DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a case for binoculars showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 7 is a reduced scale front perspective view; and
FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view thereof in a partially open condition.

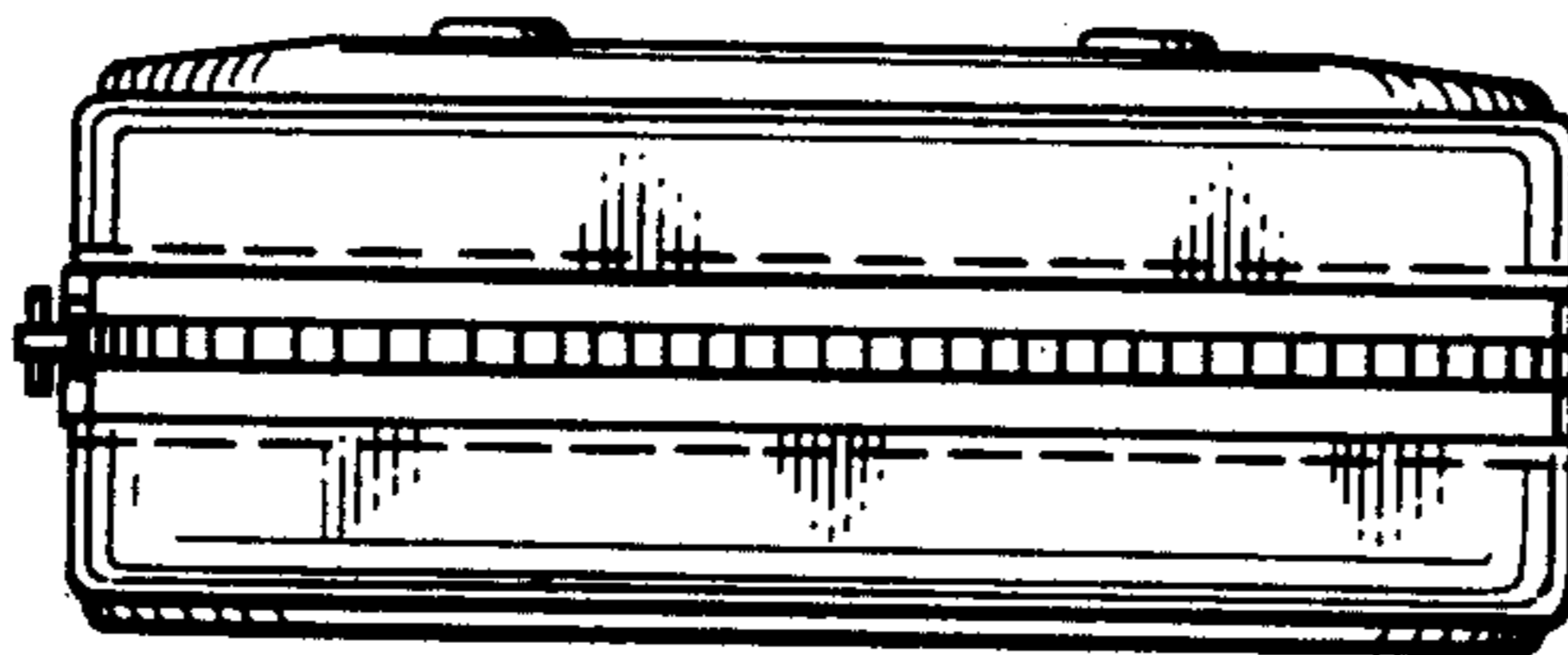
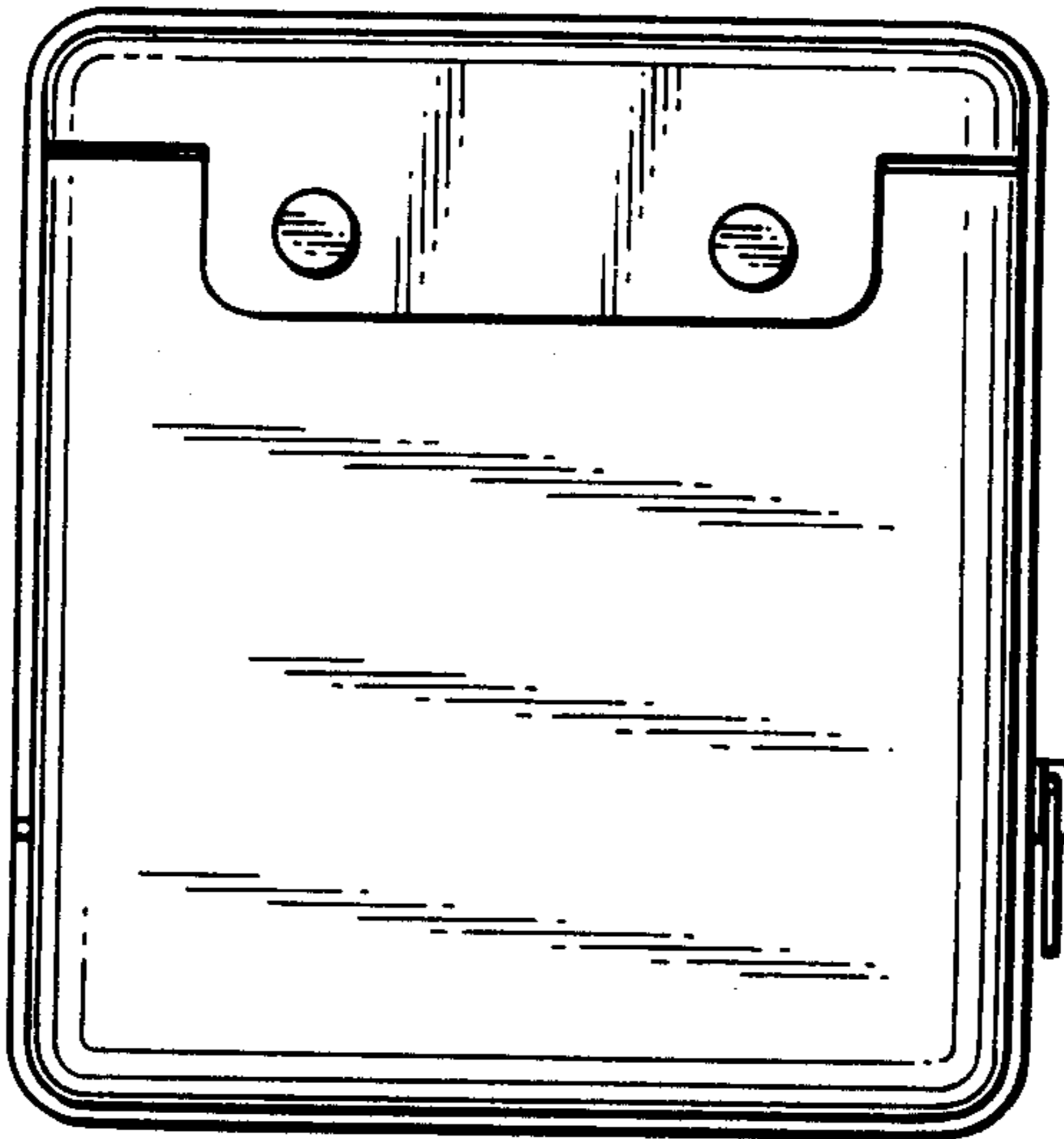

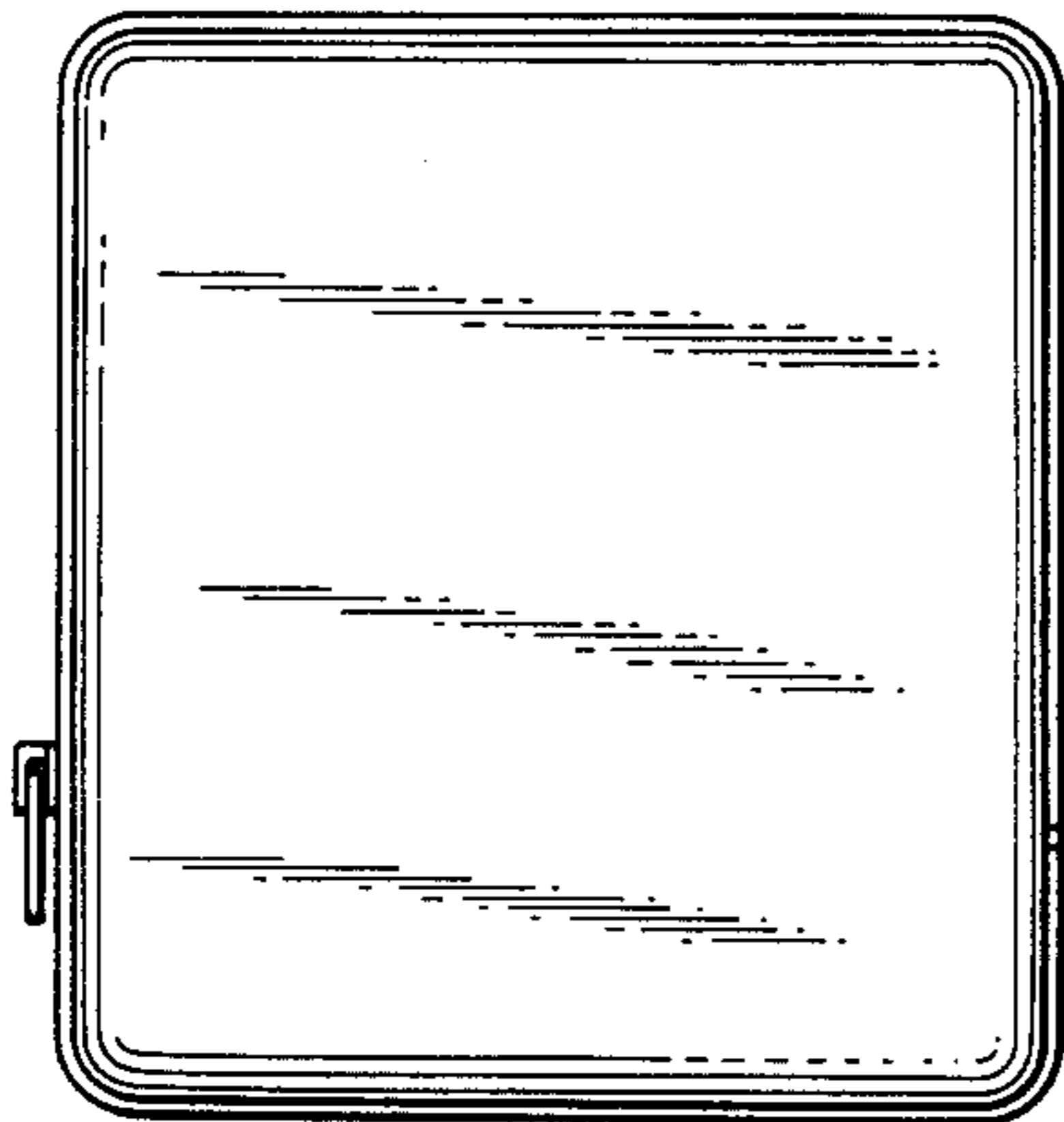

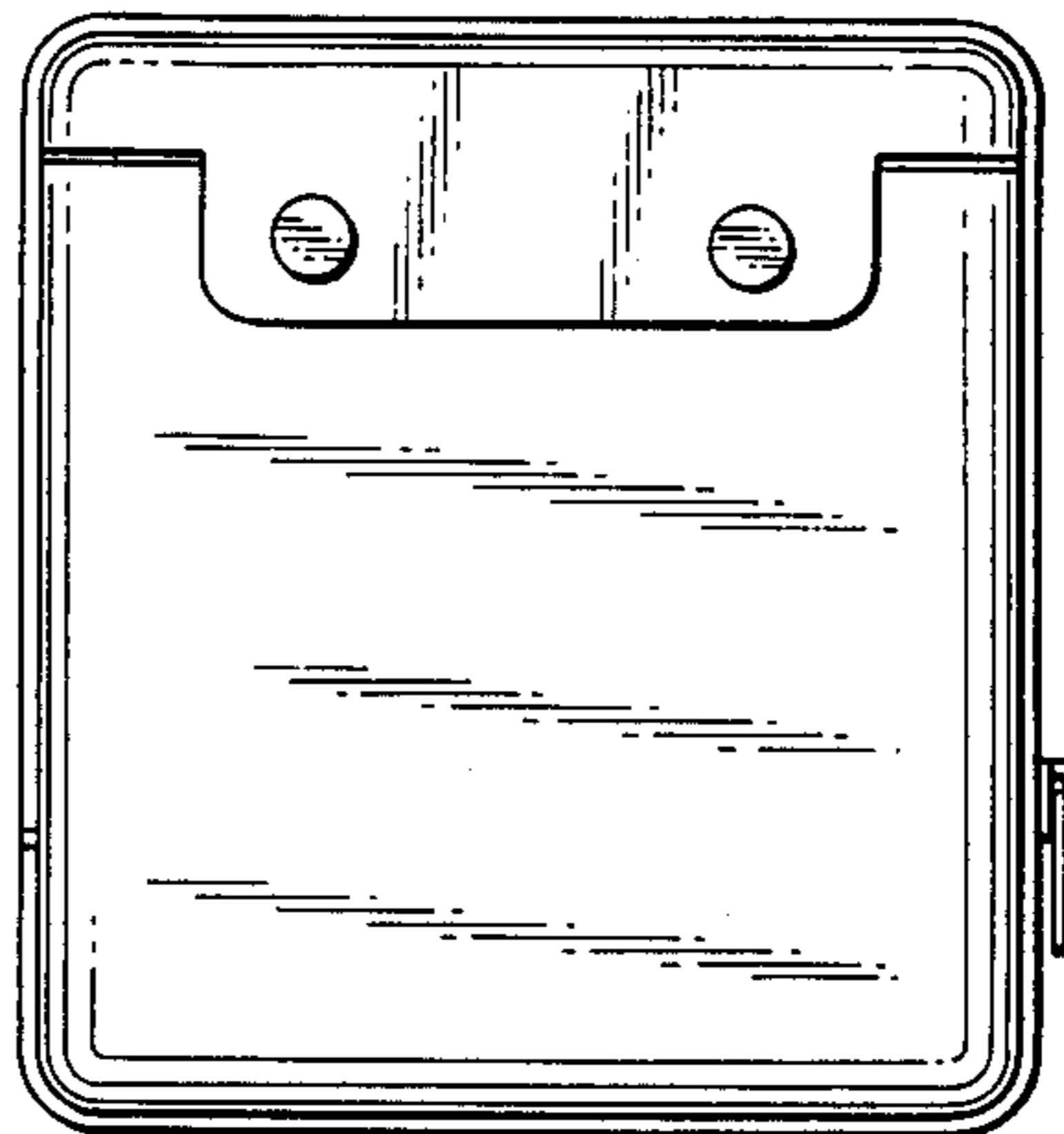

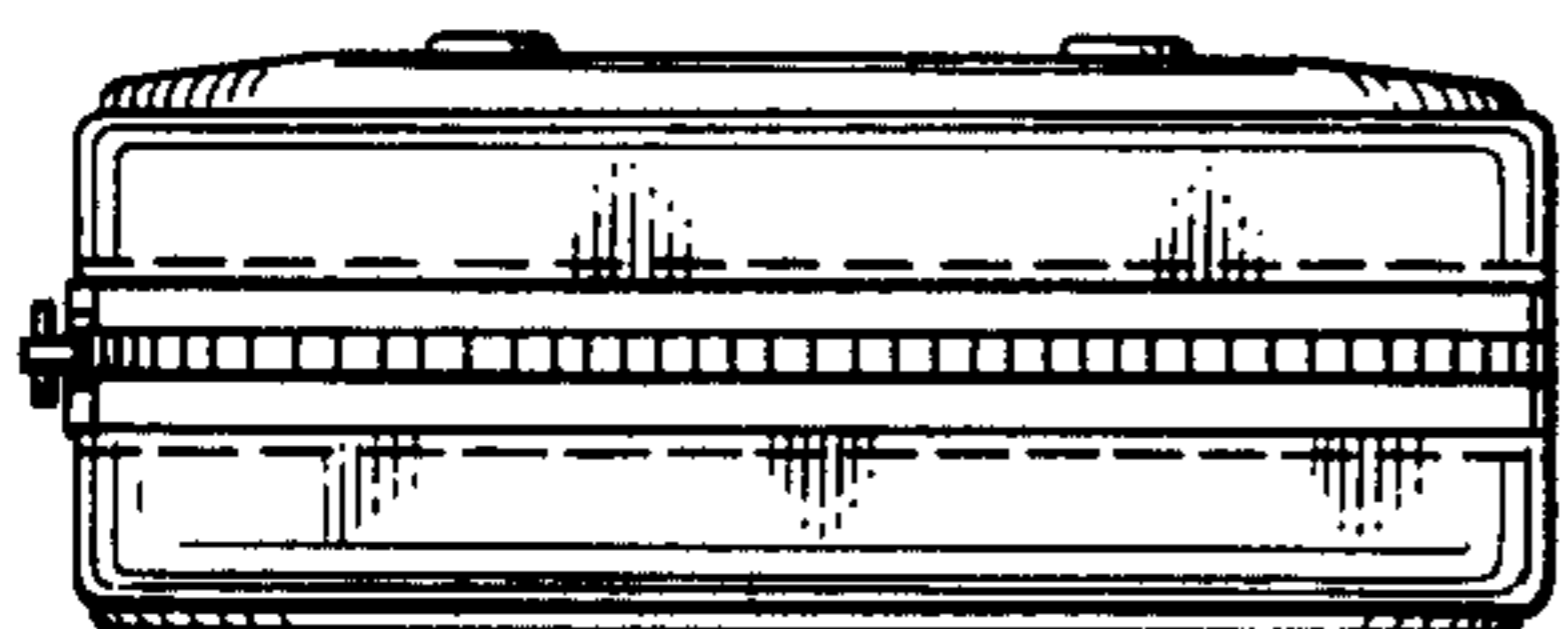

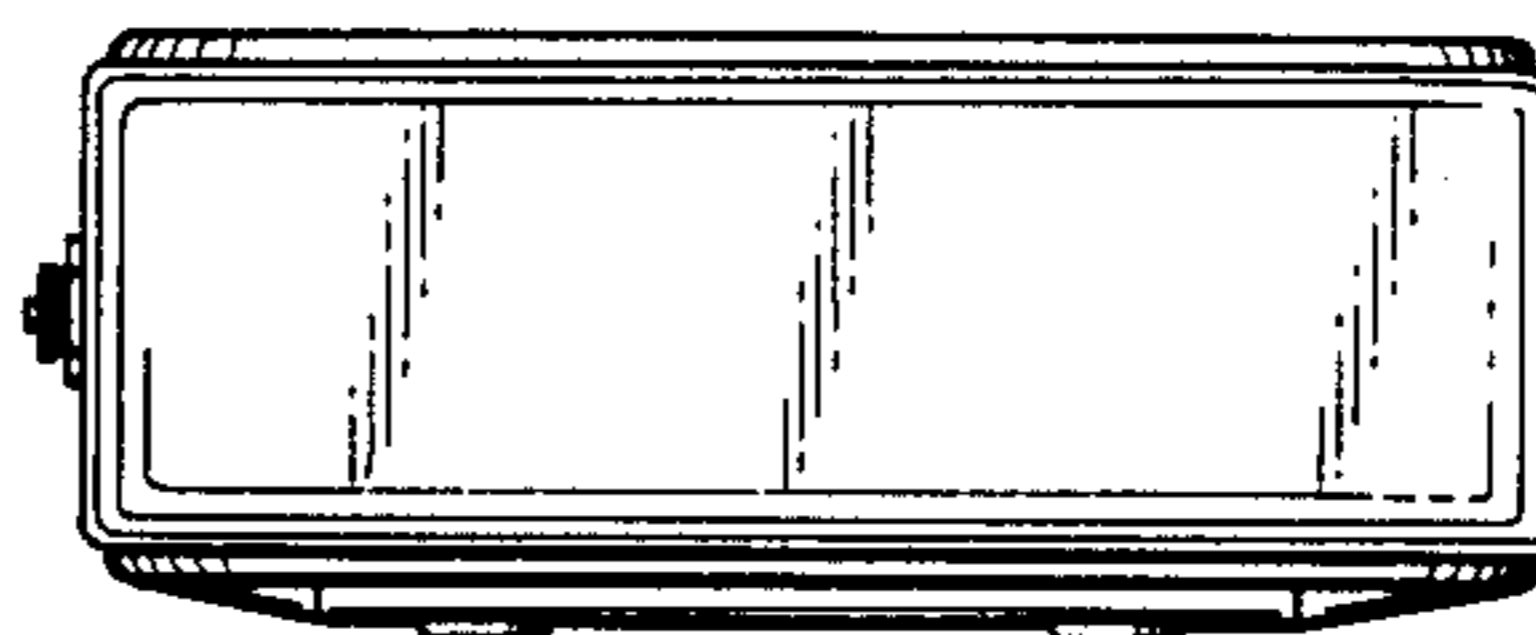

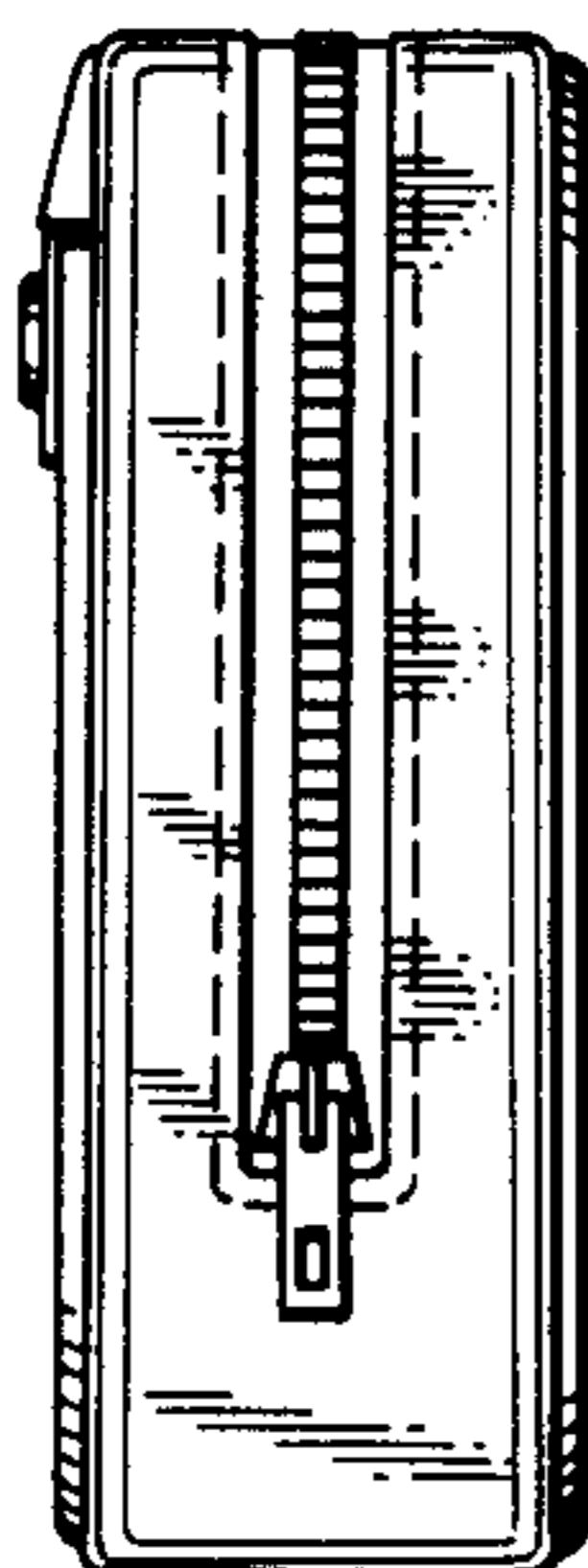

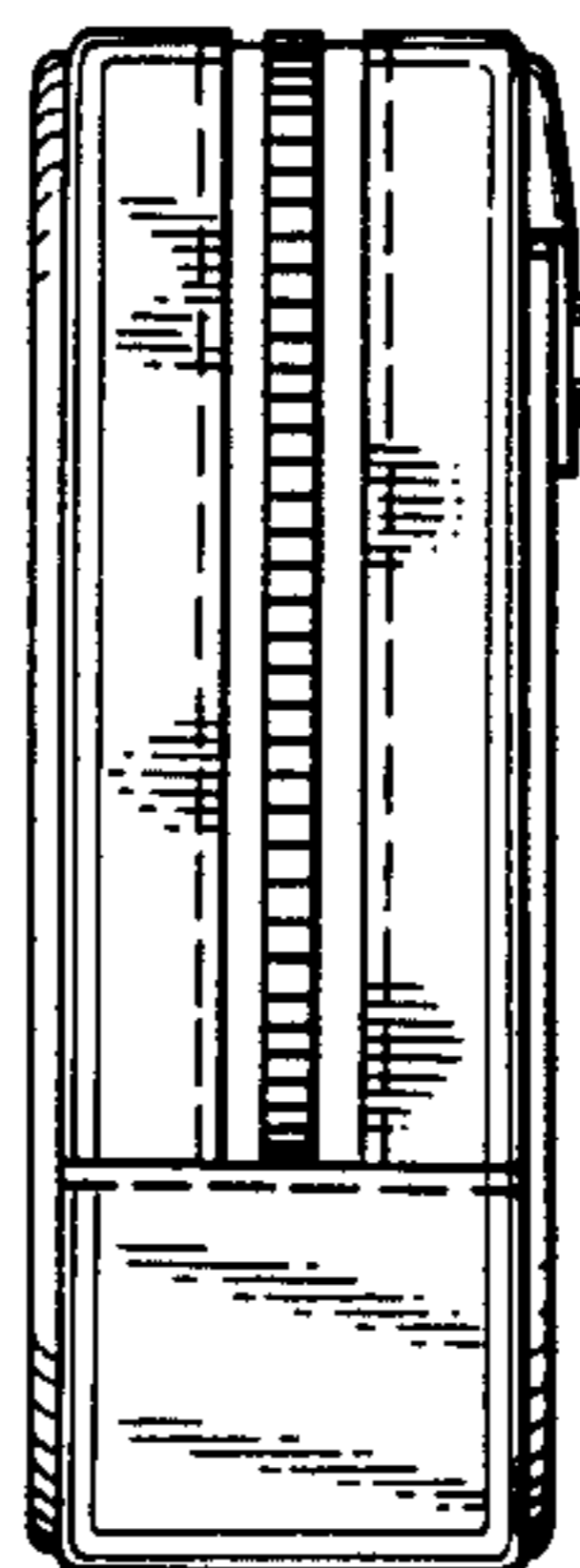

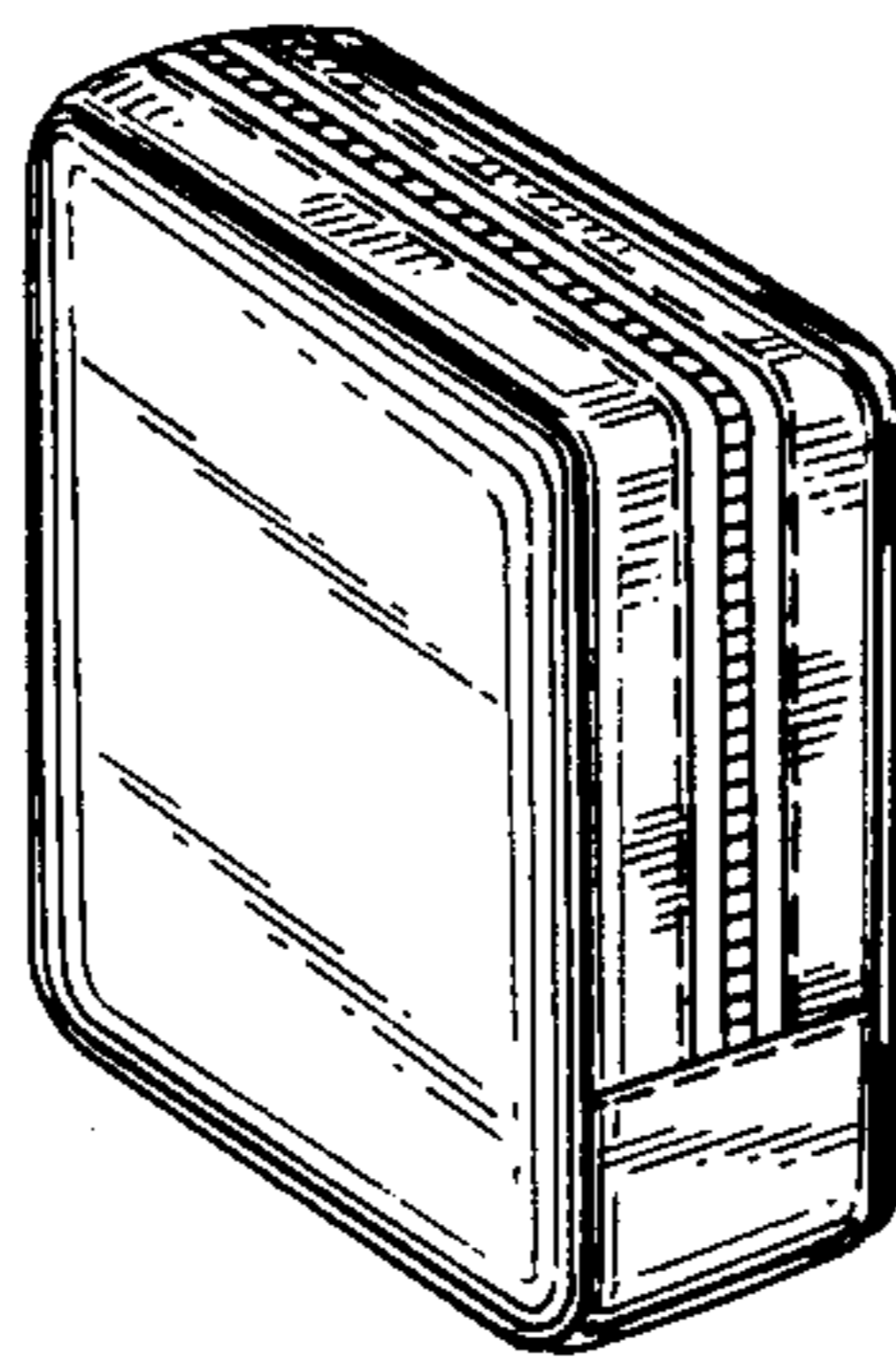
