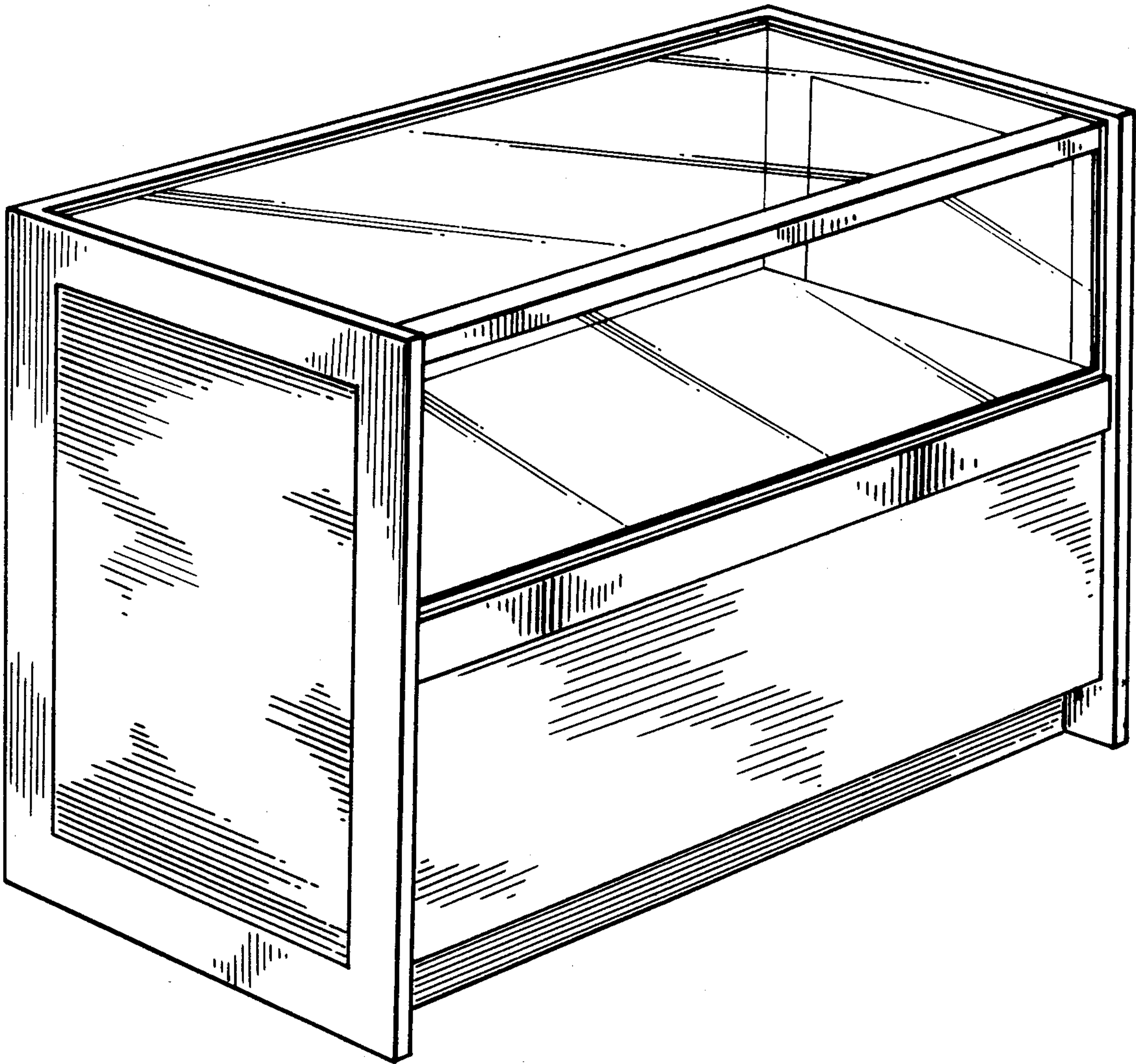

The side opposite that shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 is identical.



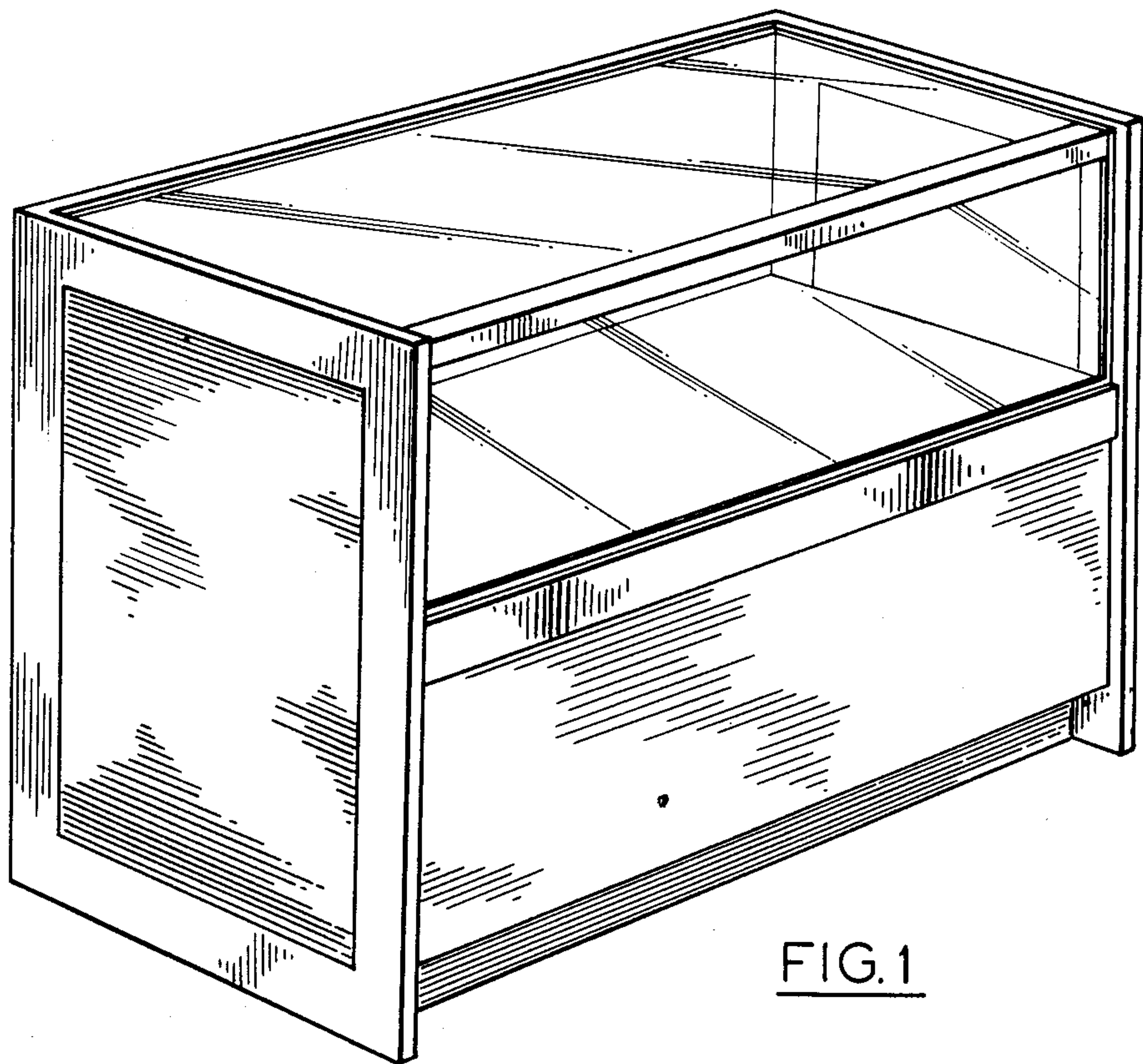

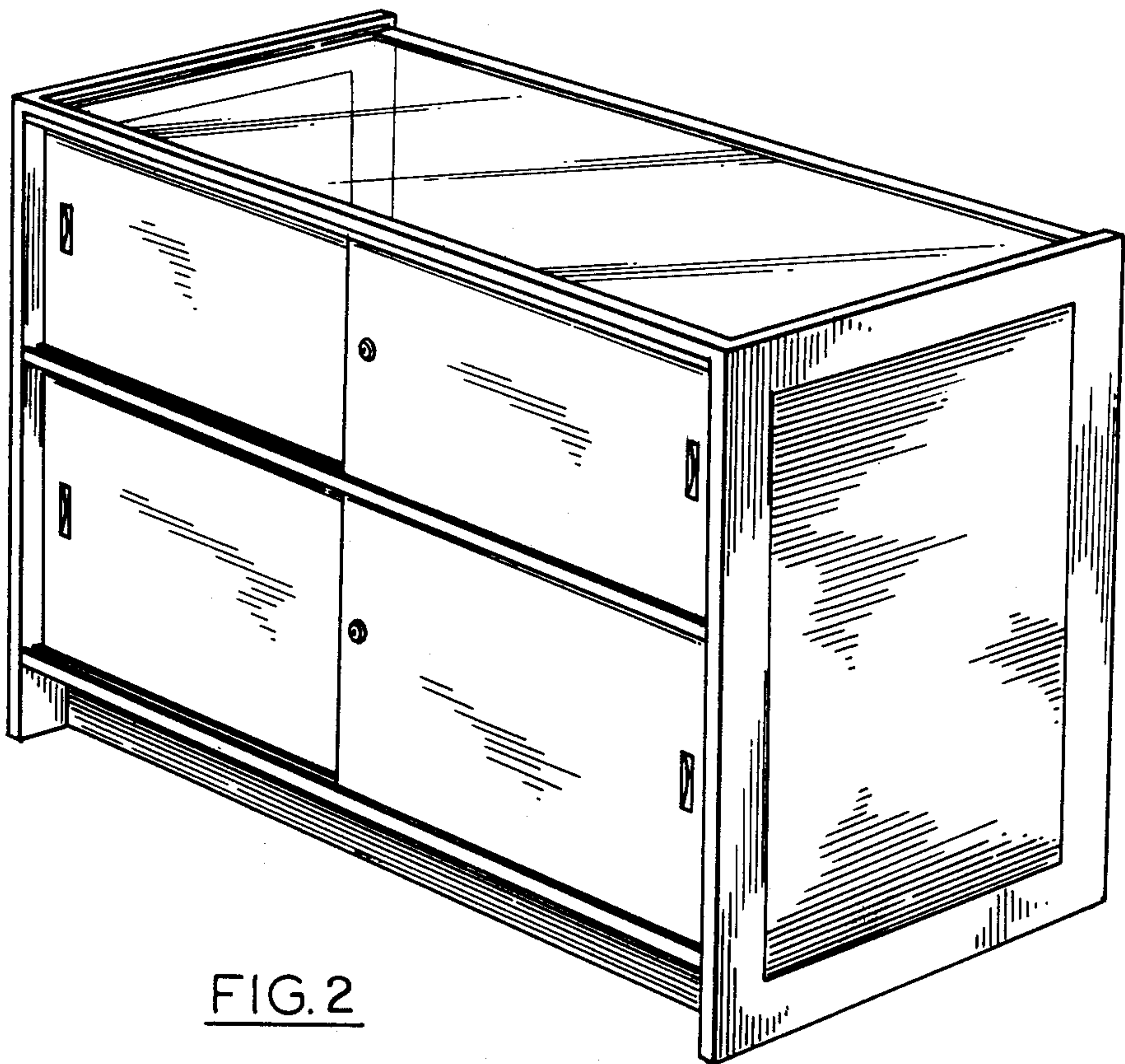
