The ornamental design for an end standard for a furniture seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a perspective view of an end standard for a furniture seat showing our design.

The edge not shown is like the edge shown while the undisclosed inner face of the standard is a mirror image of the disclosed outer face.
