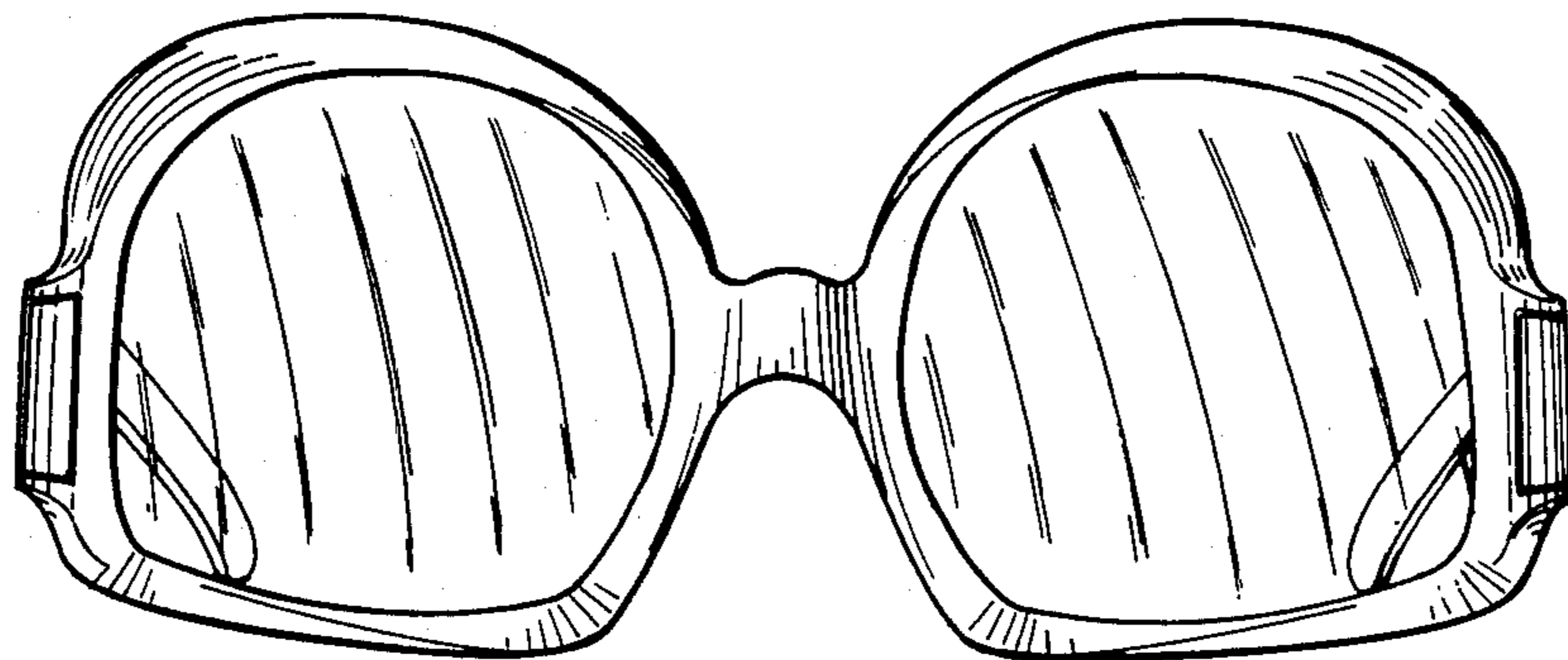

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an eyeglass frame, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



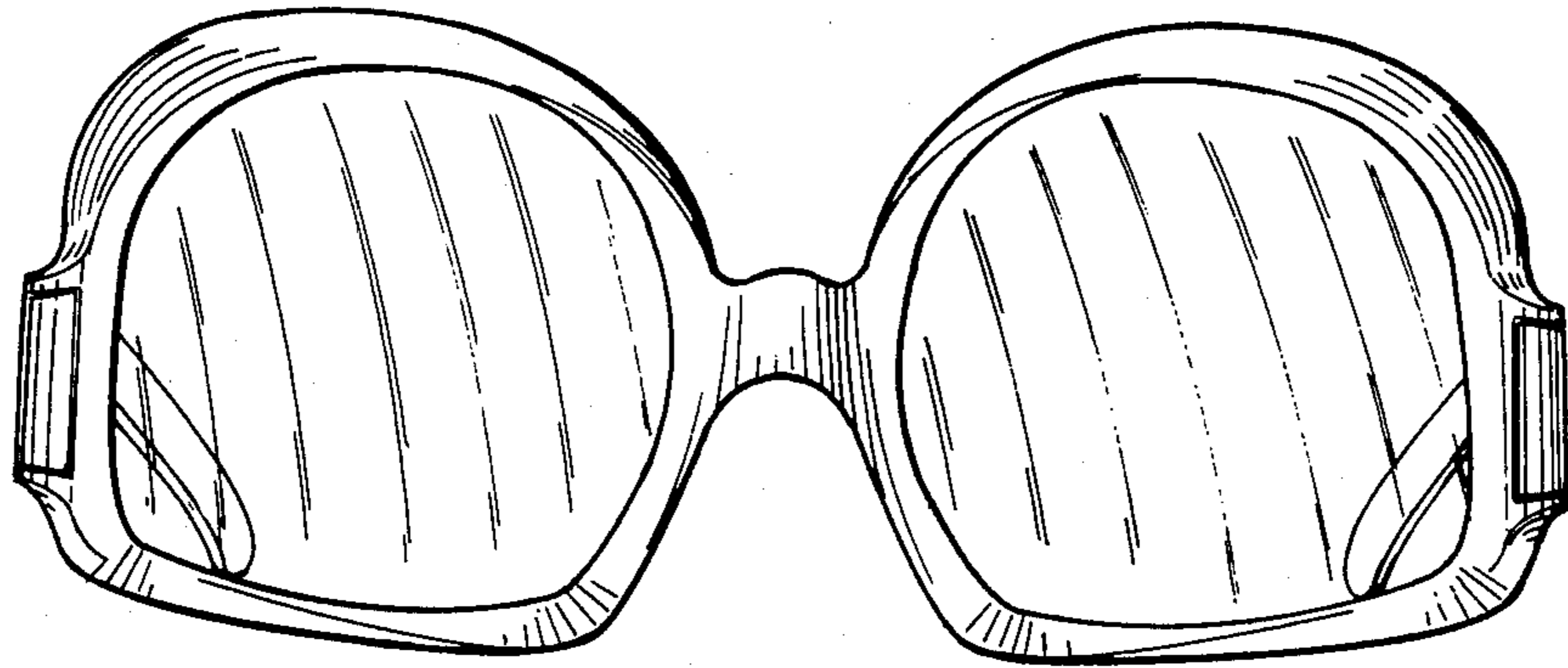

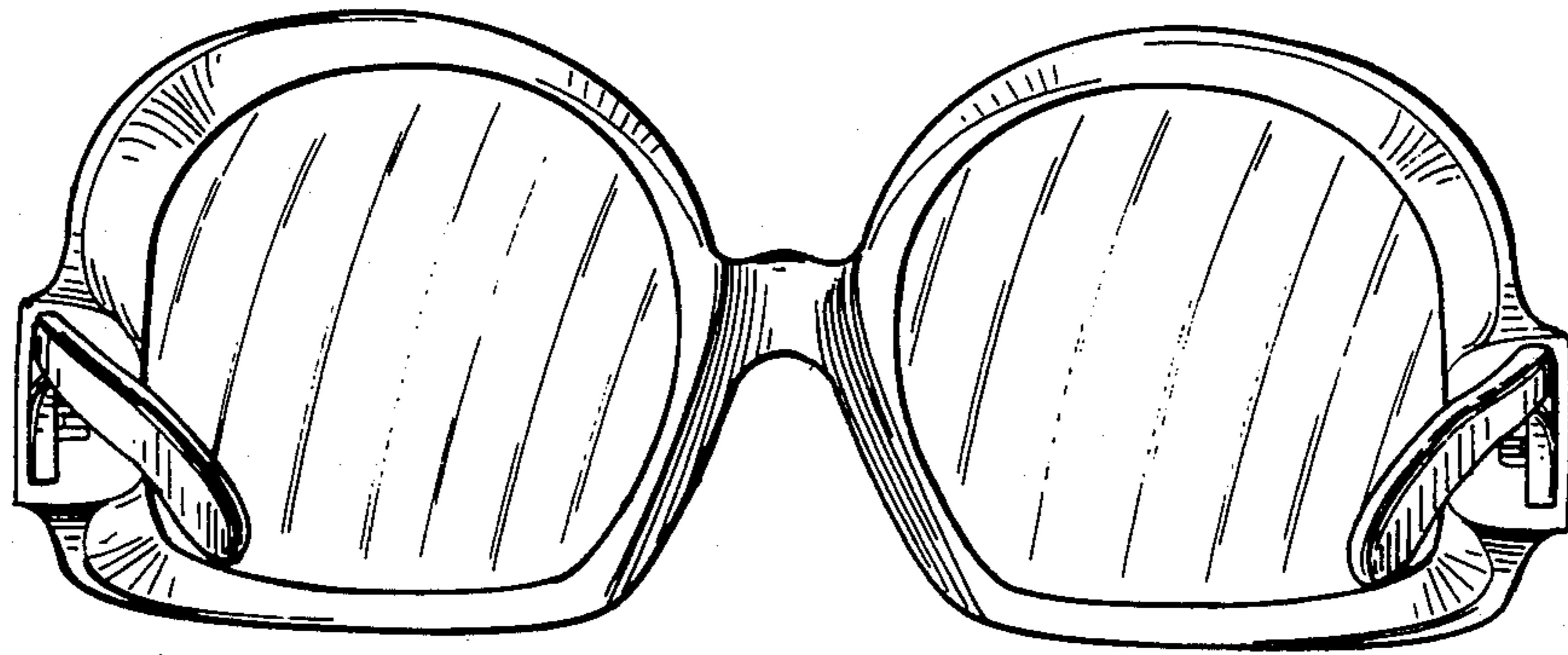

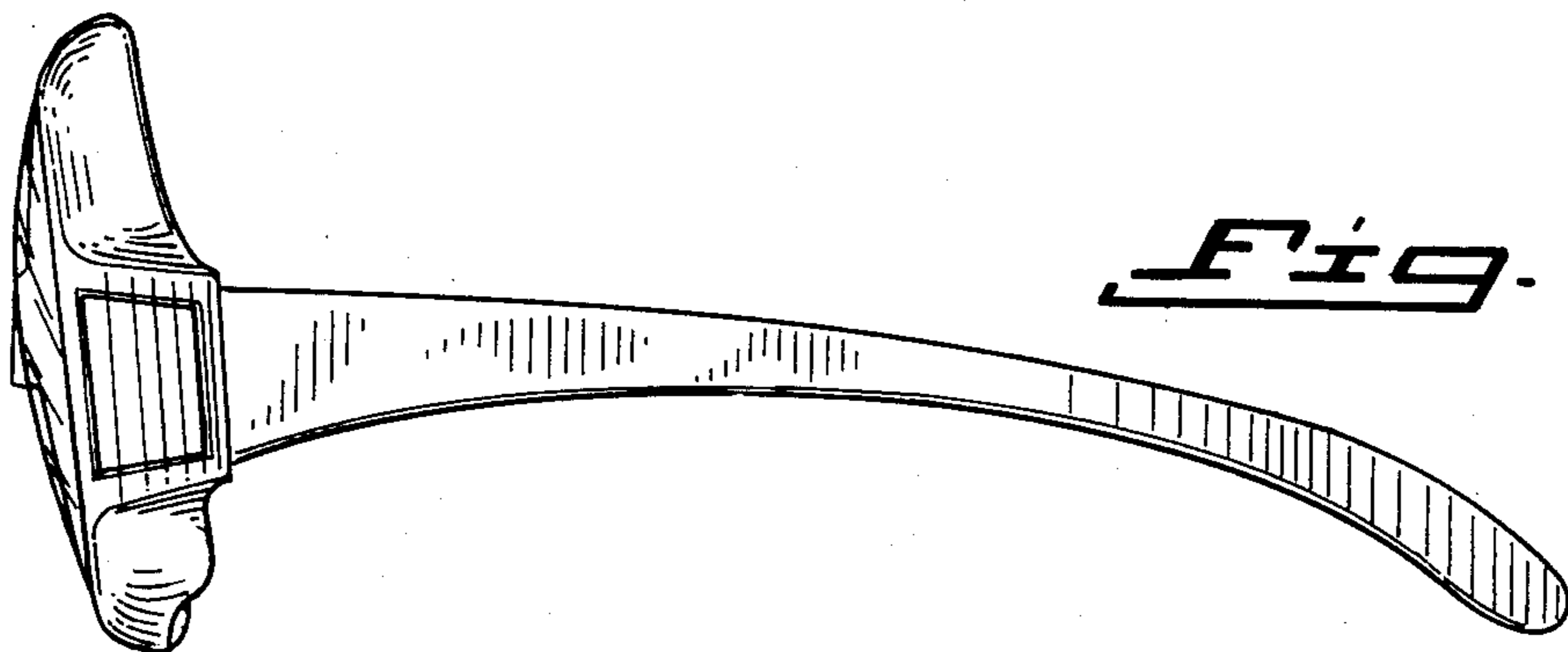

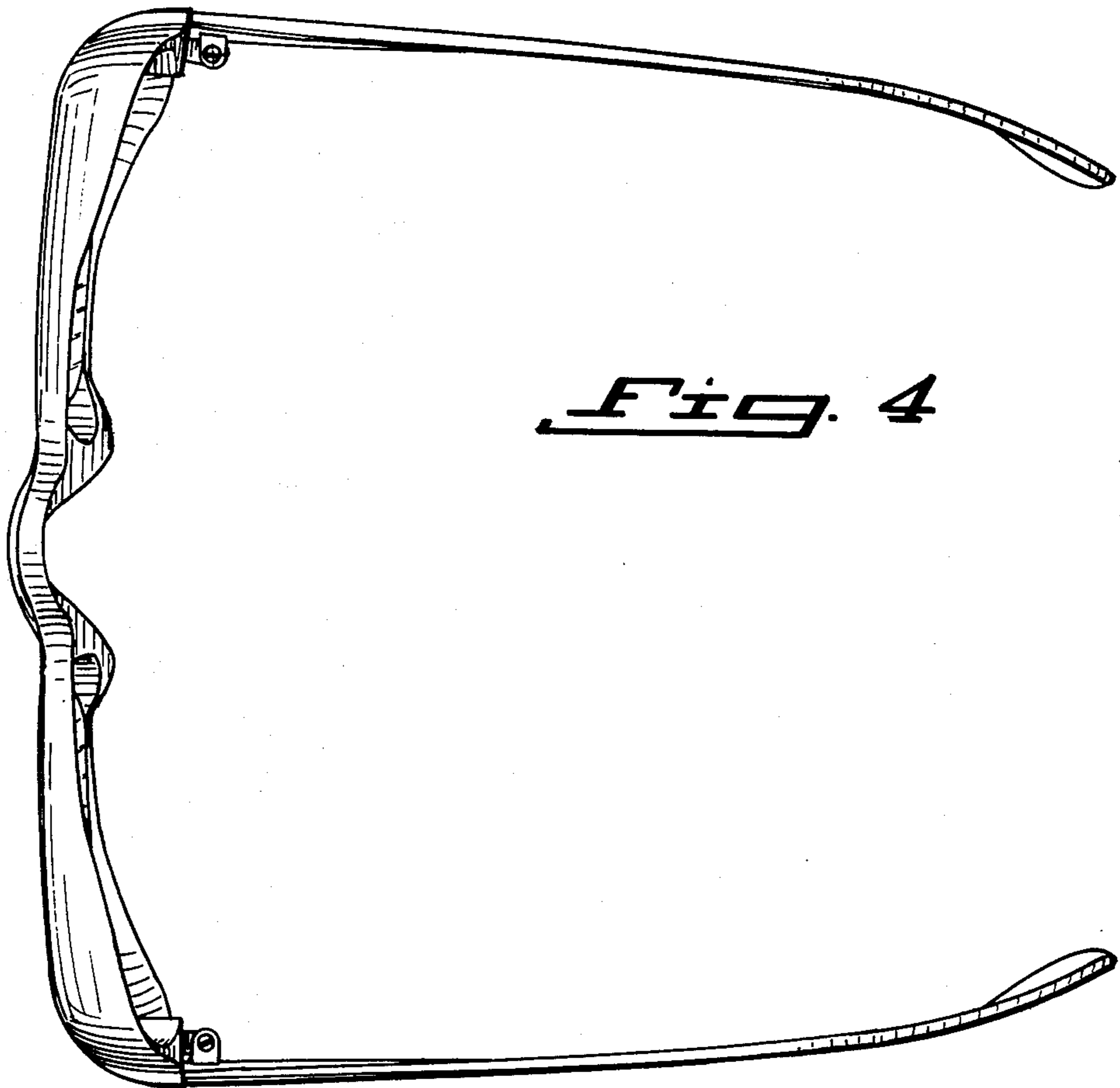

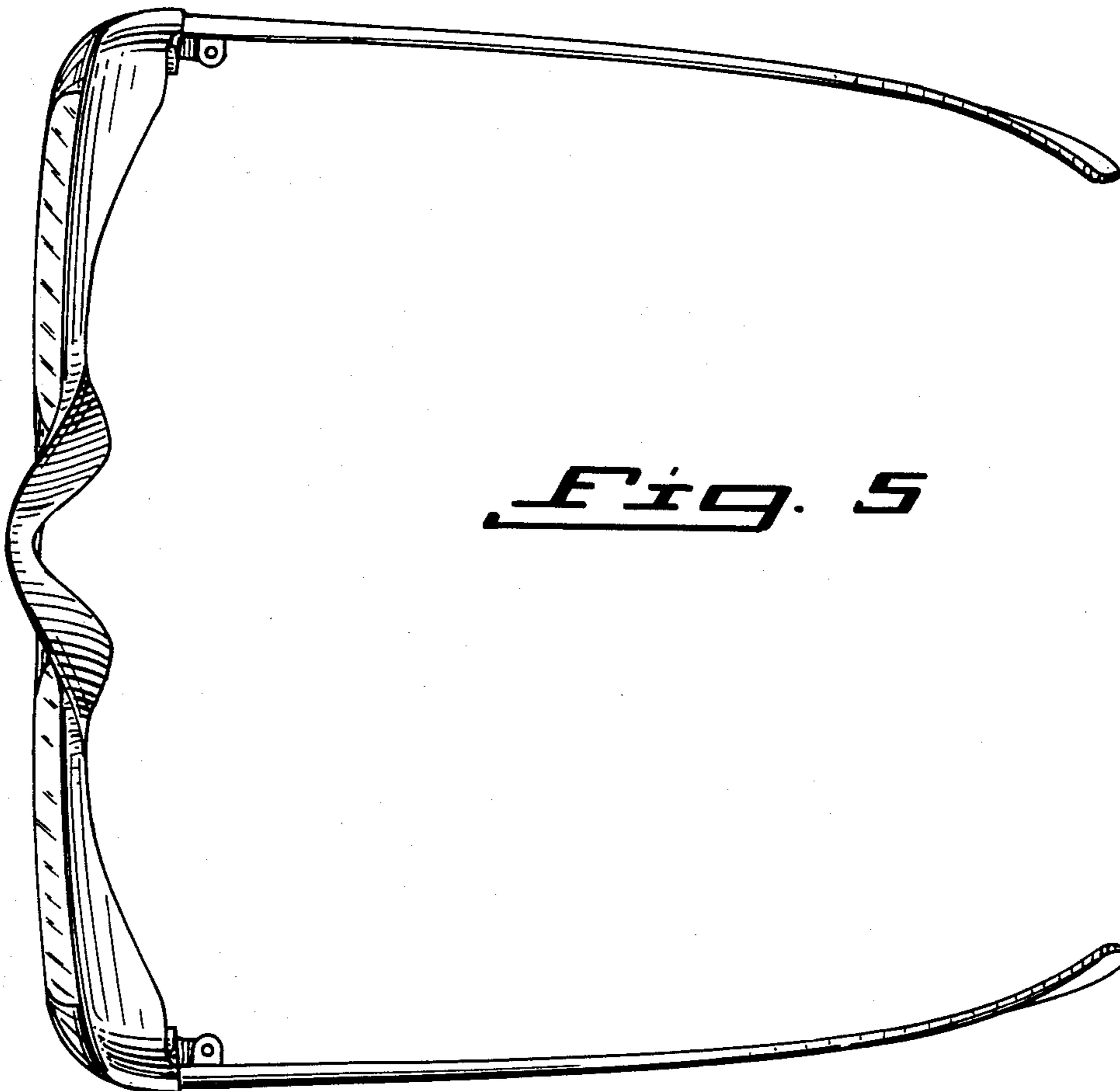
