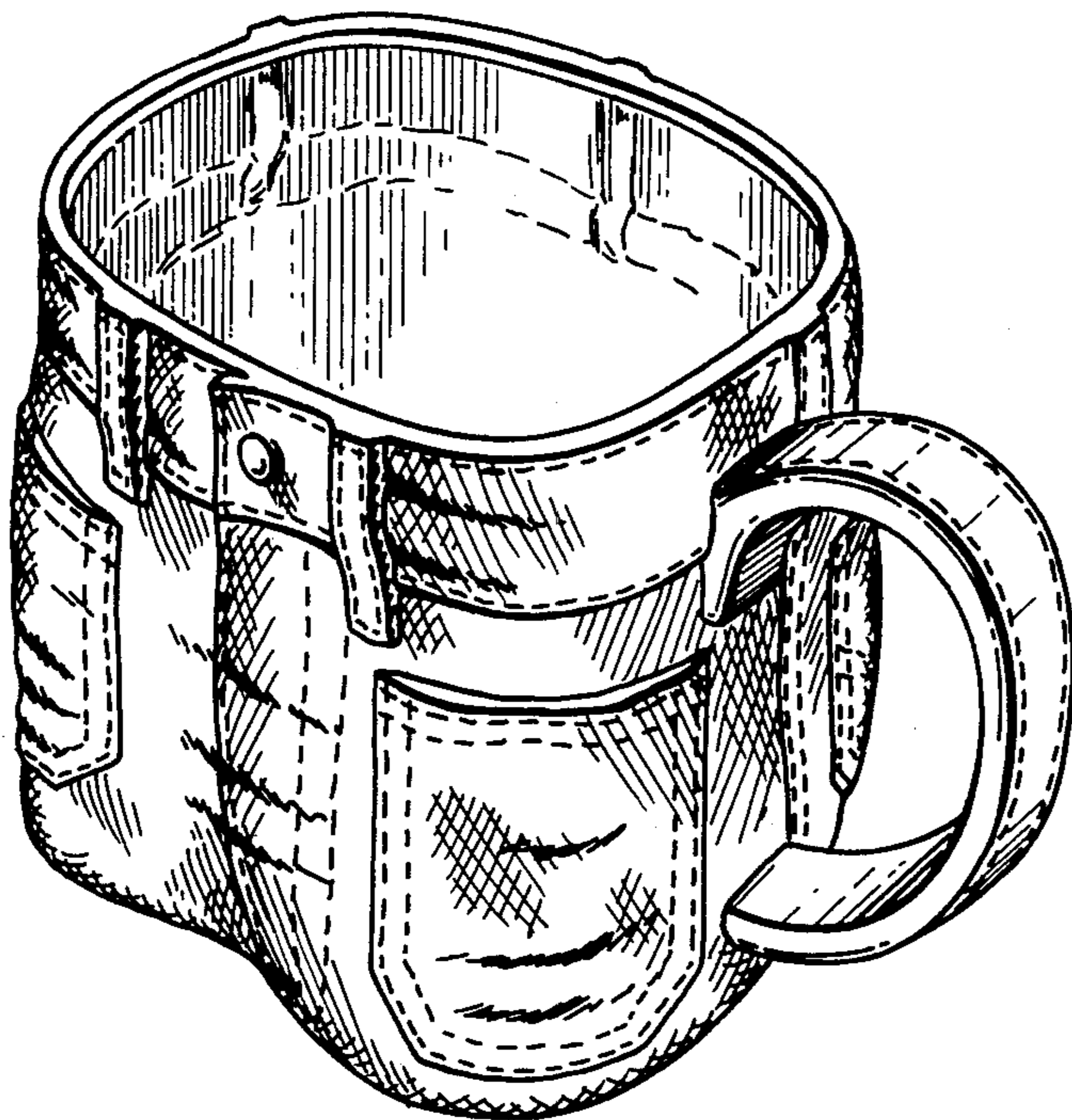

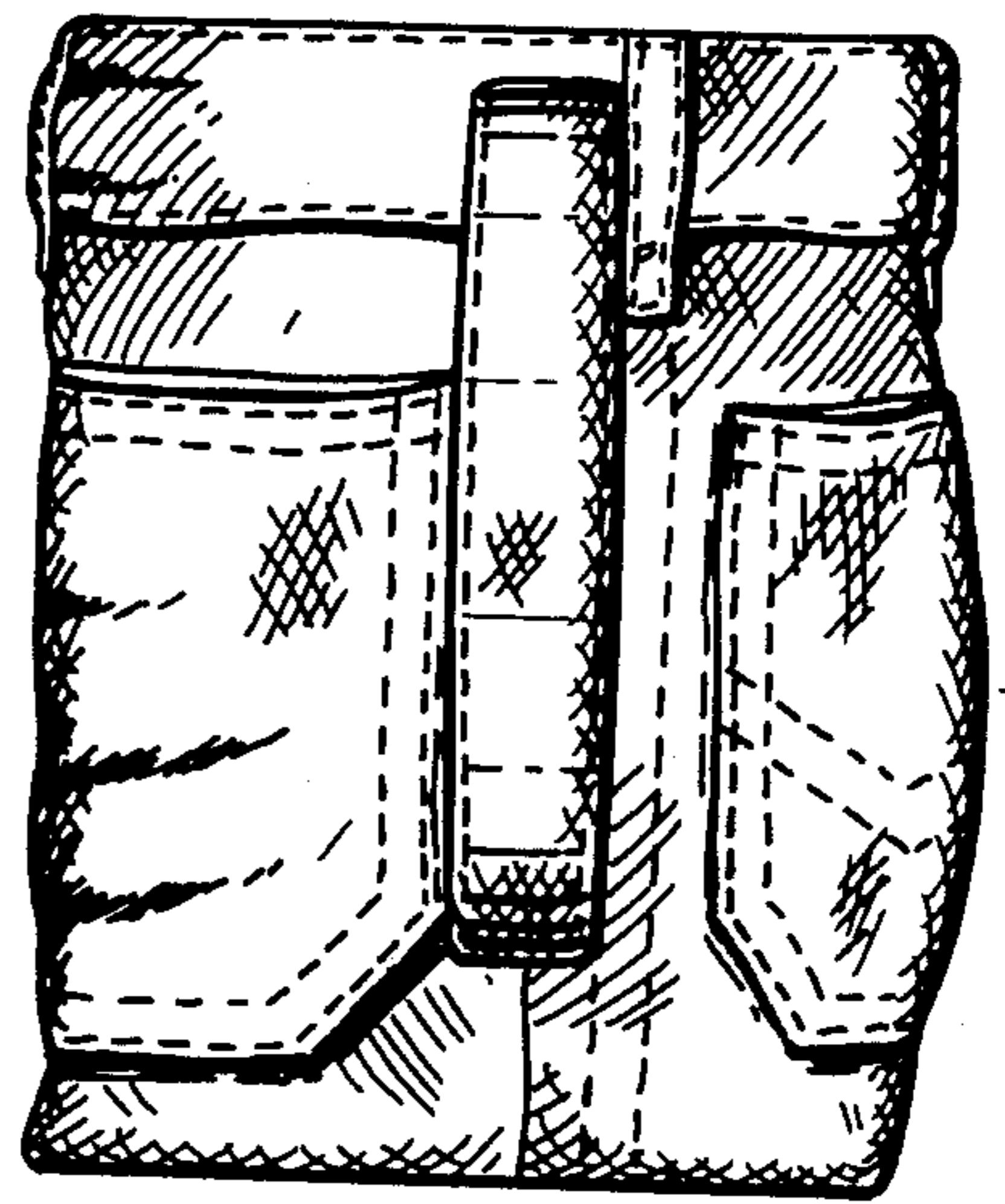

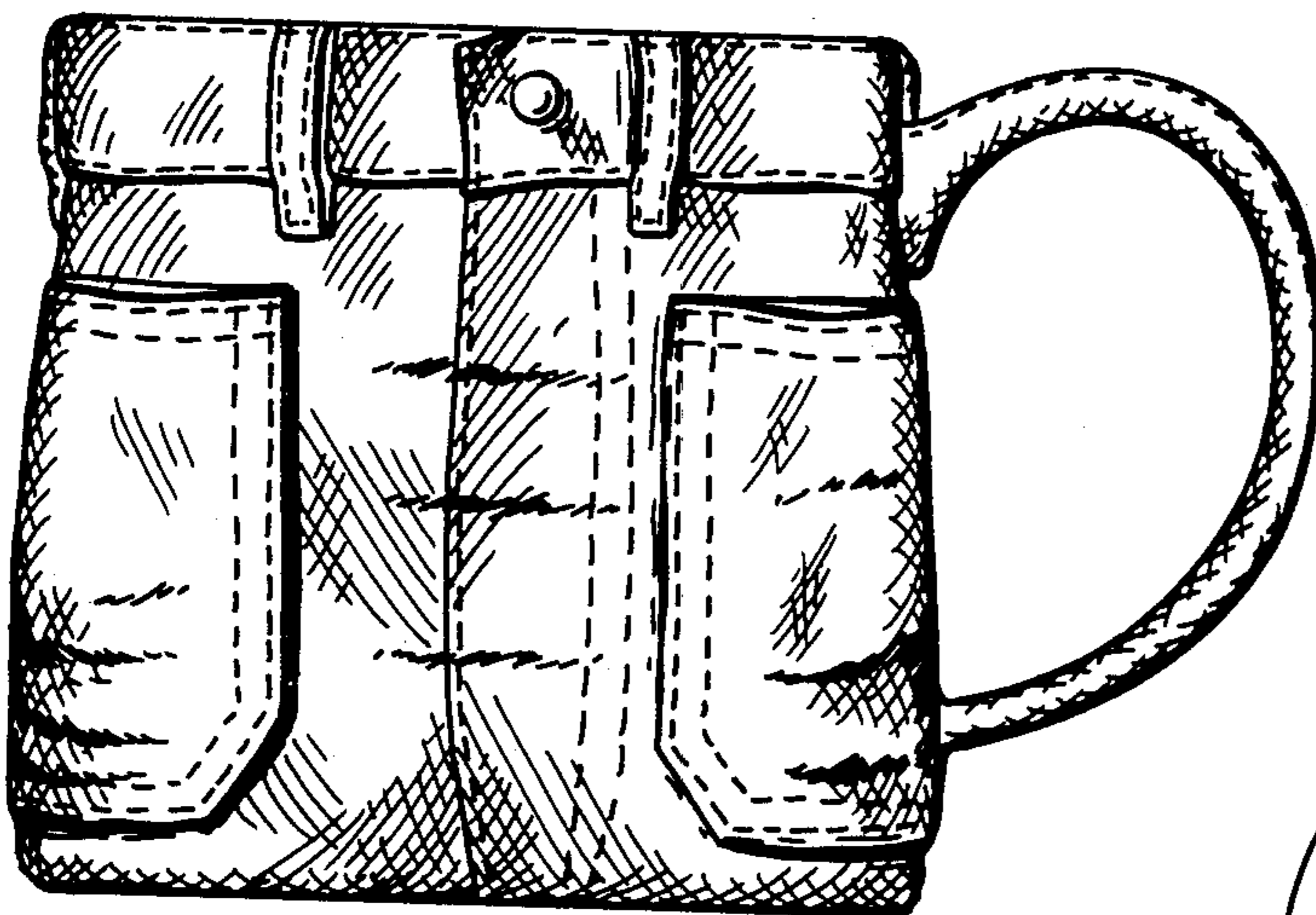

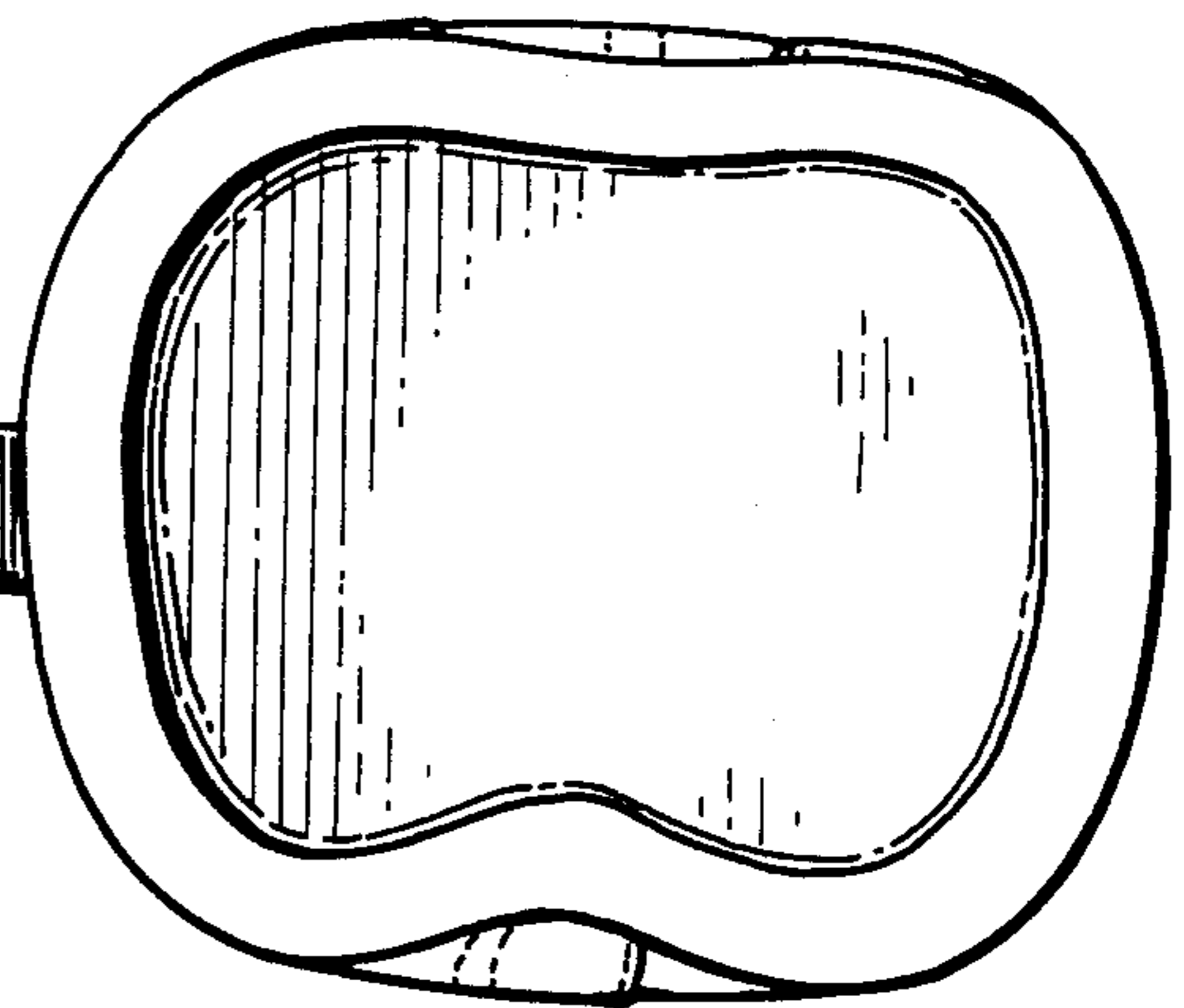
