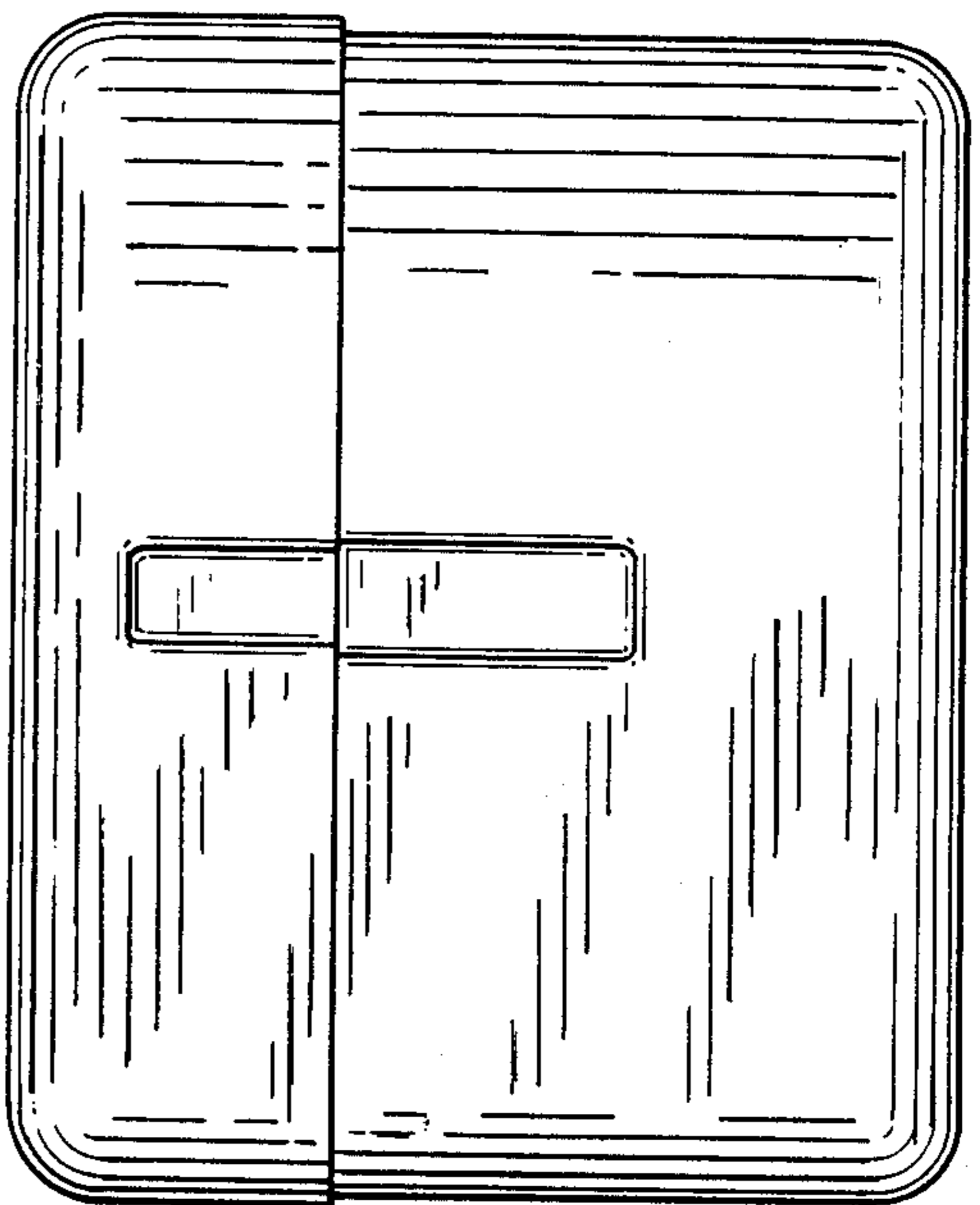
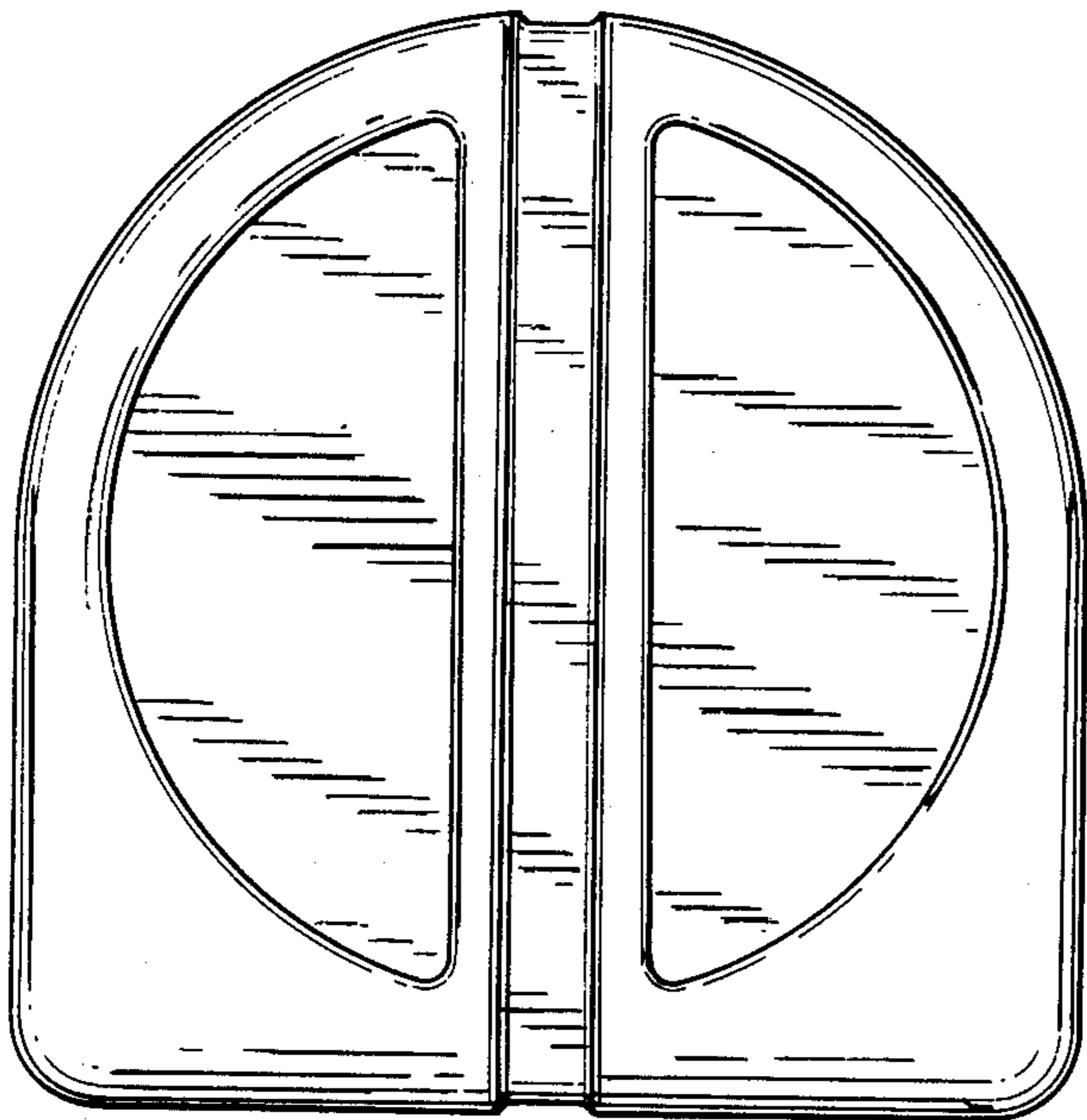

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a drum case, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a drum case showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view, a fragmentary section being broken away to show the mating slots; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view shown partially in cross-section.



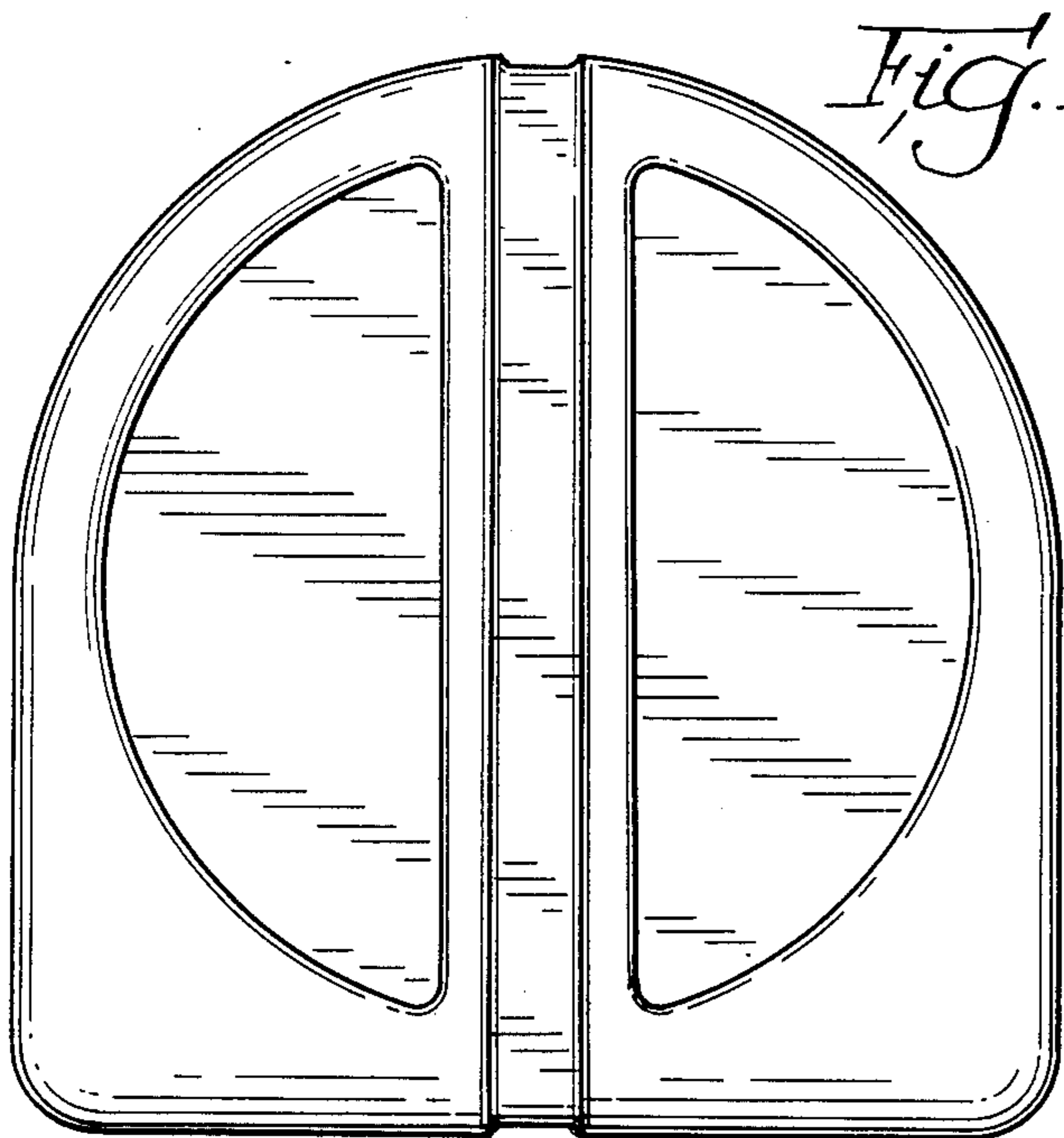

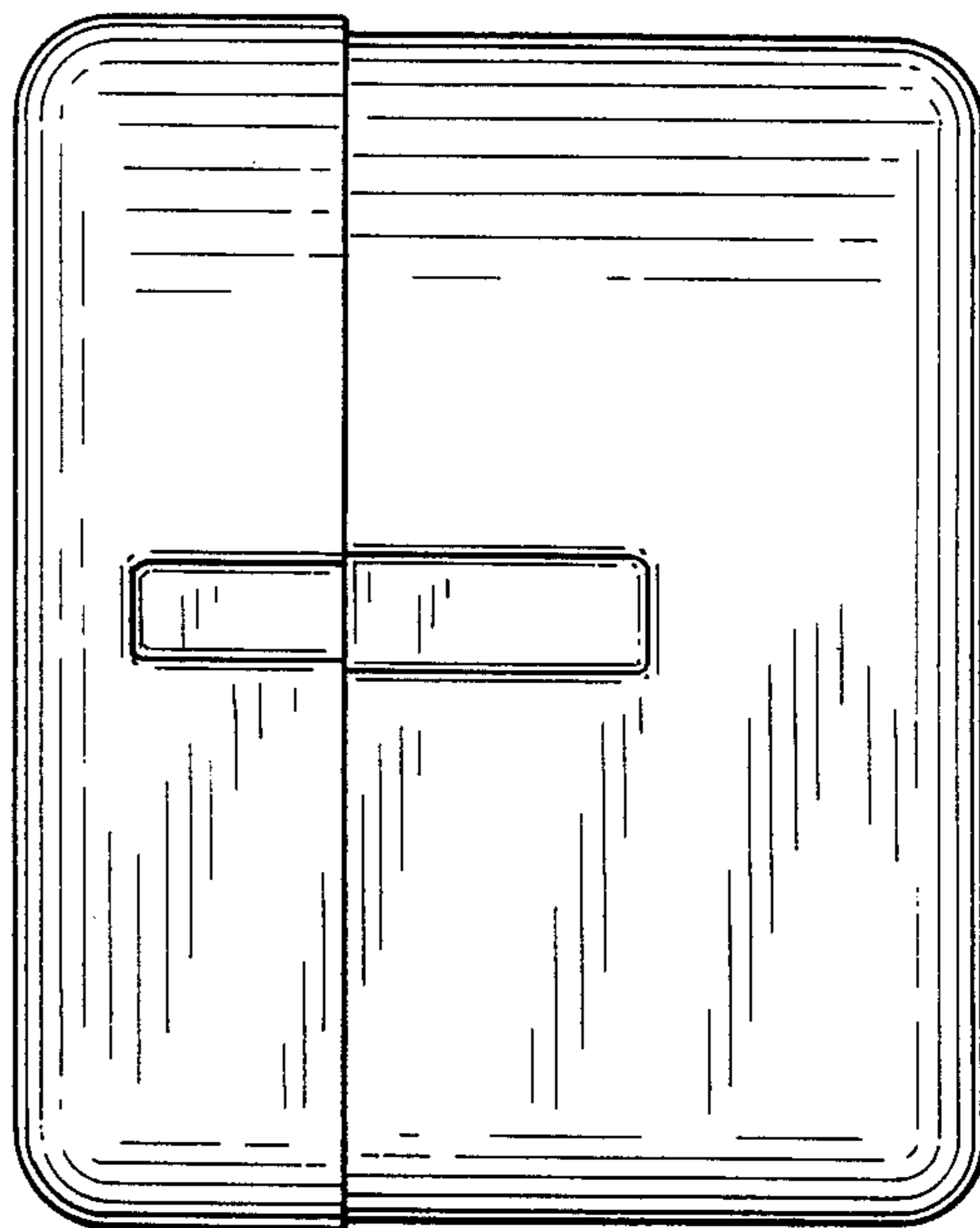

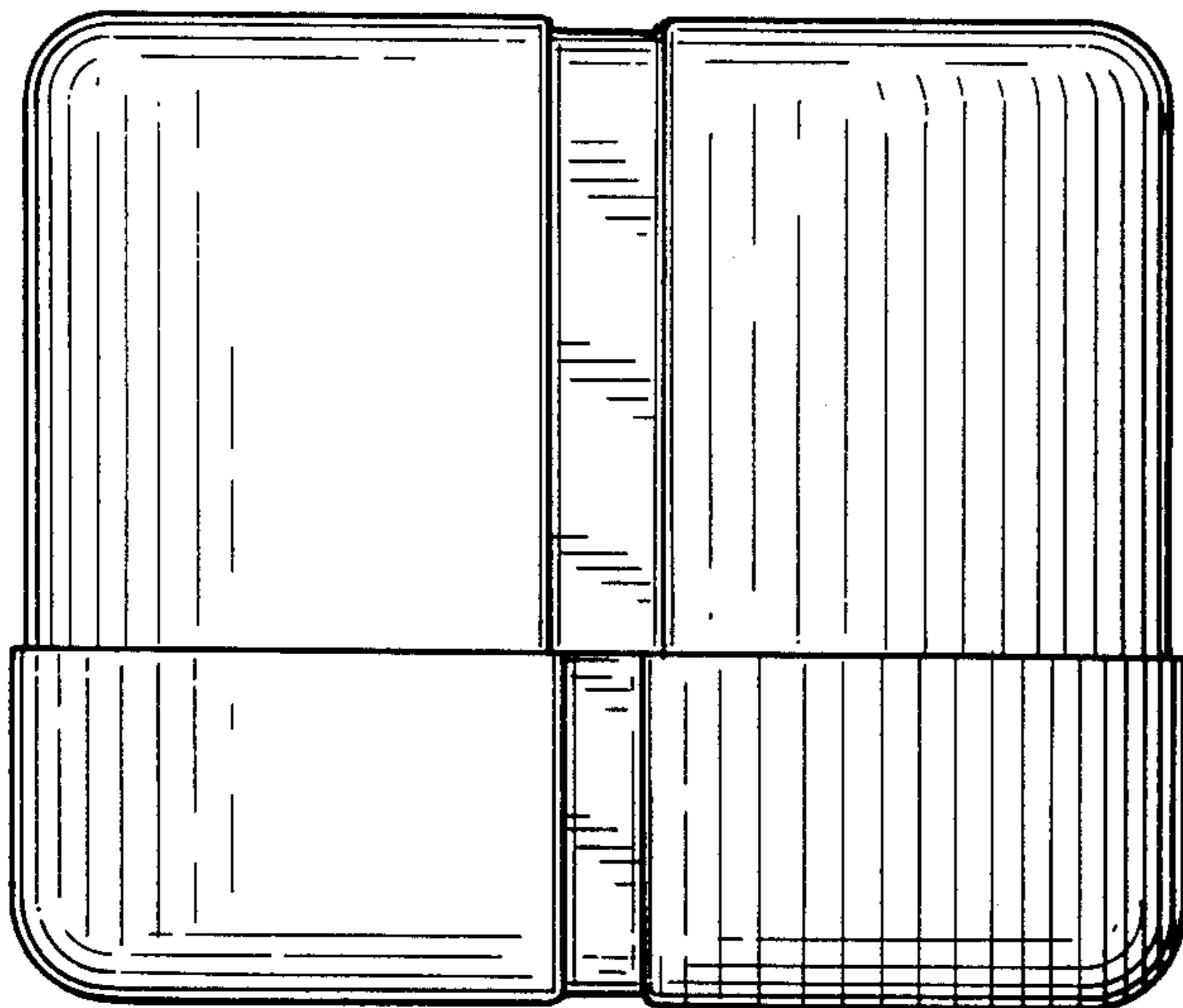

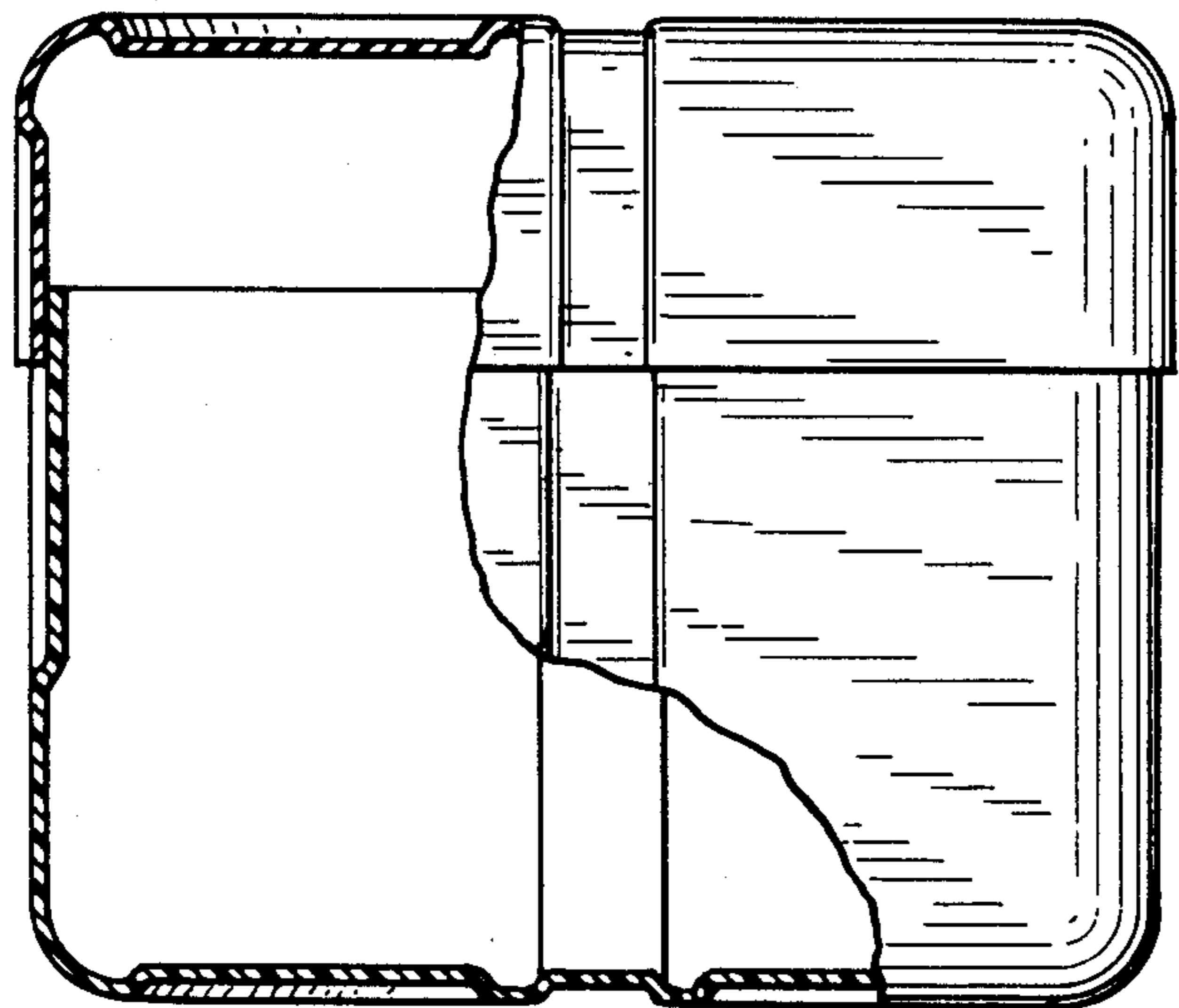
