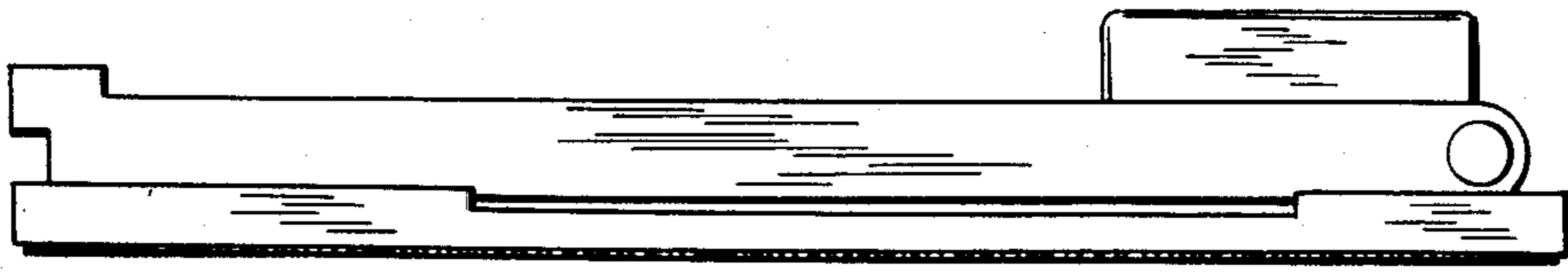
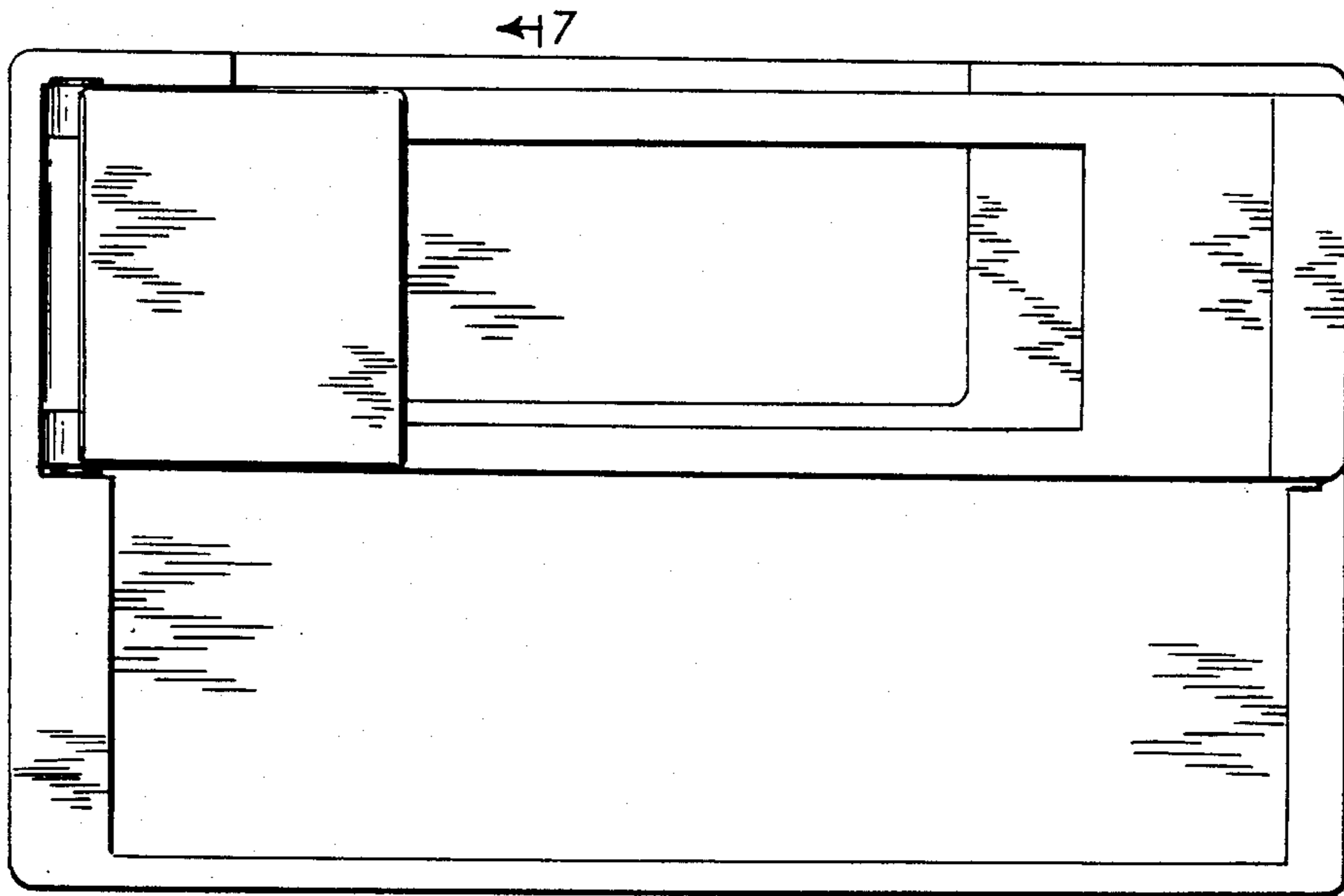

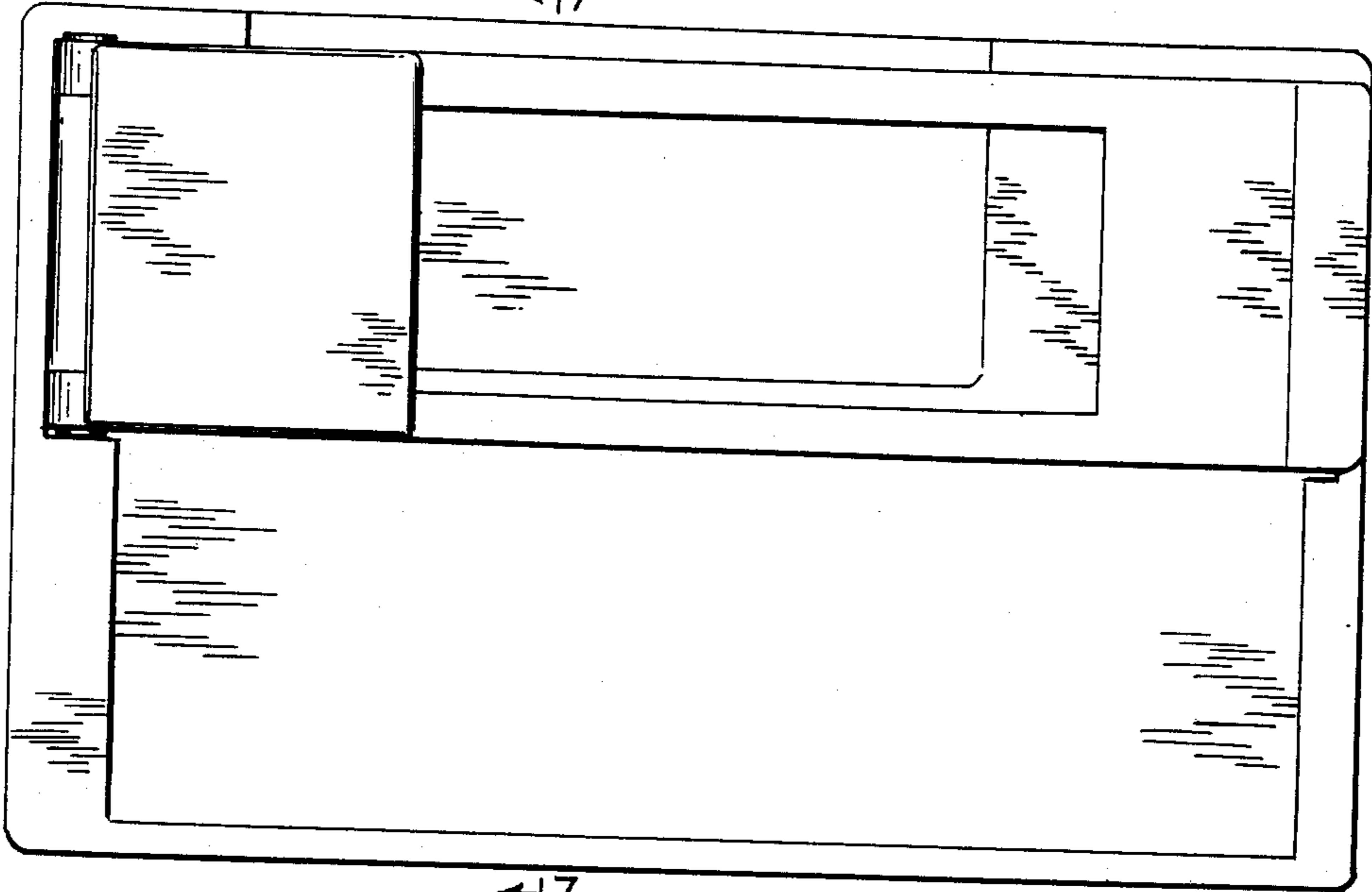
The ornamental design for a credit card imprinter or similar article, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a credit card imprinter or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof on a reduced scale.

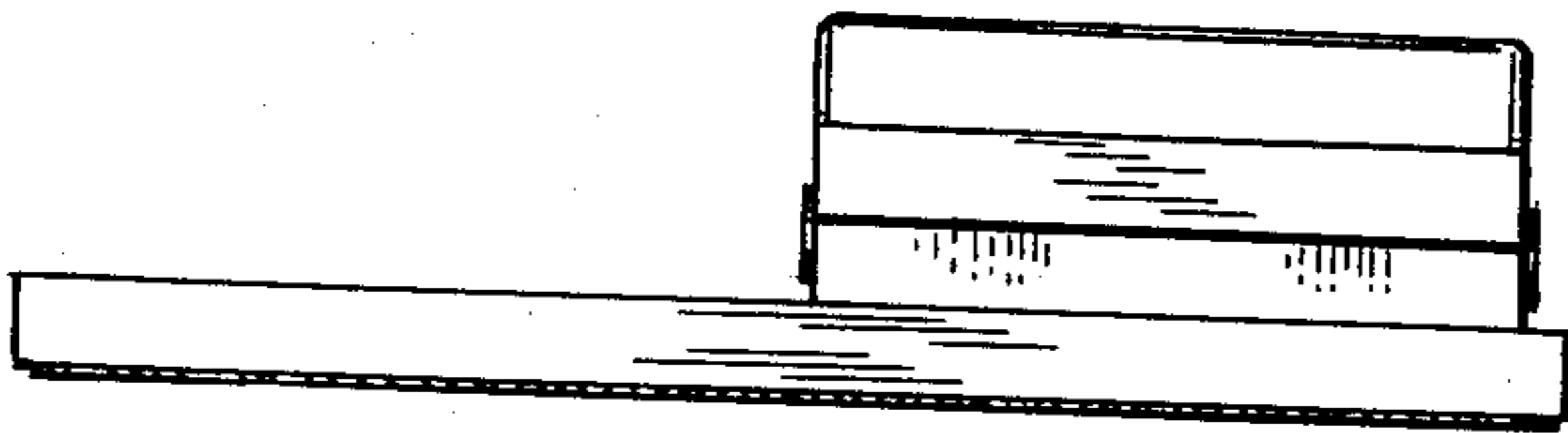

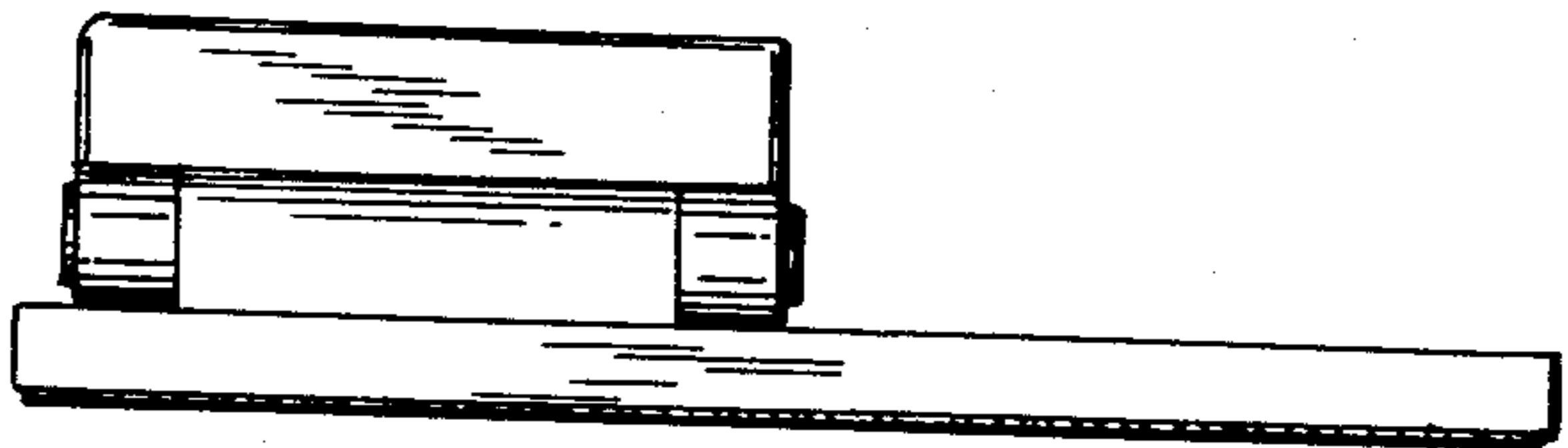

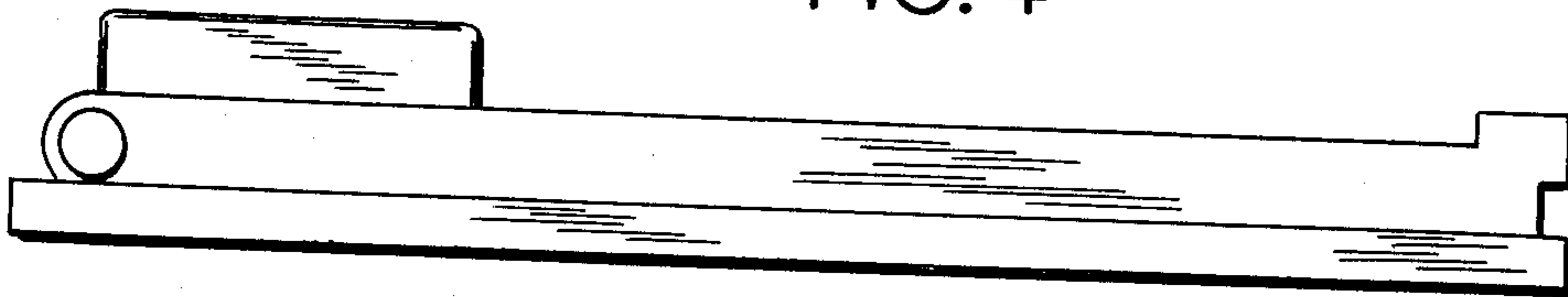

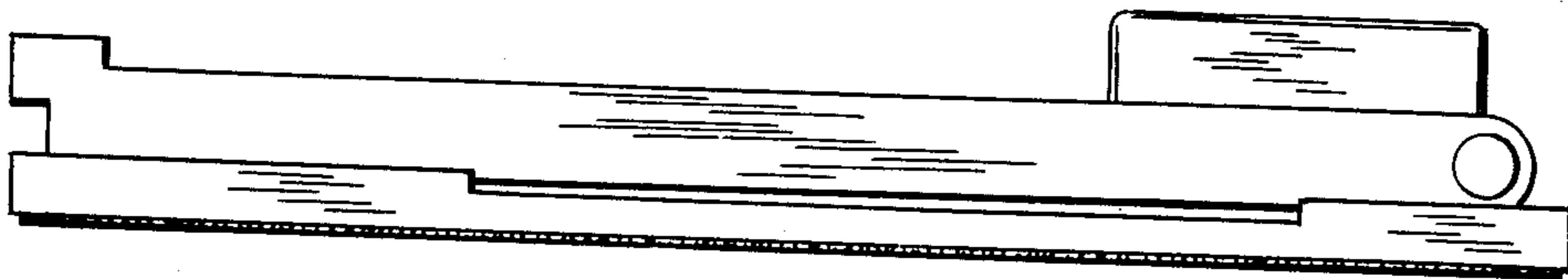
