[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined automobile radio receiver tape player and digital time and frequency displayer, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a combined automobile radio receiver, tape player and digital time and frequency displayer showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view.

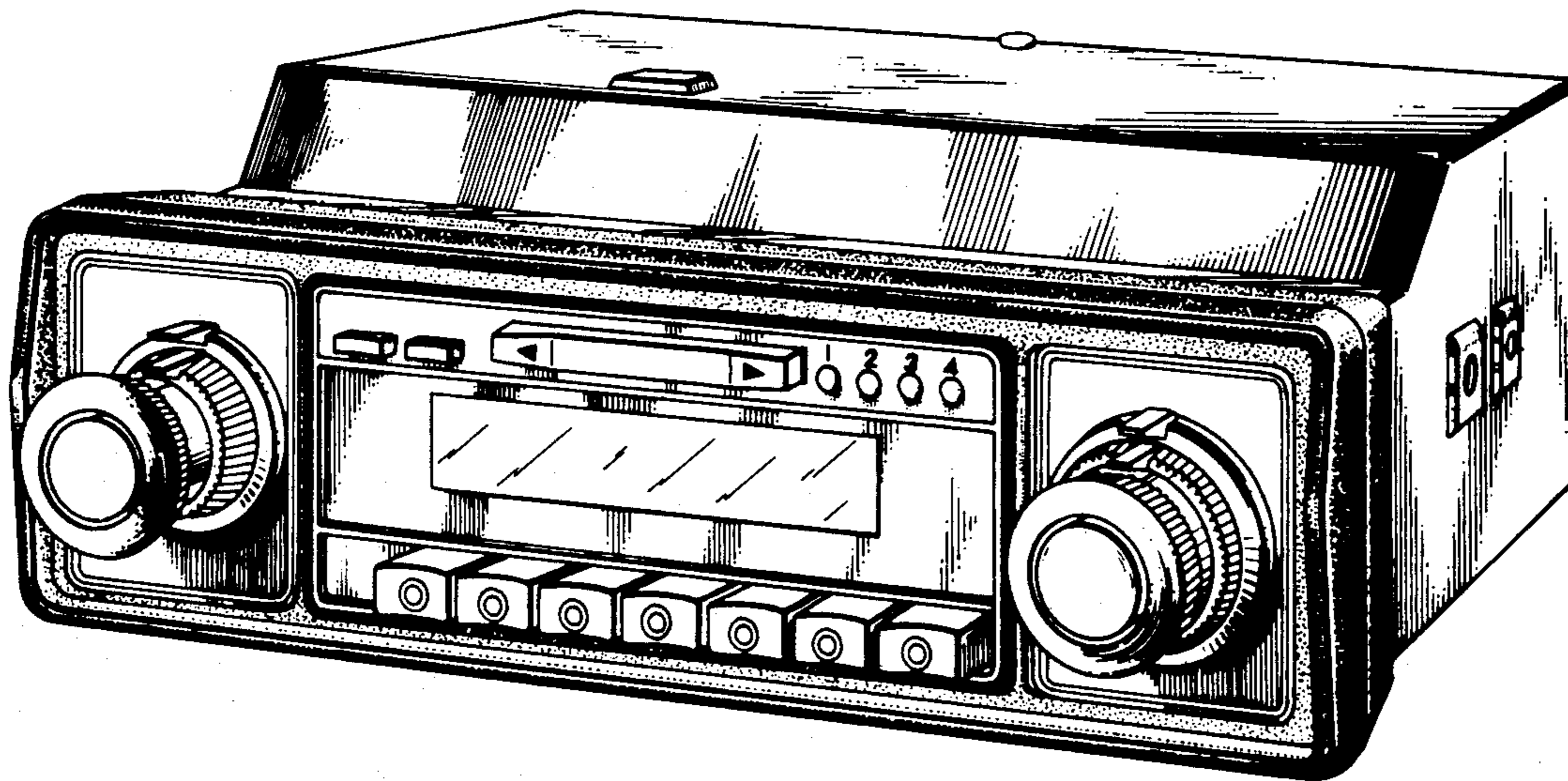

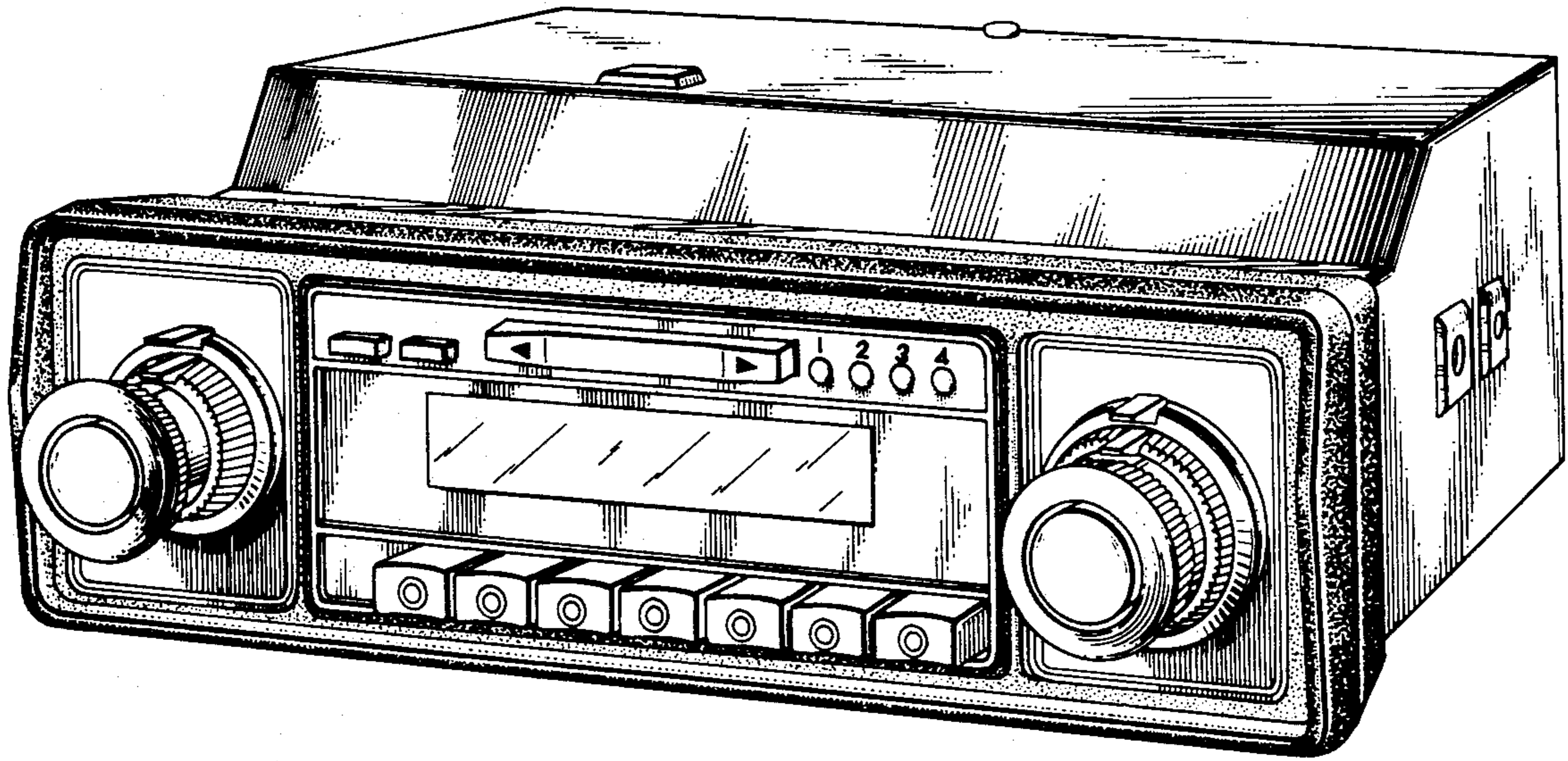

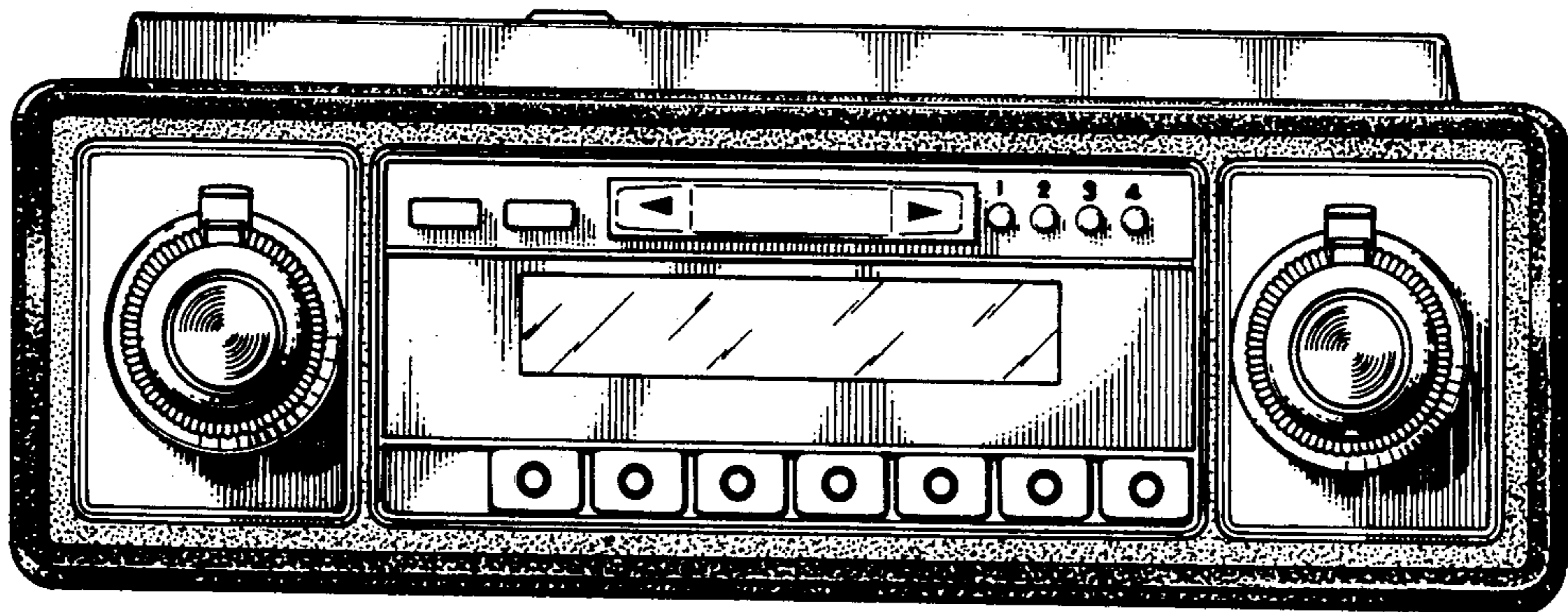

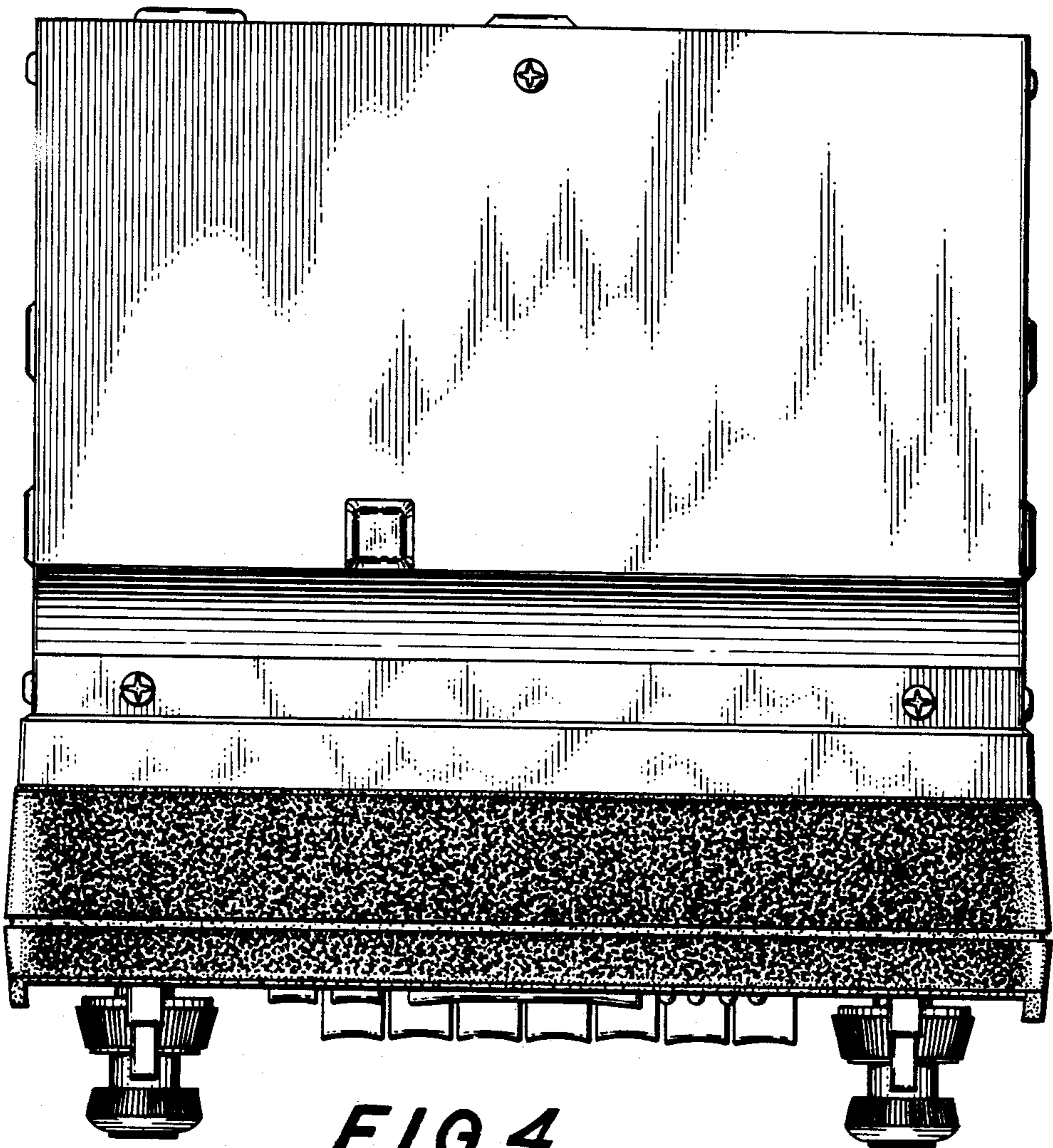
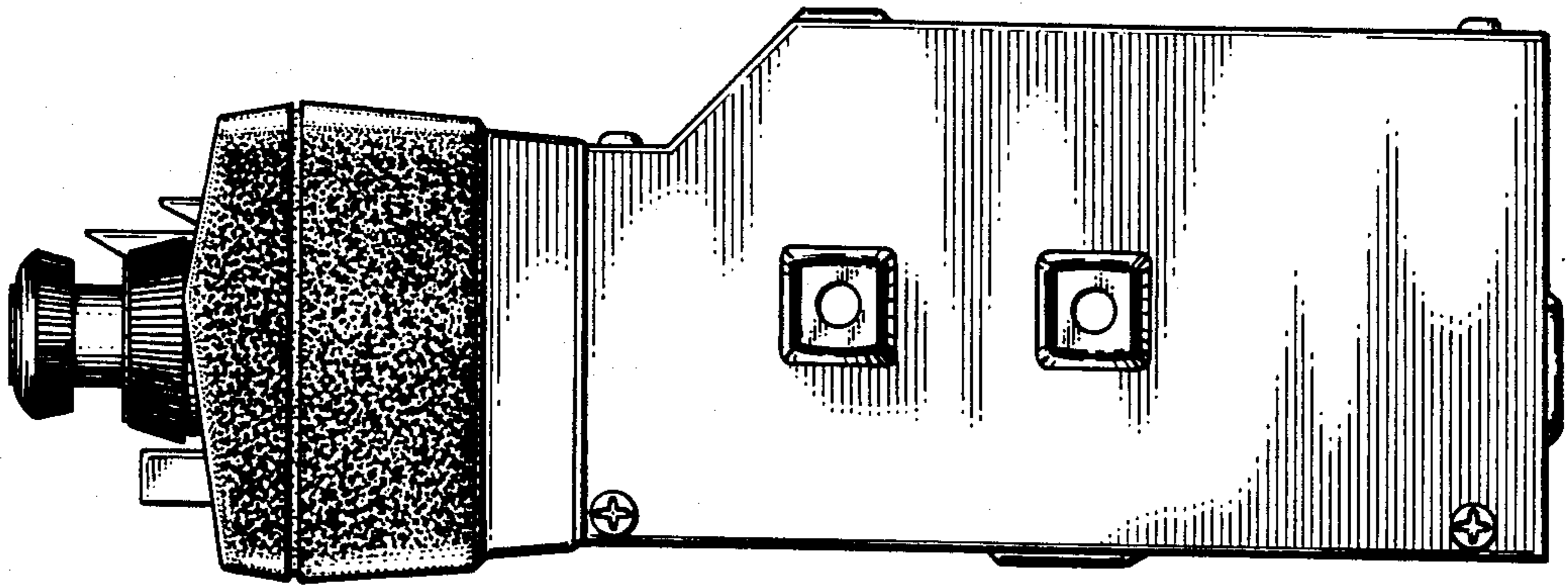

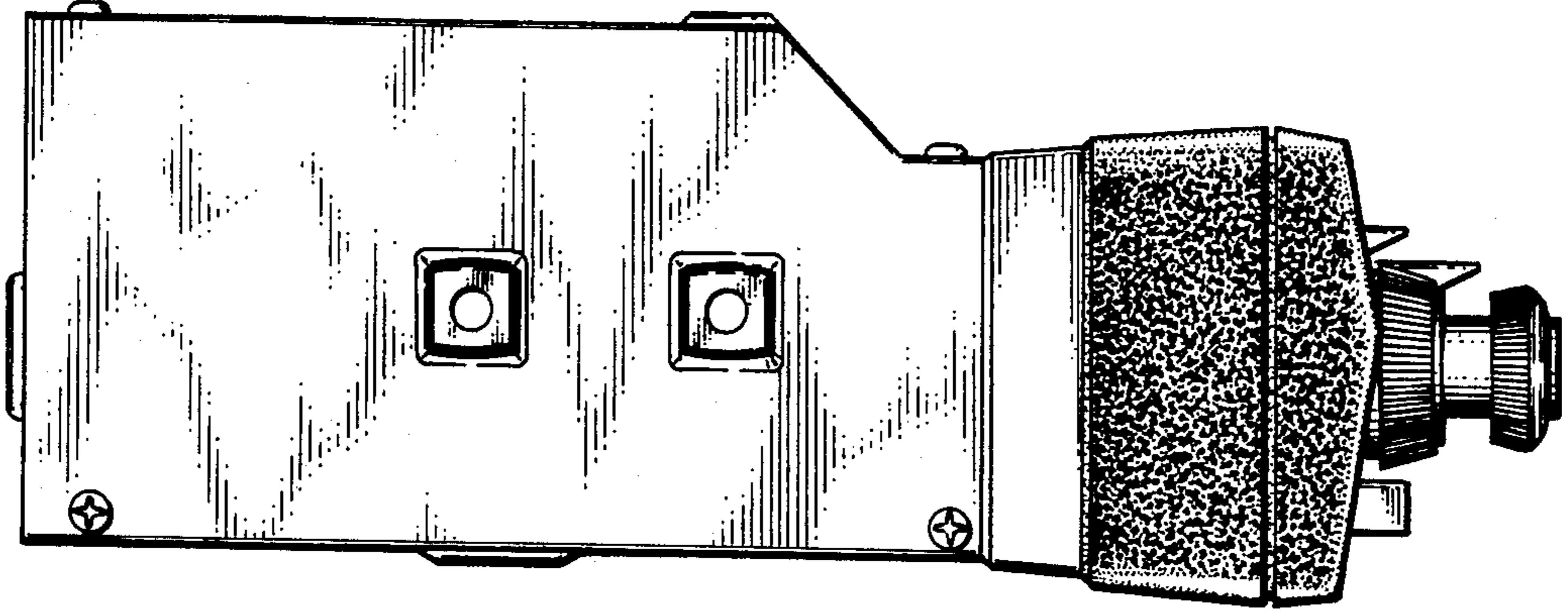

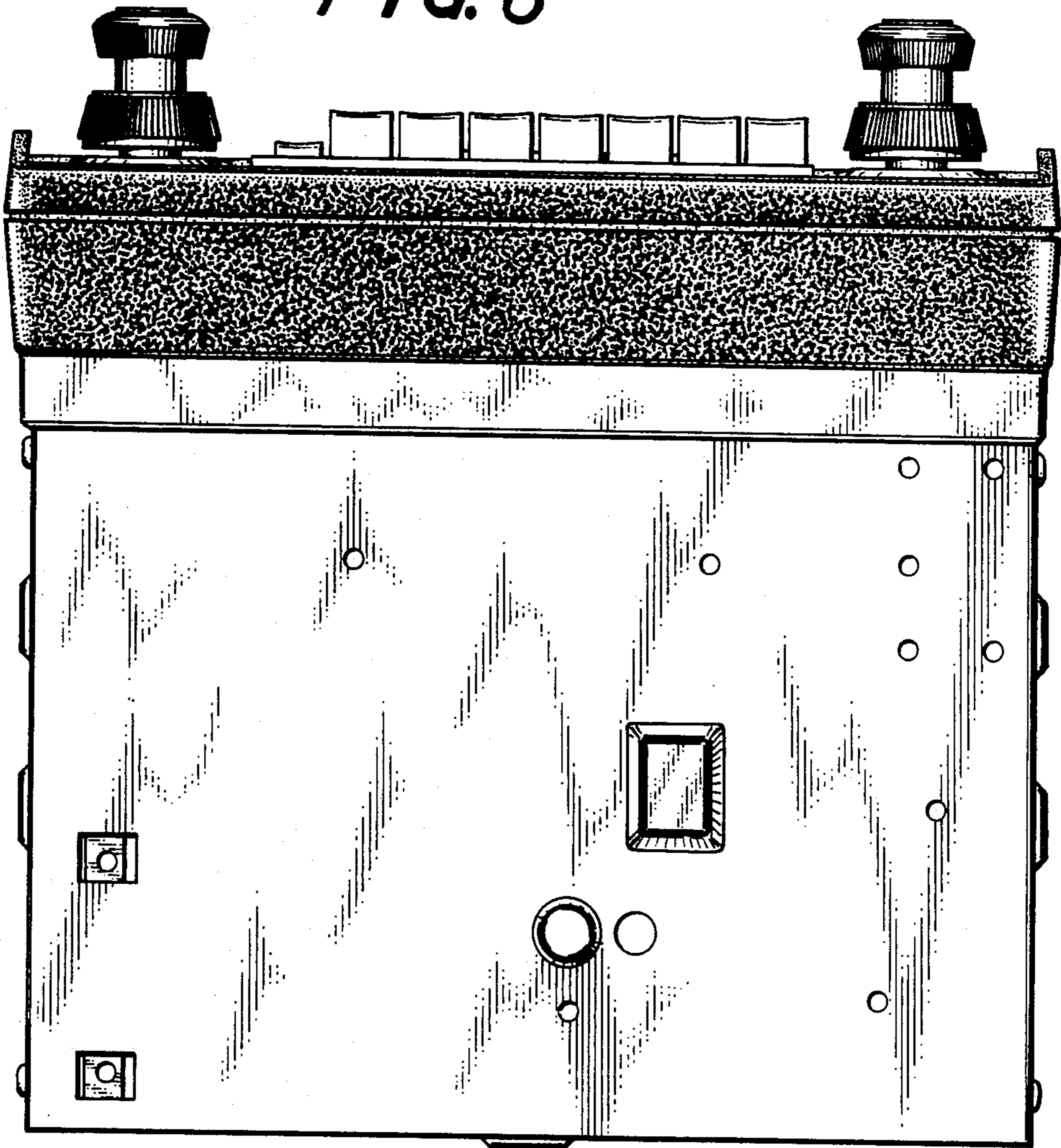
