[57] **CLAIM**
 The ornamental design for a combined bed, shelf and cabinet unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
 FIG. 1 is a left-side perspective view of the combined bed, shelf and cabinet unit incorporating our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view of the unit in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a right-side perspective view of the unit in FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 4 is a top view of our new combined bed, shelf and cabinet unit.
 The rear of the article is plain and unornamented.

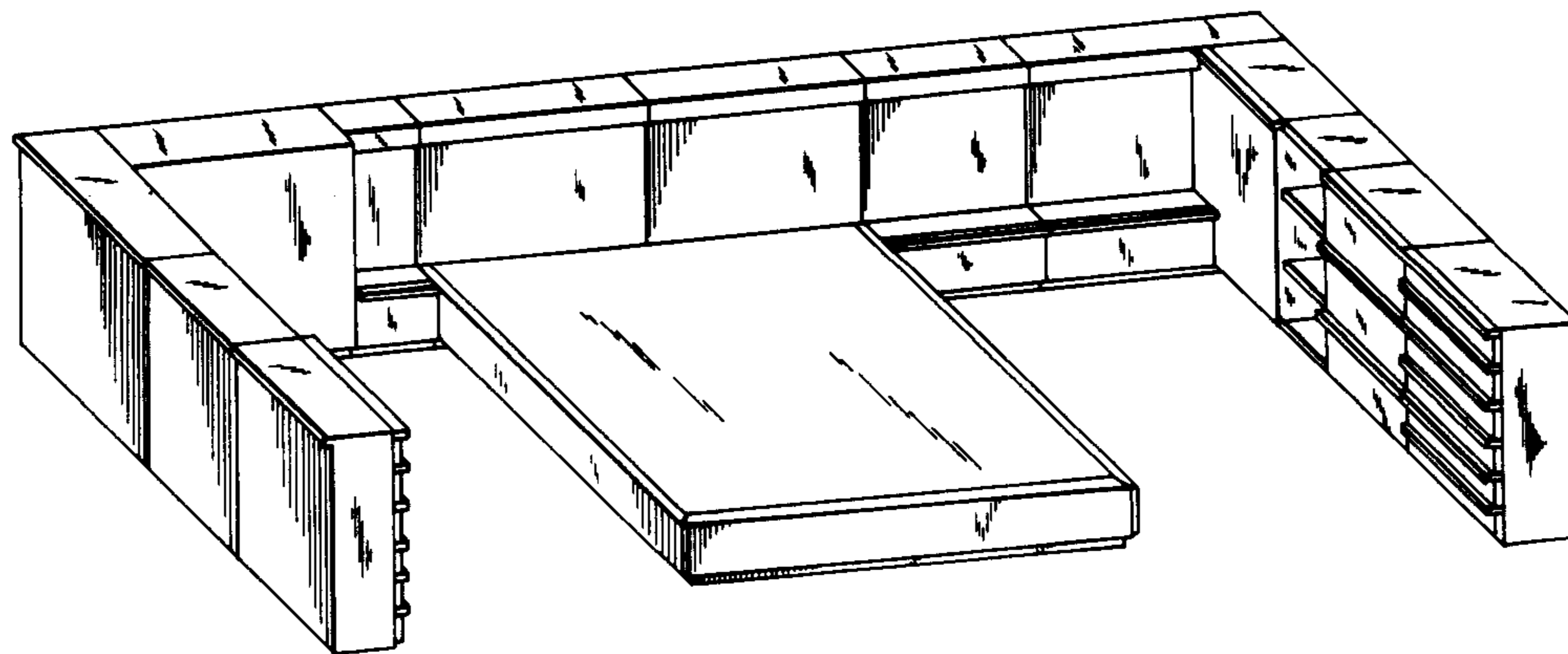
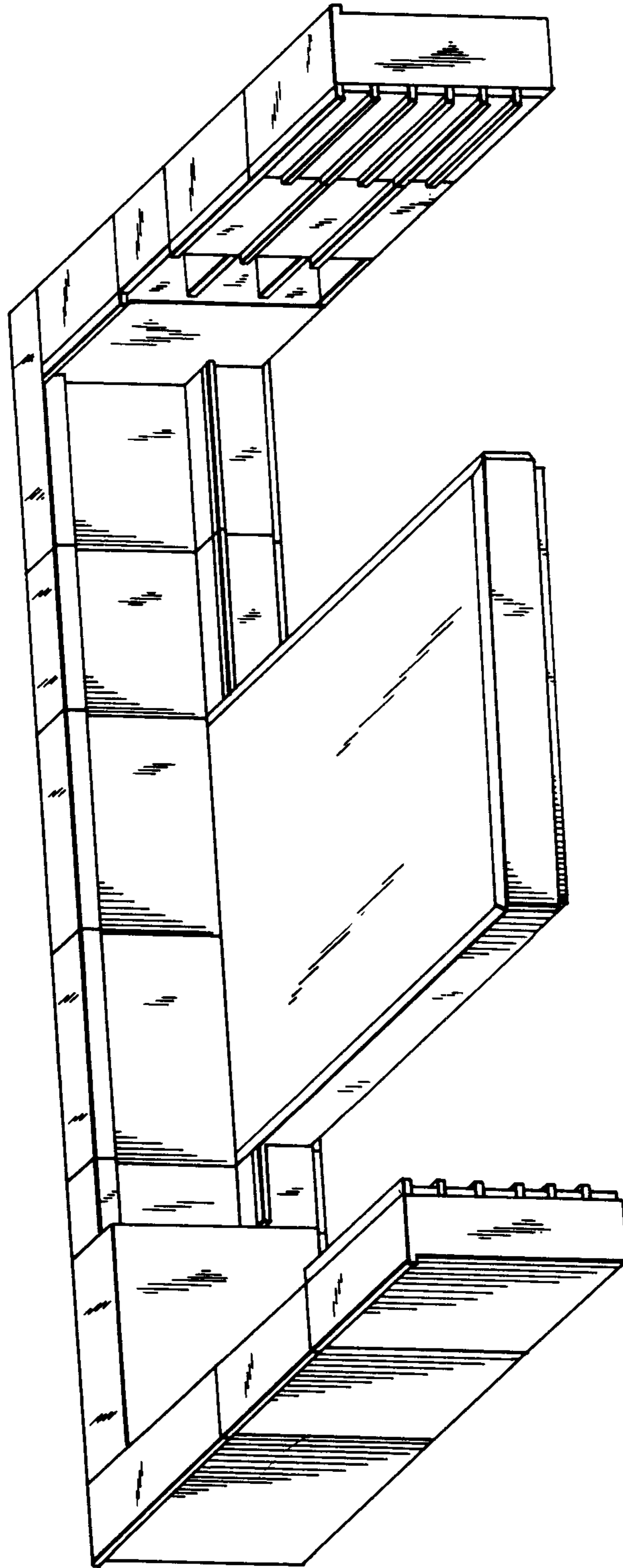

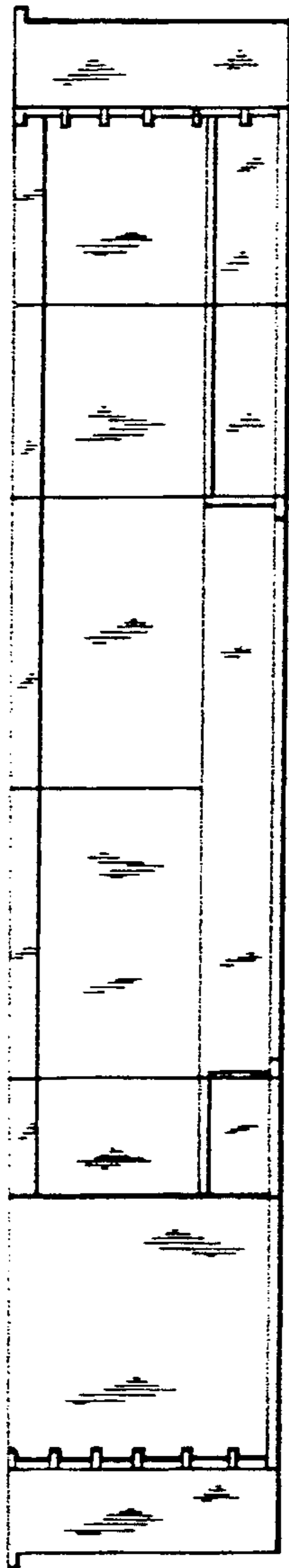

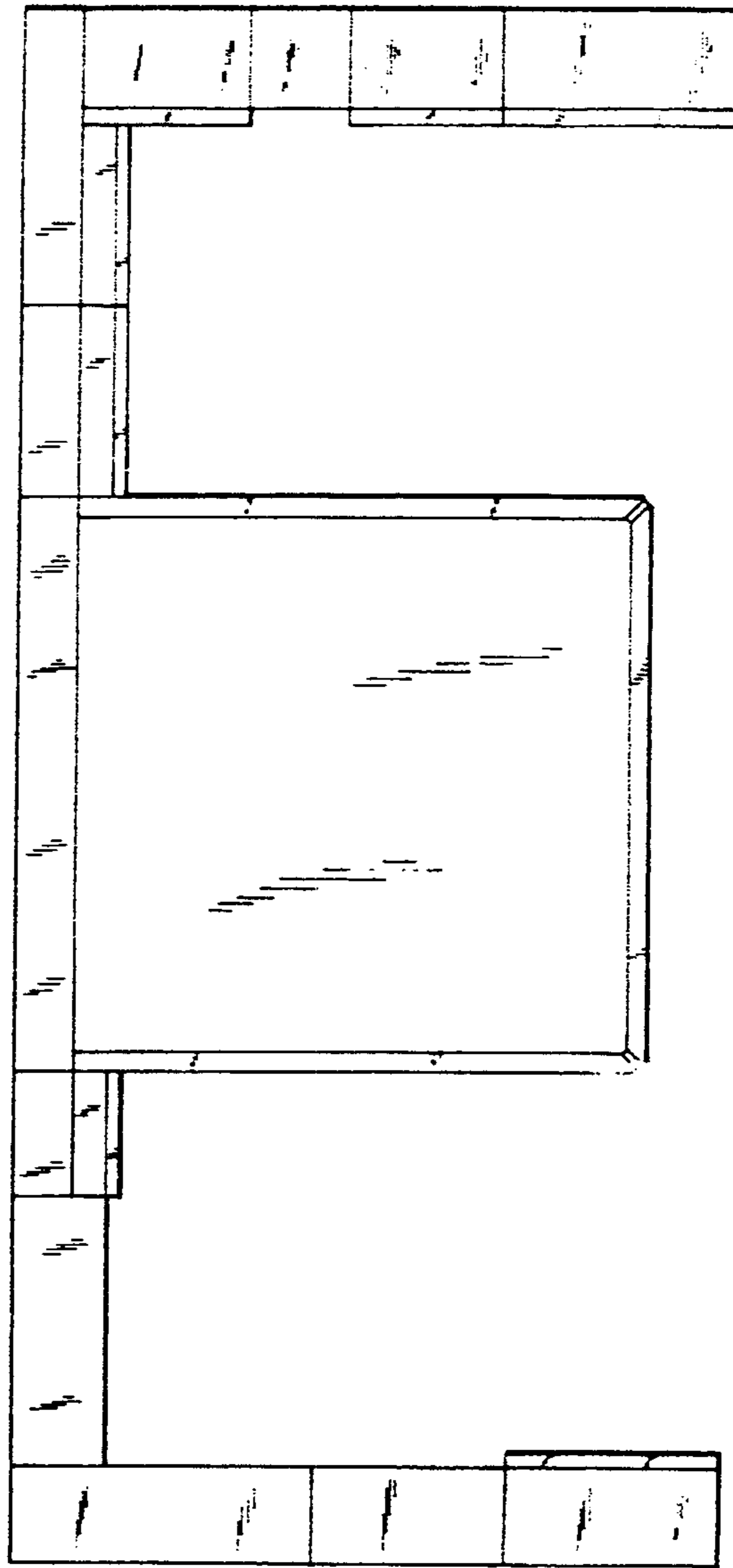
