 FIG. 2 is a fragmentary perspective view thereof.

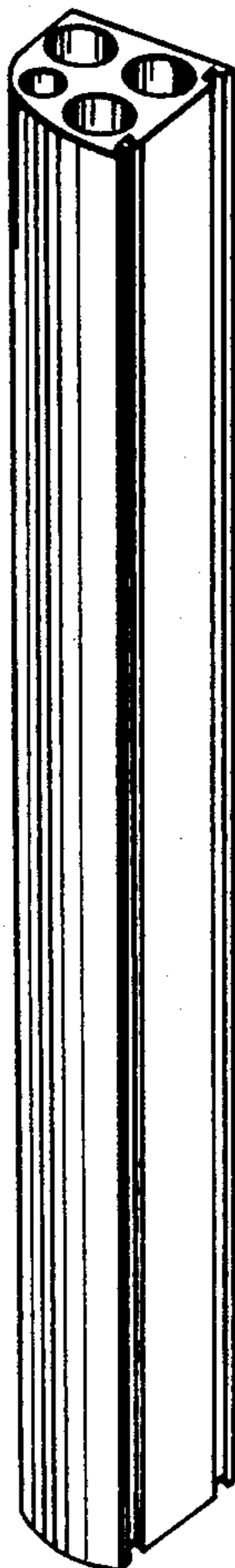
