[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a multi-purpose baby reclining seat with table board, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side view thereof, (as a reclining and rocking chair with table board)

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof,

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof,

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof, and

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof, (as a horizontal cradle with casters).

FIG. 6 is a view similar to FIG. 5 showing the appearance with the table board removed.

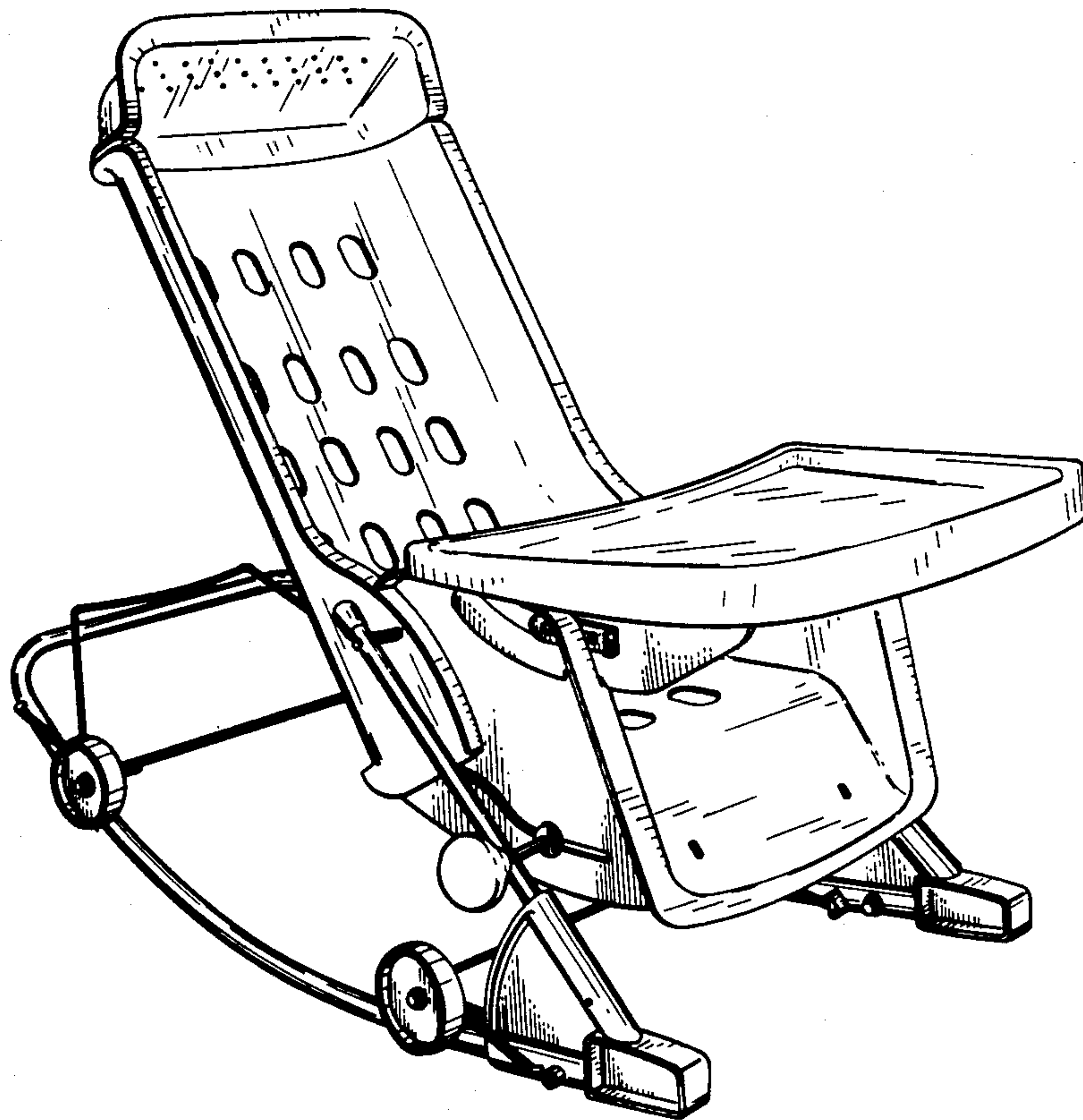

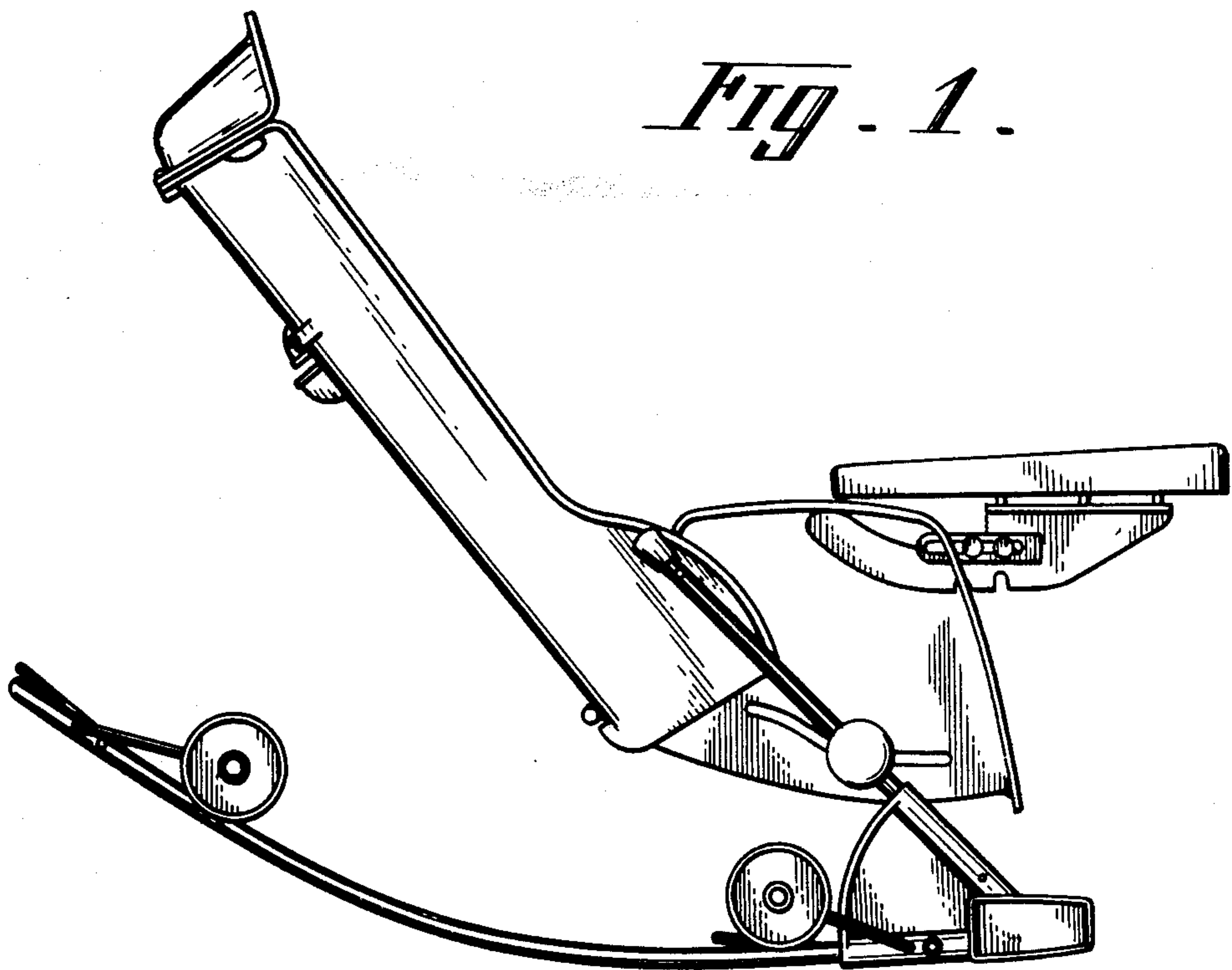
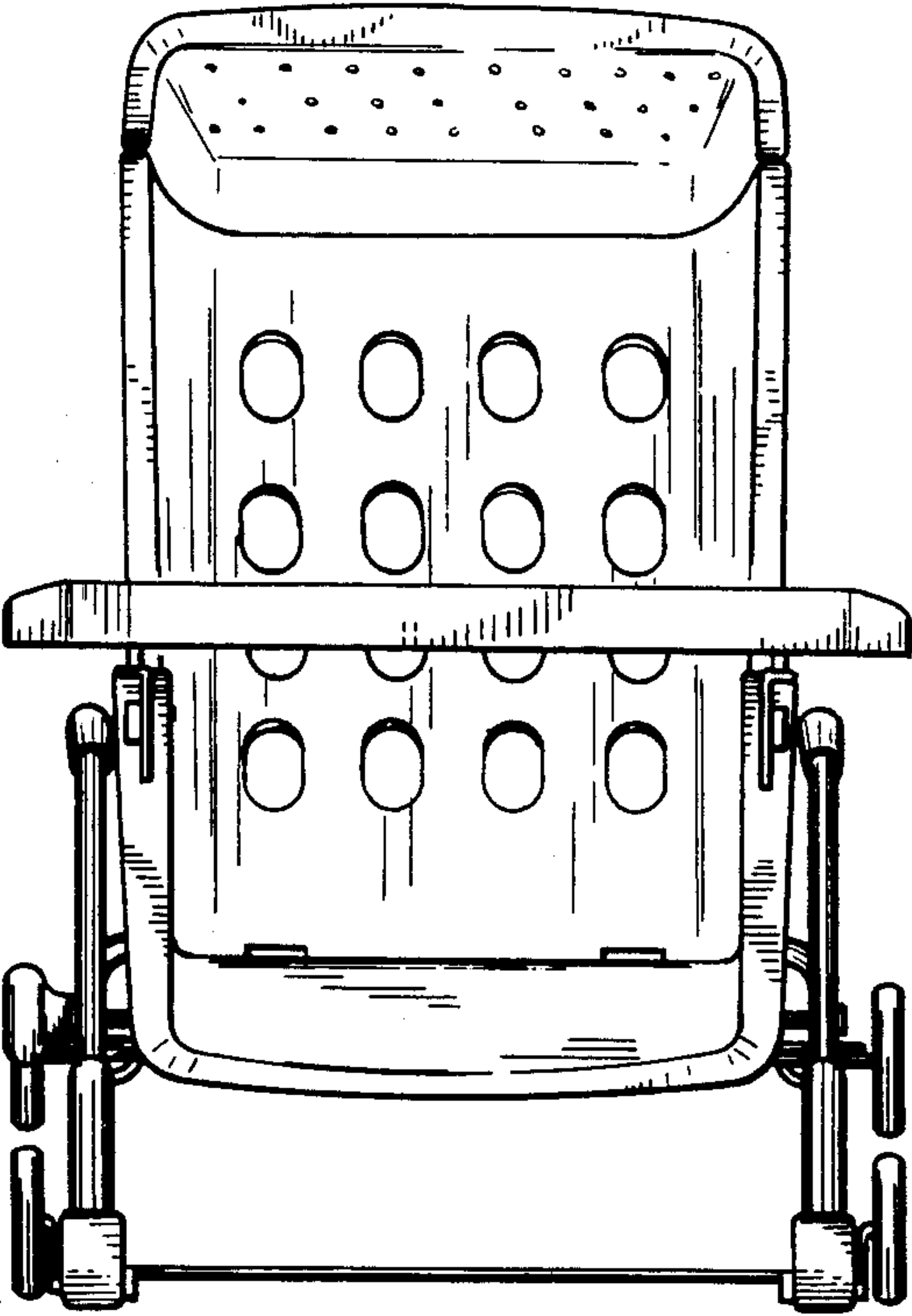

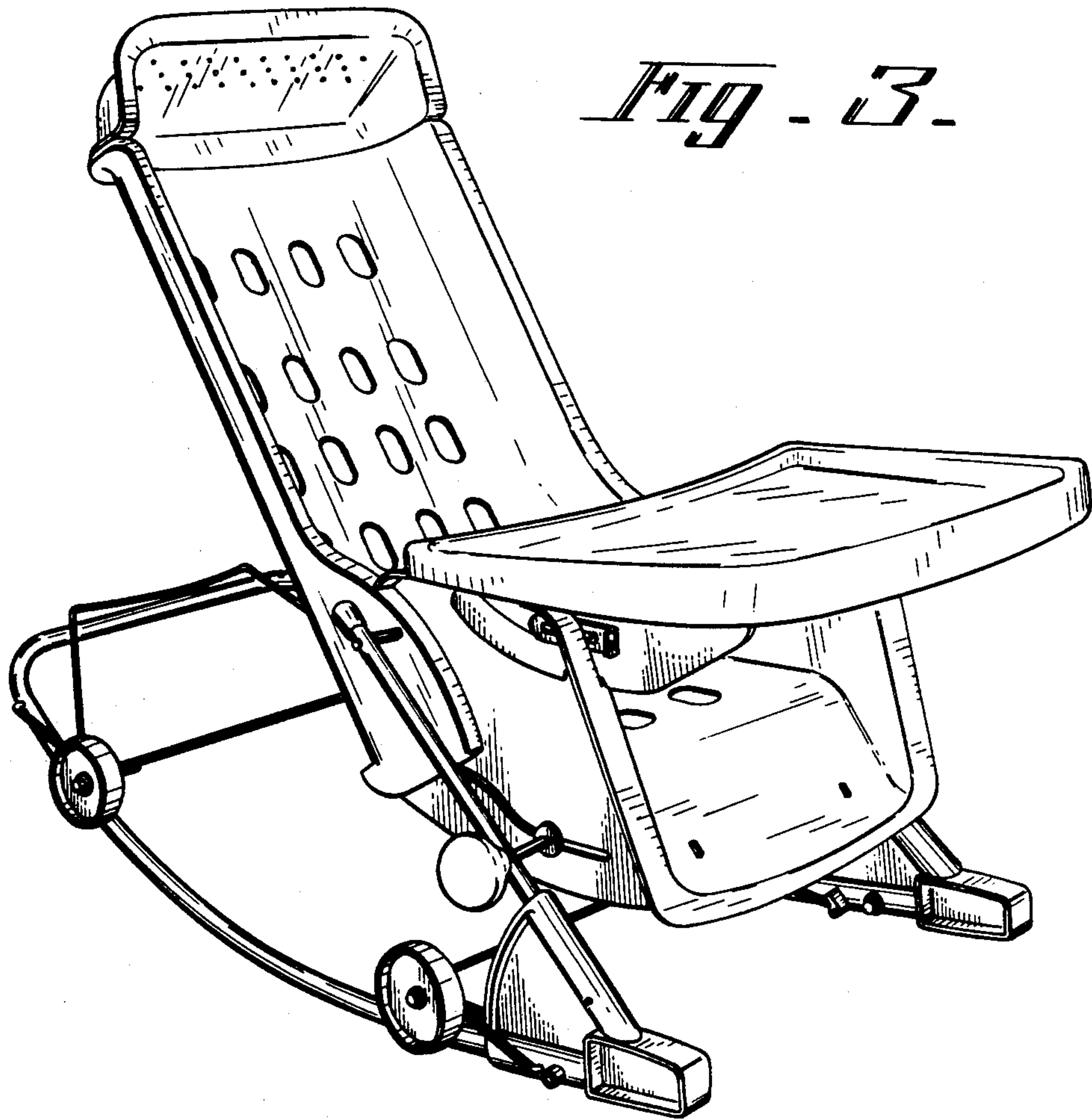

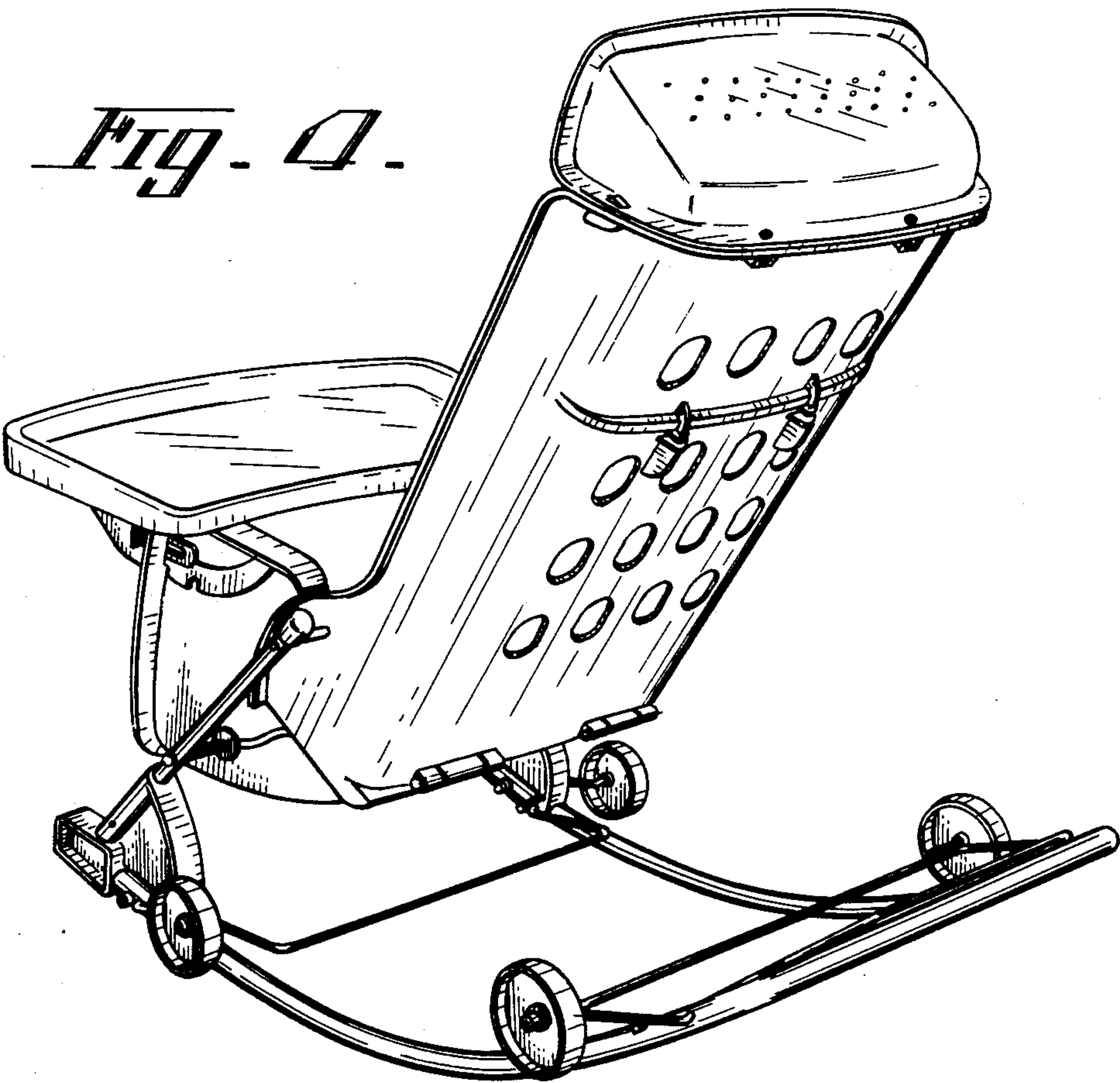
