DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clip for a writing instrument or similar article showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;


FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1 and showing the sword in relief with respect to its dark background.









