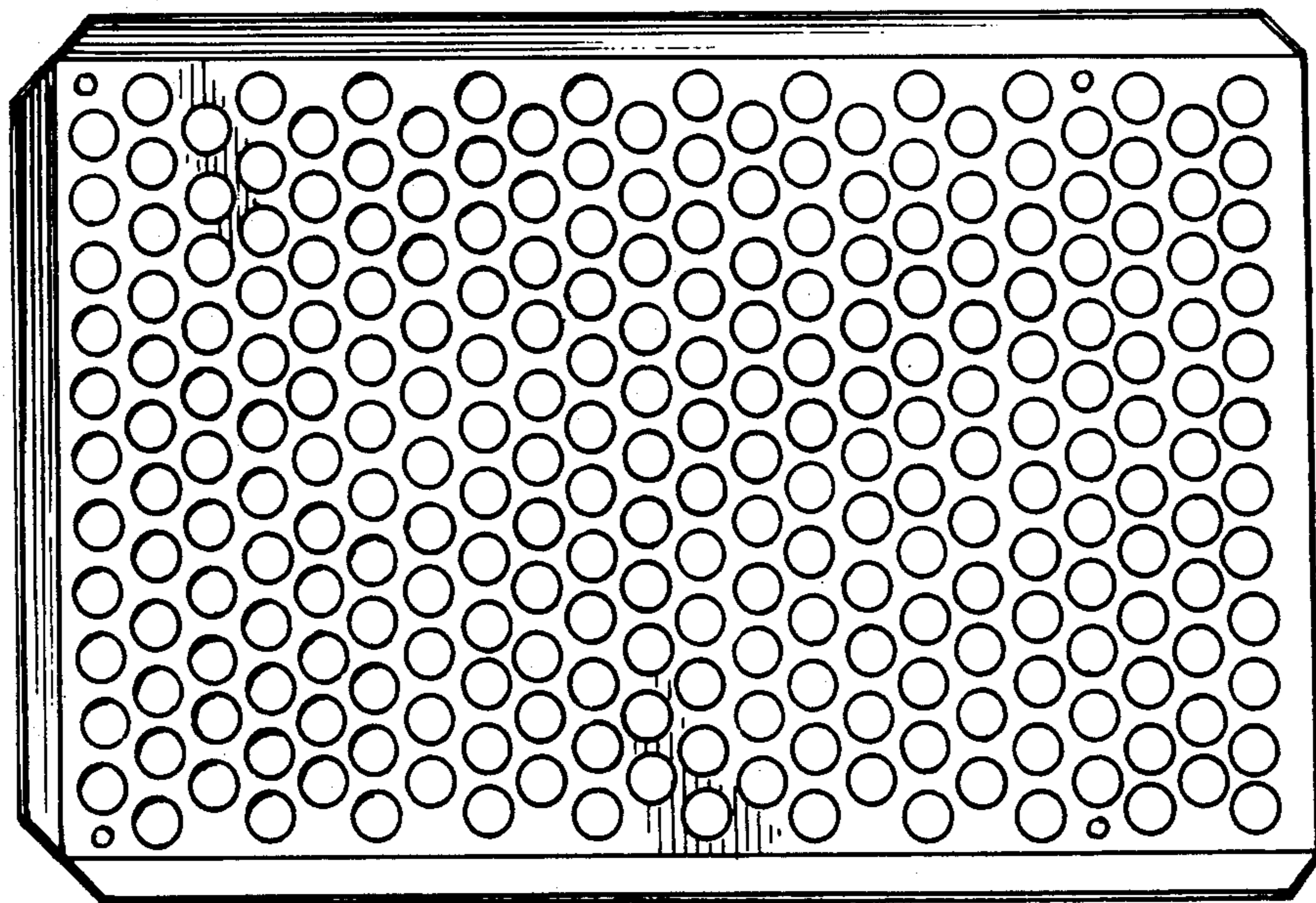

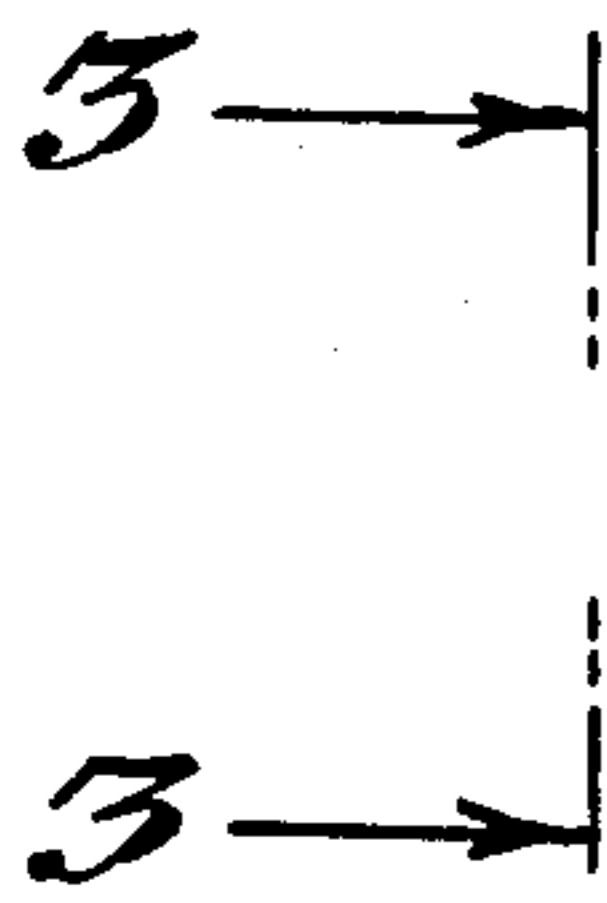
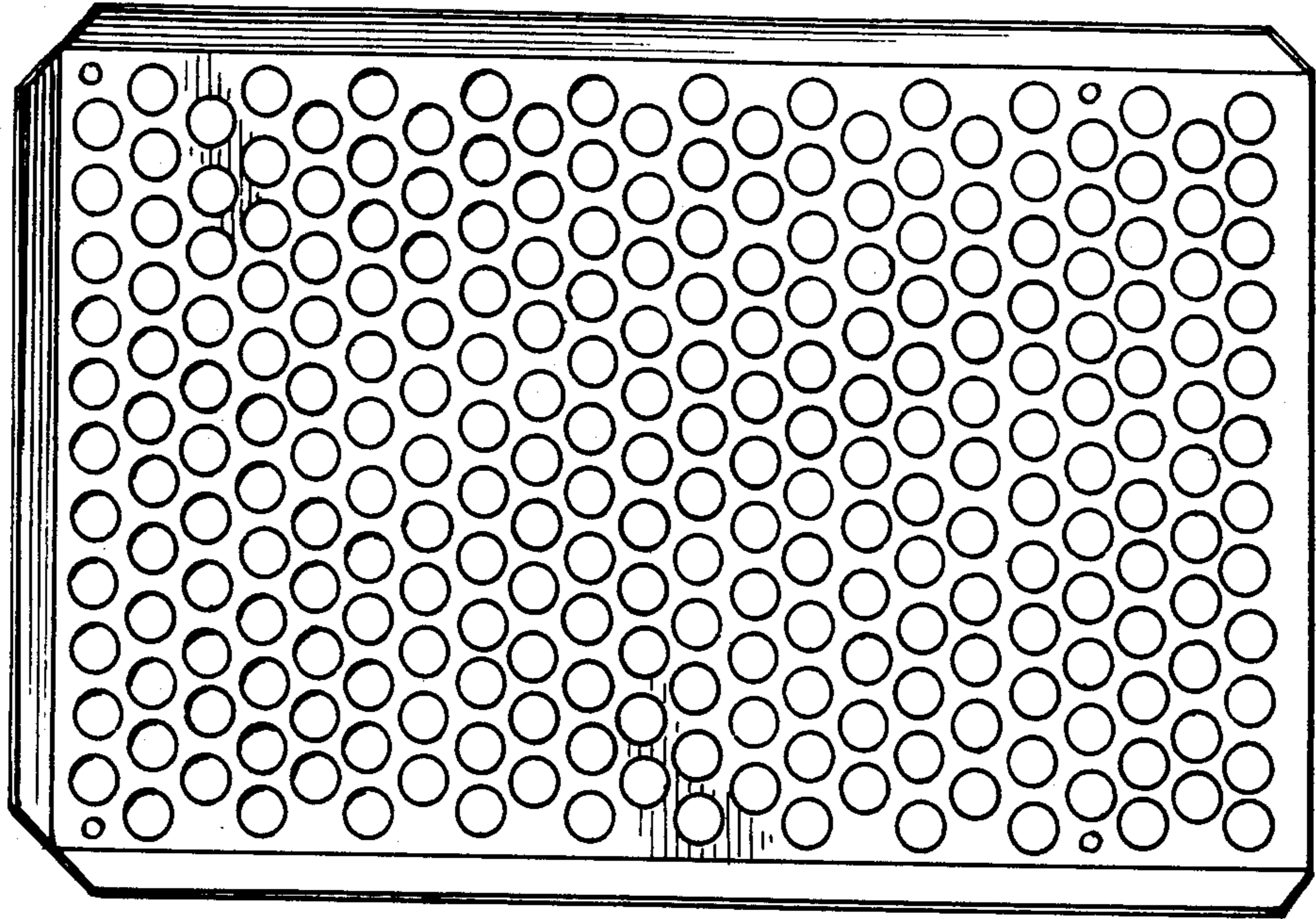
The ornamental design for coin sorter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

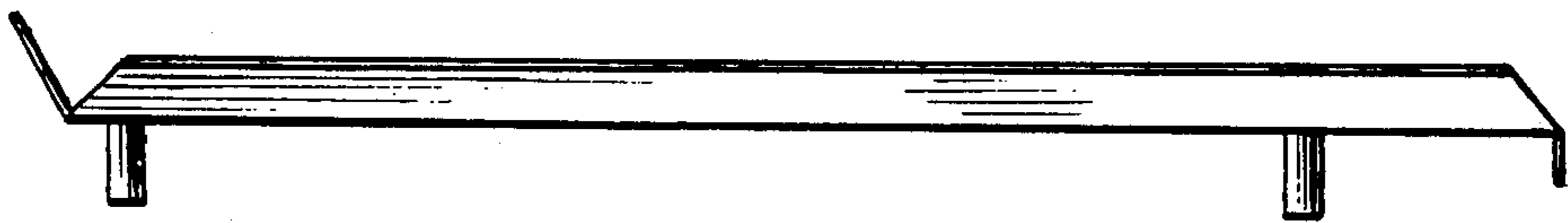
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a coin sorter showing my new design;

 FIG. 4 is a top and right end perspective view thereof with intermediate portions broken away and delineated by dashed lines for ease of illustration.



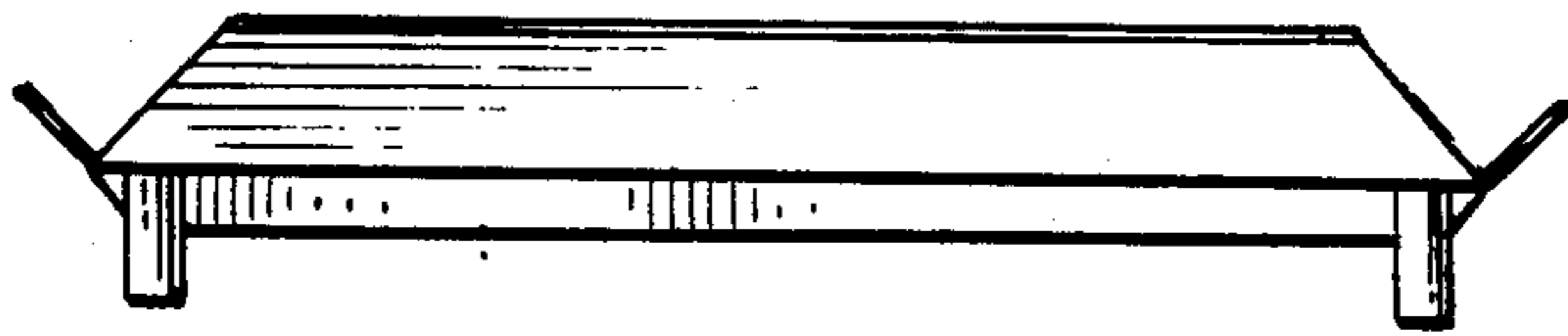
