and desk set base, as shown and described.

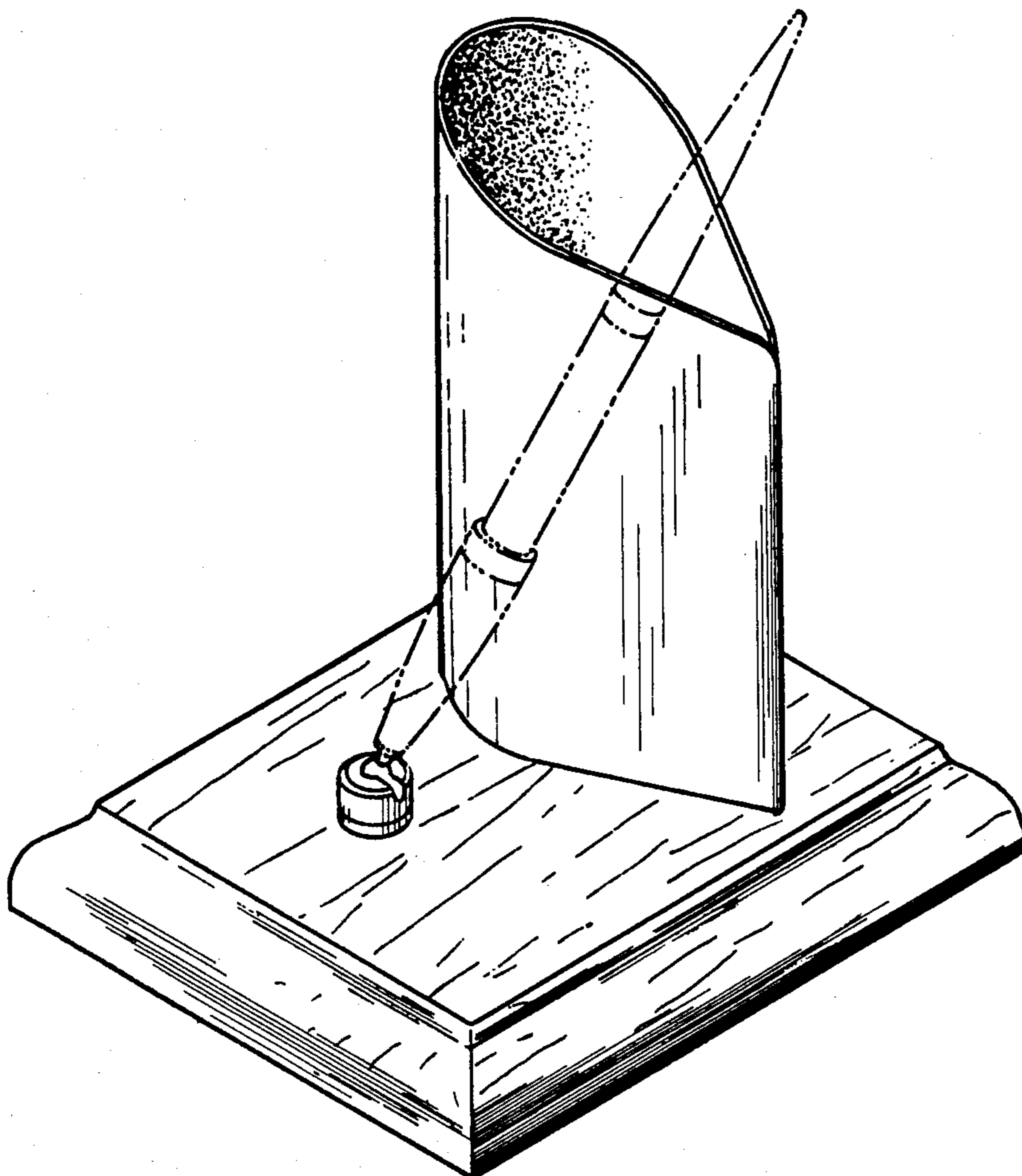
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view.



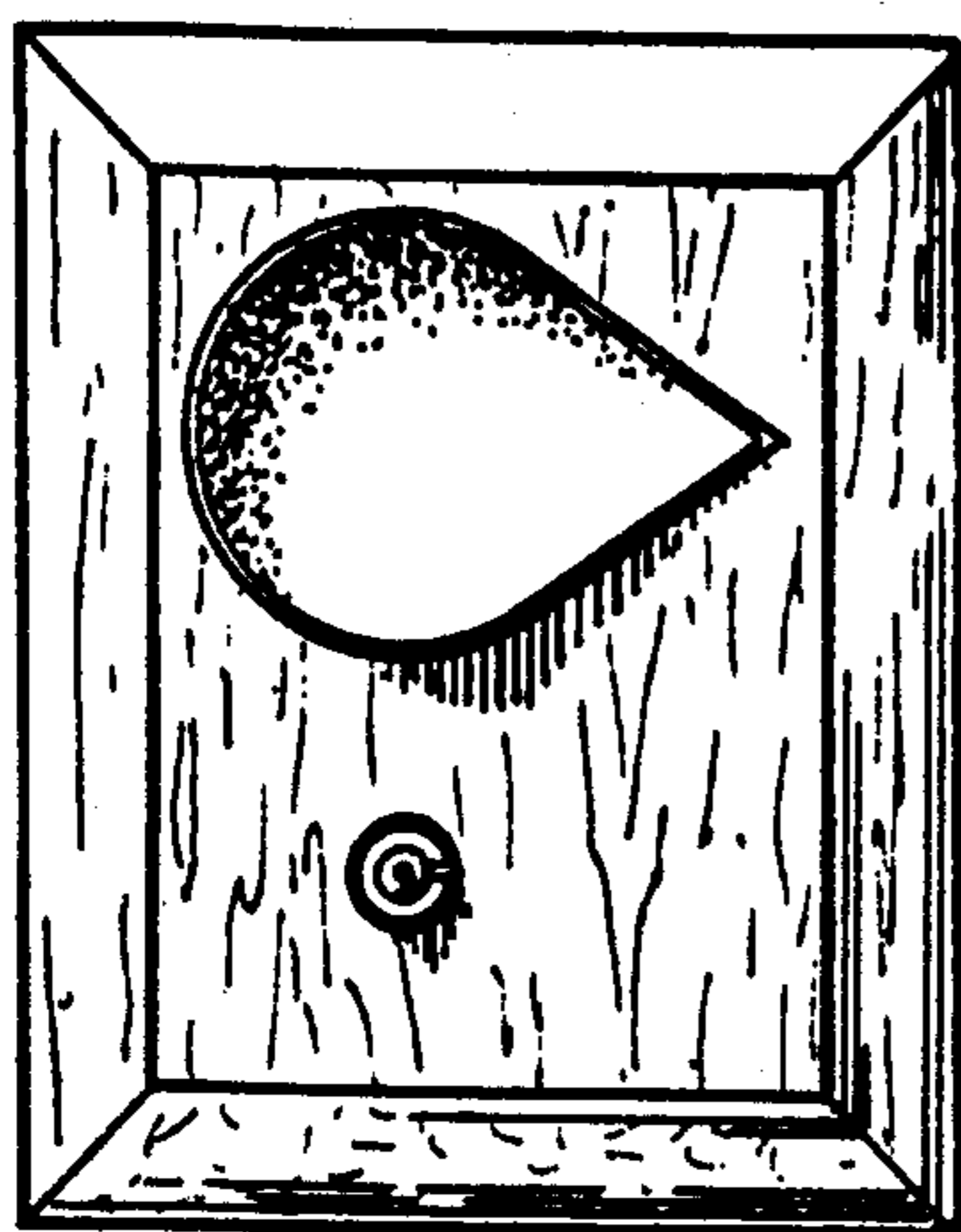

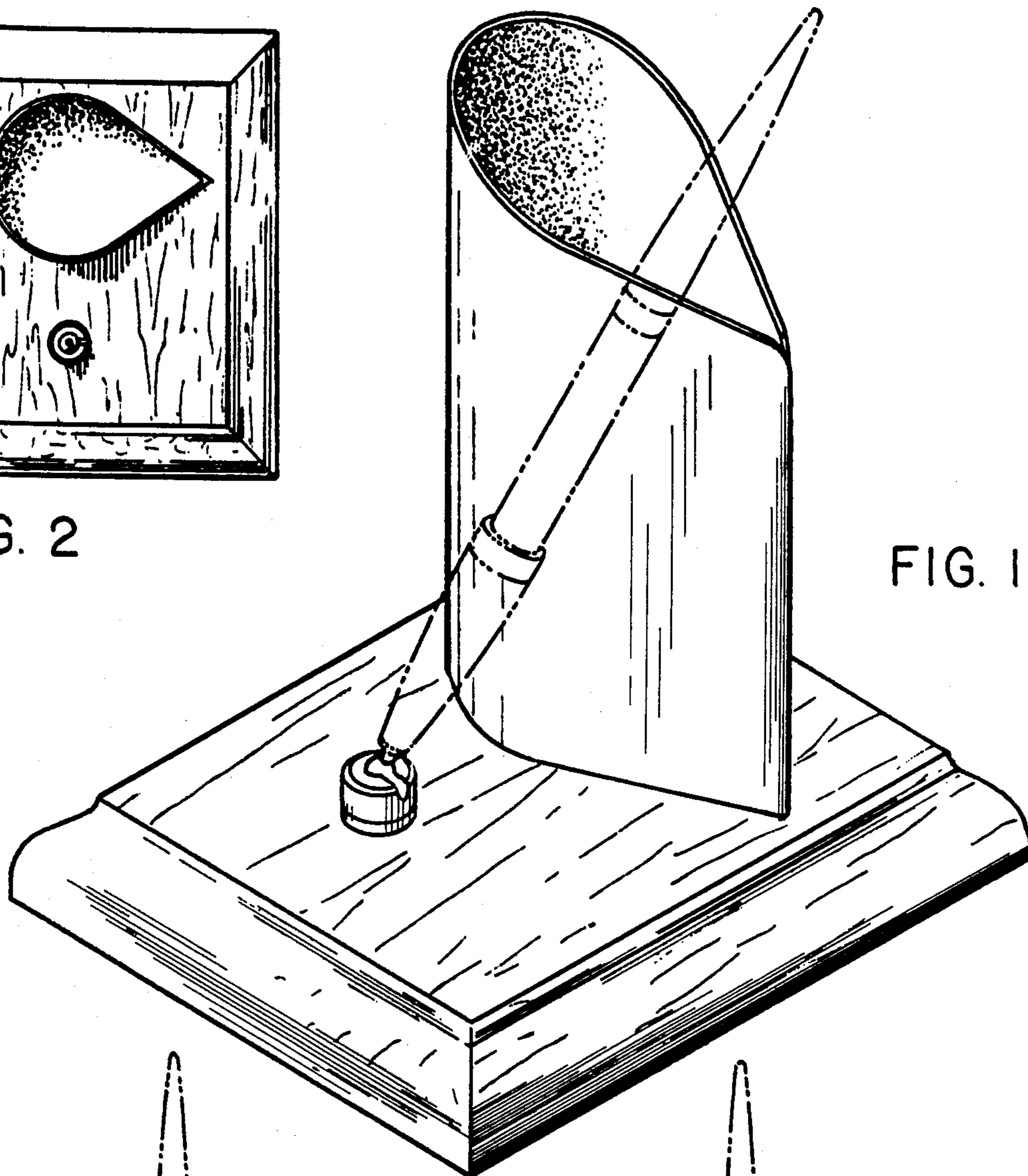

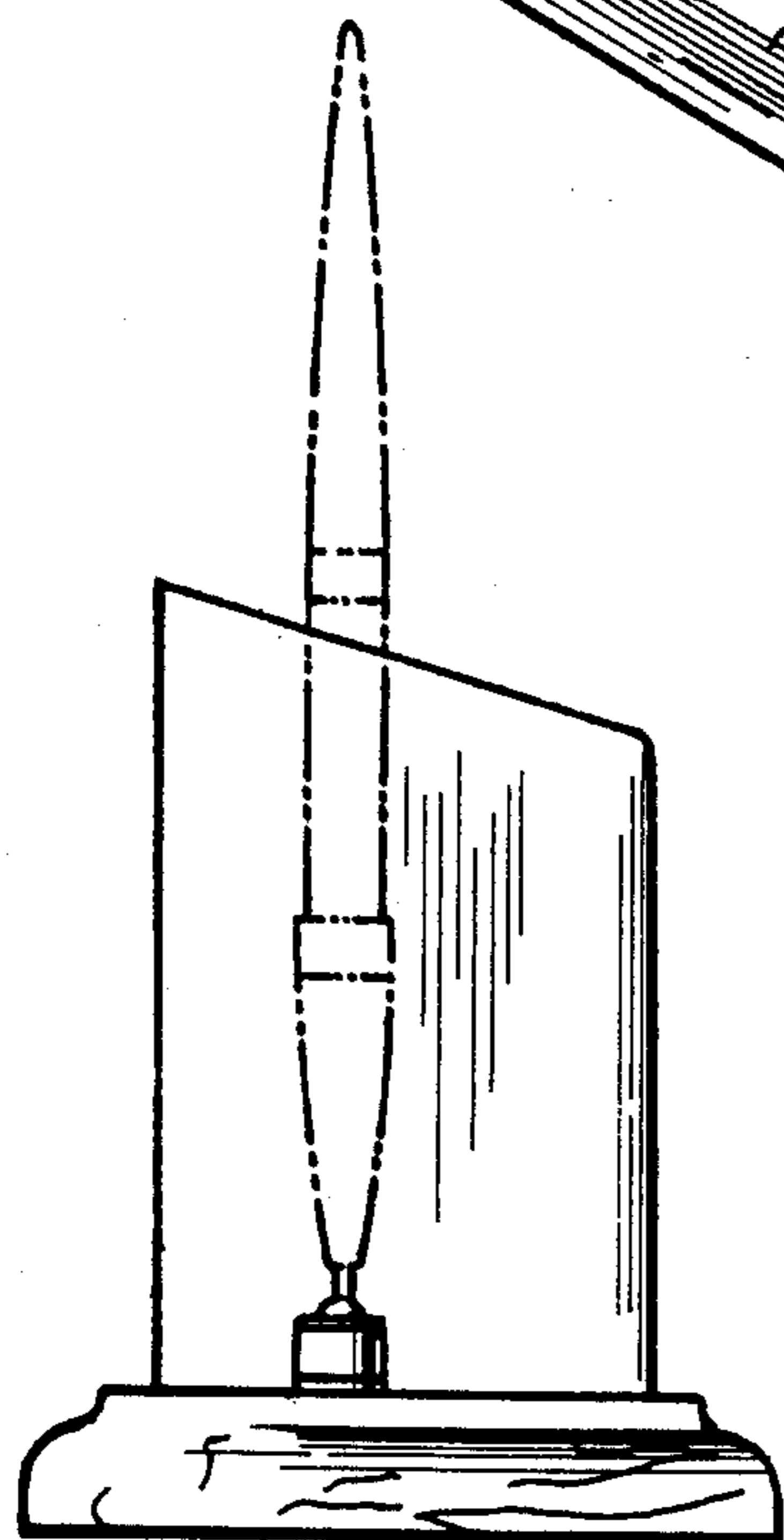

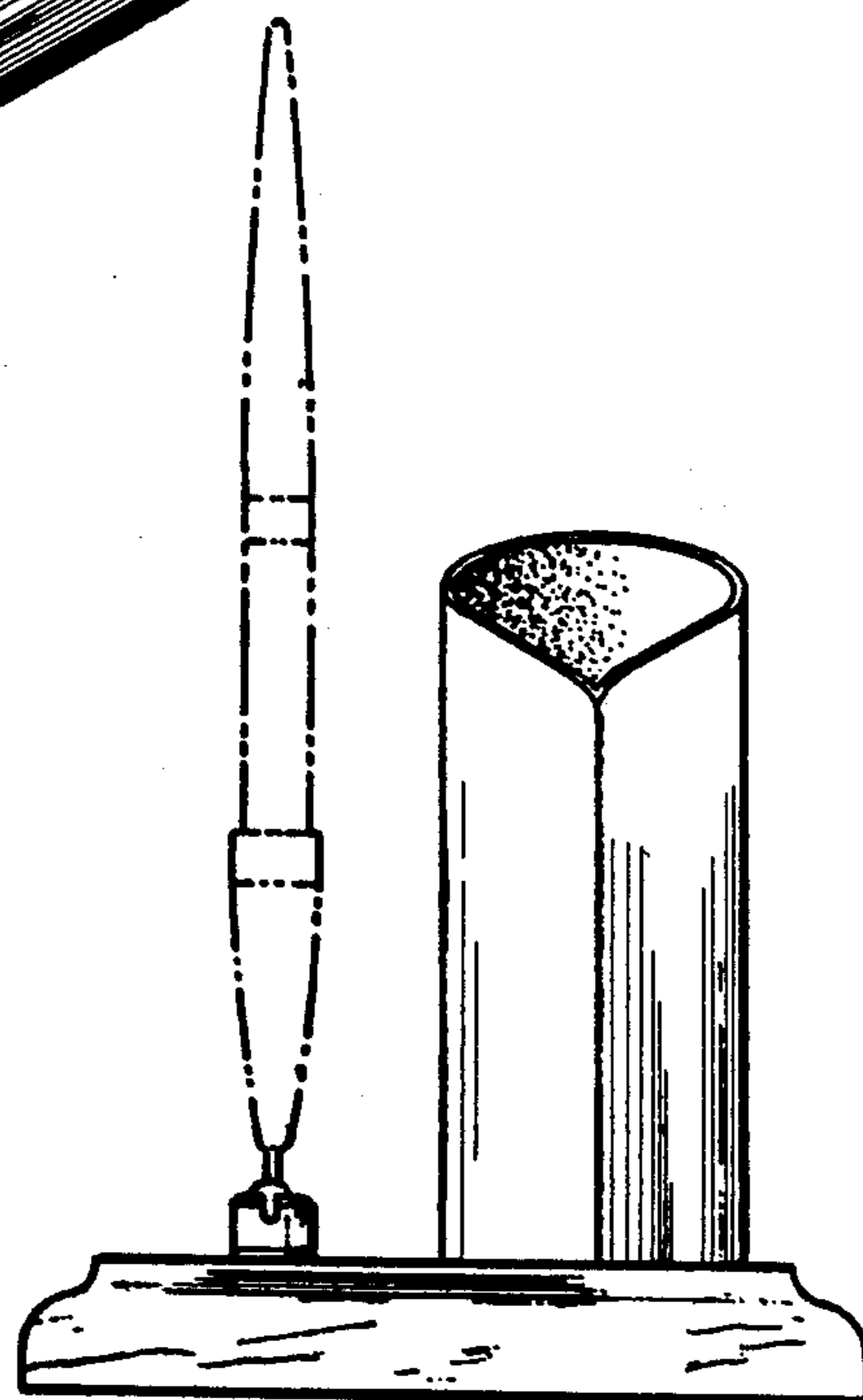
