FIG. 5 is an end view taken from the left of FIG. 2.

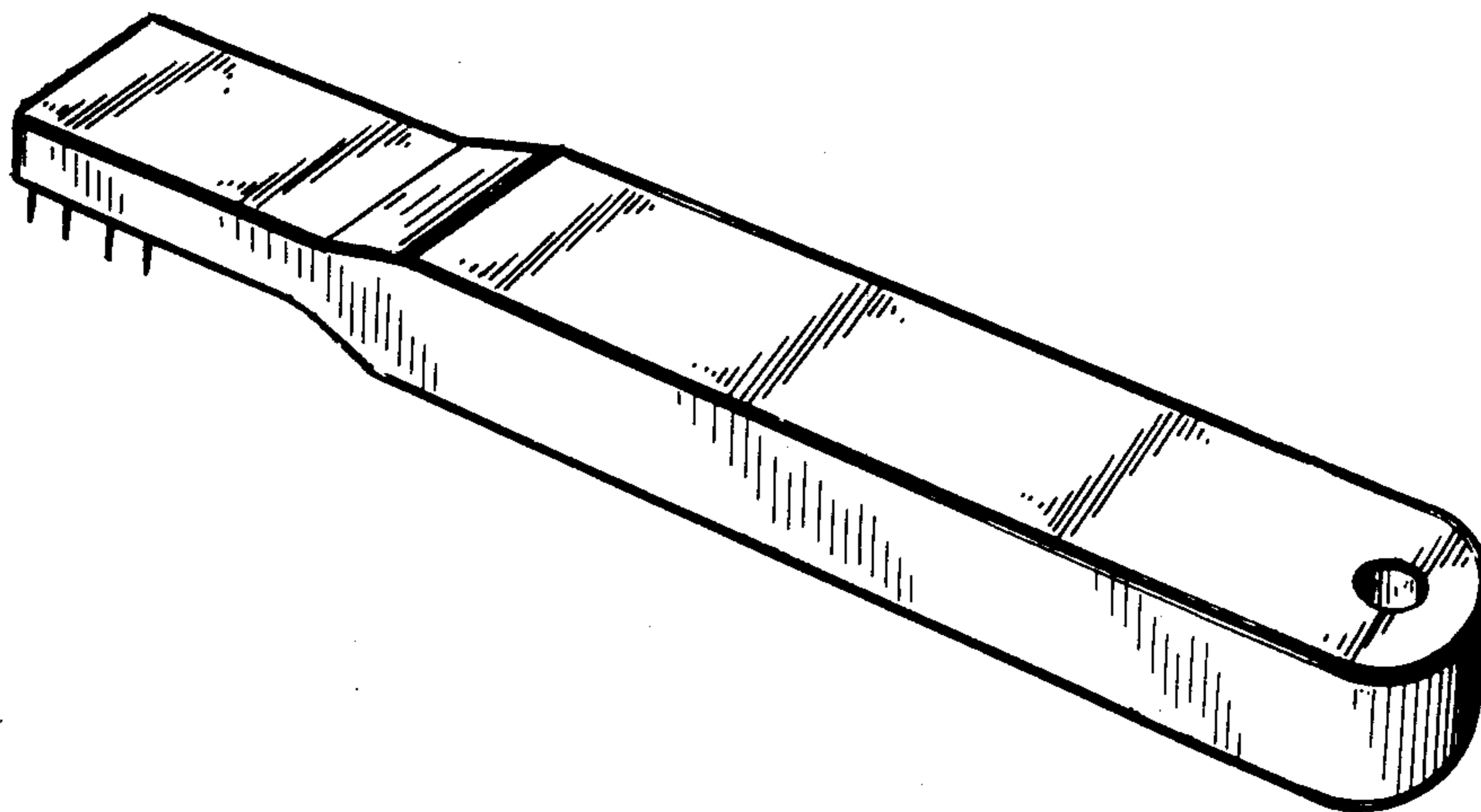

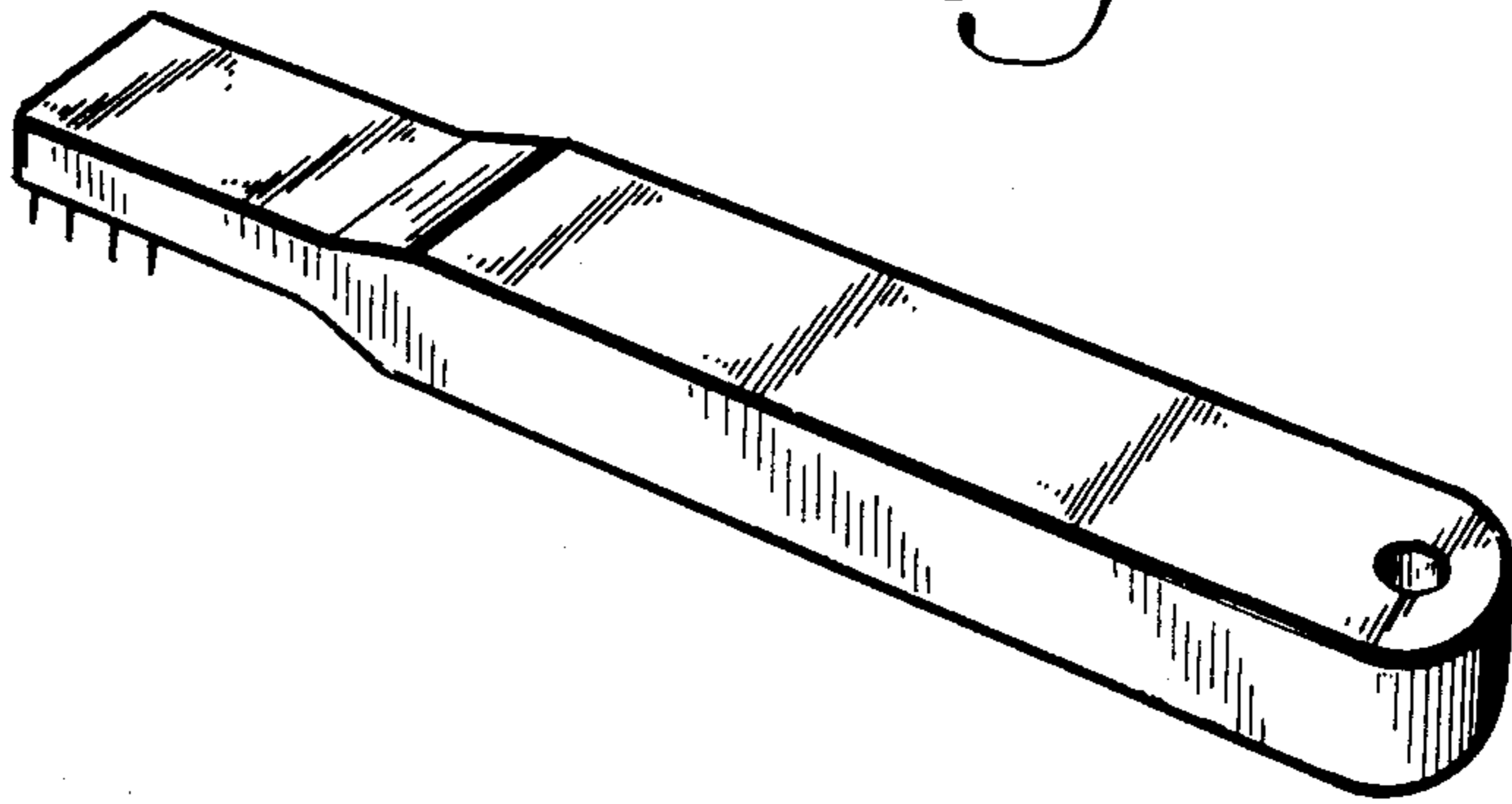

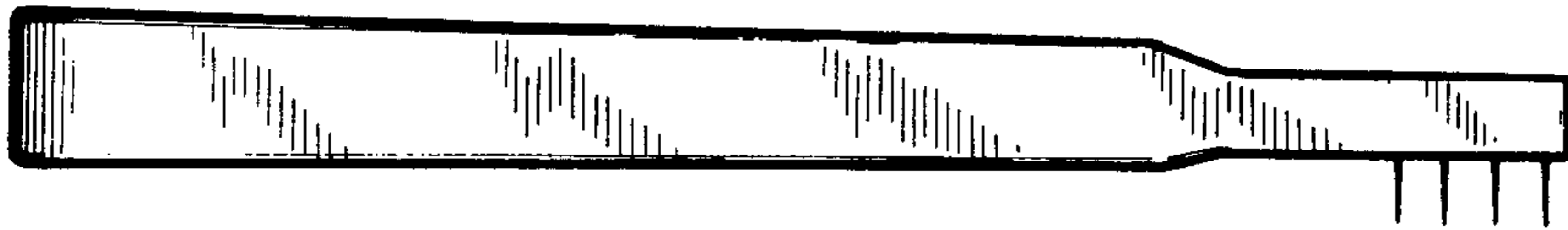

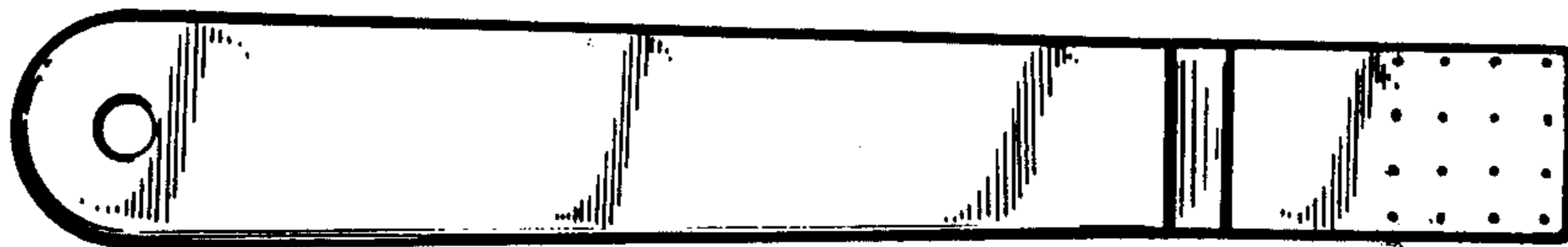

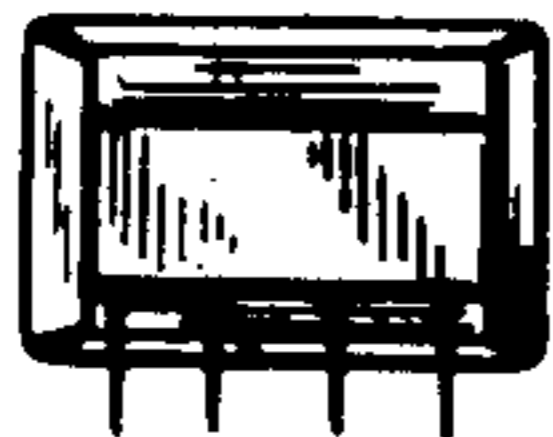
