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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a T-shirt, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a front elevational view of a T-shirt showing my new design. The contrasting neck and sleeve bands continue on the rear of the T-shirt and the rear is otherwise plain and unornamented.
