The rear and bottom of the scaffold jack are substantially flat and unornamented.

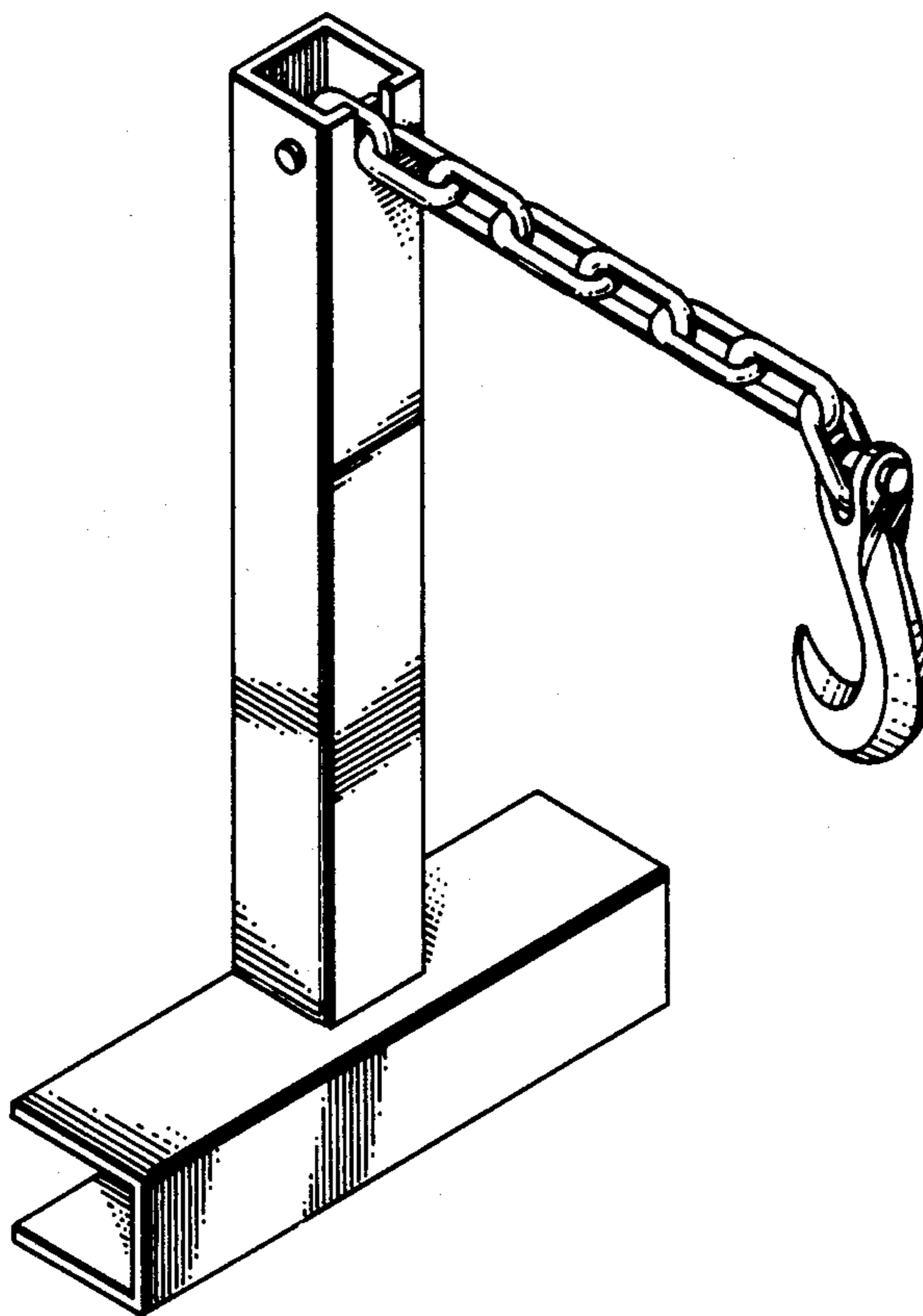

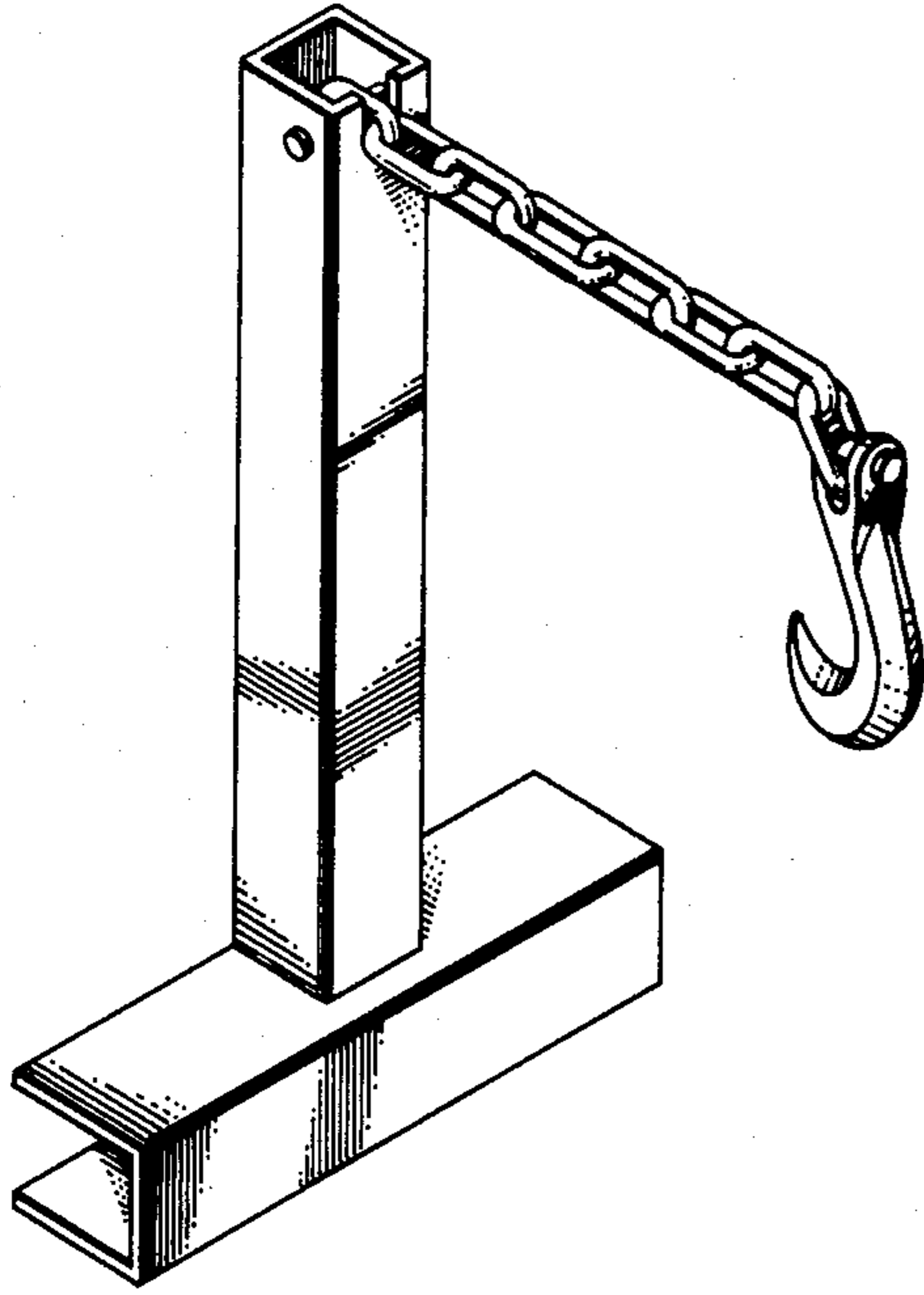

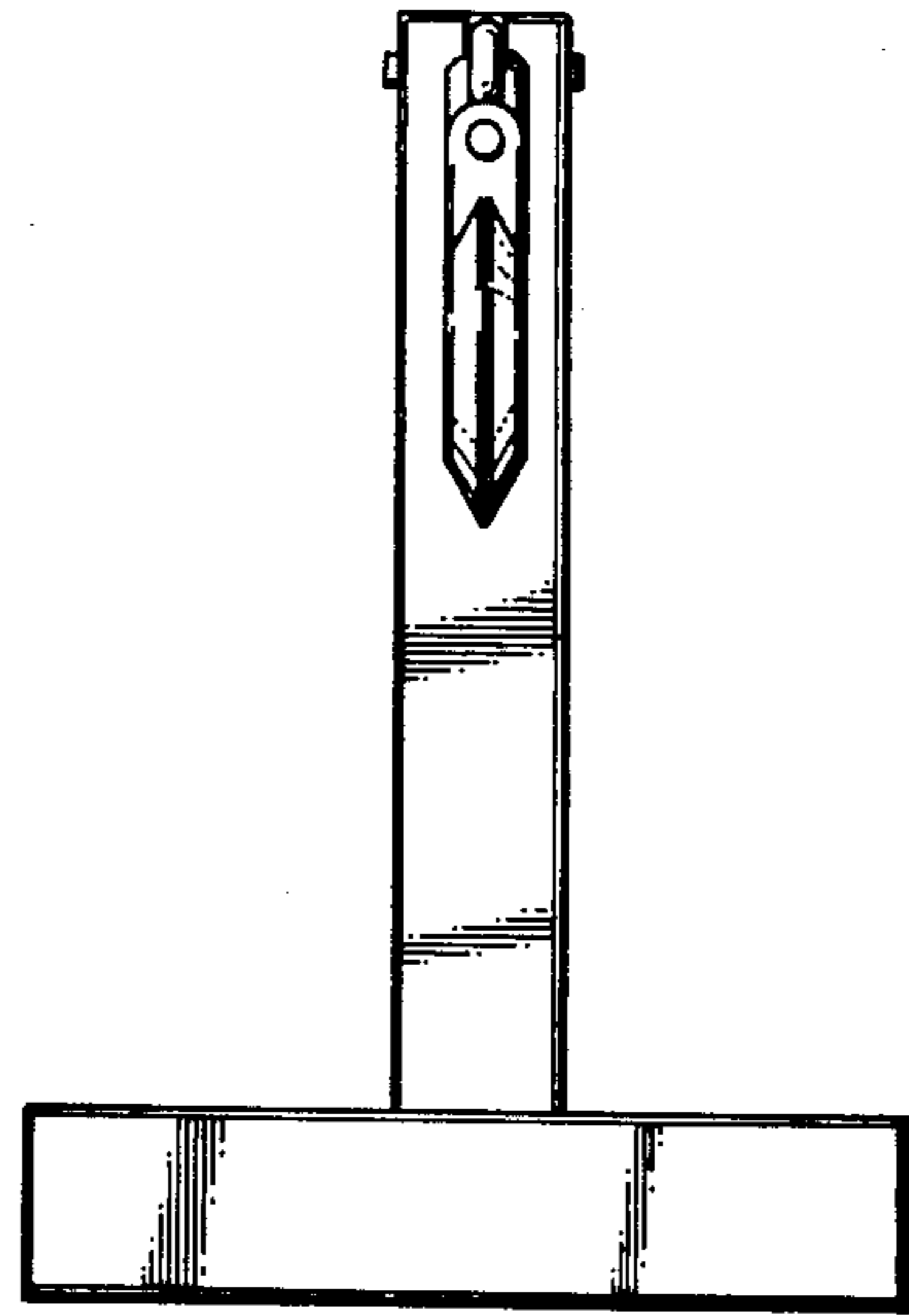

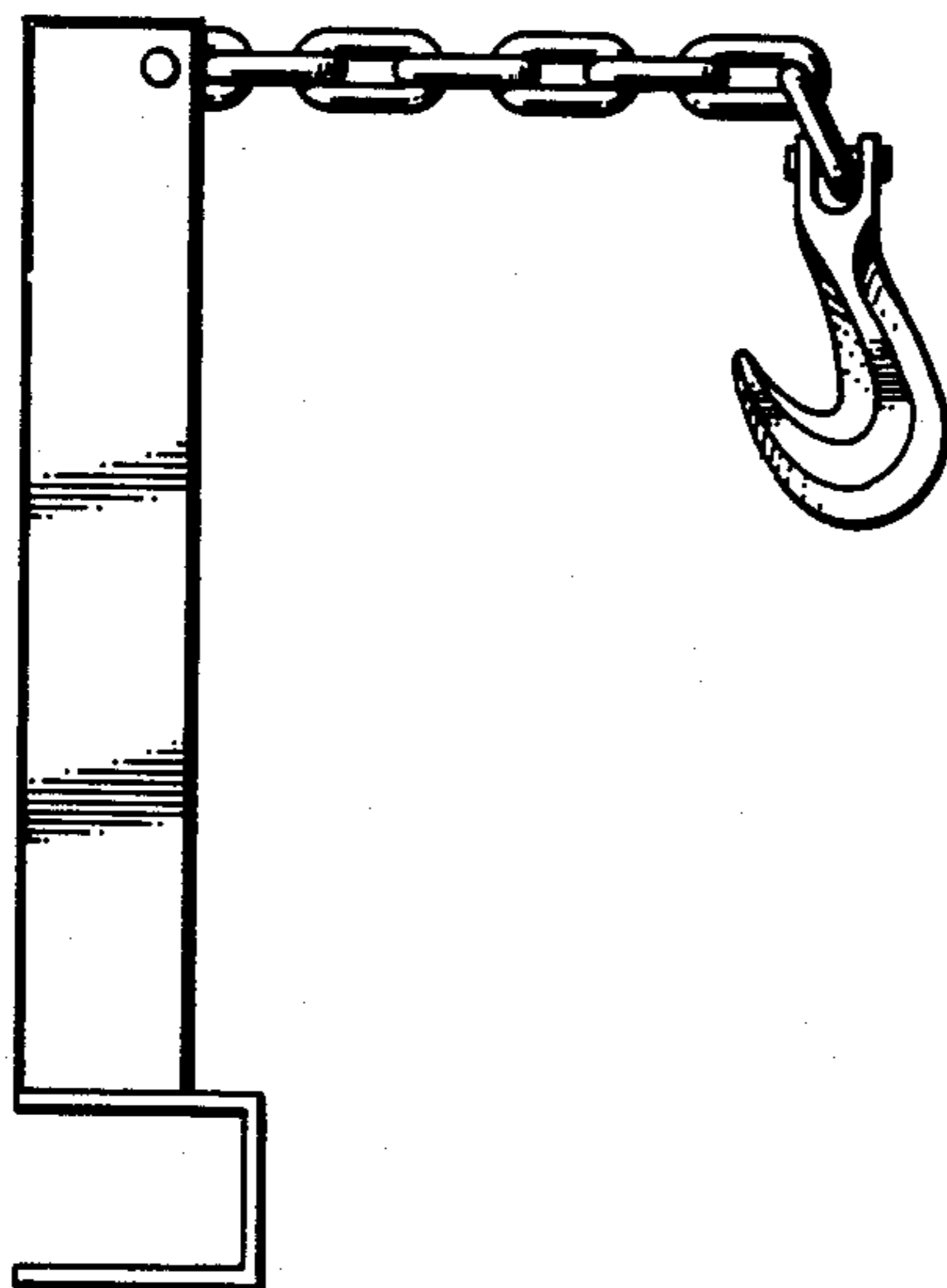
