DESCRIPTION

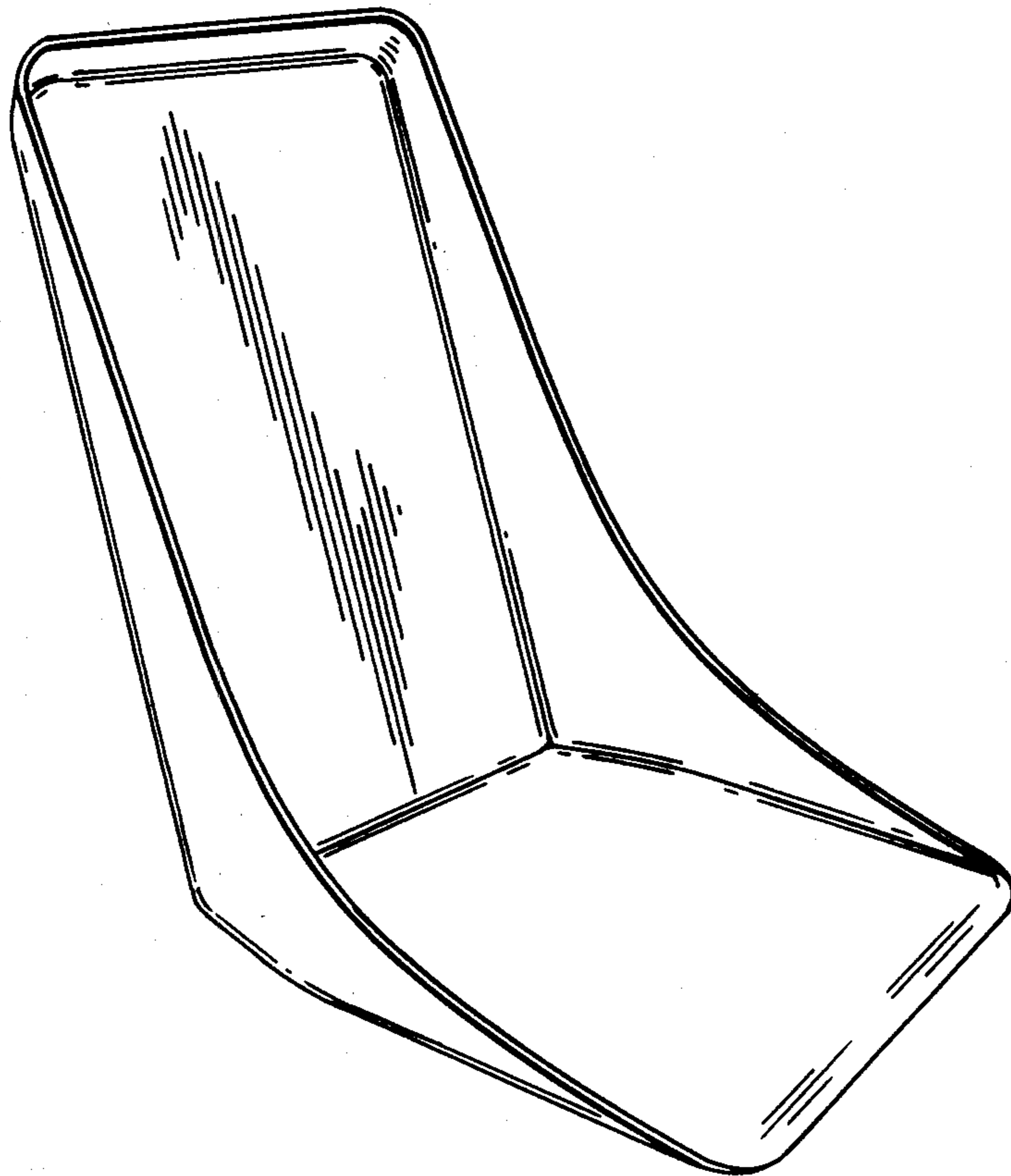
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a boat seat shell incorporating our new design;

The side not shown is the same as the side illustrated.



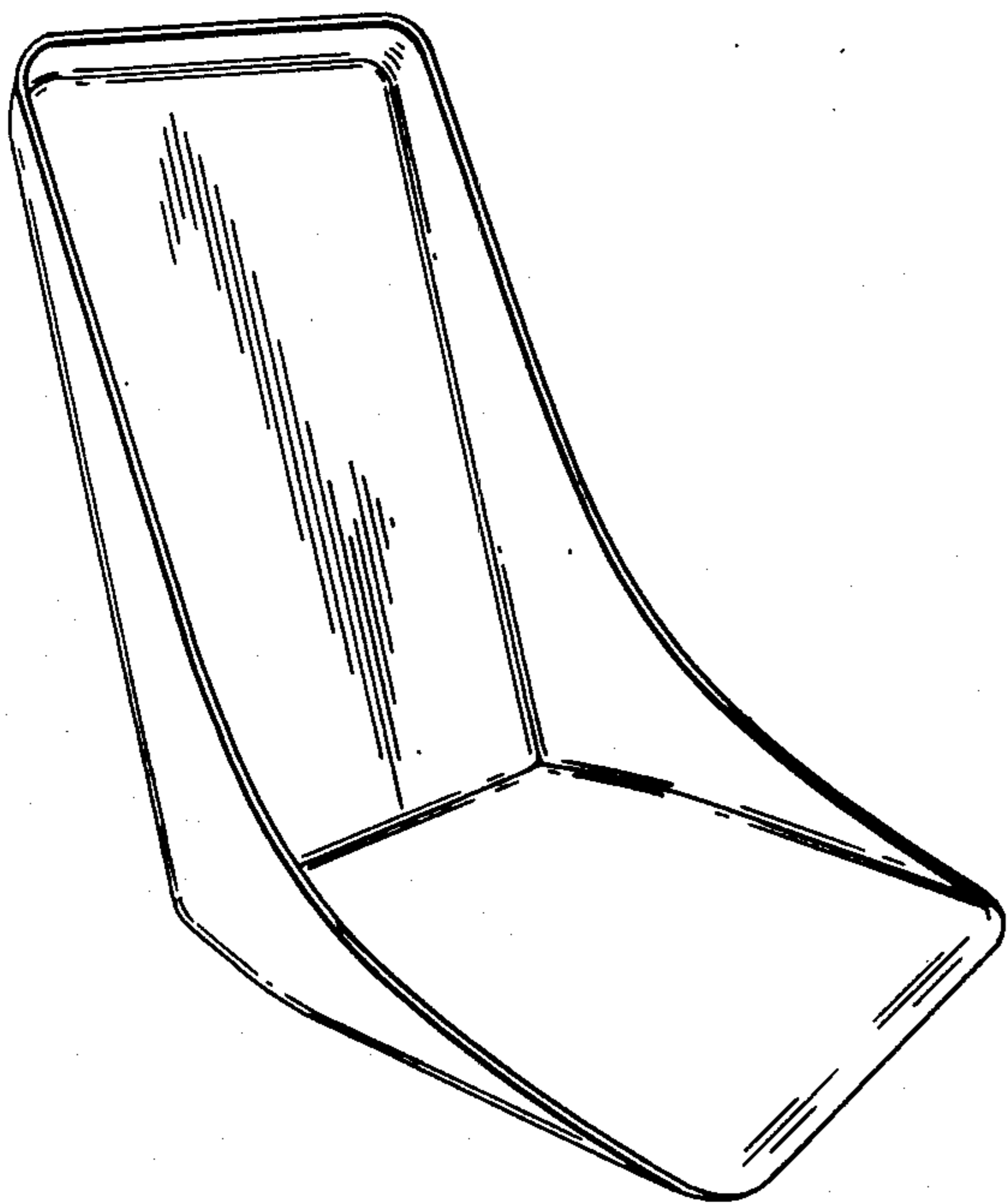

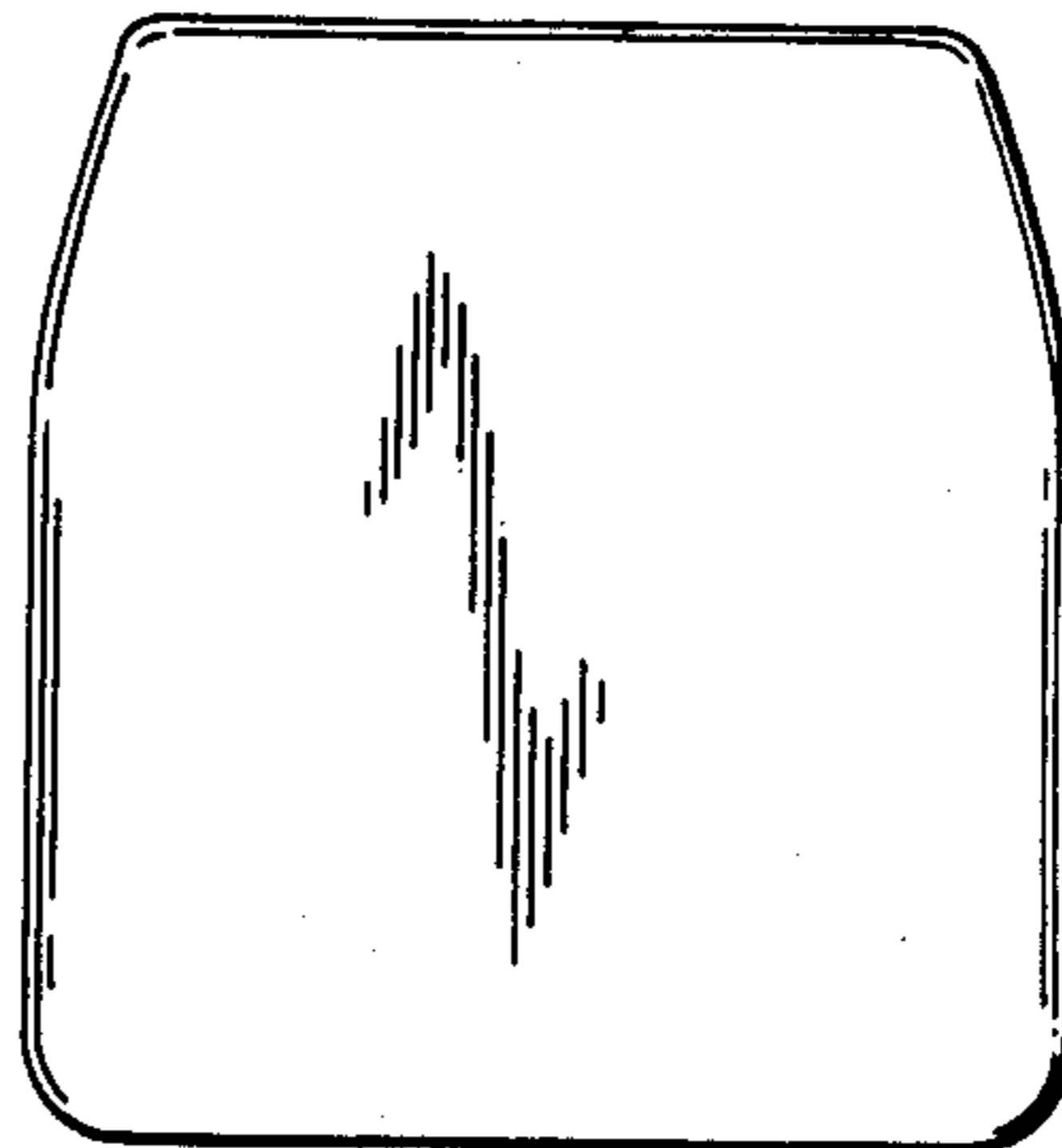

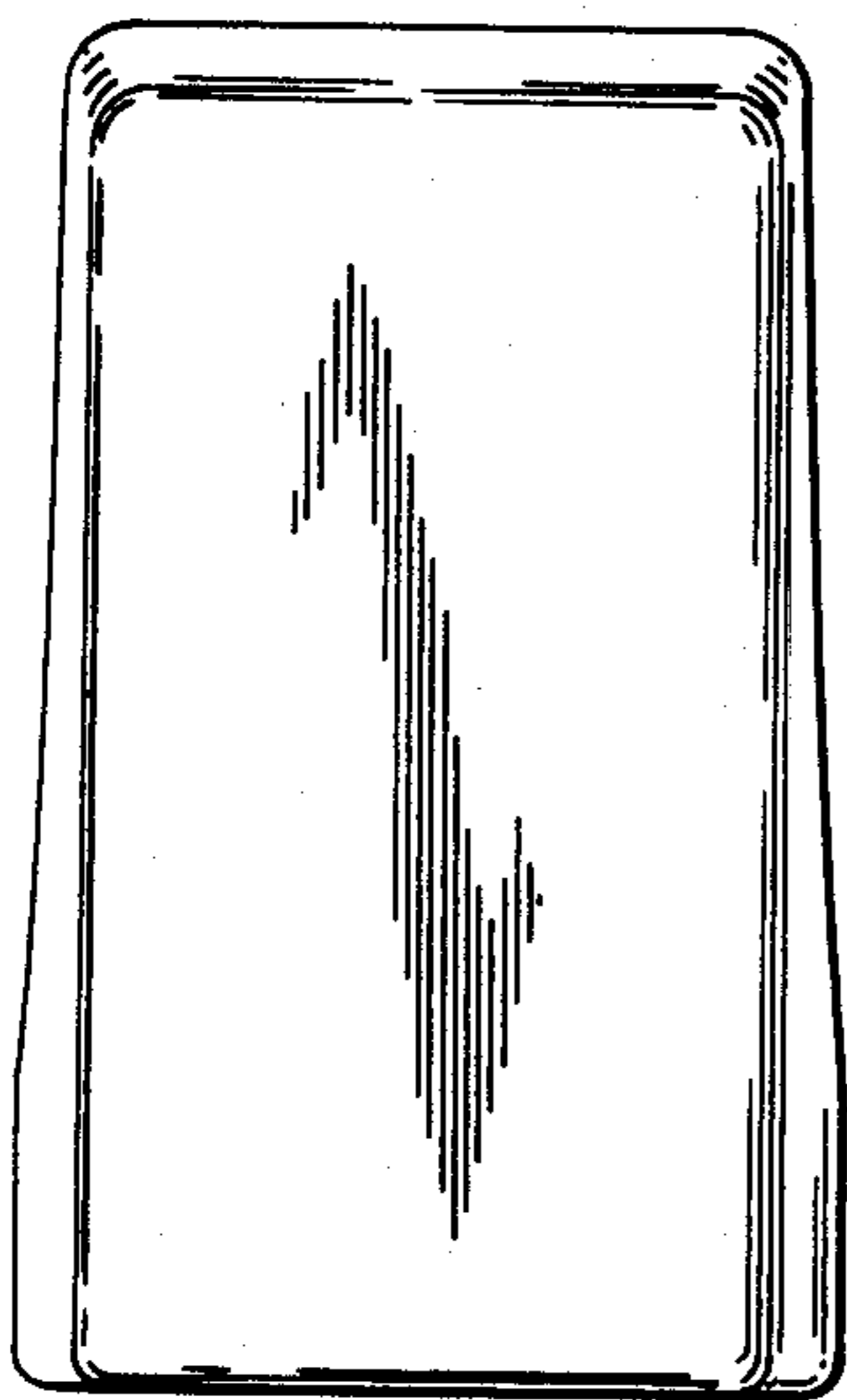

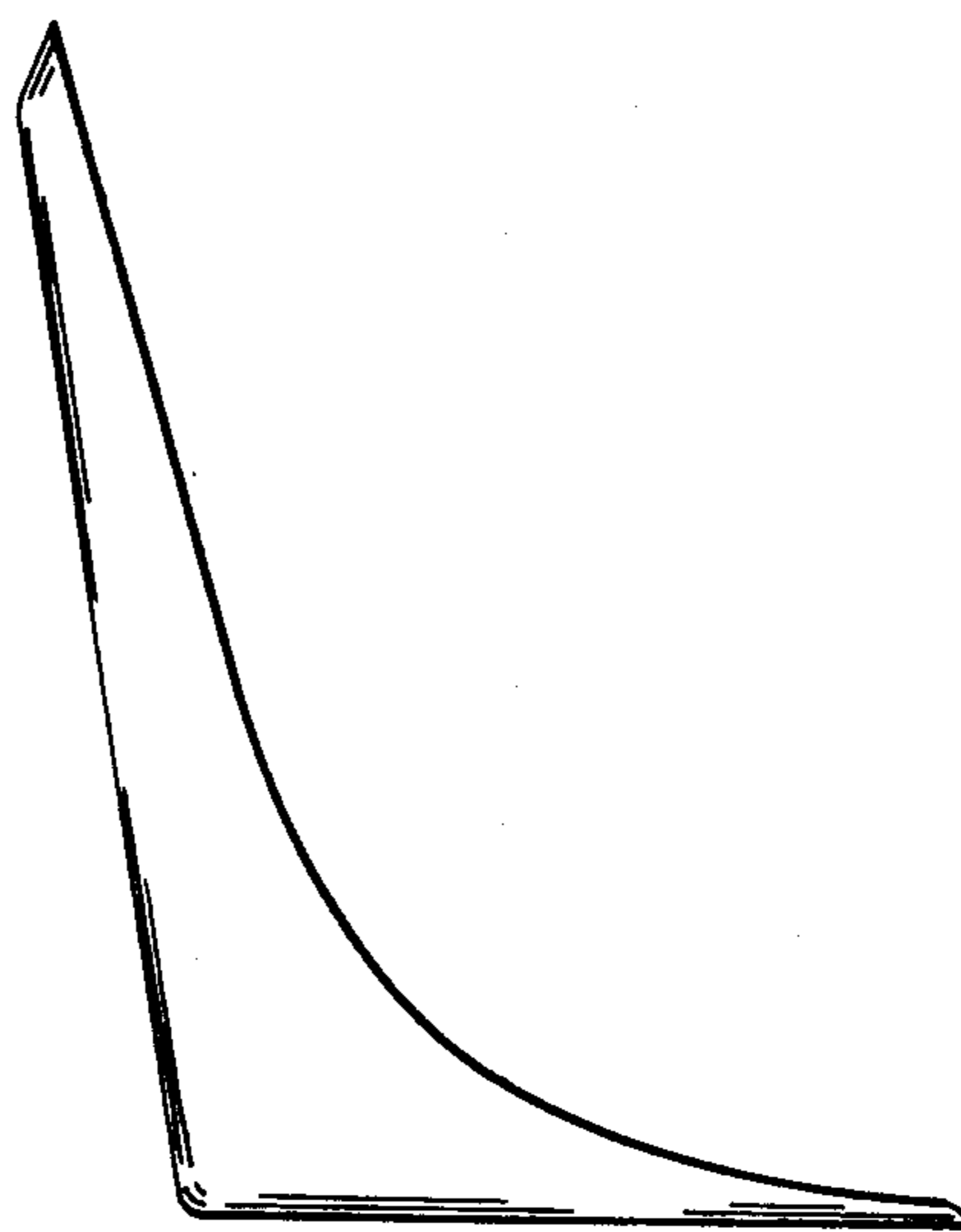
