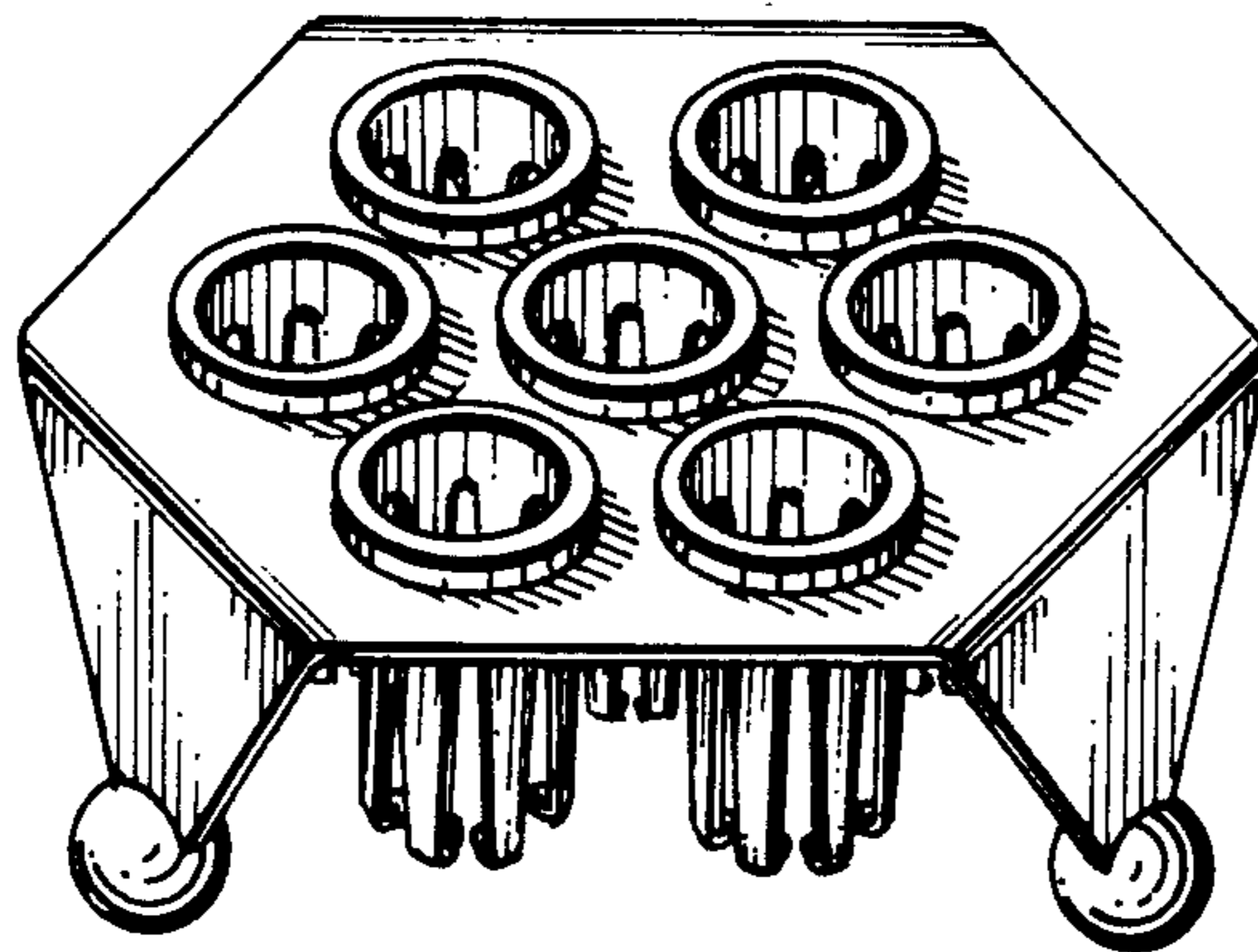

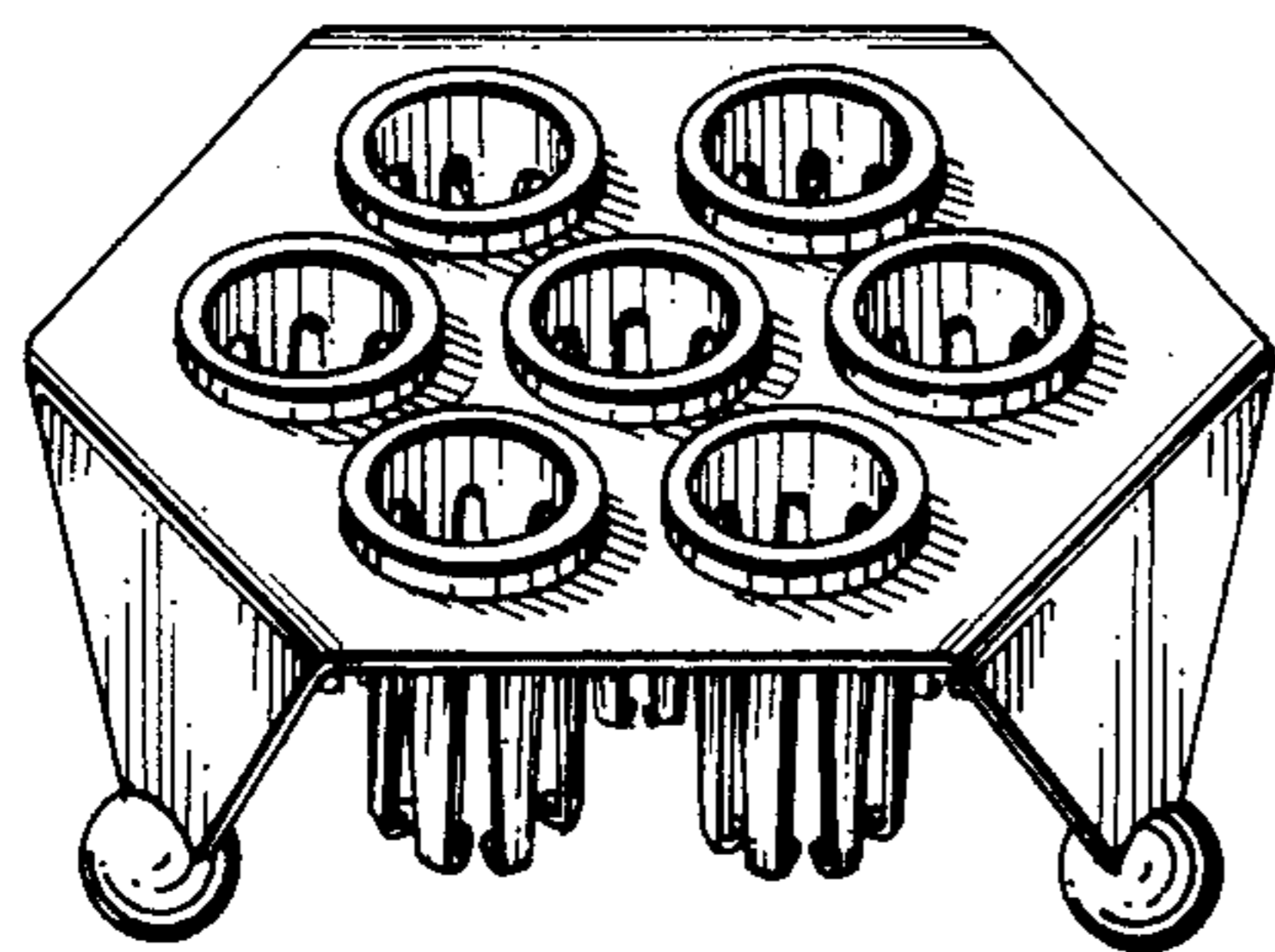
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lipstick tube holder, as shown.

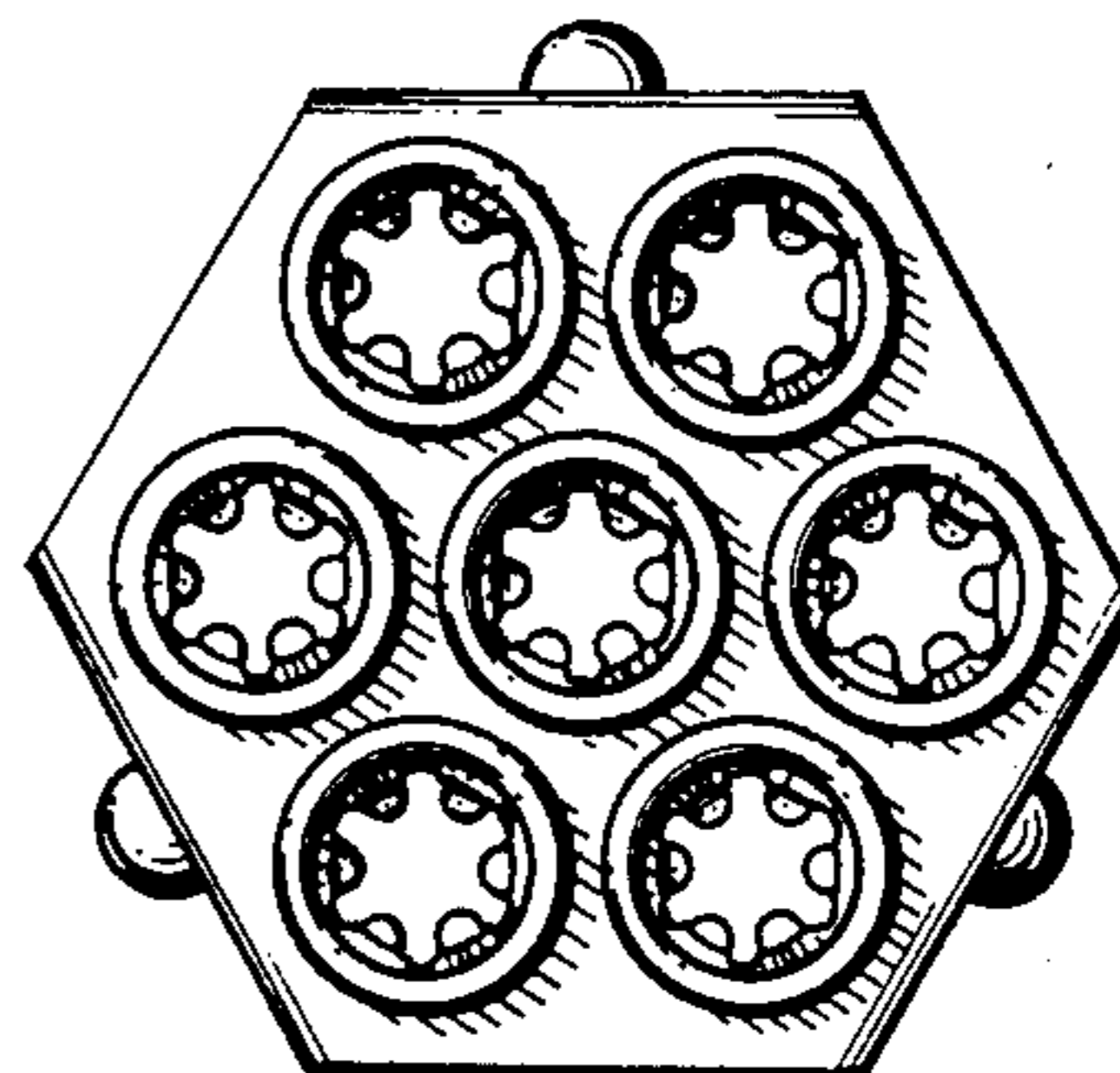
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



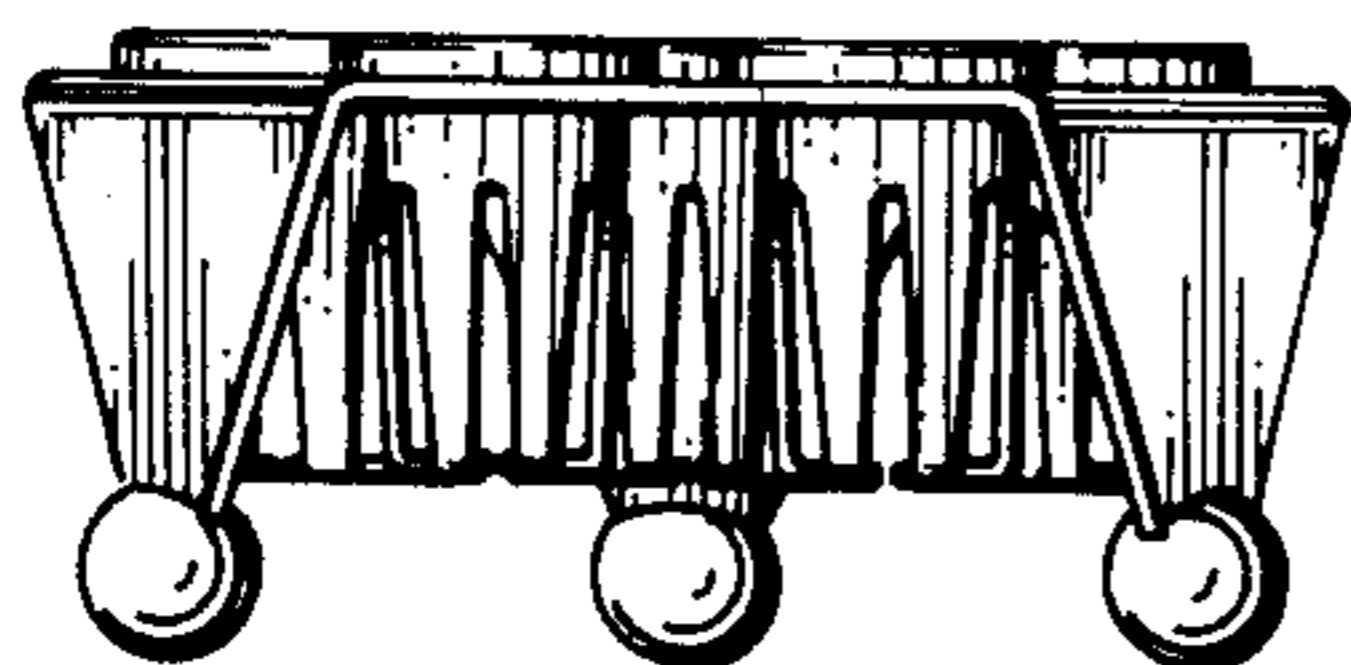

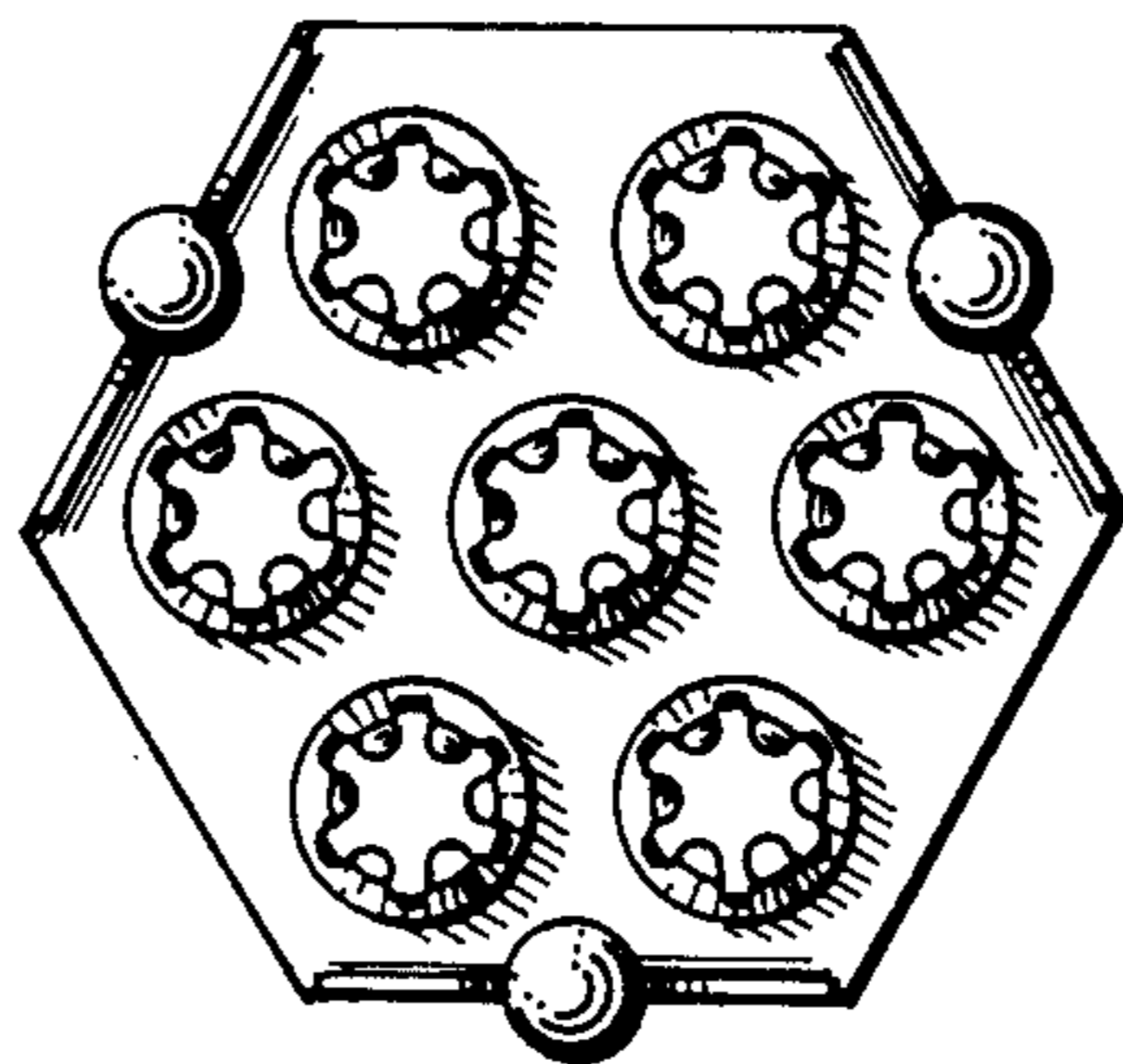
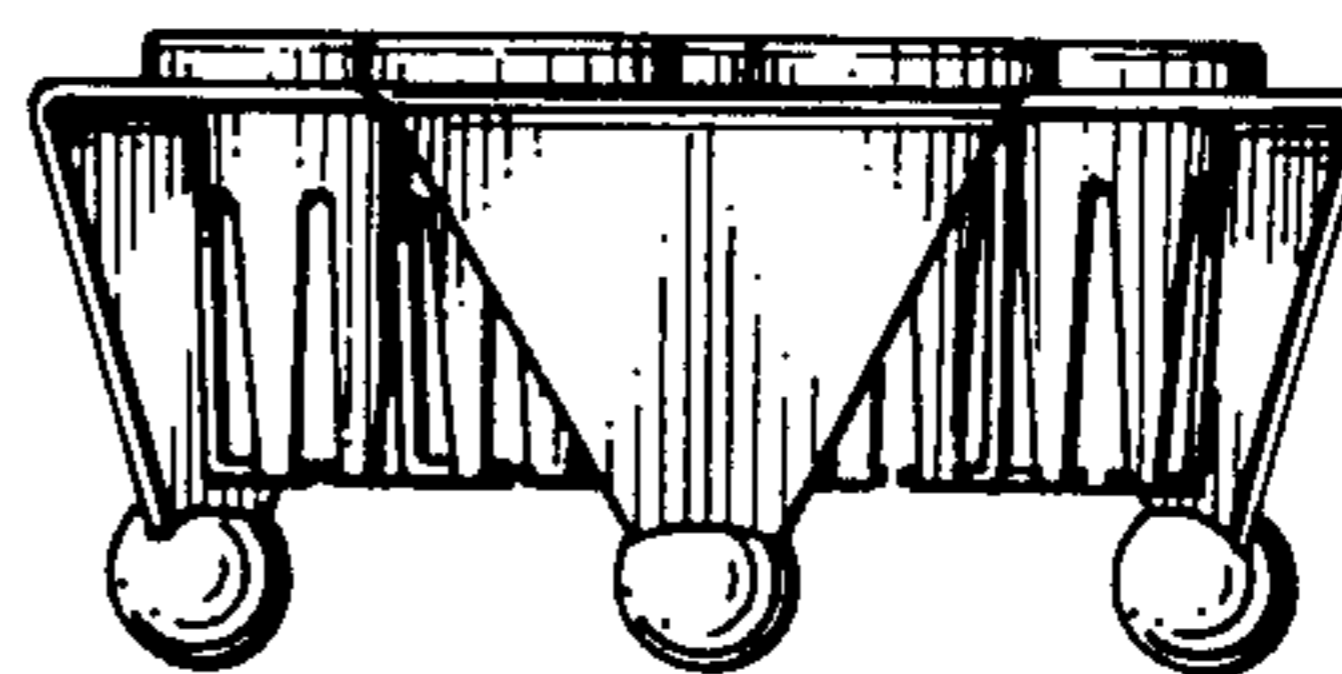
