DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined leaf
sweeper body and handle showing my new design;

it being understood that the handle has been broken
away for convenience of illustration;

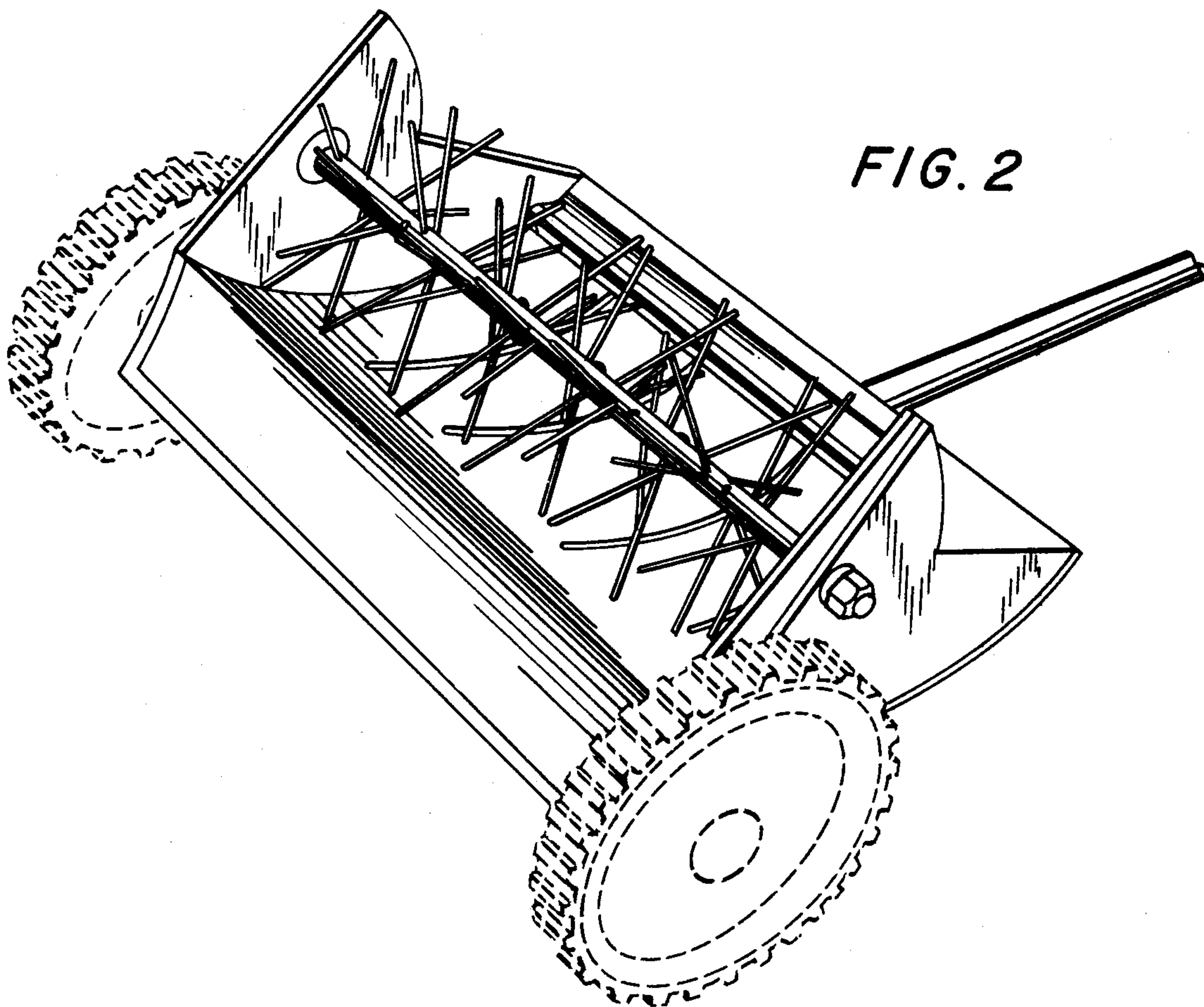
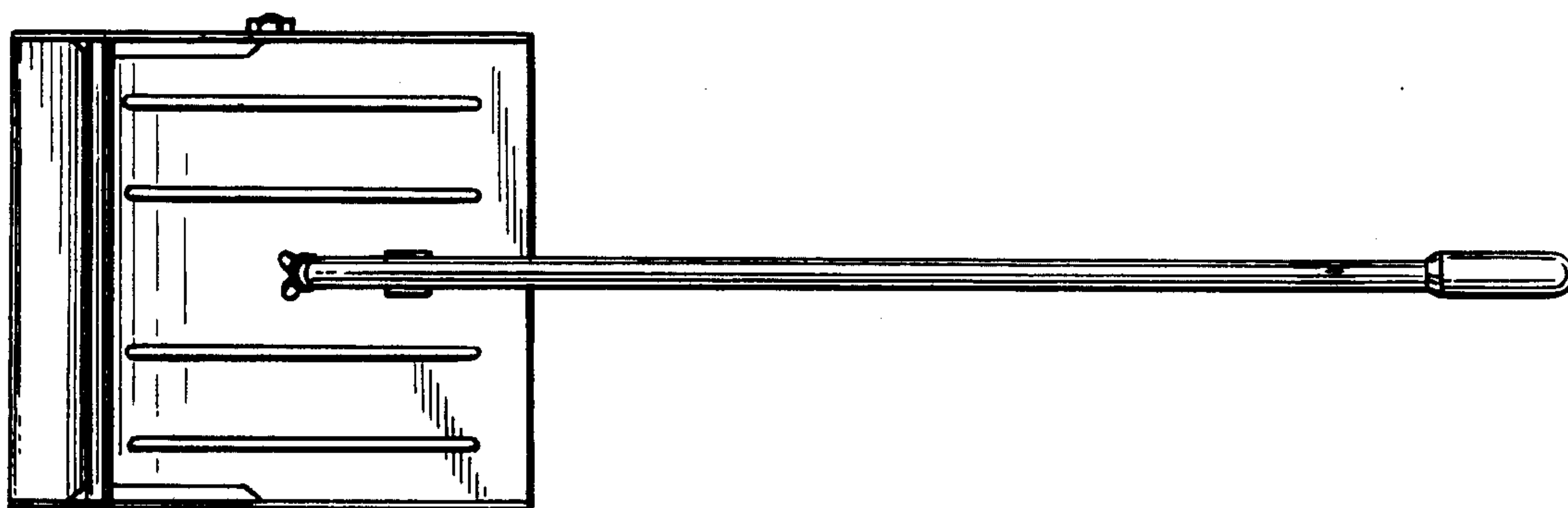


FIG. 3*FIG. 4*

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

purposes only.

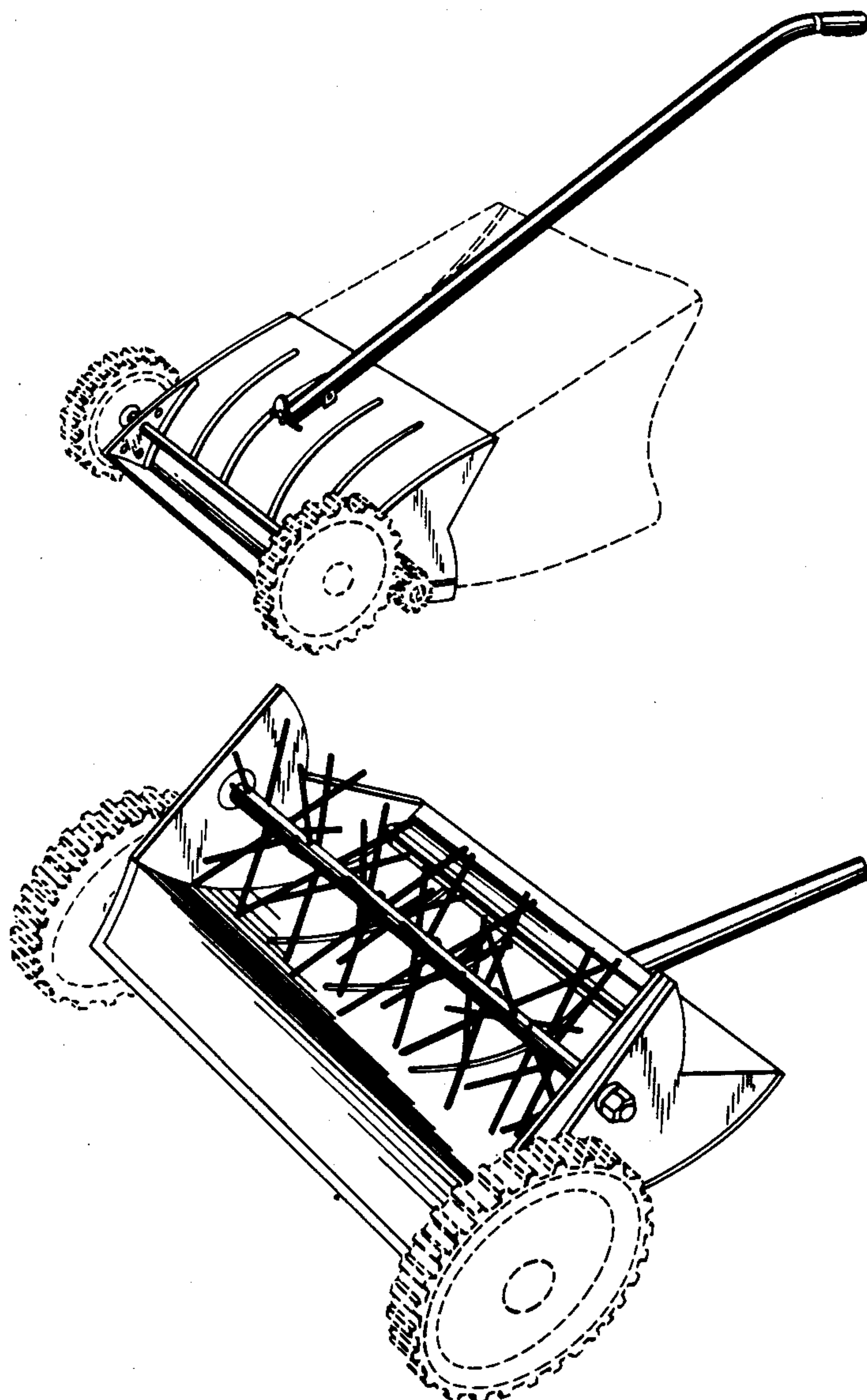

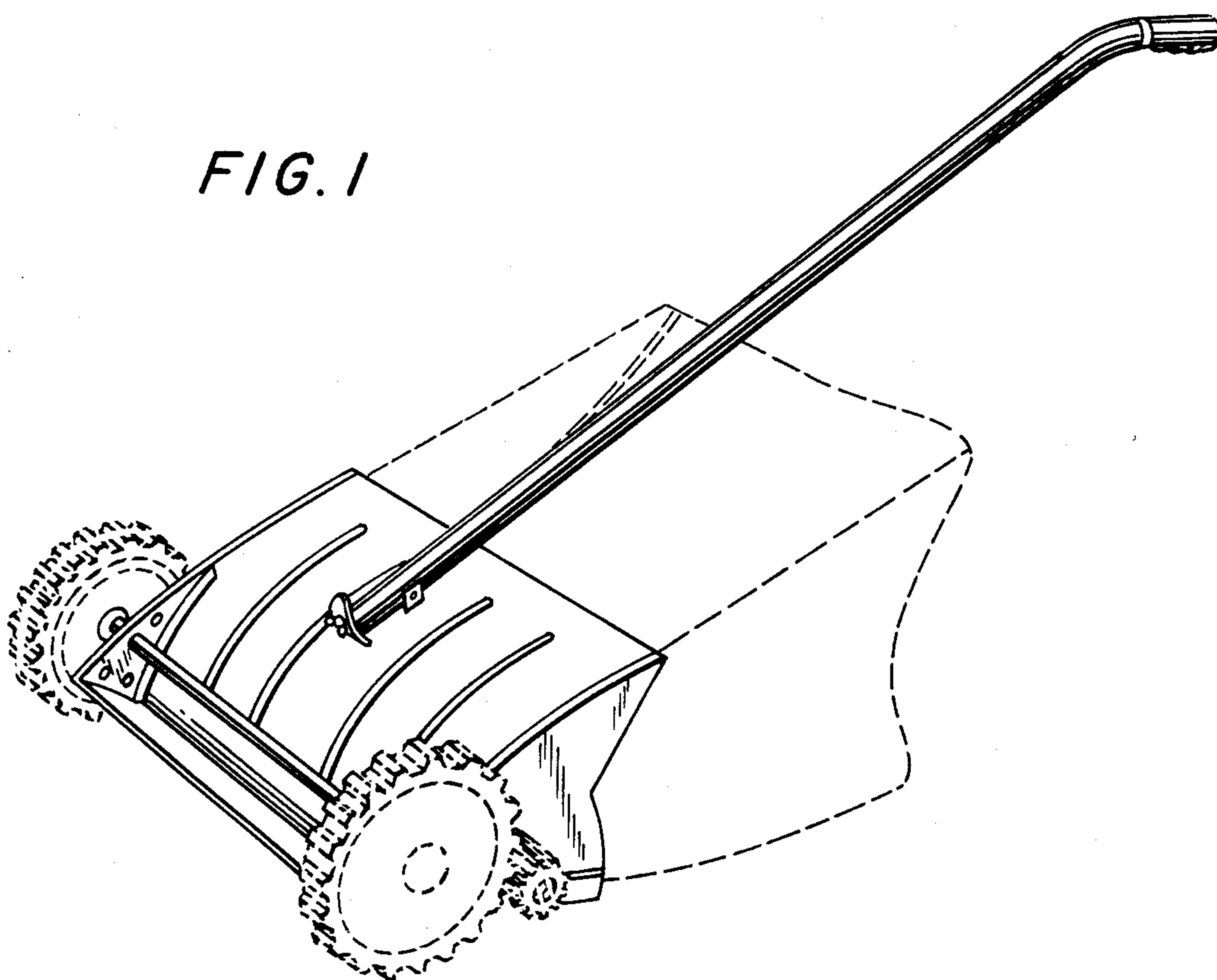
