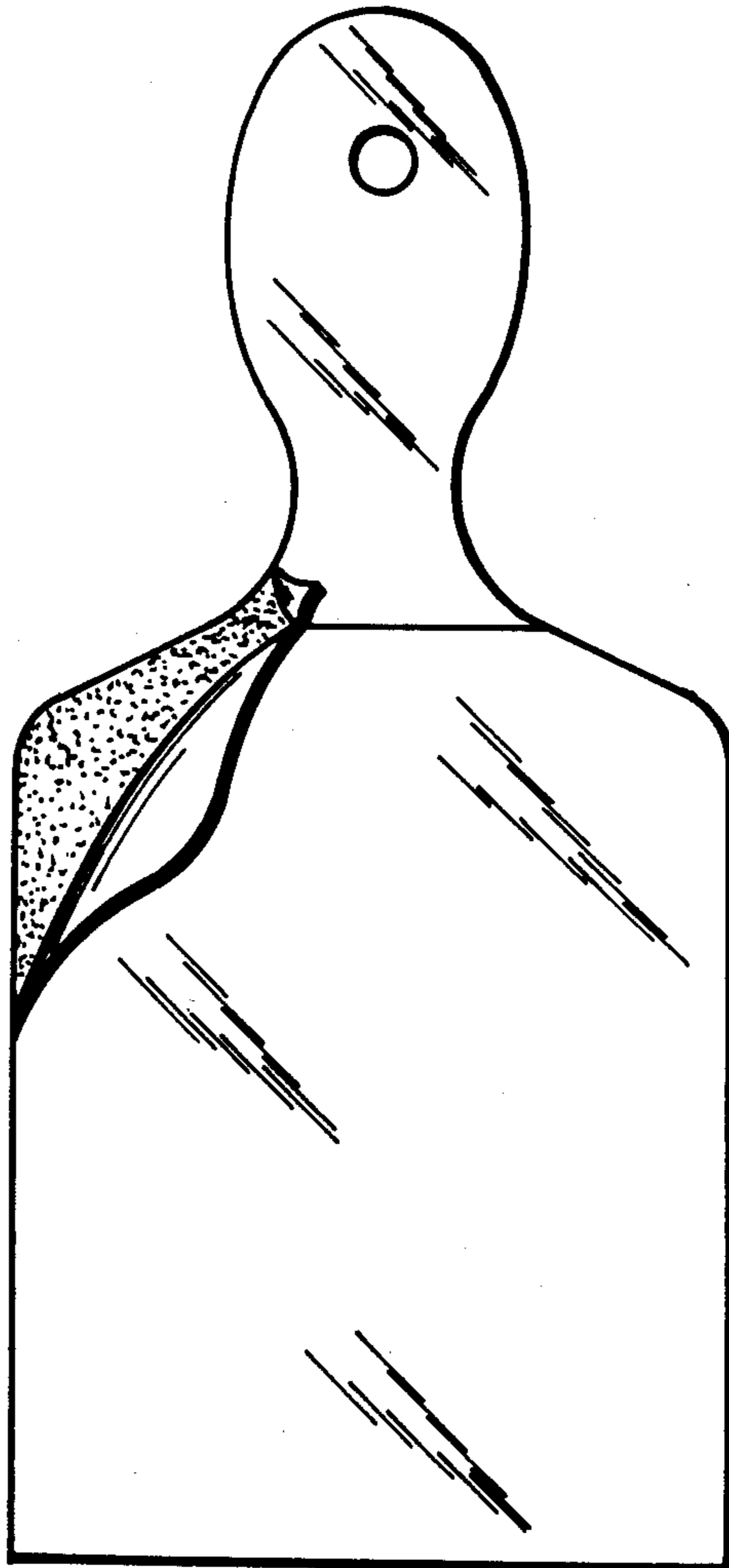
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a gummed lint lifter, showing my new design;

The gummed lint lifter is of no substantial thickness.



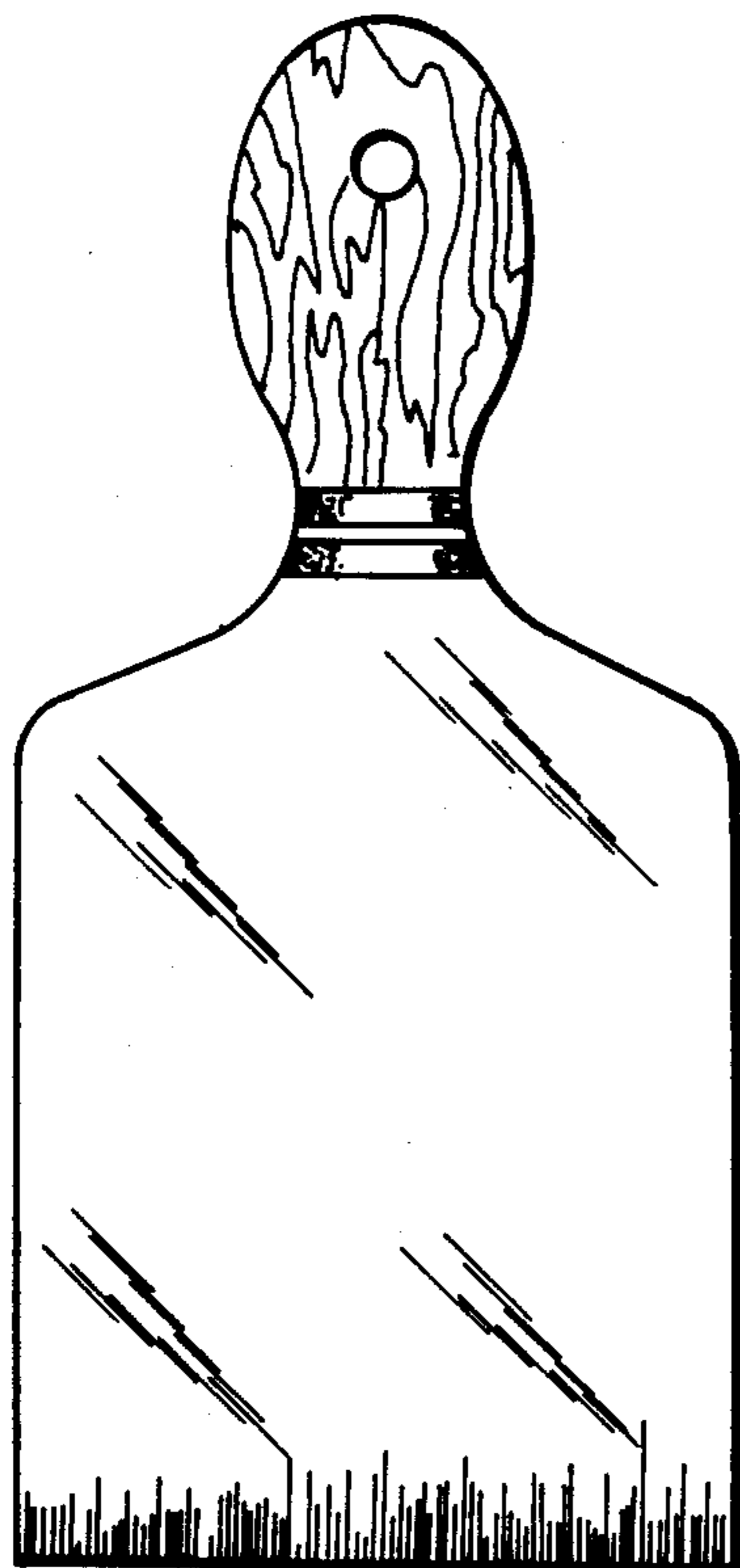

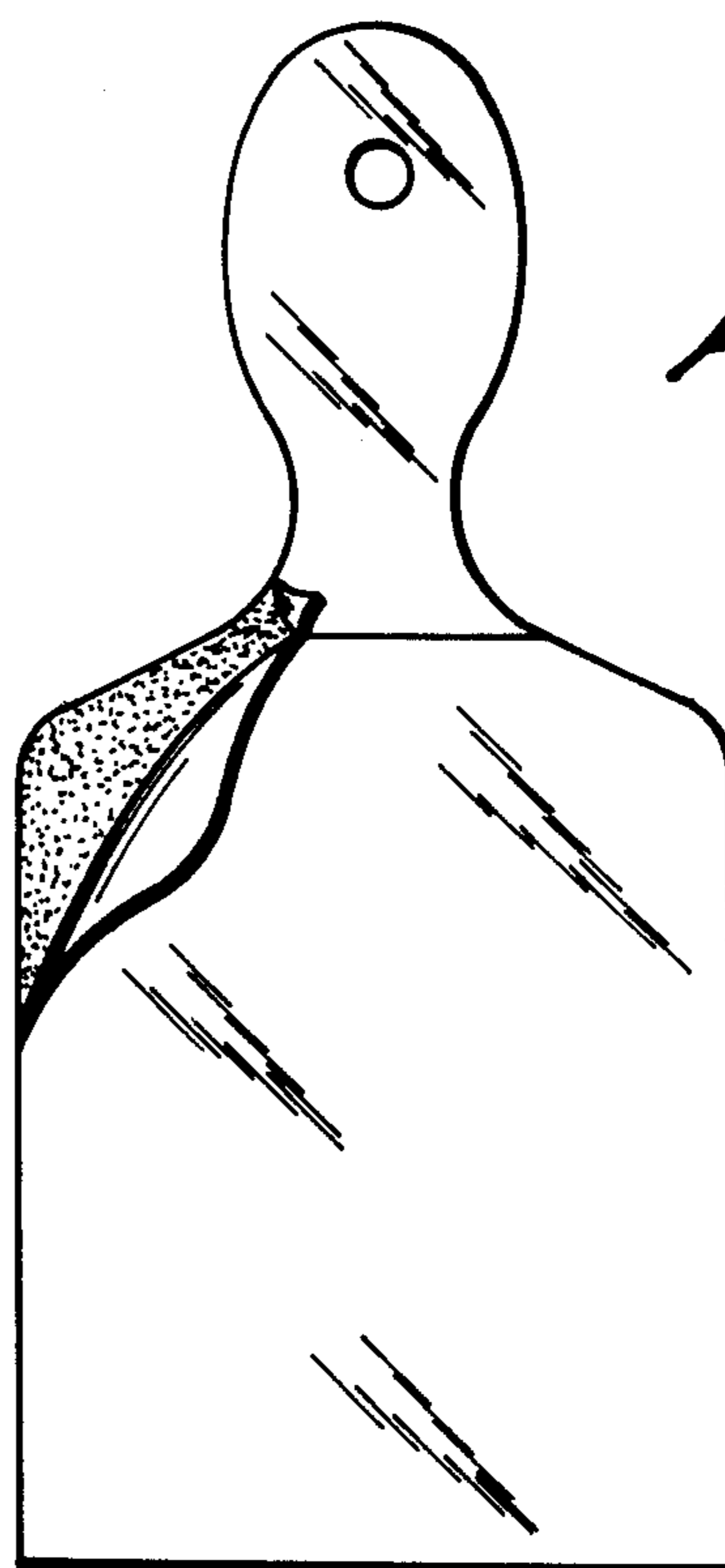
