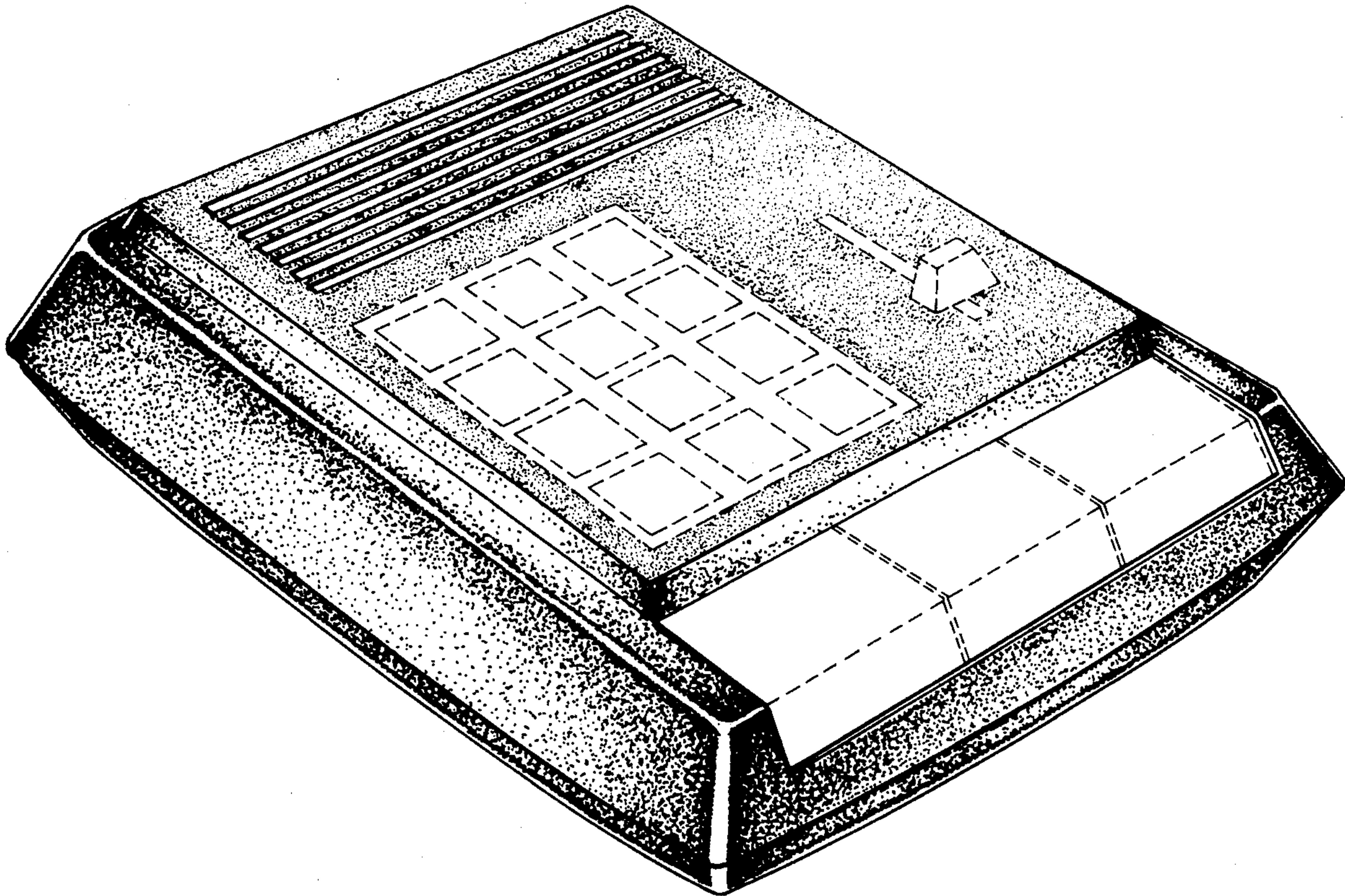

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a housing for a loudspeaking telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a housing for a loudspeaking telephone, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view, to a reduced scale; FIG. 3 is a front view, to a reduced scale; FIG. 4 is a rear view, to a reduced scale; and FIG. 5 is a left side view, to a reduced scale. The broken lines representing touch call pad, sliding volume control and switches are shown for illustrative purposes only.





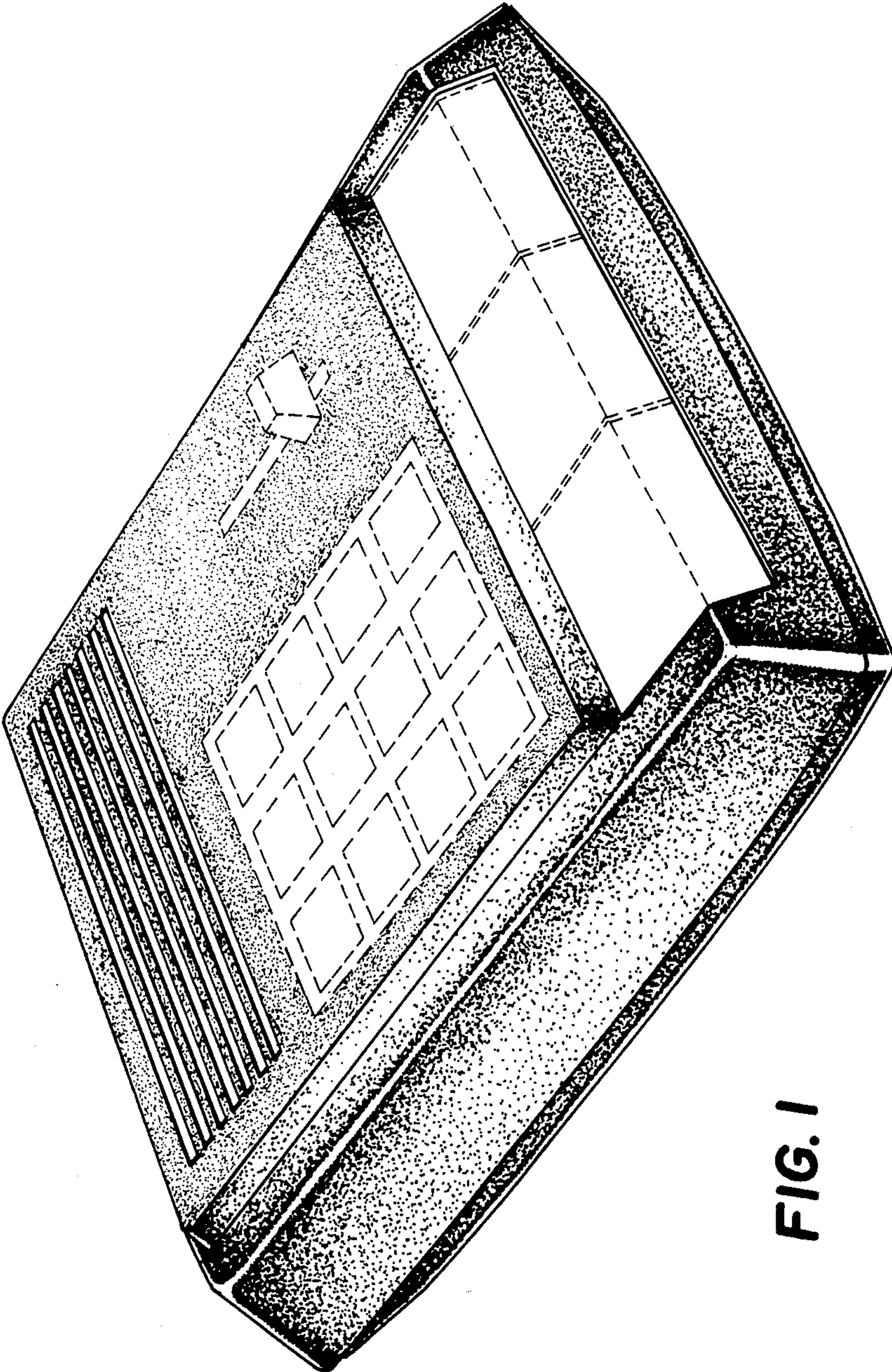

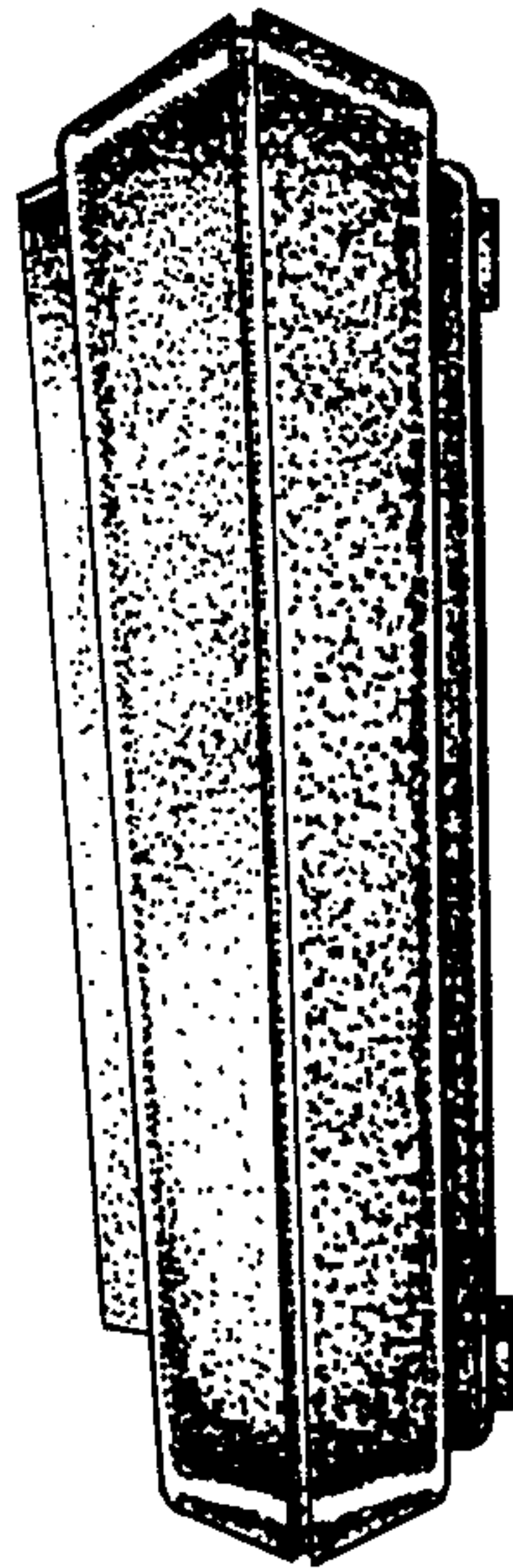

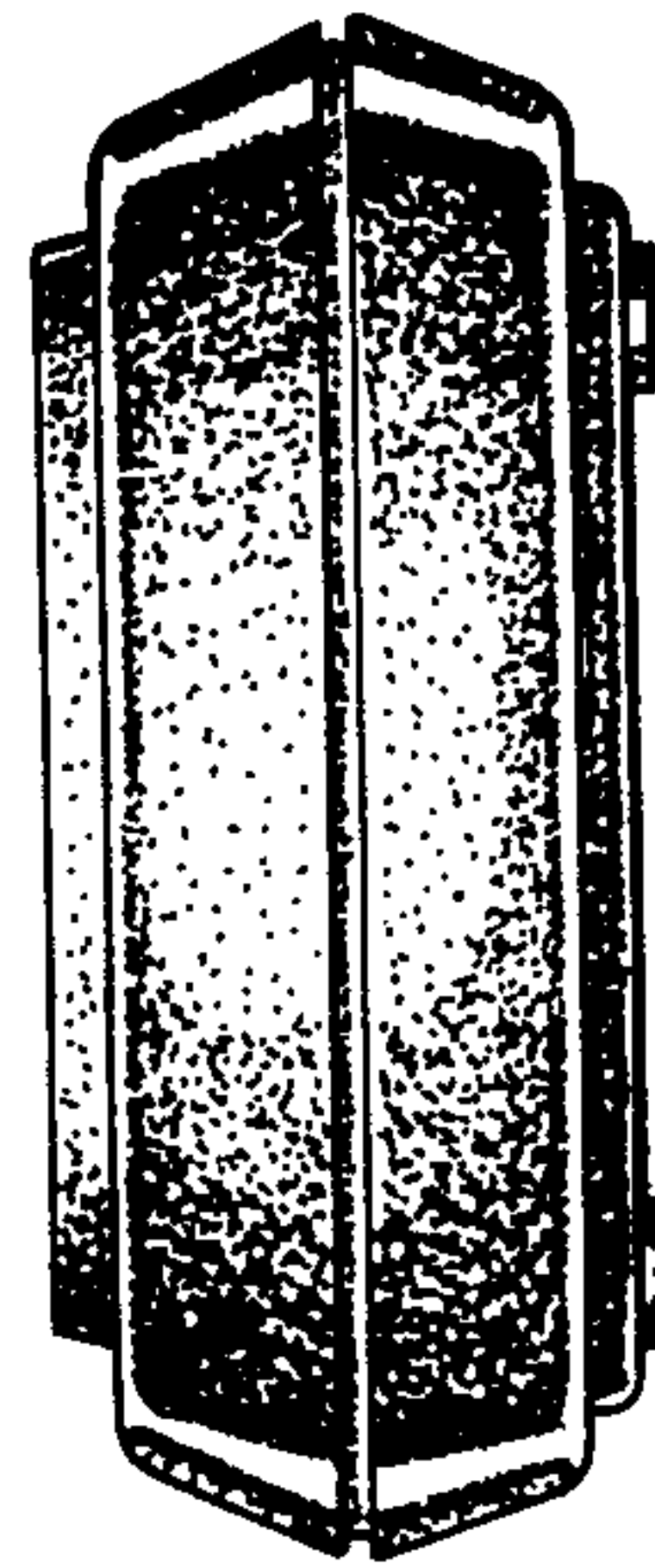

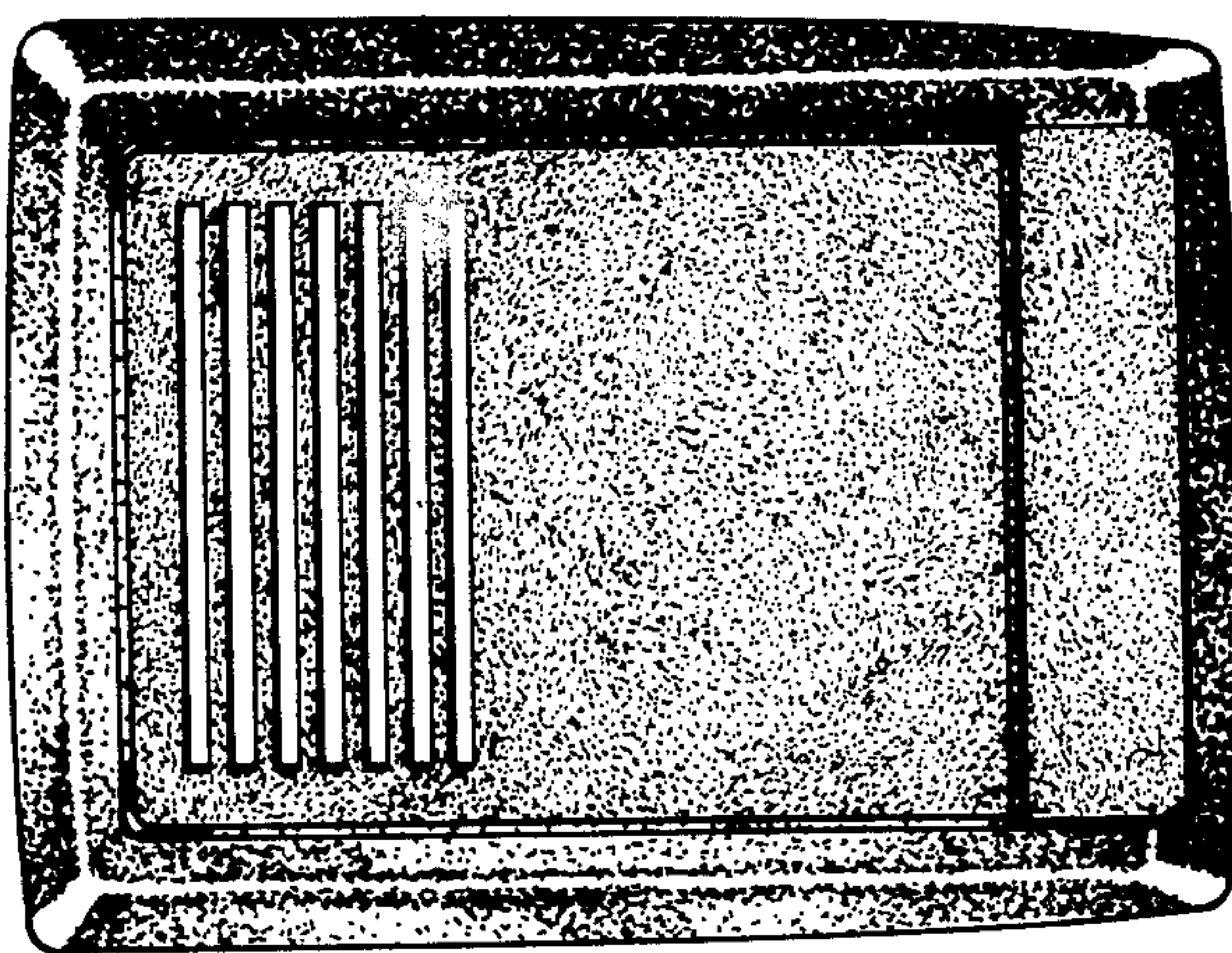

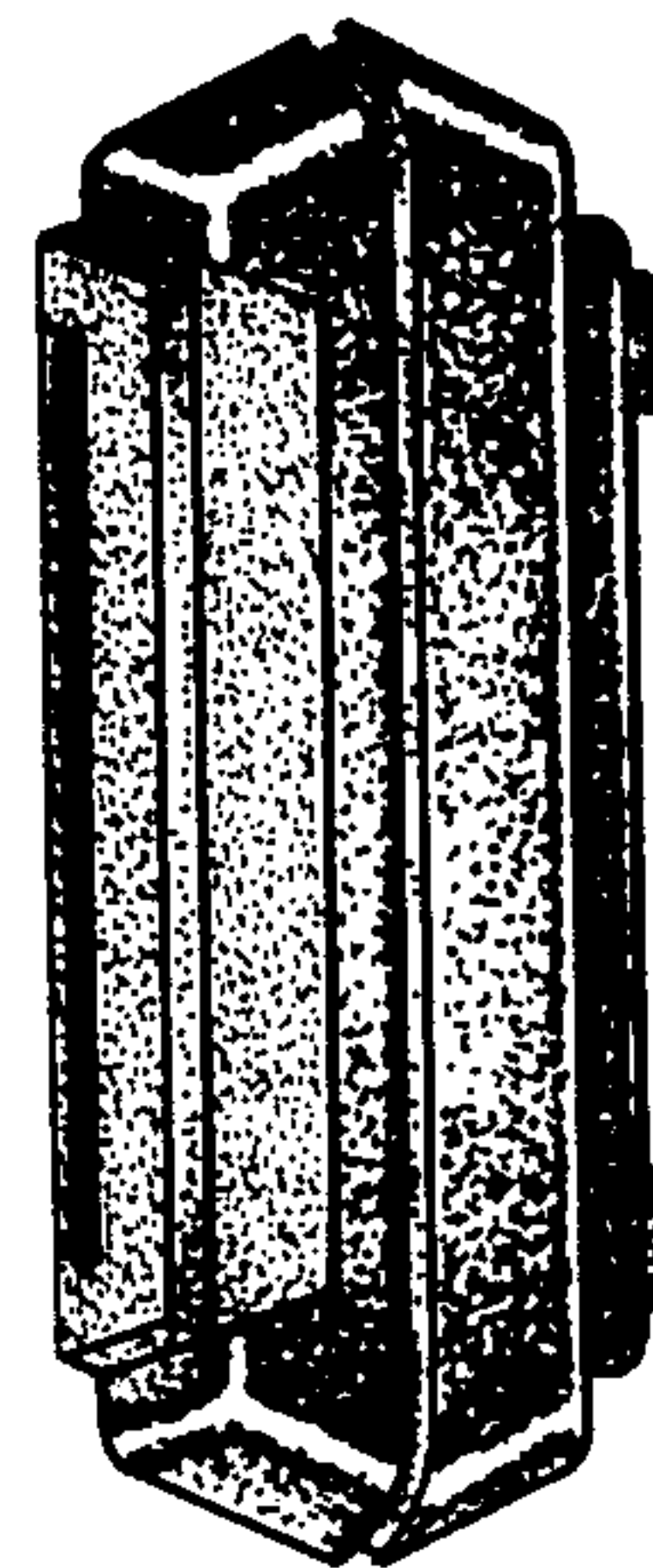
