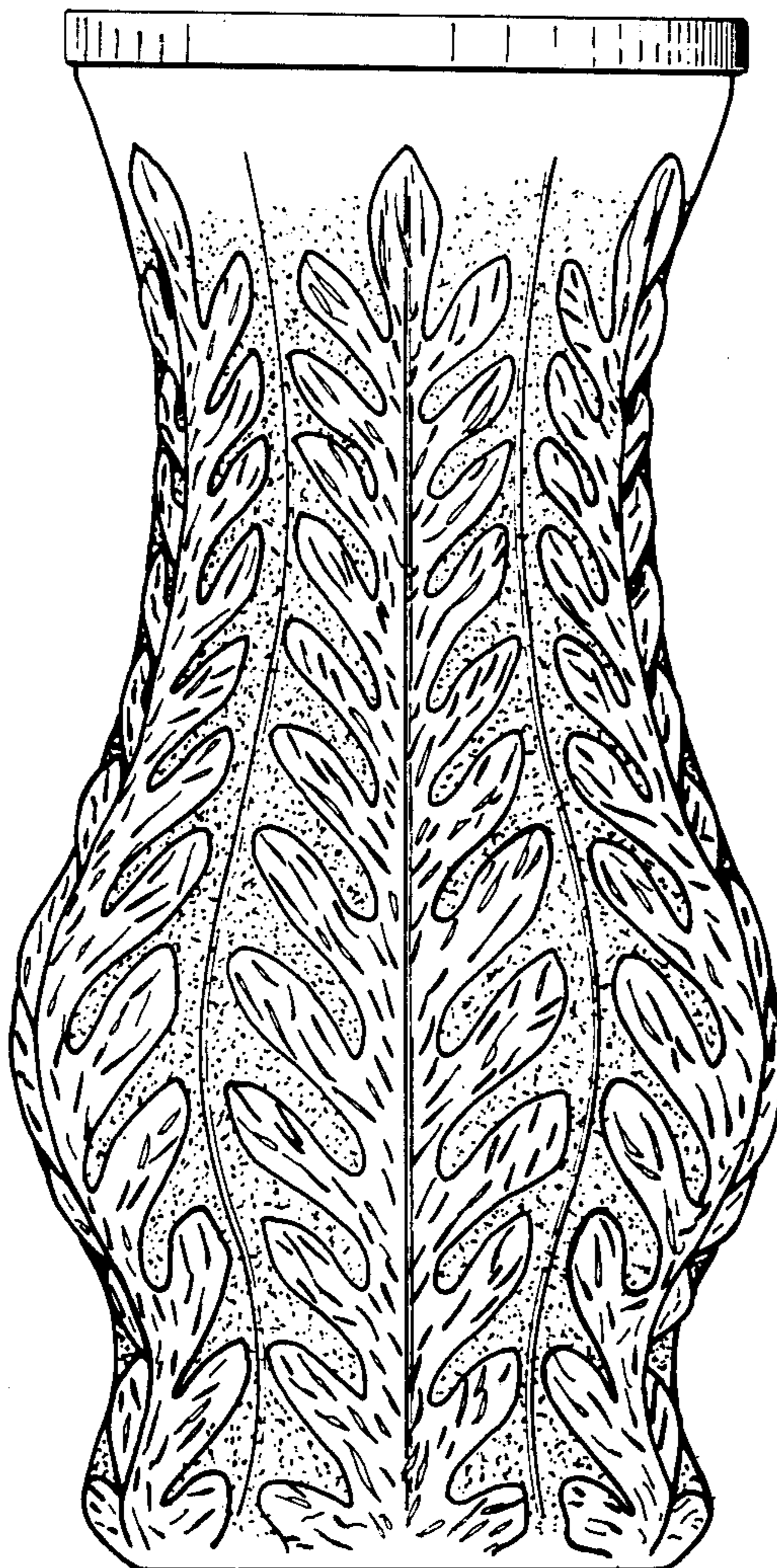
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a vase embodying our new design.

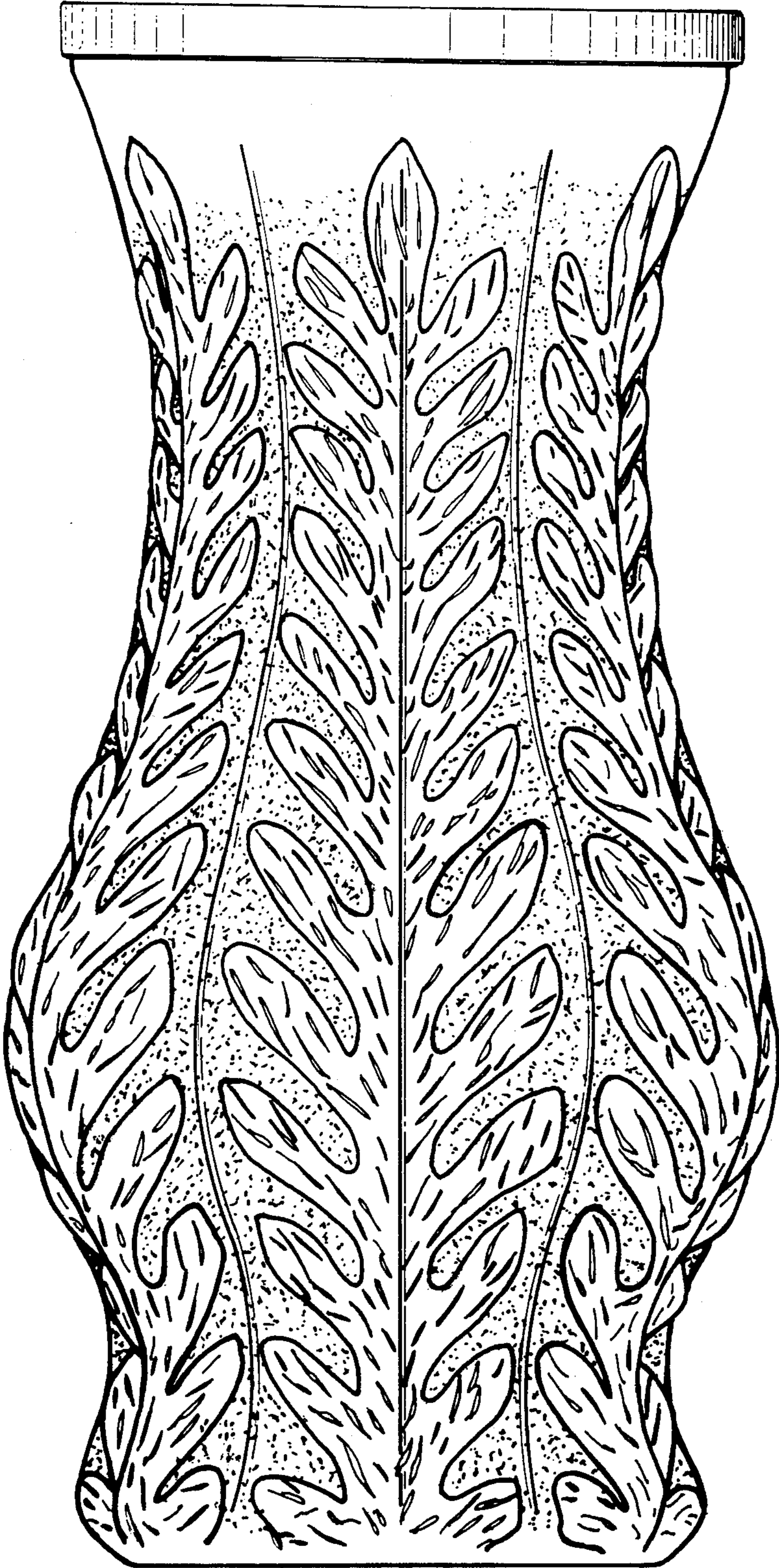

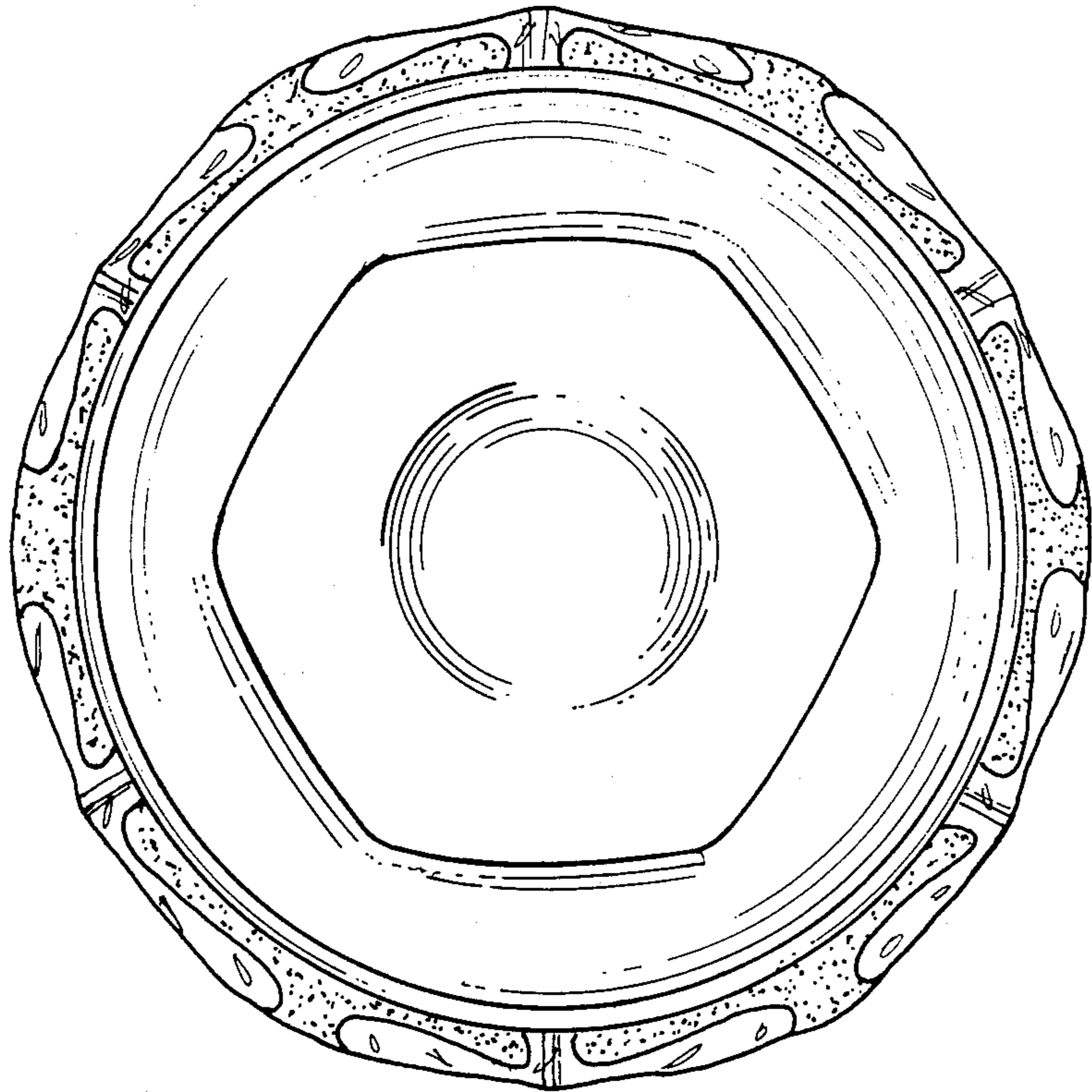

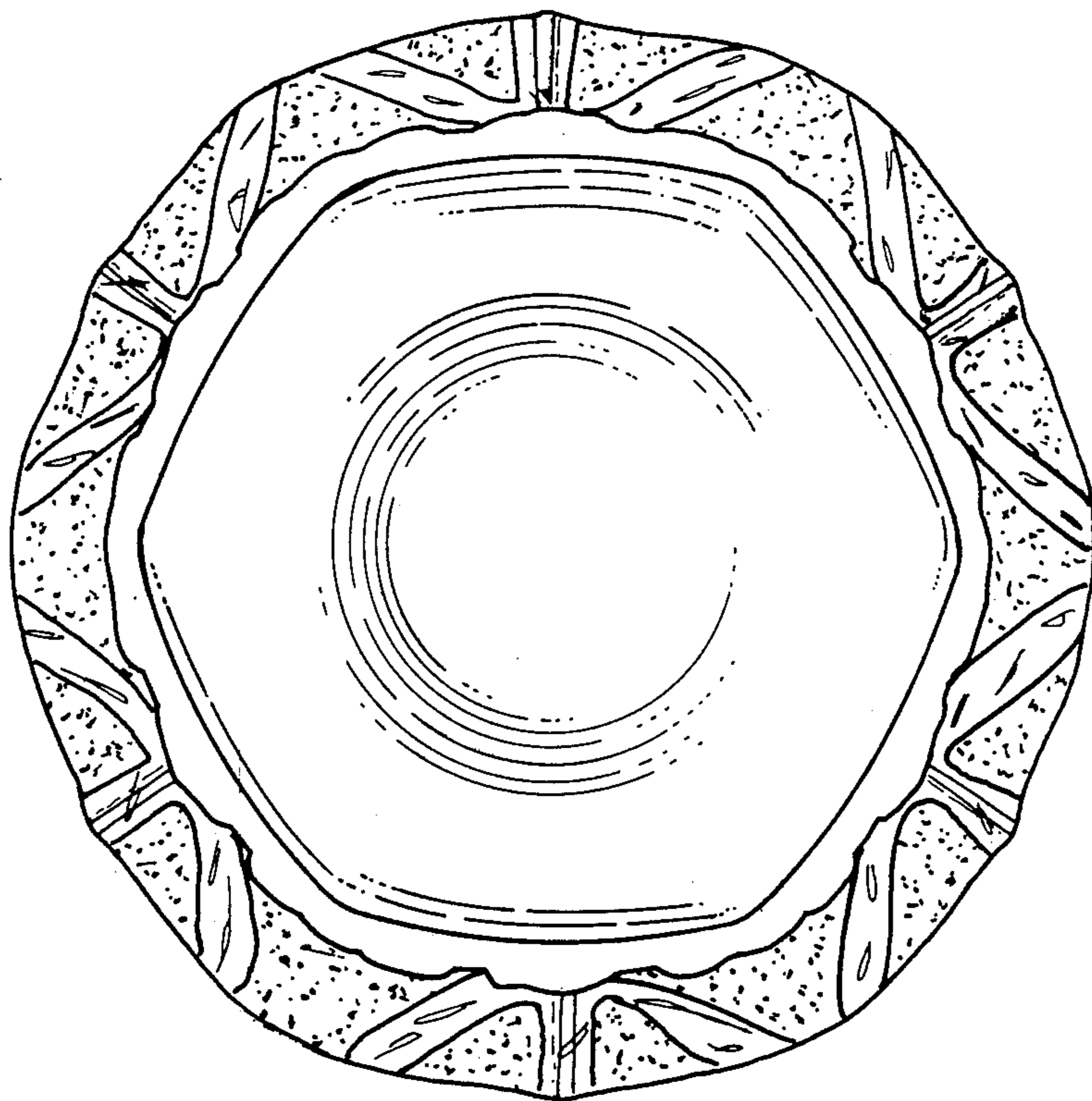
