[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cigarette and cigar holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cigarette and cigar holder showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof, wherein the only difference resides in the configuration of the clamp.

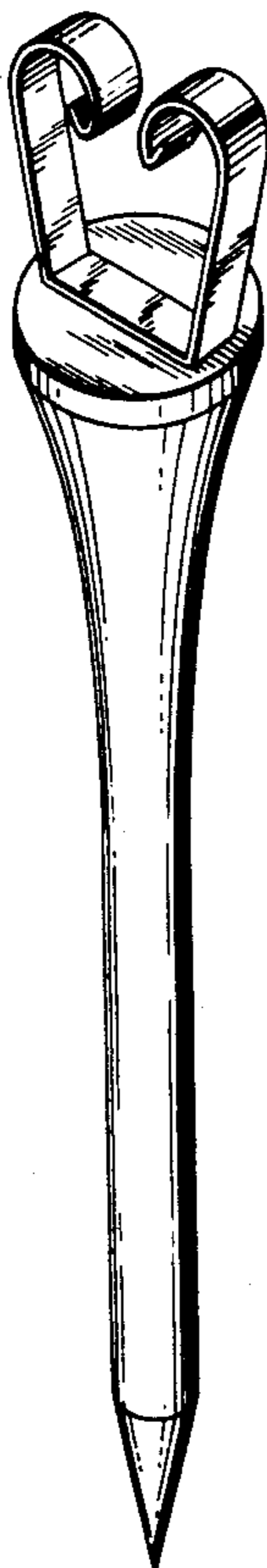

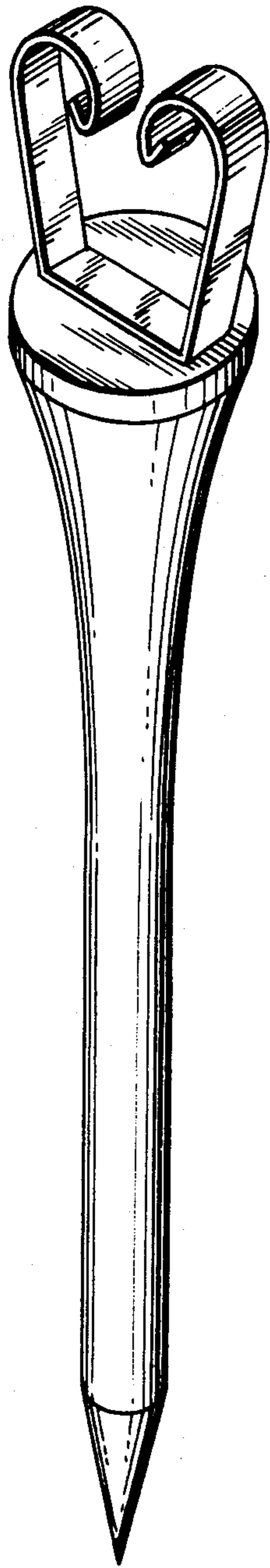

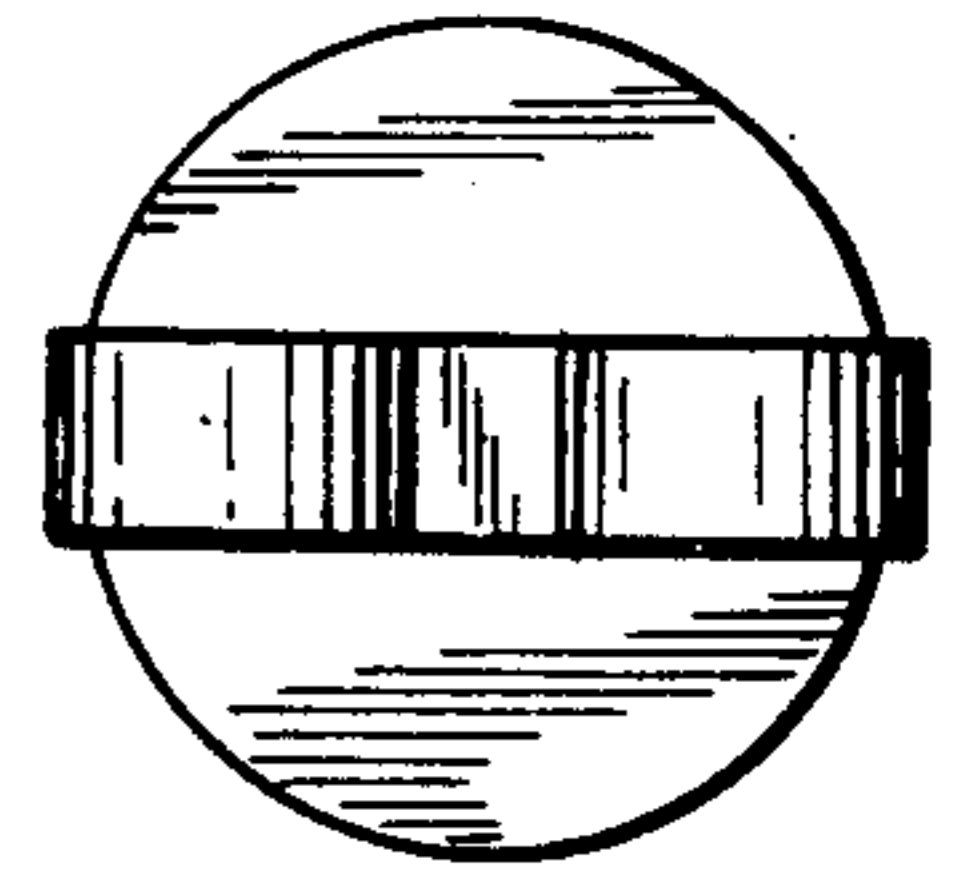

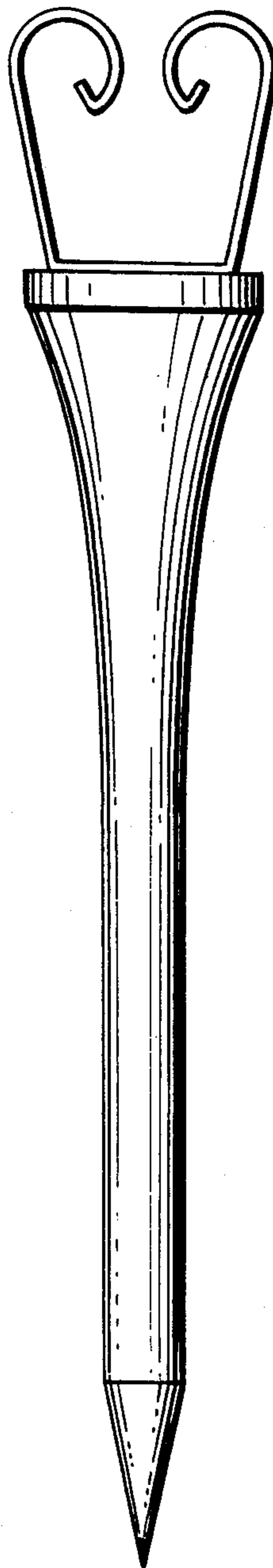

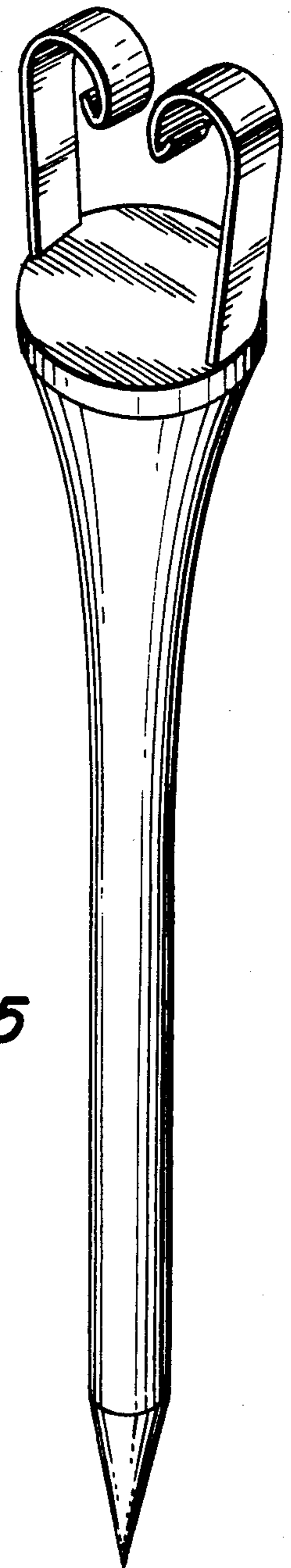
