DESCRIPTION

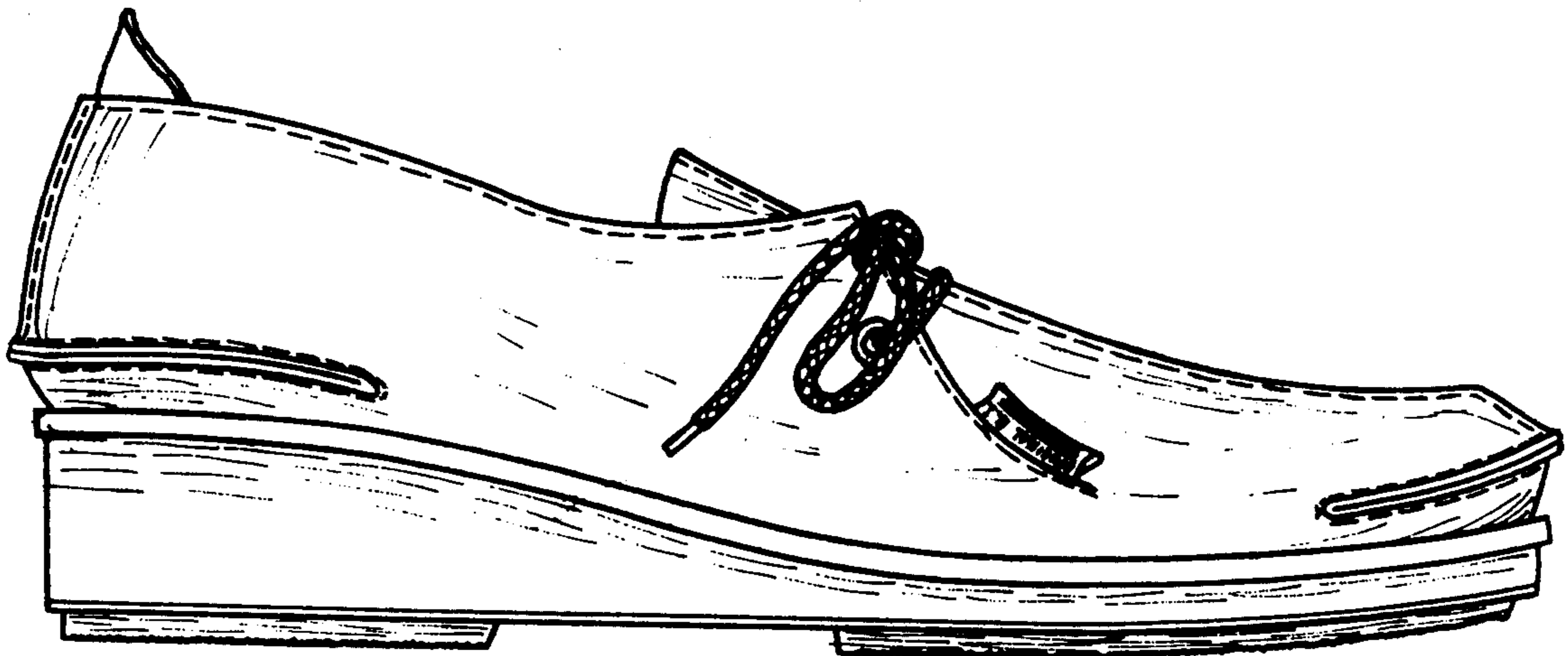
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a shoe showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view from the opposite side as that shown in FIG. 2.



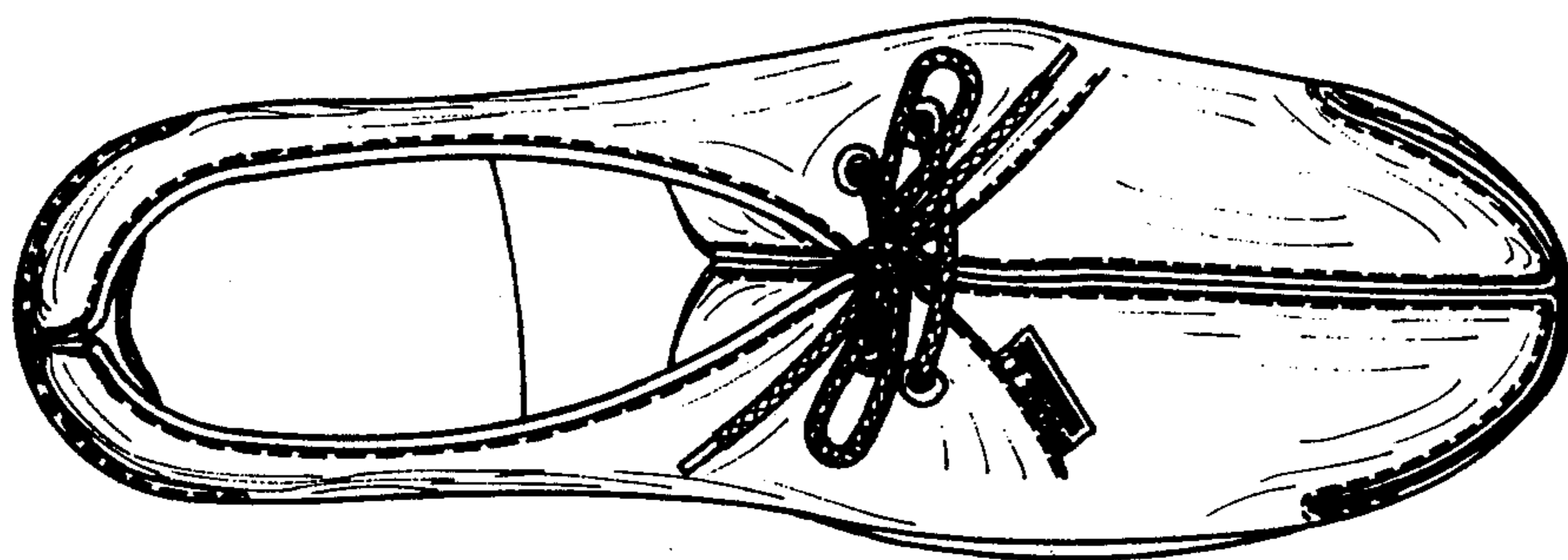

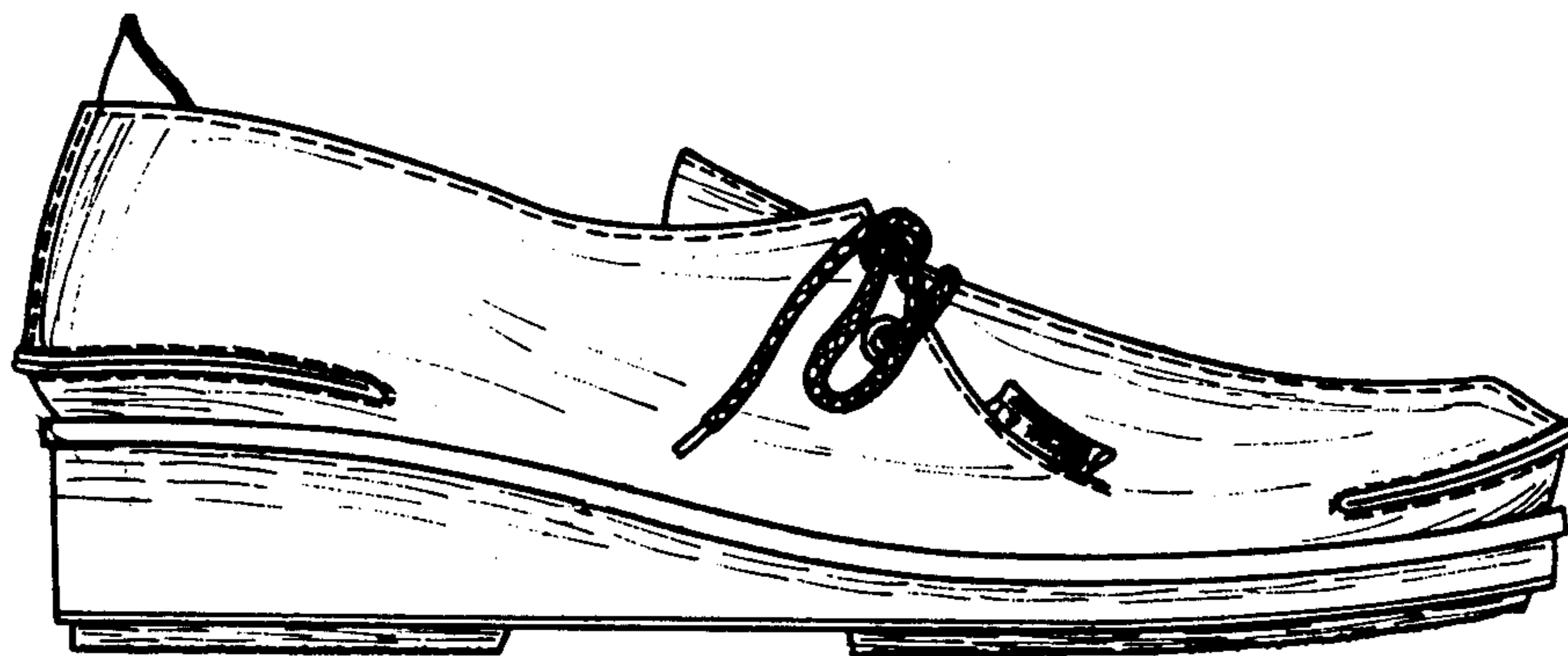

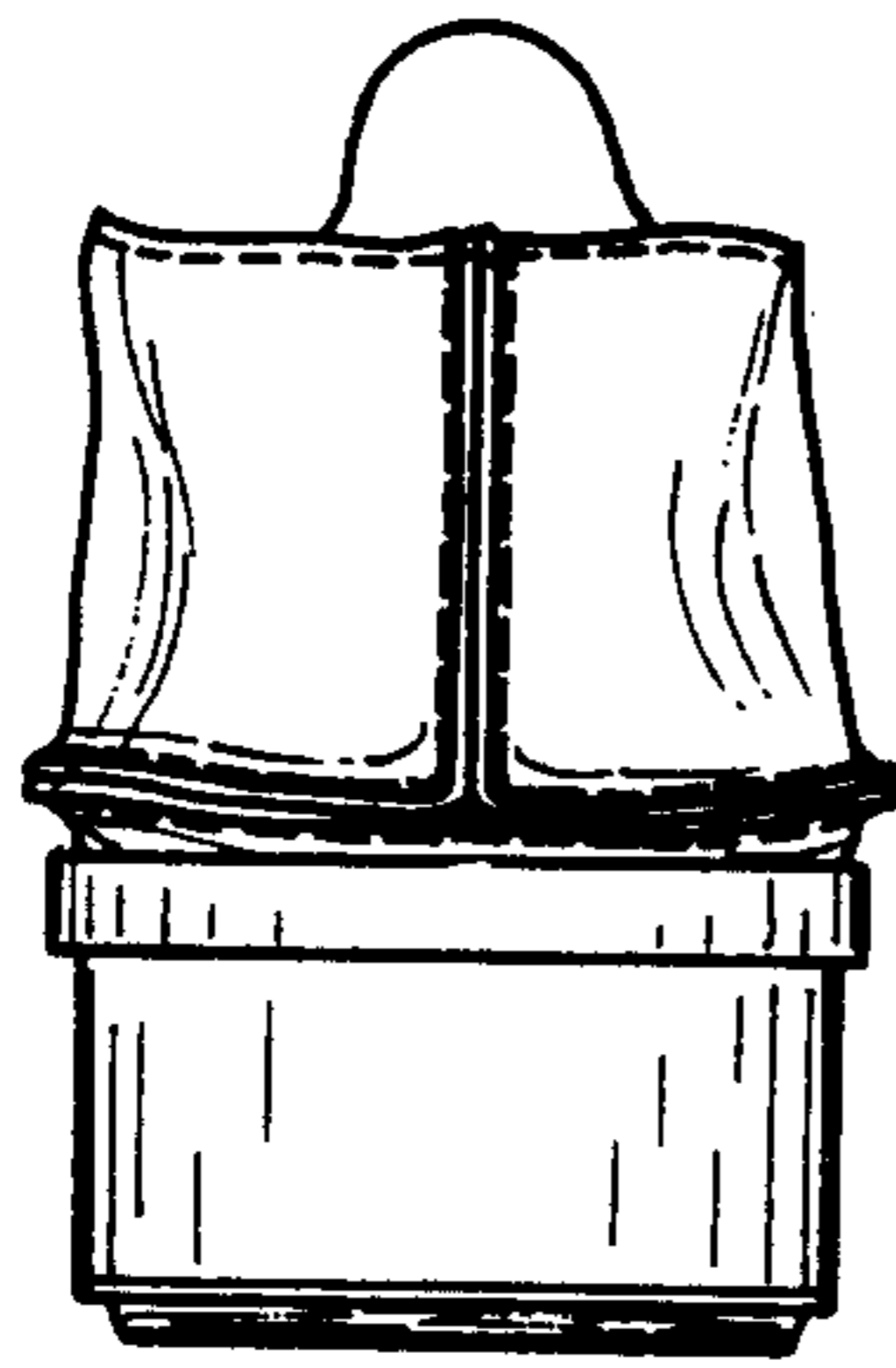

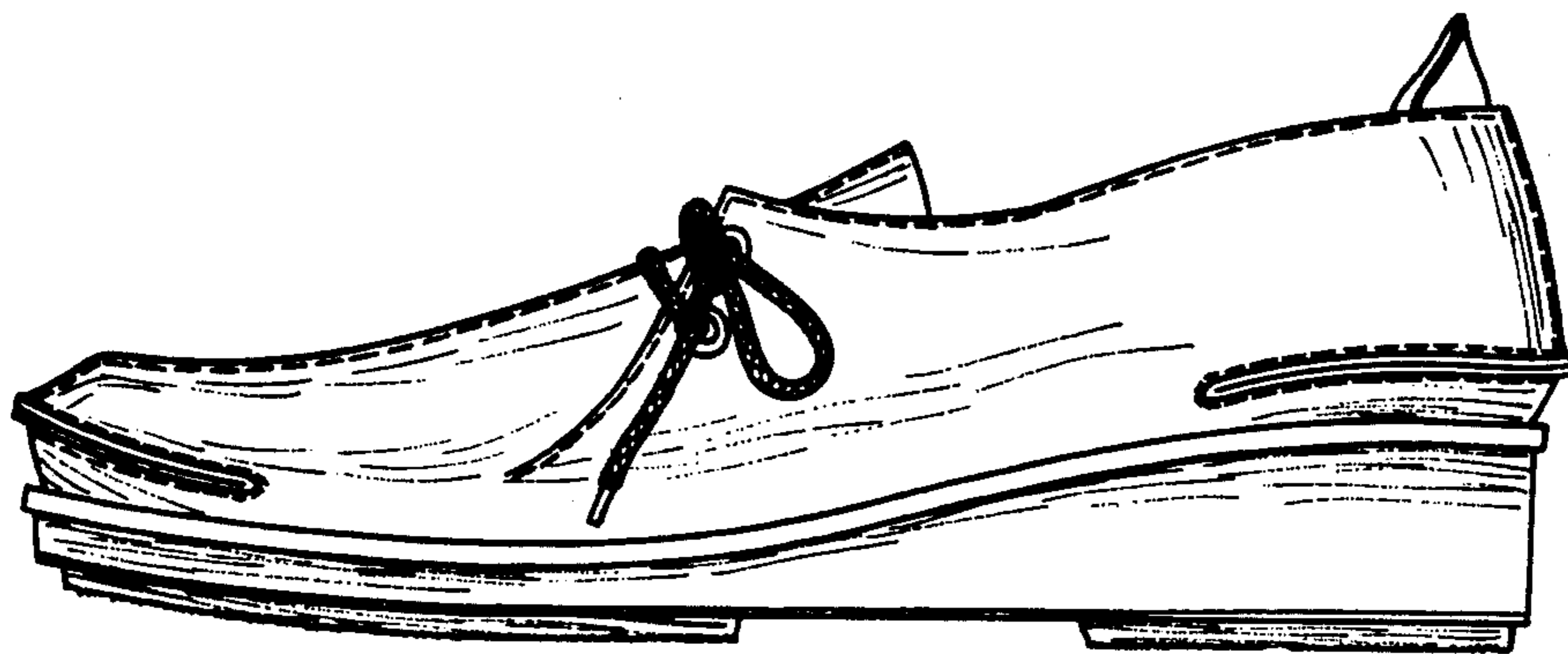
