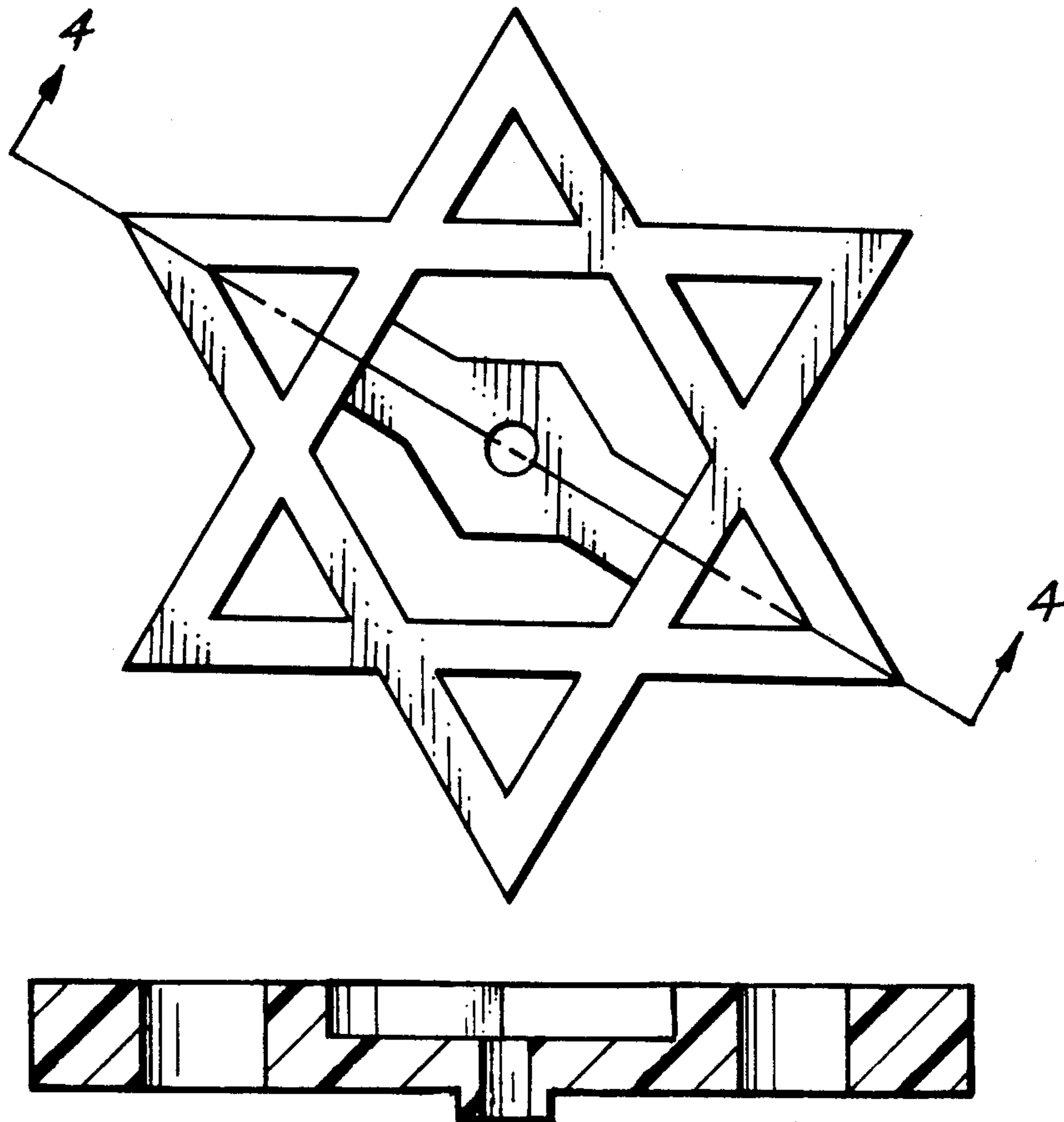

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a buoyant wick holder, essentially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the buoyant wick holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1.



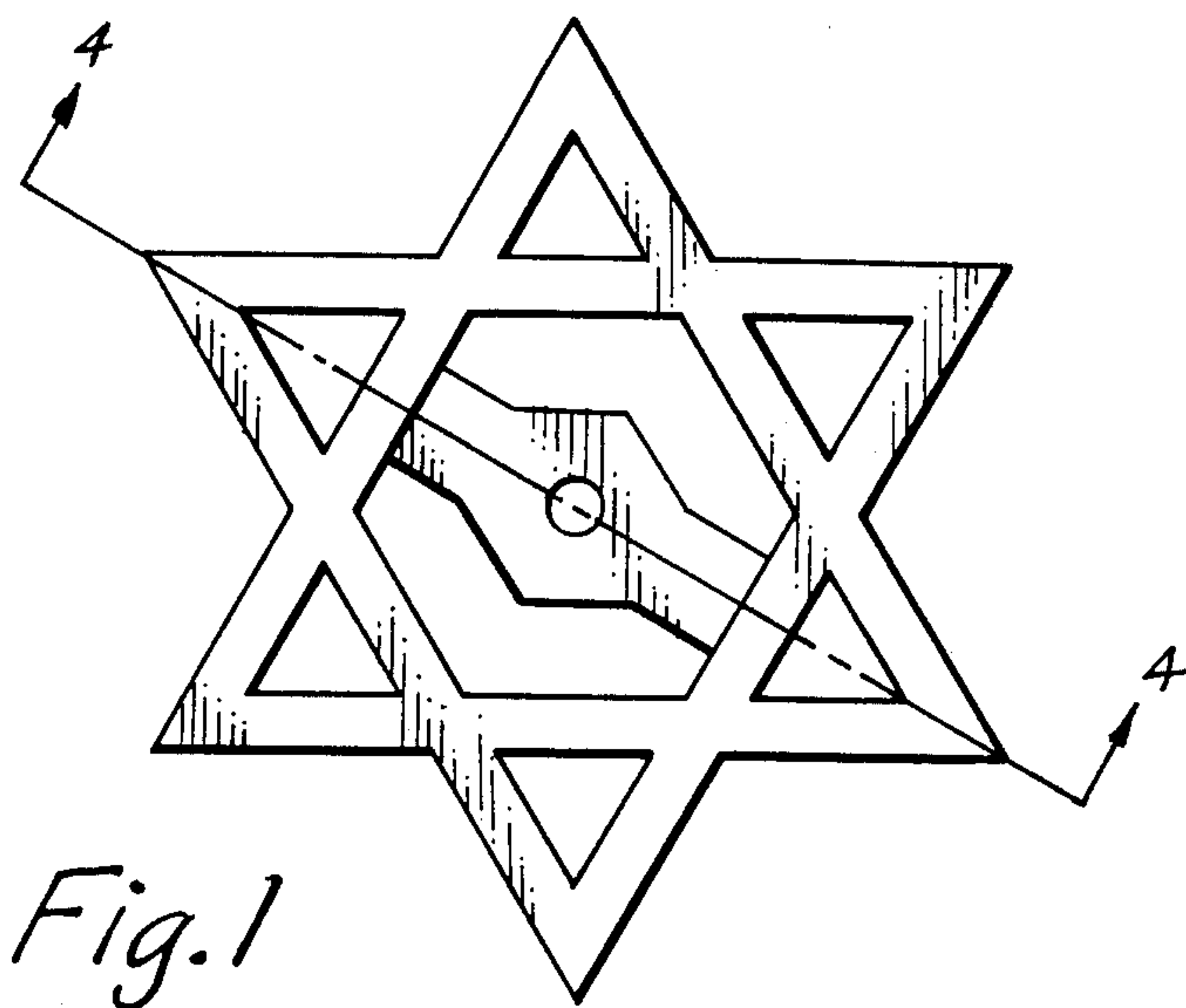

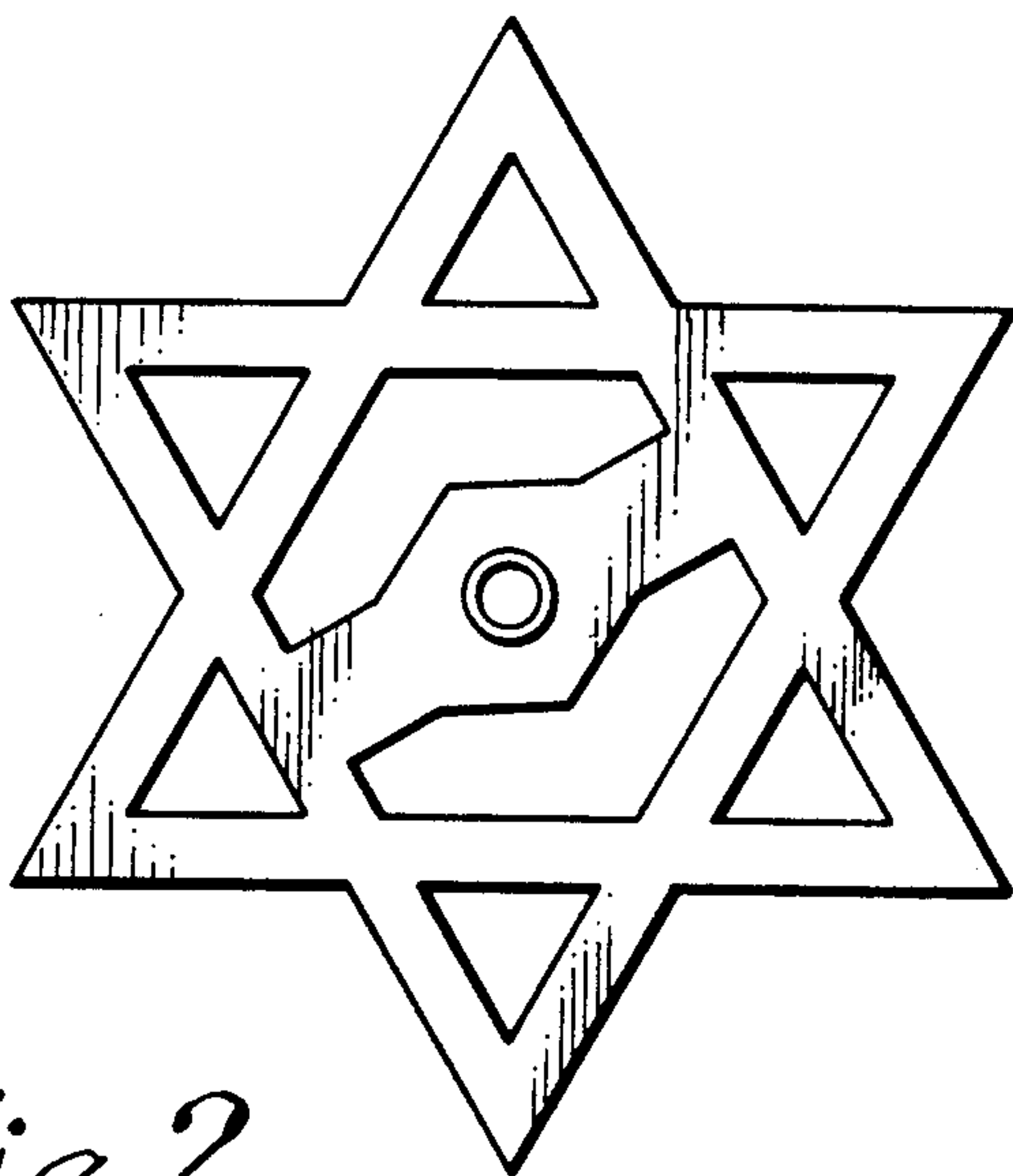
