FIG. 3 is an edge view thereof.

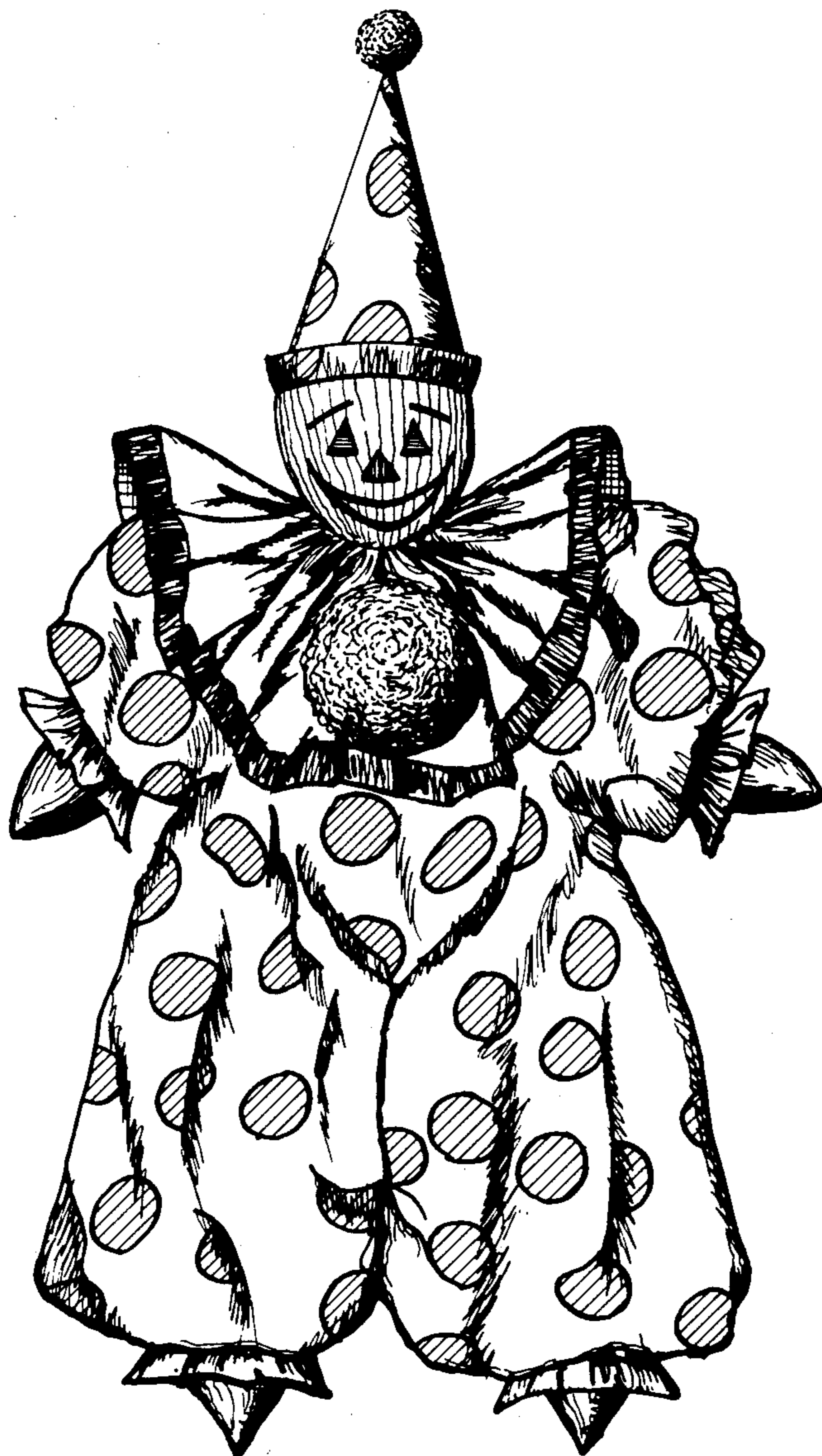

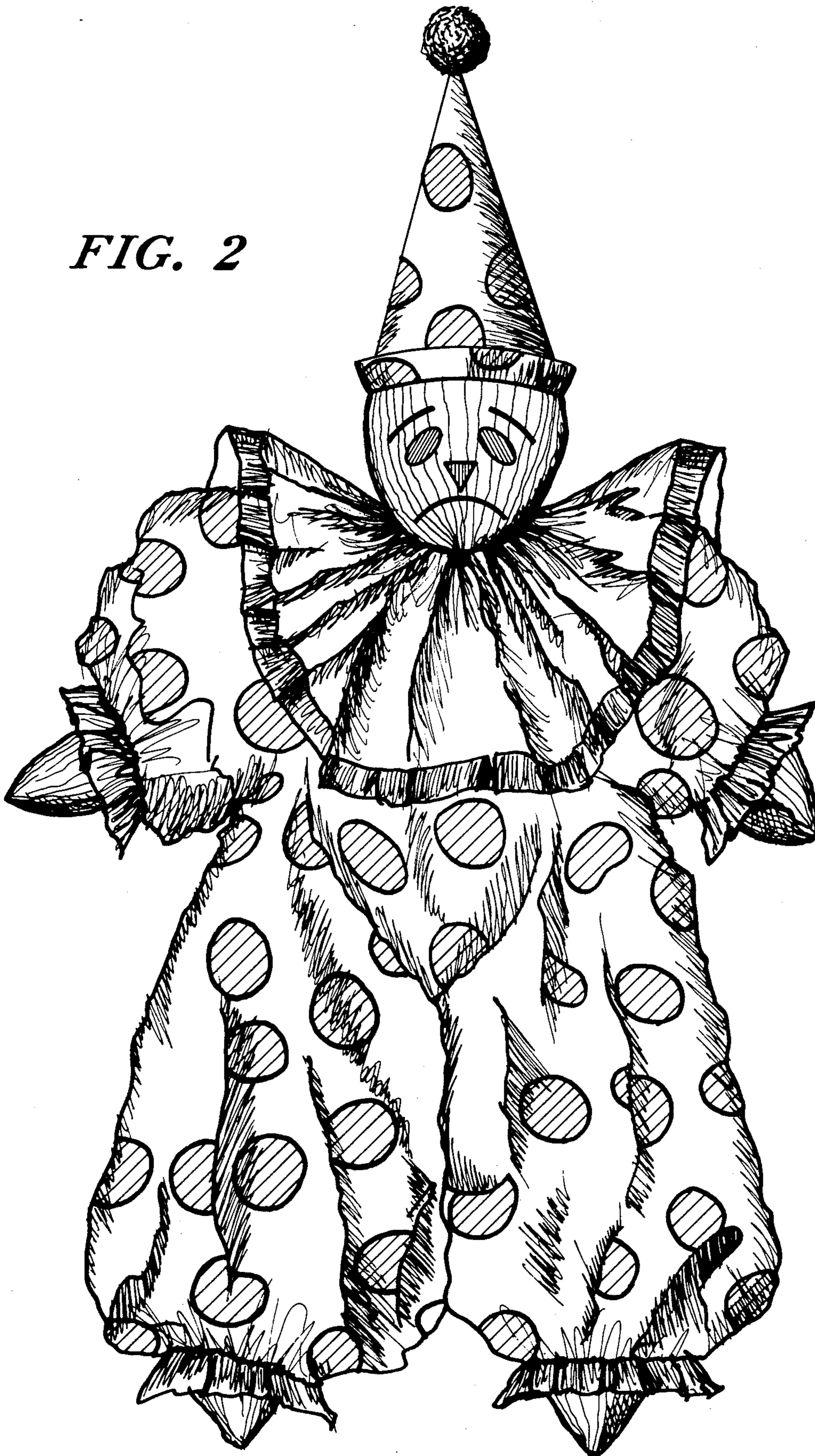
