[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined towel caddy and tissue dispenser, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the combined towel caddy and tissue dispenser showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view from one side thereof, the other side being a mirror image; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 1; and FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken on line 6-6 of FIG. 1.
