The ornamental design for a platform type shoe sole, as shown and described.

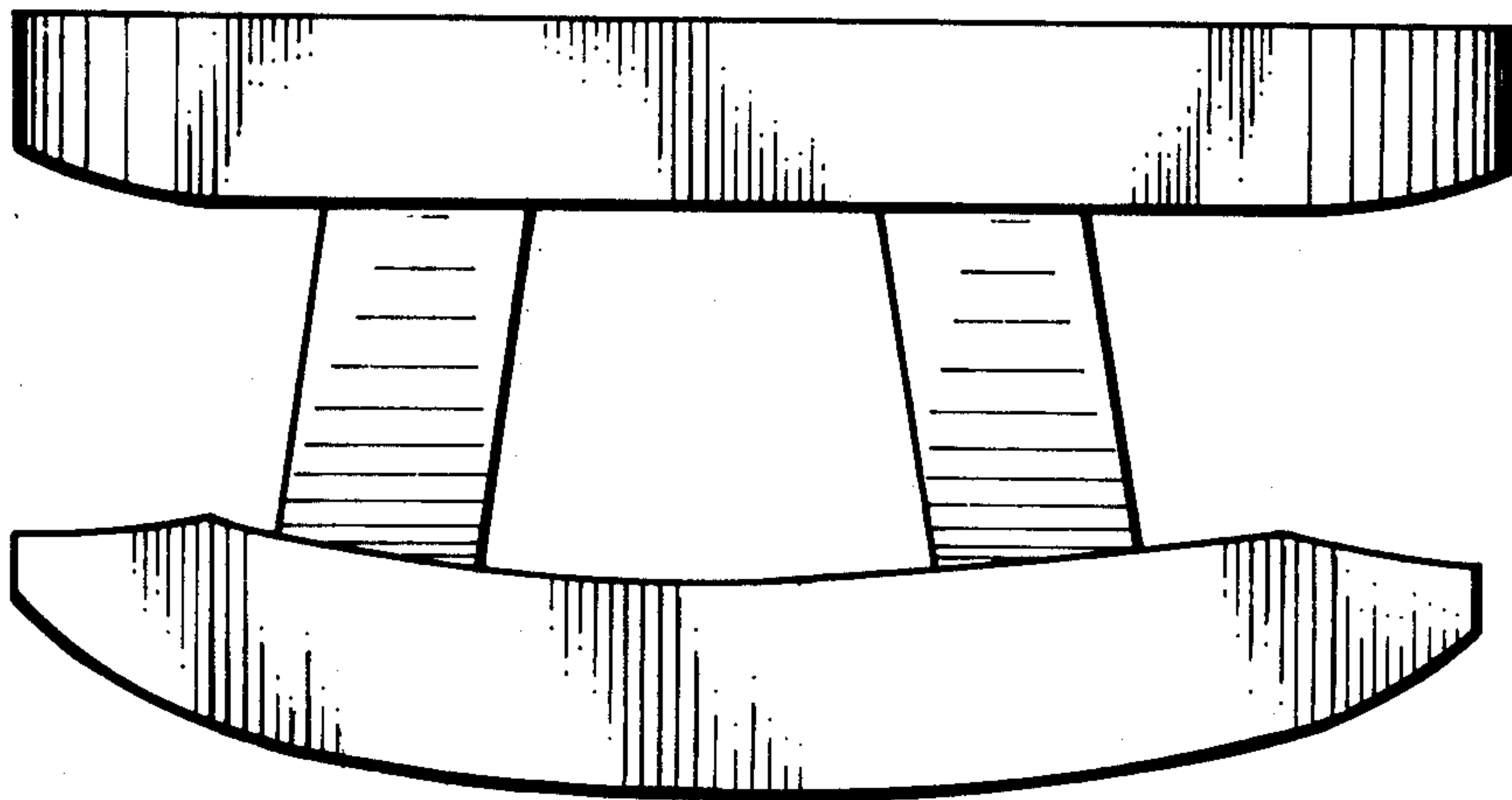
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a platform type shoe sole showing my new design; the right side being a mirror image thereto;

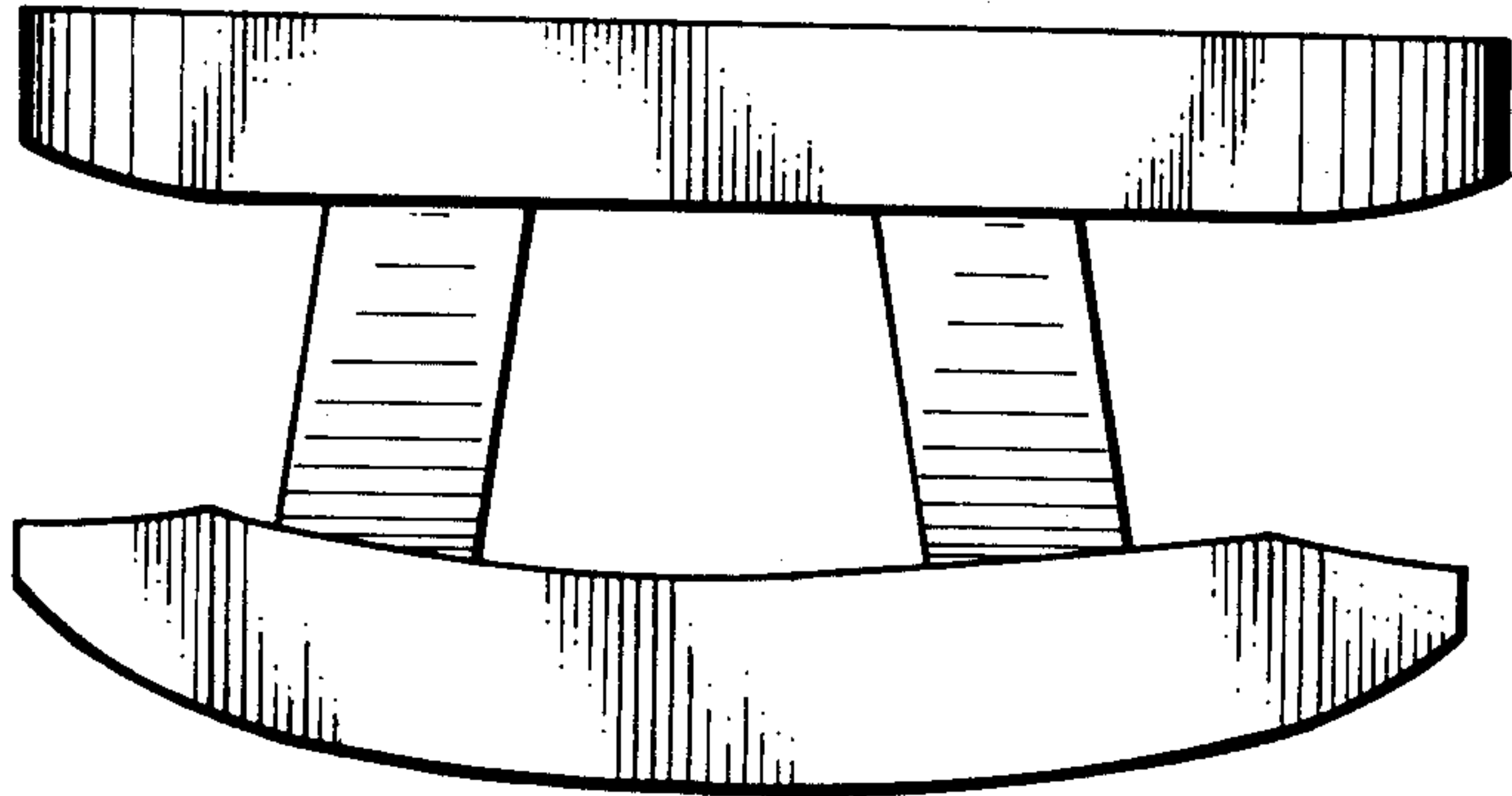

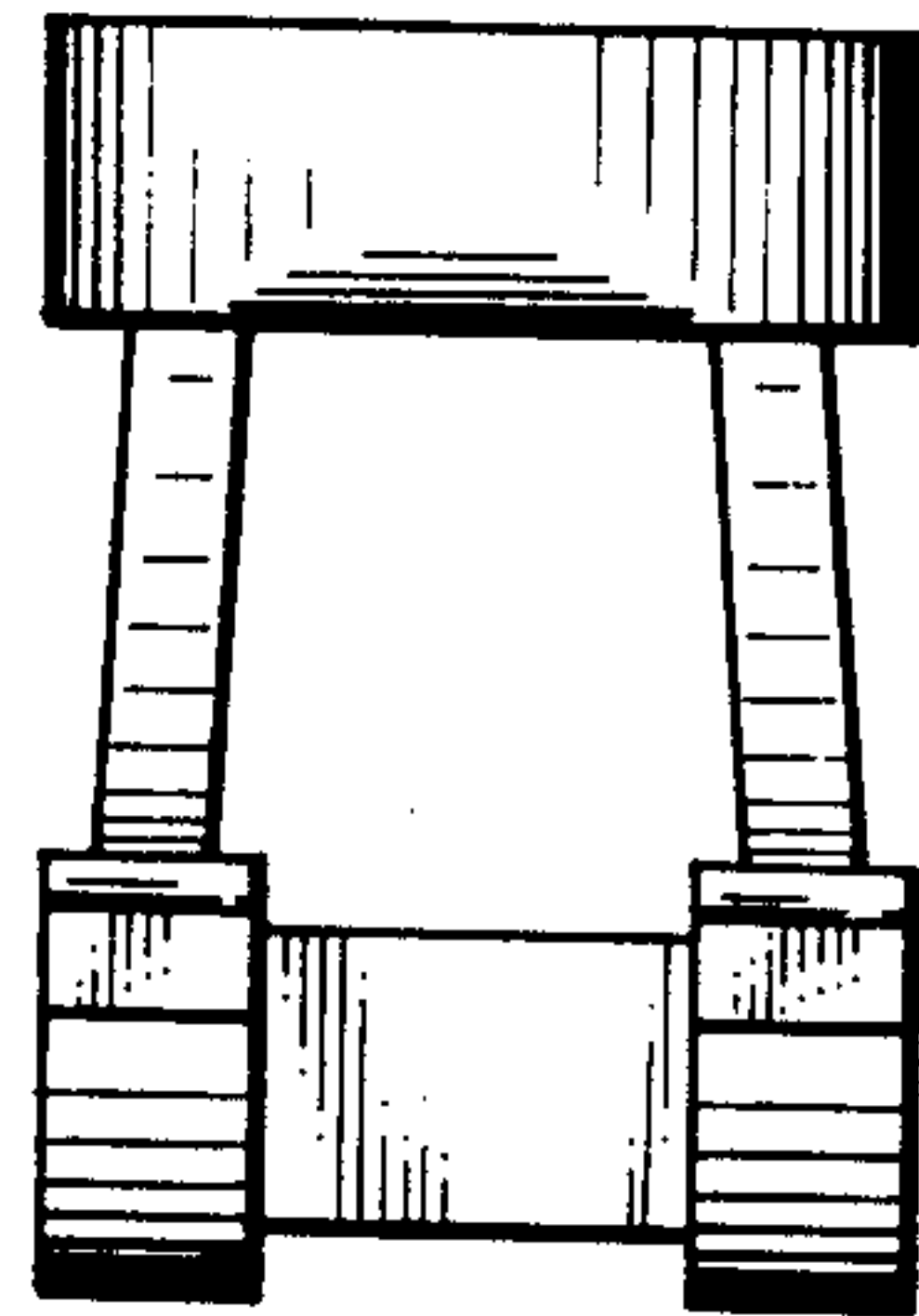

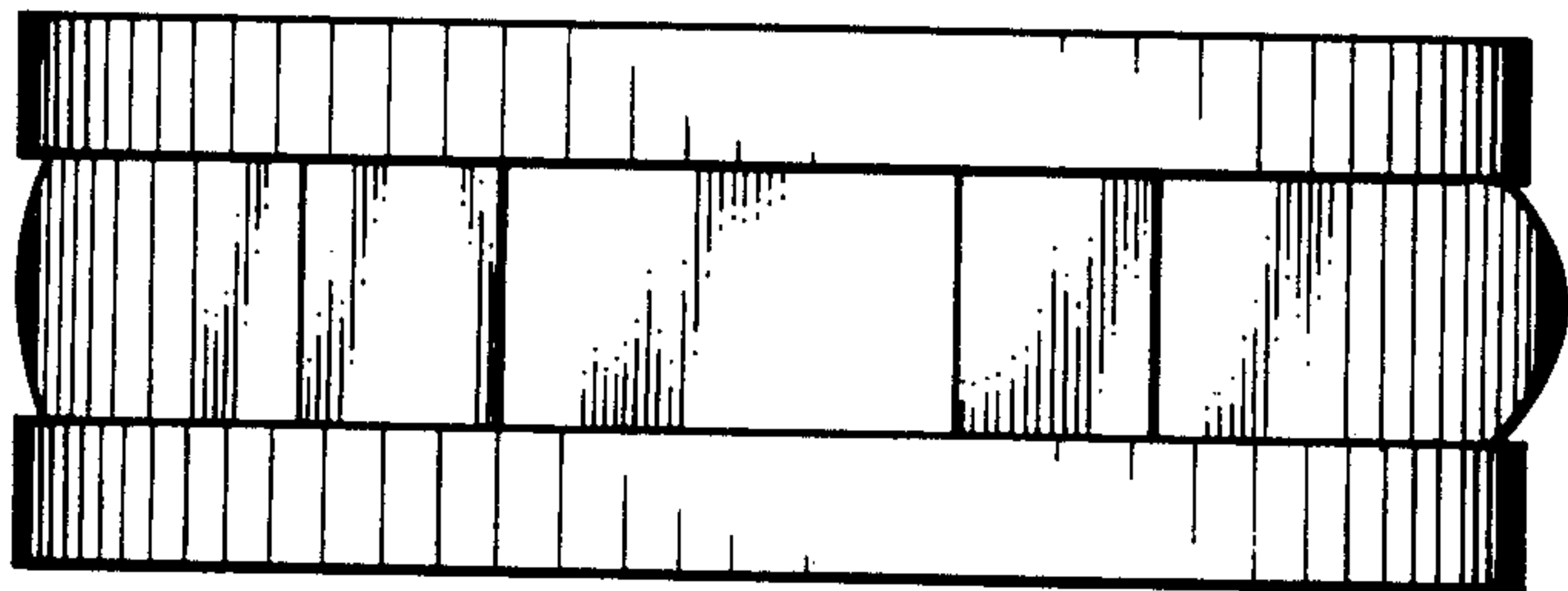

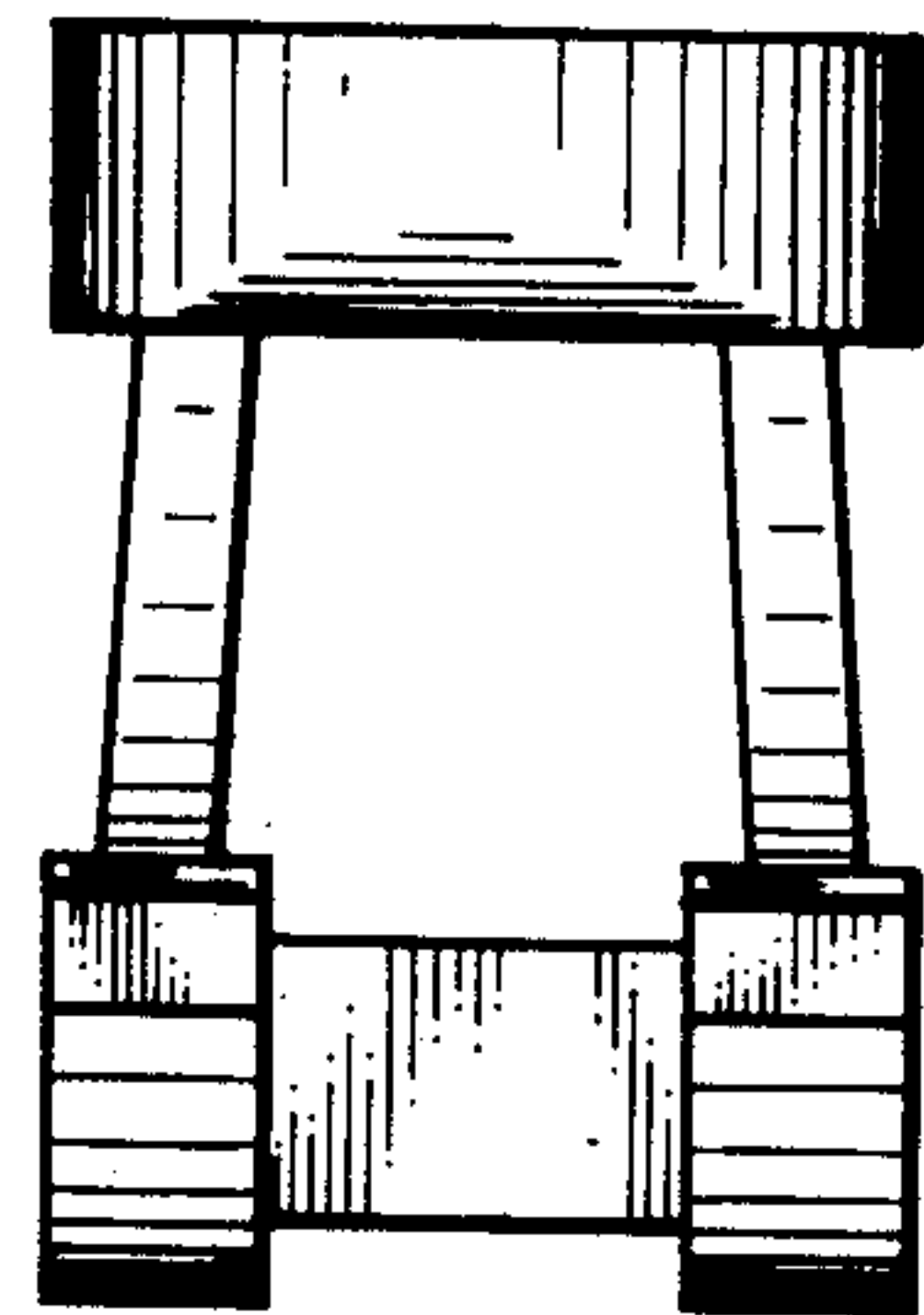
