[57] CLAIM

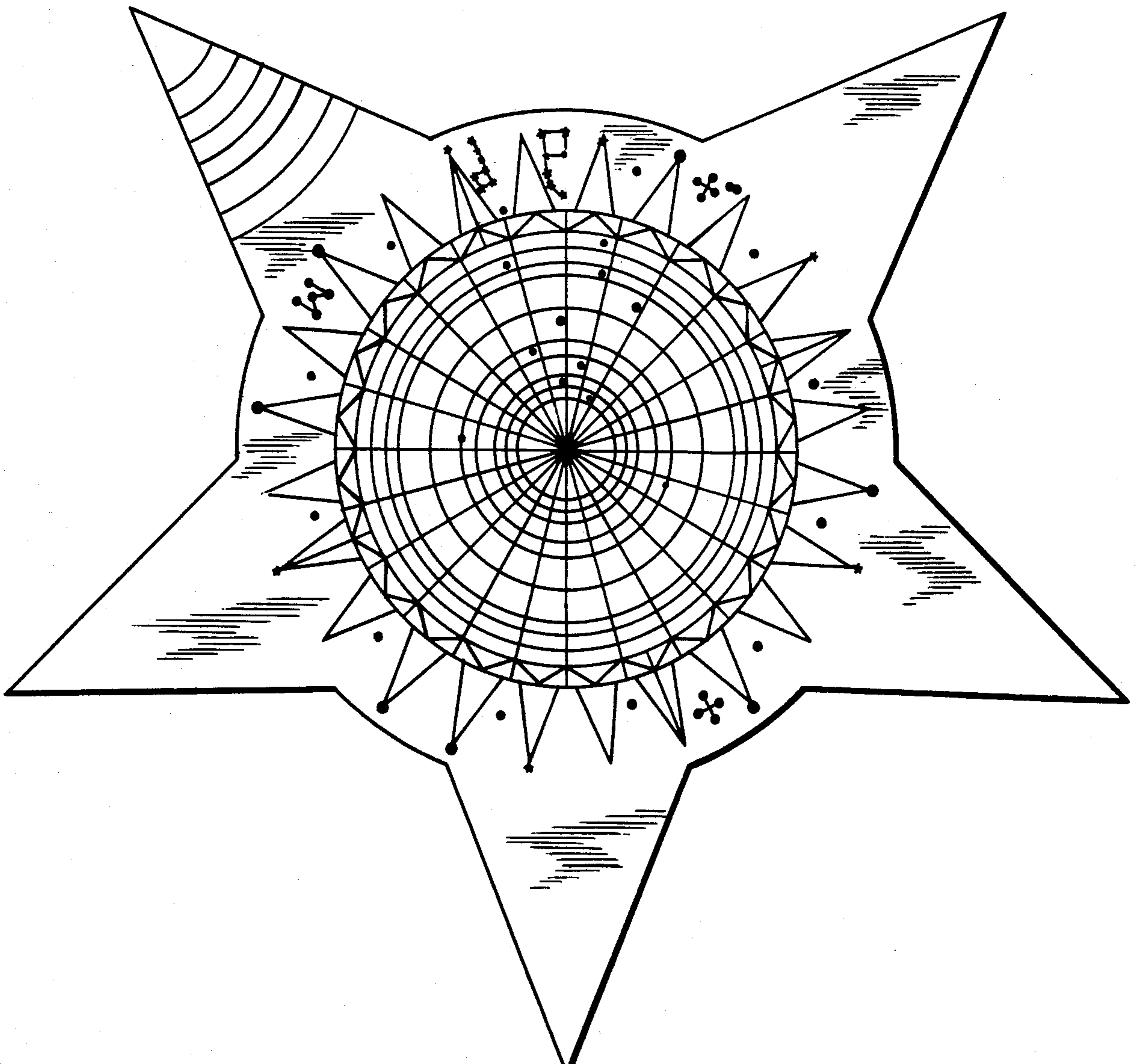
The ornamental design for a solar system game board, or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of my solar system game board, or similar article, showing my new design, with the wings in open position;

FIG. 2 is a similar view with the wings in closed position over the body of the board; and

FIG. 3 is an enlarged section on the line 3—3 of FIG. 2. The bottom of the board is undecorated.



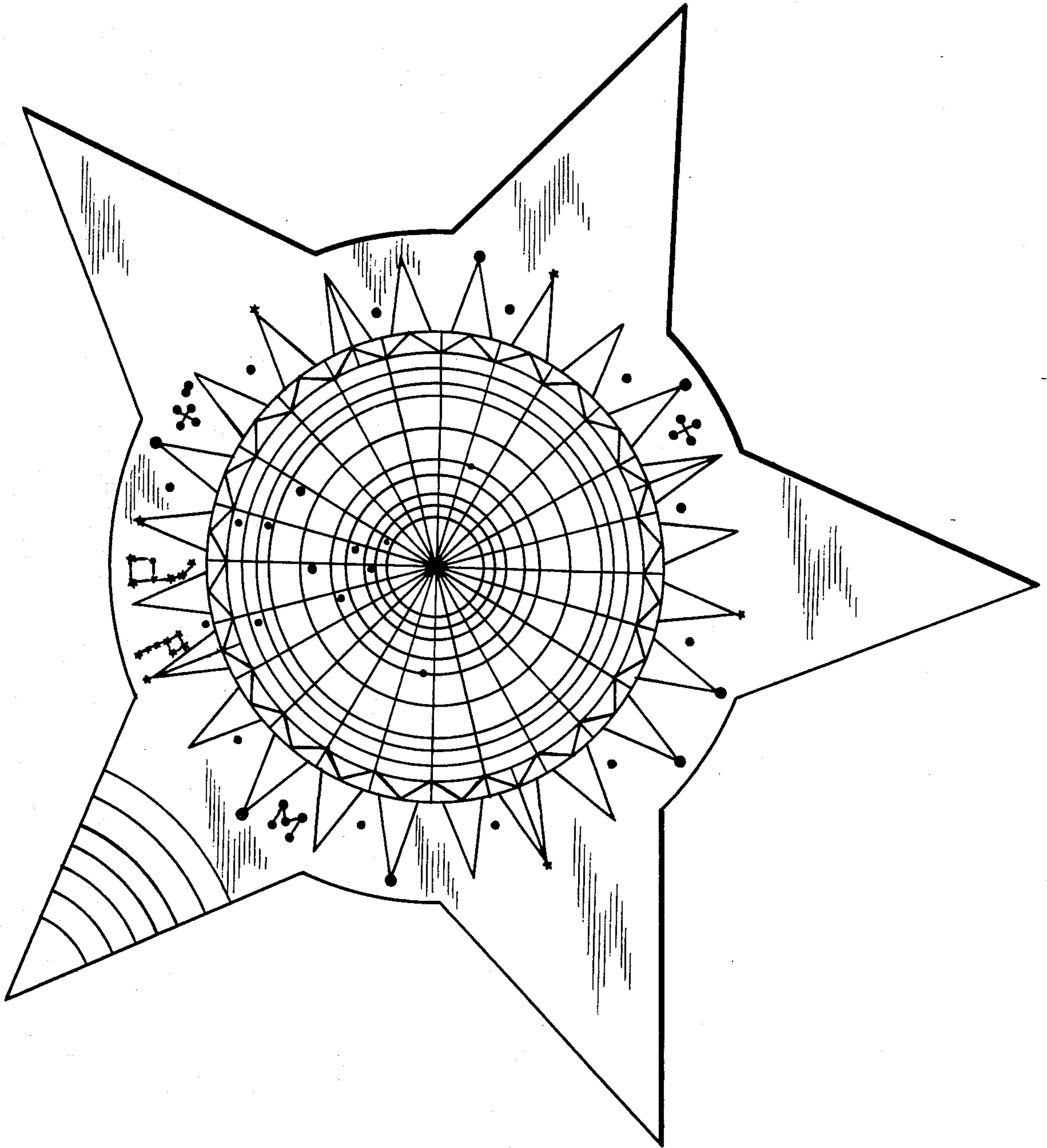

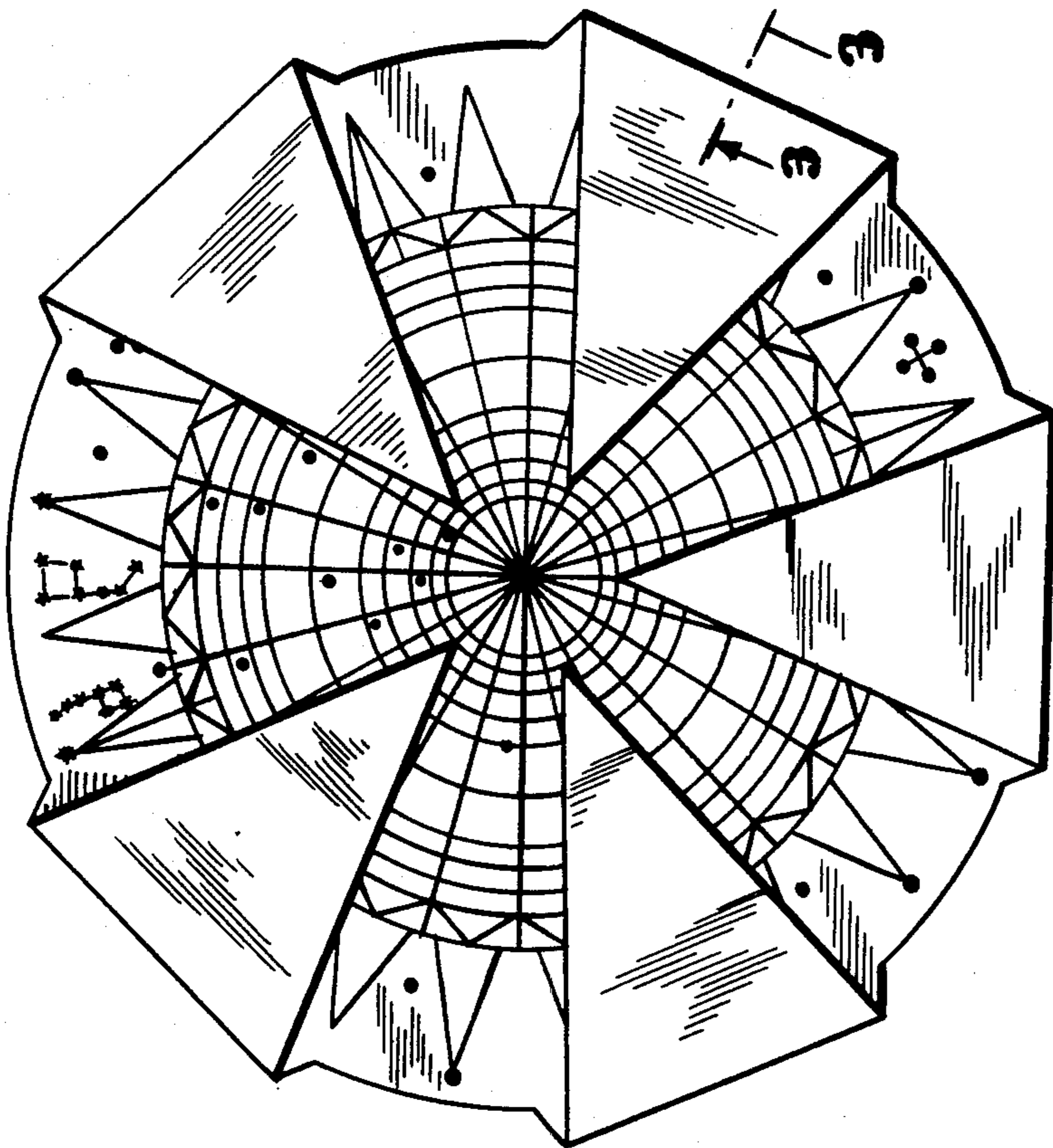
