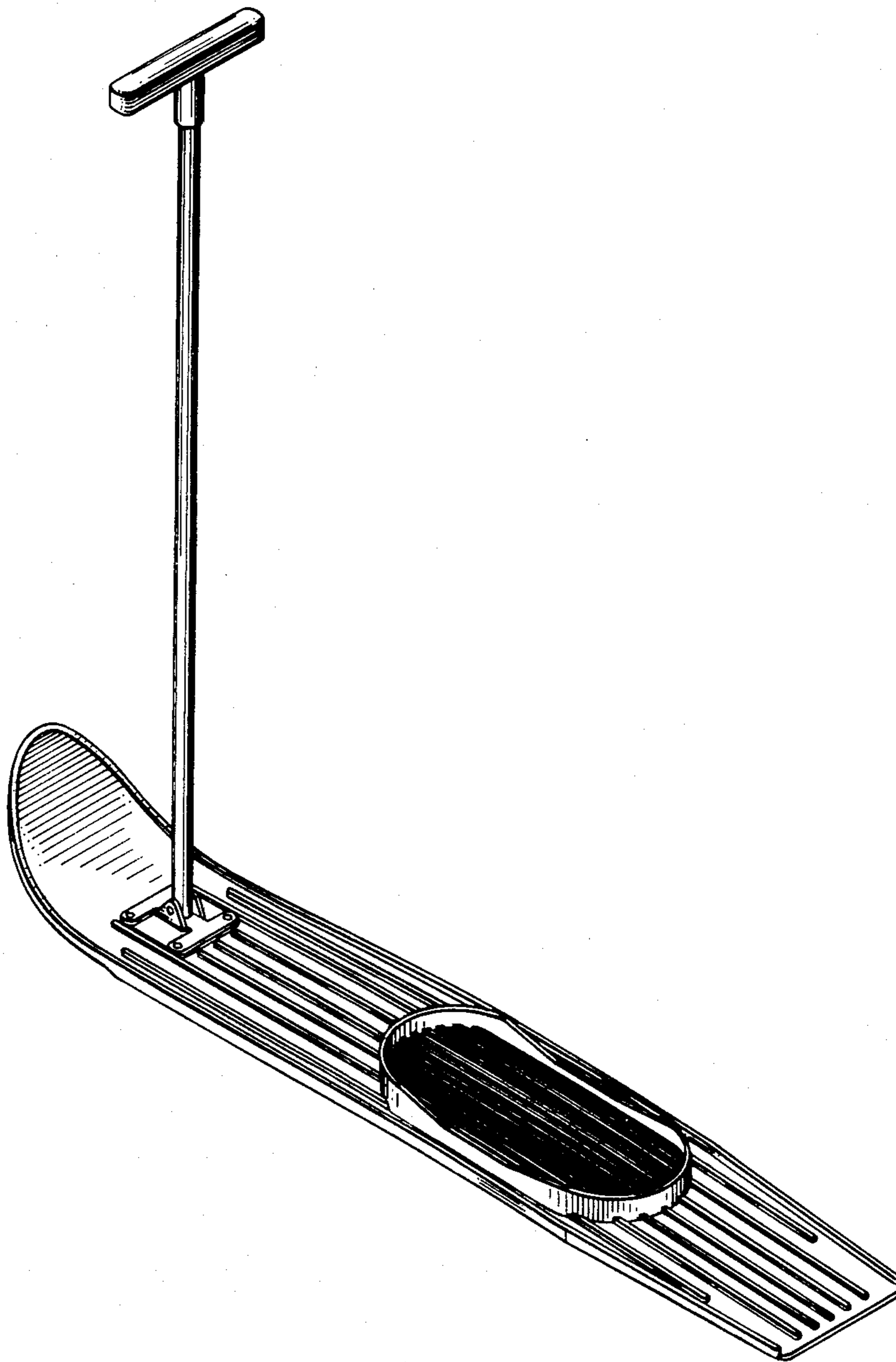

The ornamental design for a snow scooter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a snow scooter showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the side opposite being substantially identical;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view; and  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view.  
The handle member has been shown partially in fragment in FIG. 3 for ease of illustration.



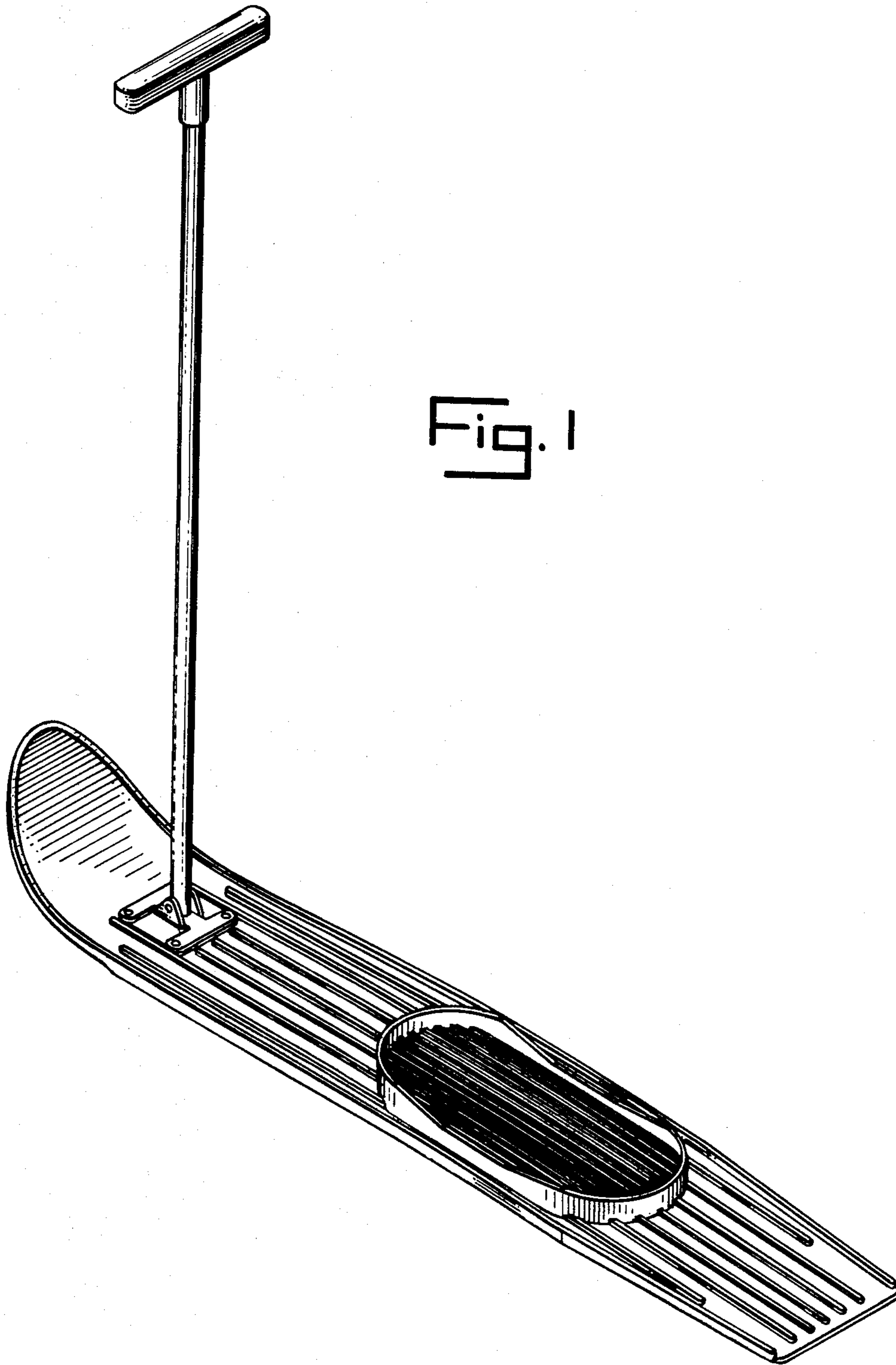

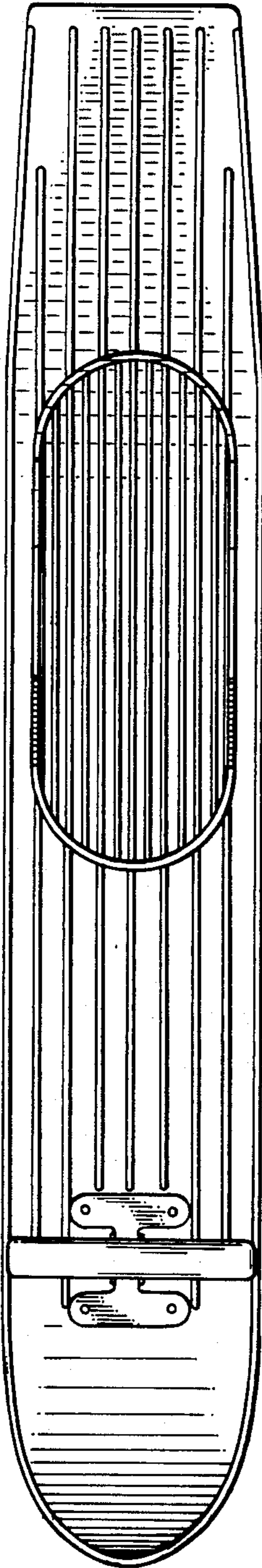

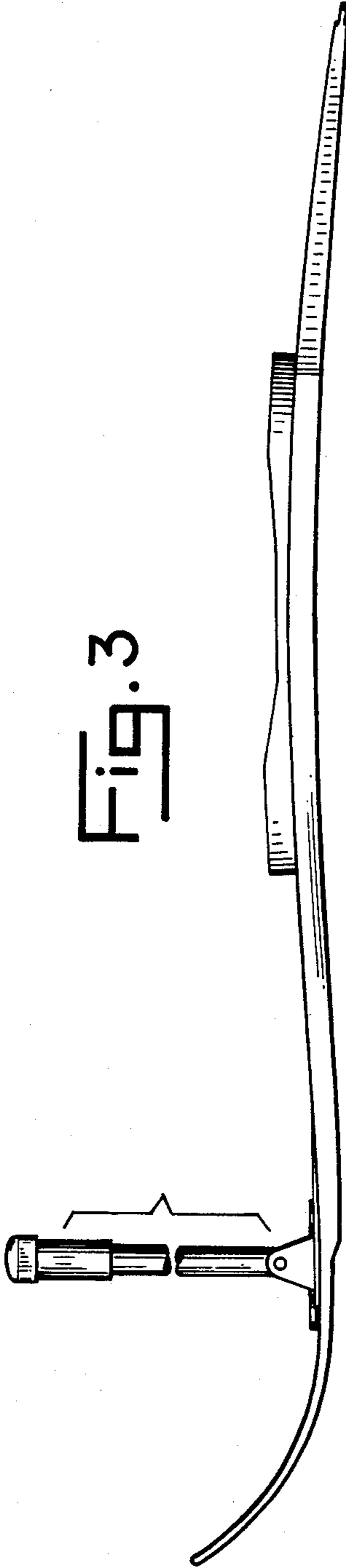

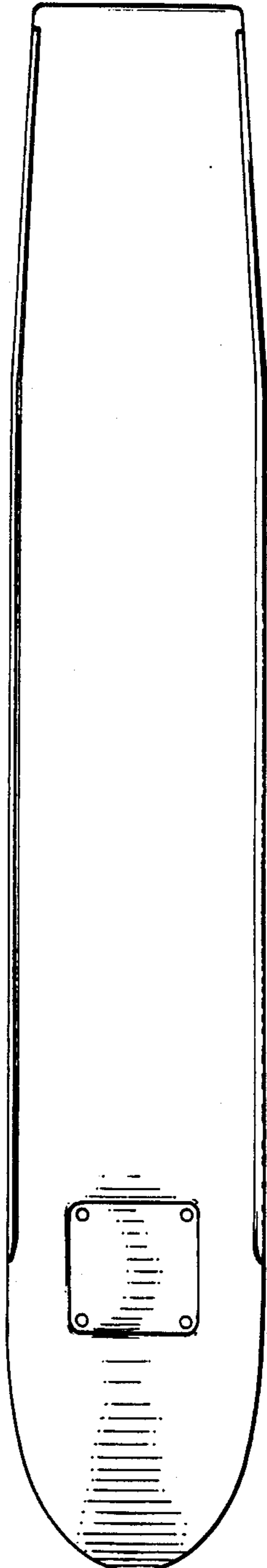

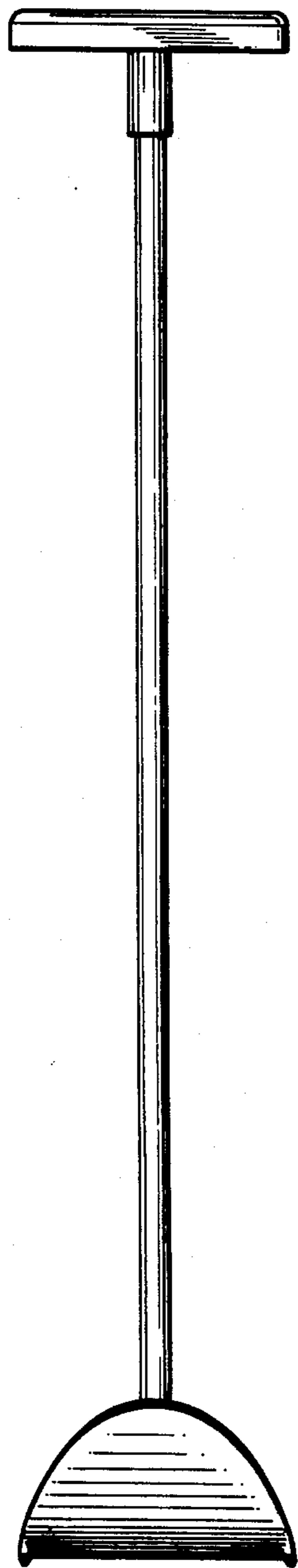
