The rear of the plaque is plain and unornamented.

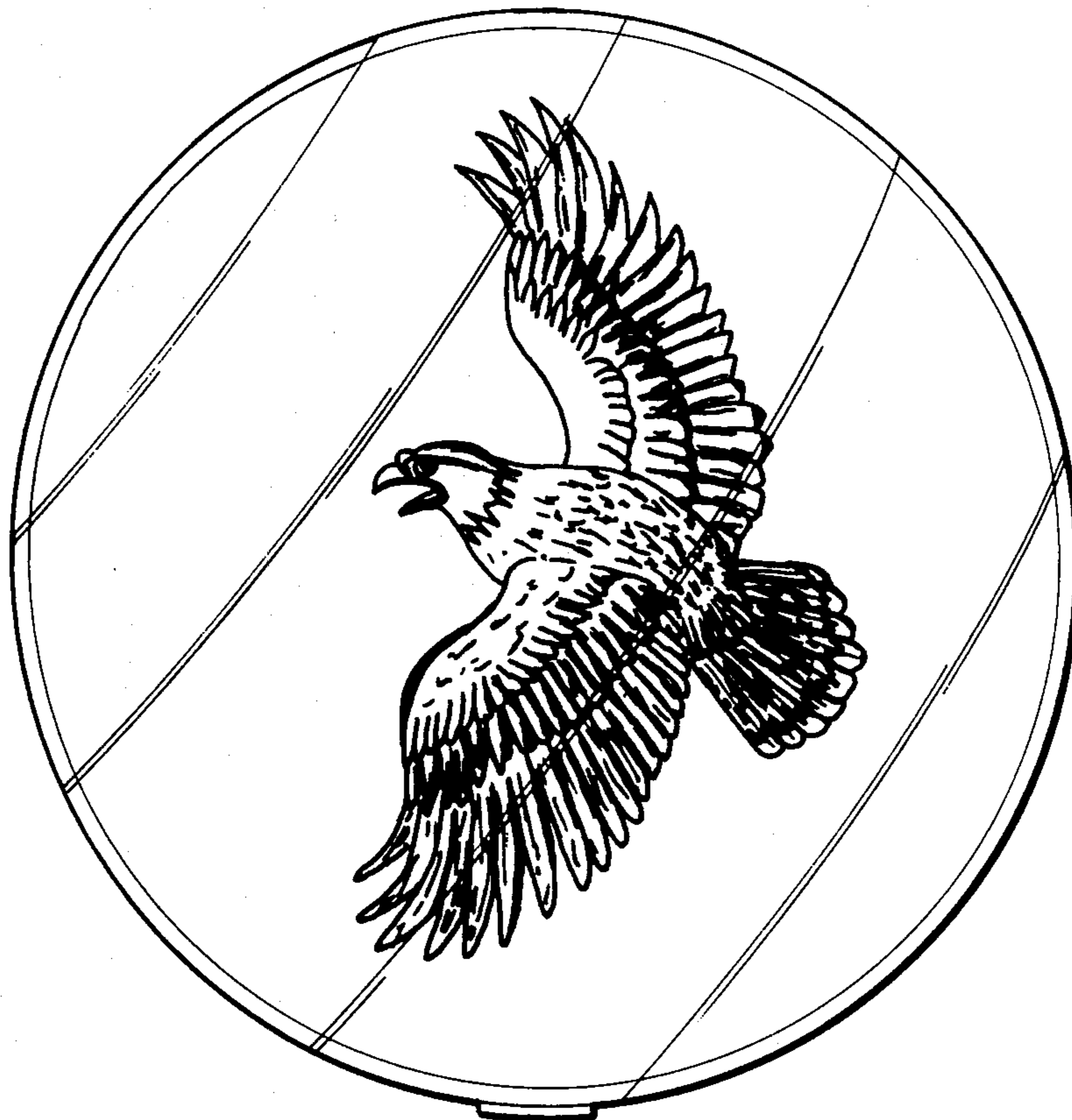

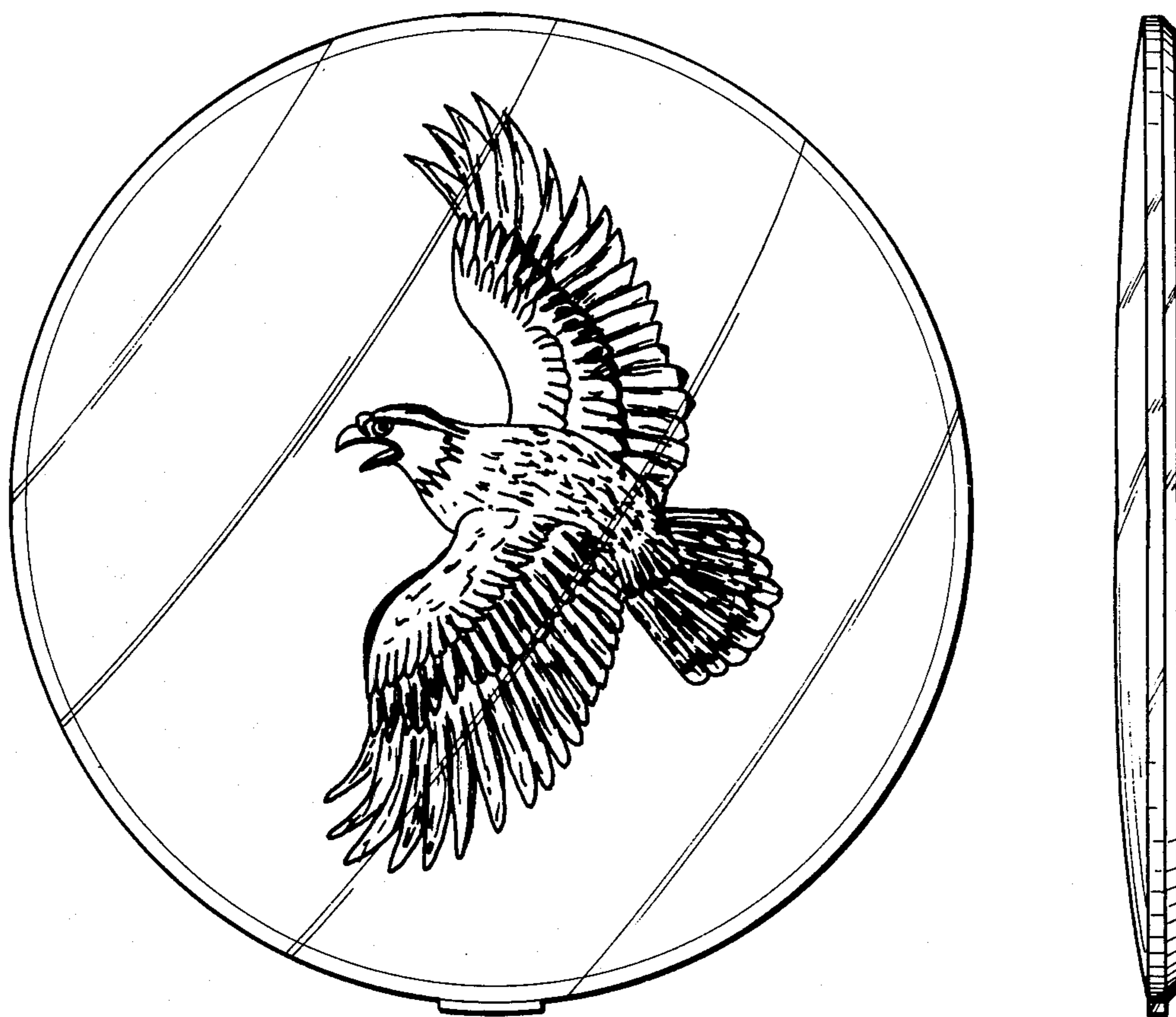
