[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined hockey and pool
game table, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined hockey and
pool game table, with the pool surface in the upward or
playing position, showing the new design thereof;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof opposite to
that shown in FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof but with the air-
hockey playing surface in the upward or playing posi-
tion.

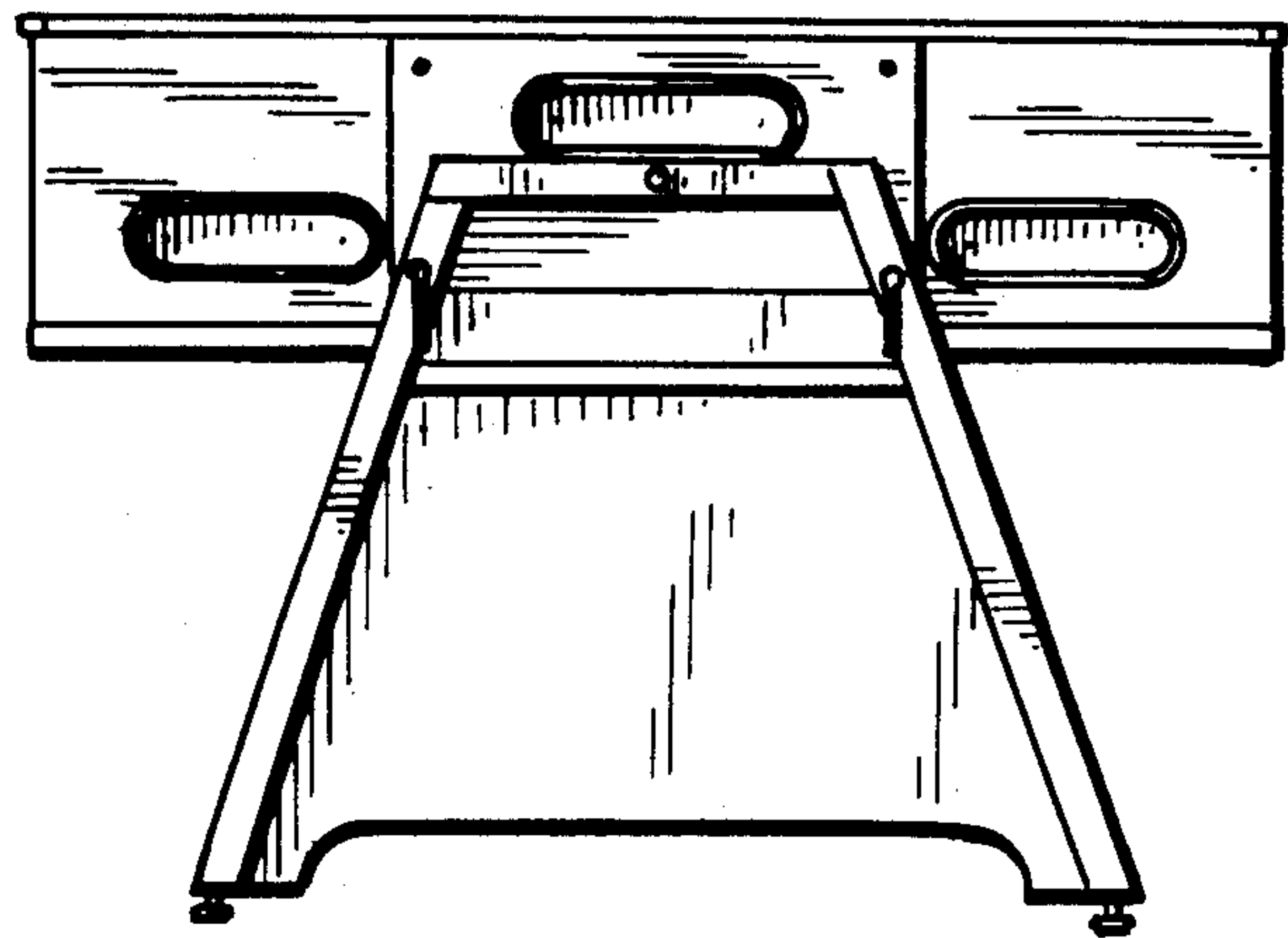

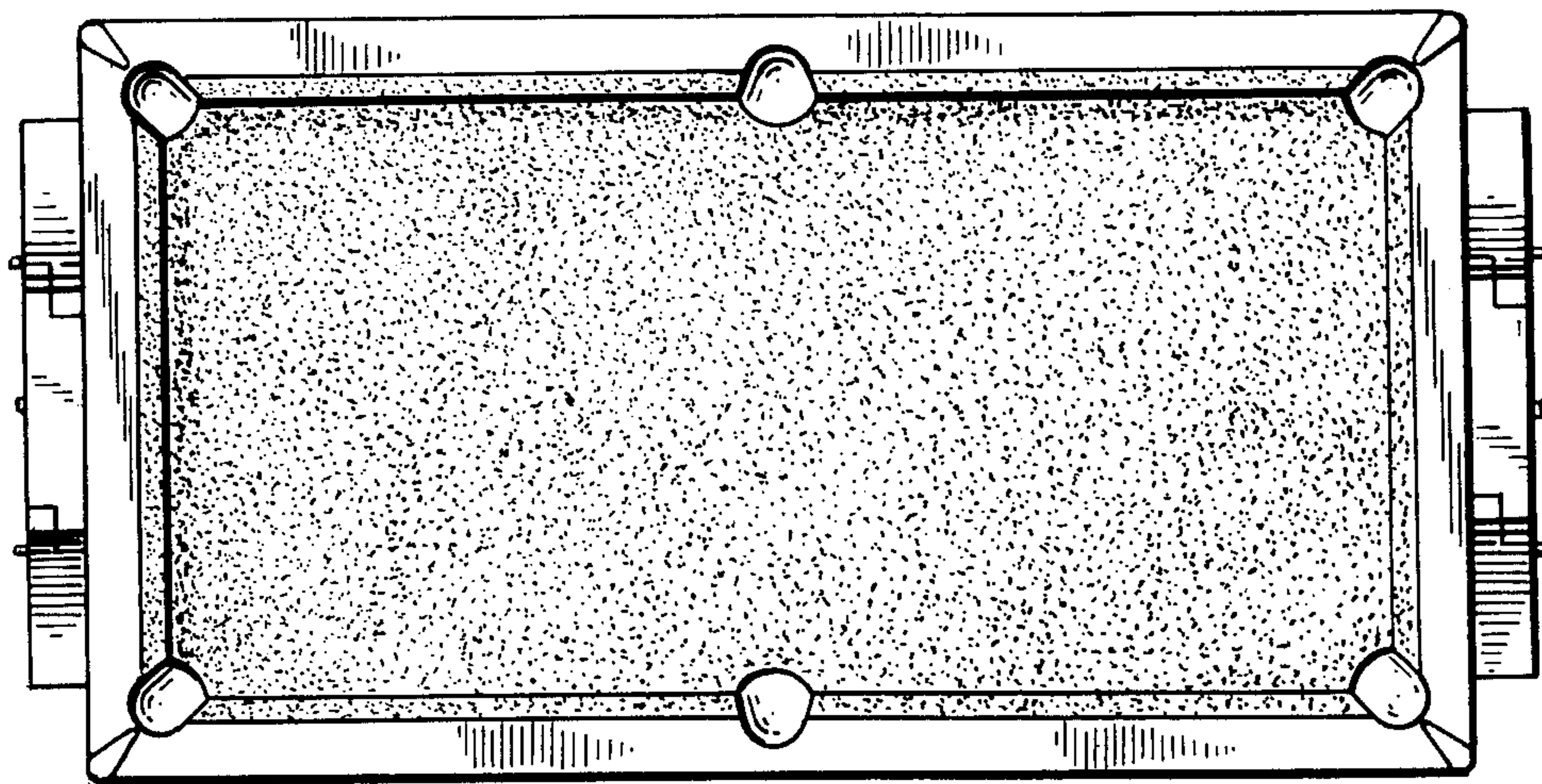

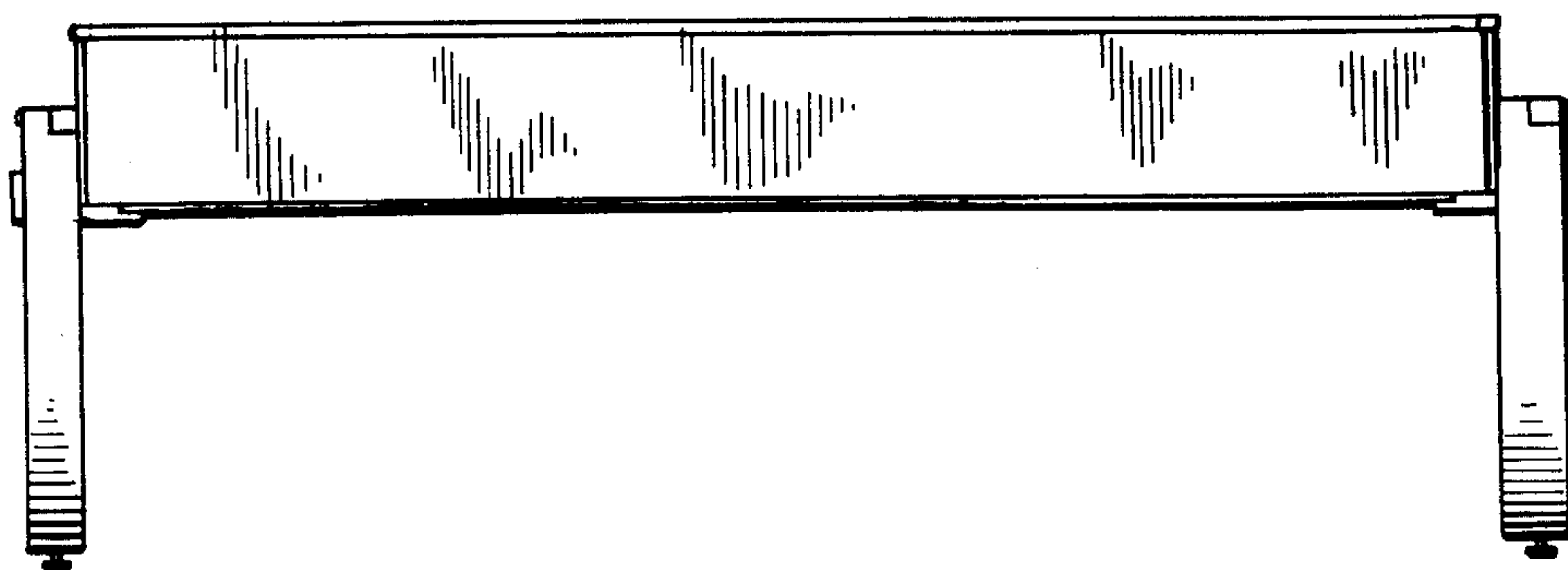

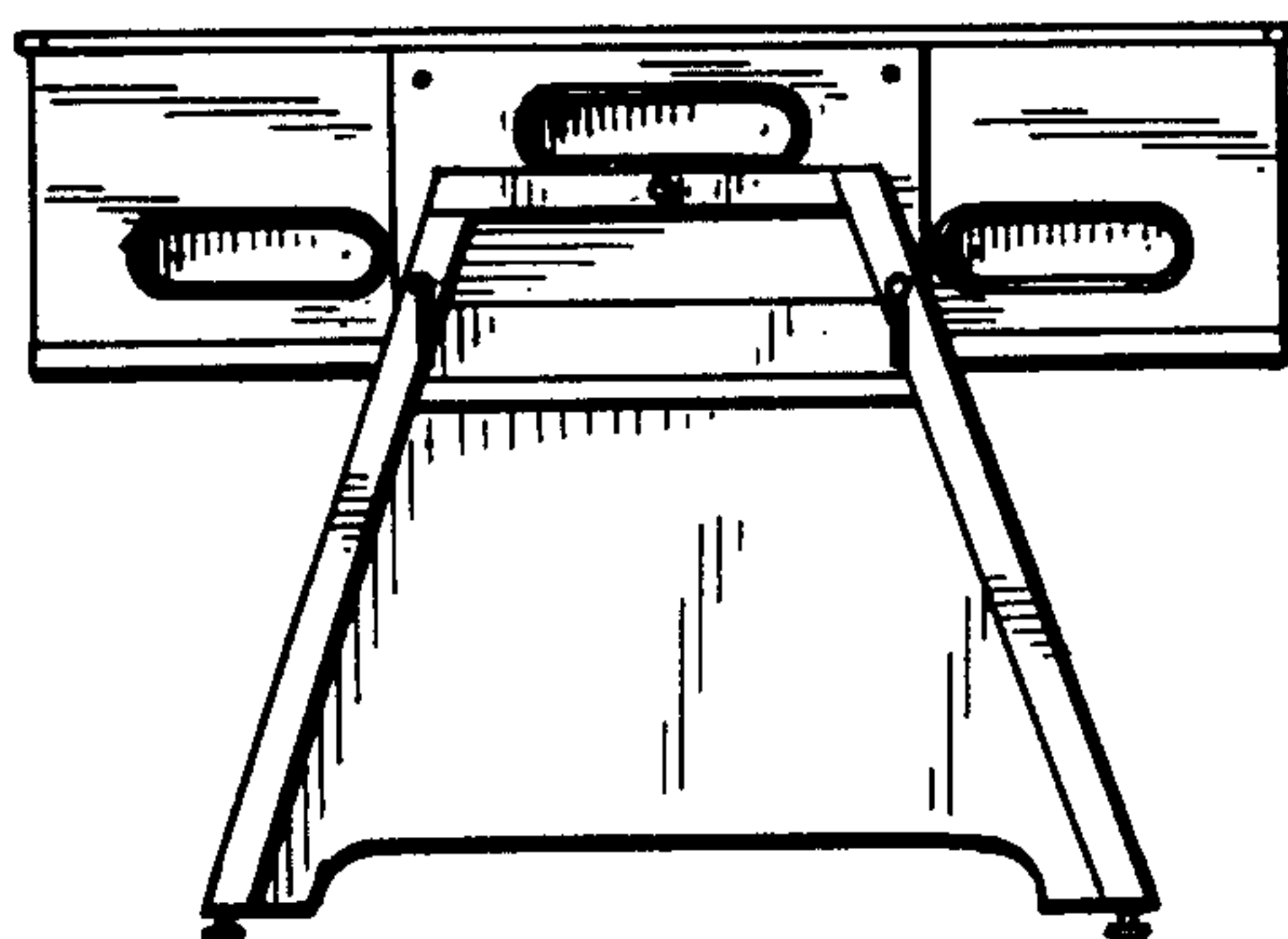

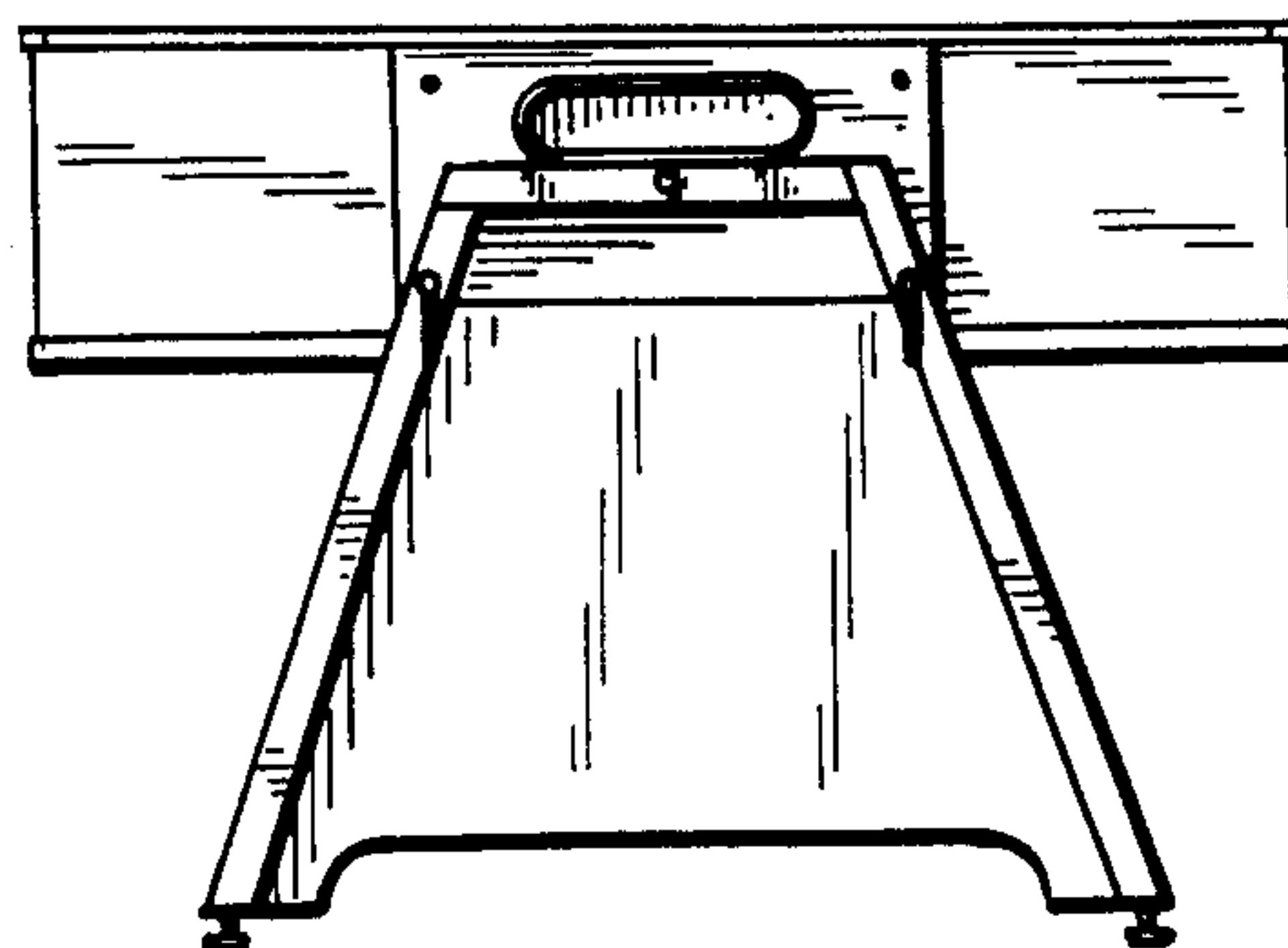

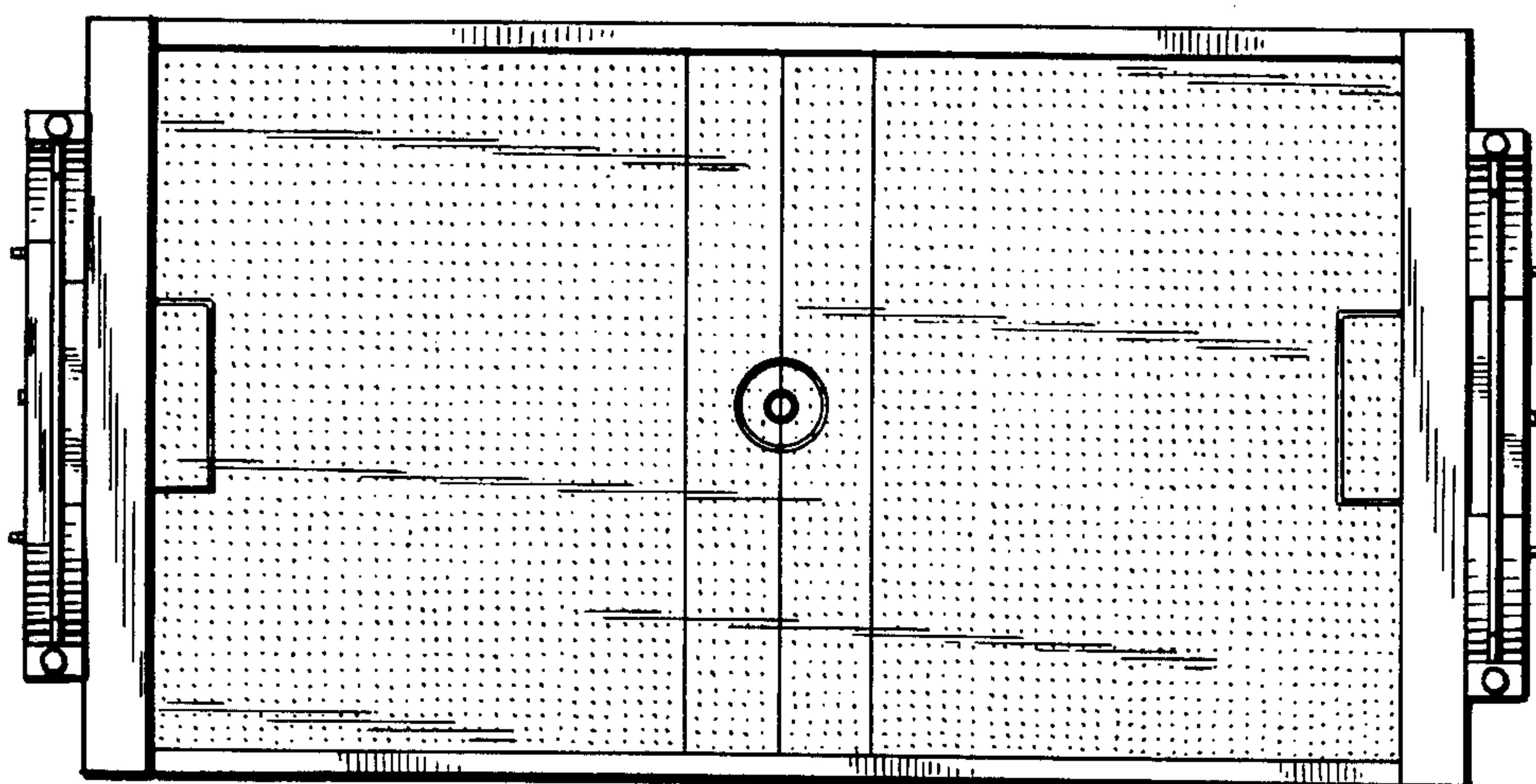
