[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined divider and sign holder for merchandise bins, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined divider and sign holder for merchandise bins showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

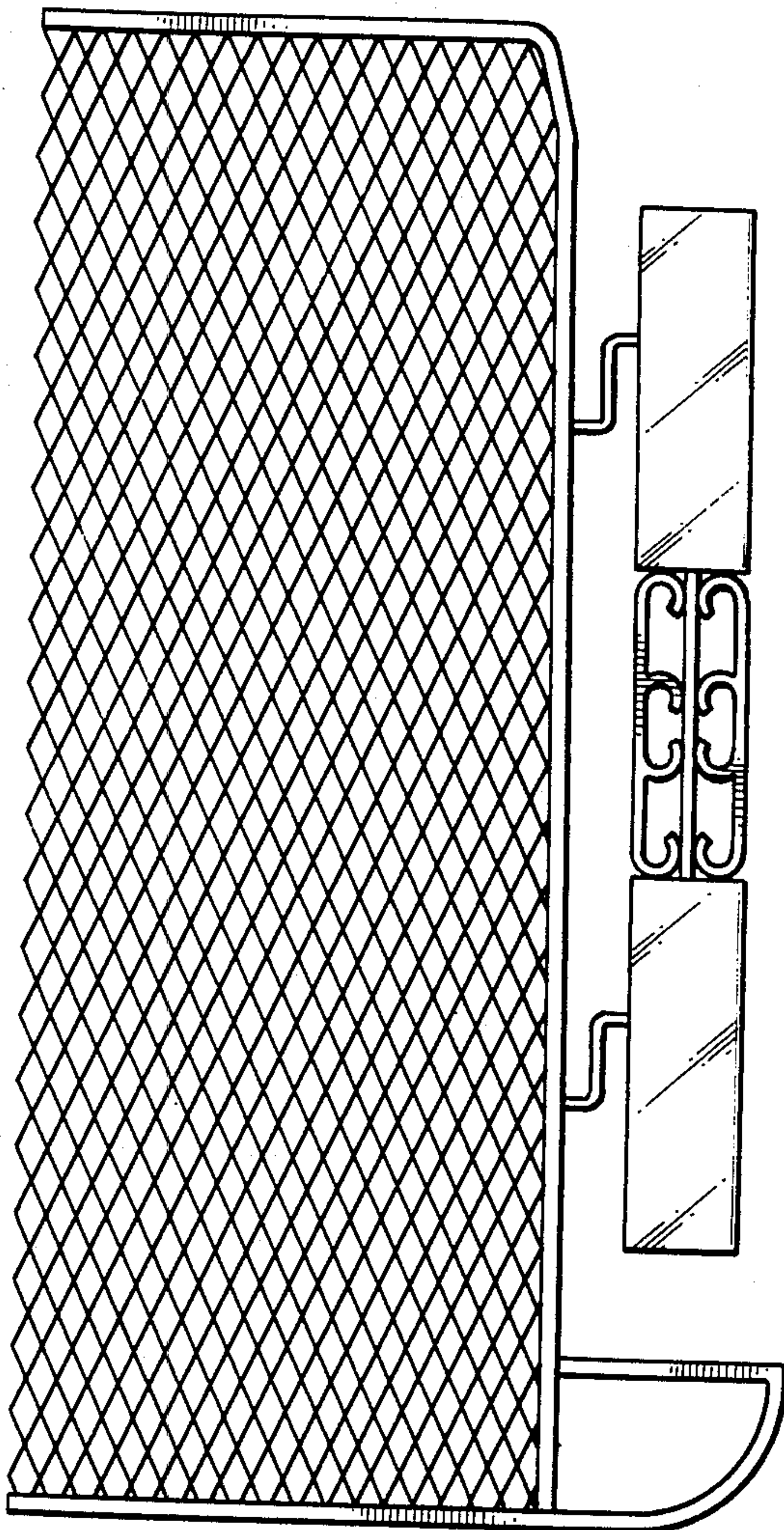

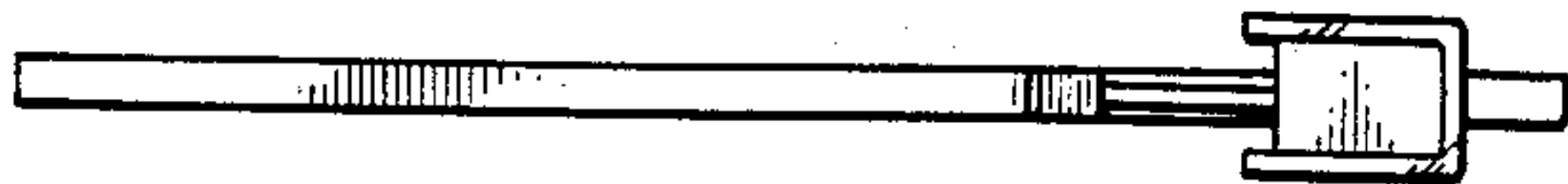

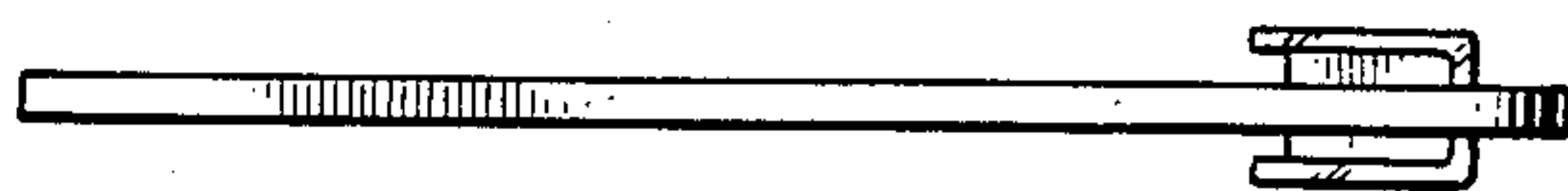

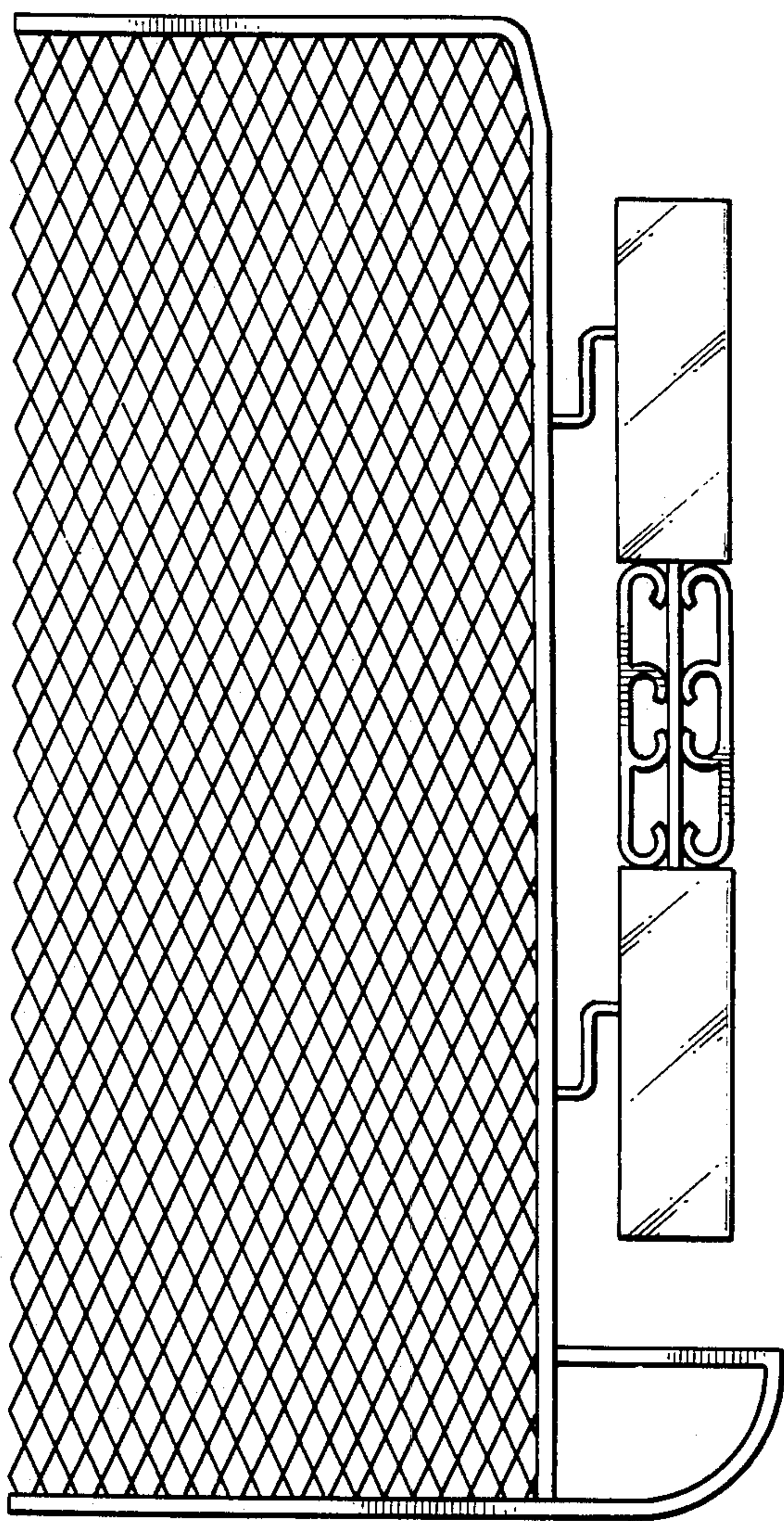
