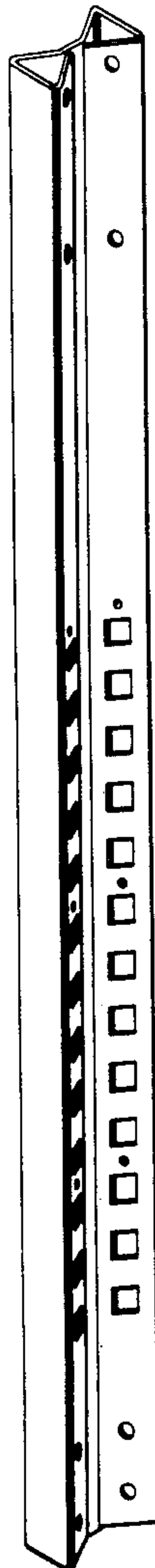
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shelf support post, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance as the side shown;

 FIG. 4 is an inner elevational view; and
 FIG. 5 is a top view, the bottom being the same in appearance as the top.

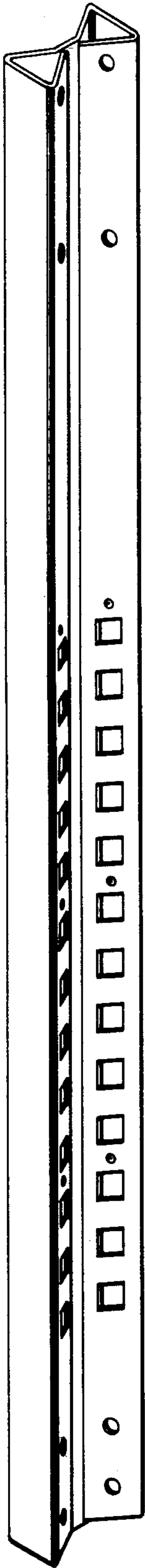

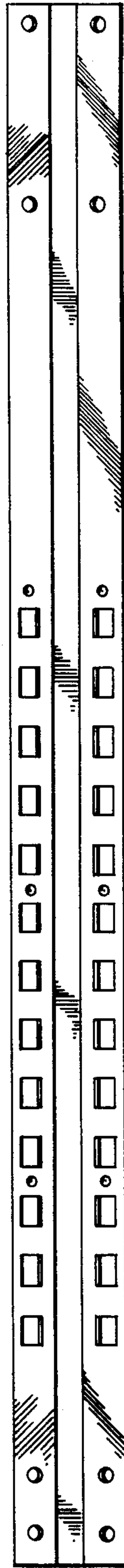

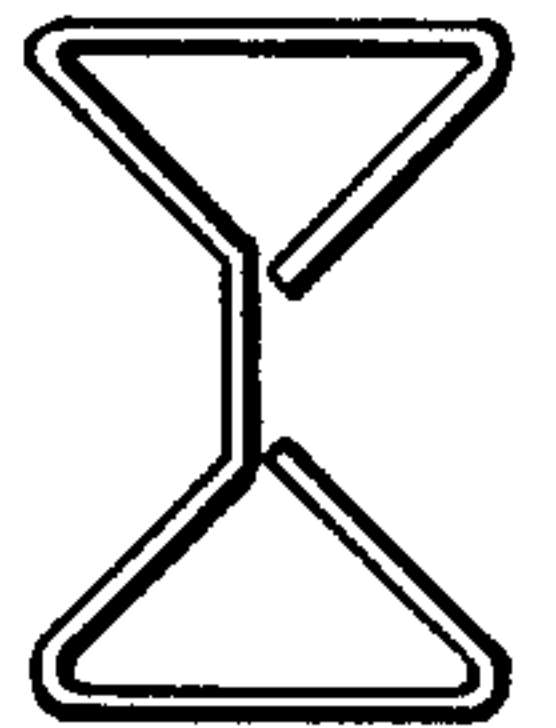
