[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a patient positioning cushion, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cushion showing my design in unfolded position;

FIG. 2 is a side view in folded position, the opposite side view (not shown) being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 3 is a front view in folded position;

FIG. 4 is a rear view in folded position; and

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the cushion in unfolded position.

The broken lines shown in FIG. 2 are for illustrative purposes only.

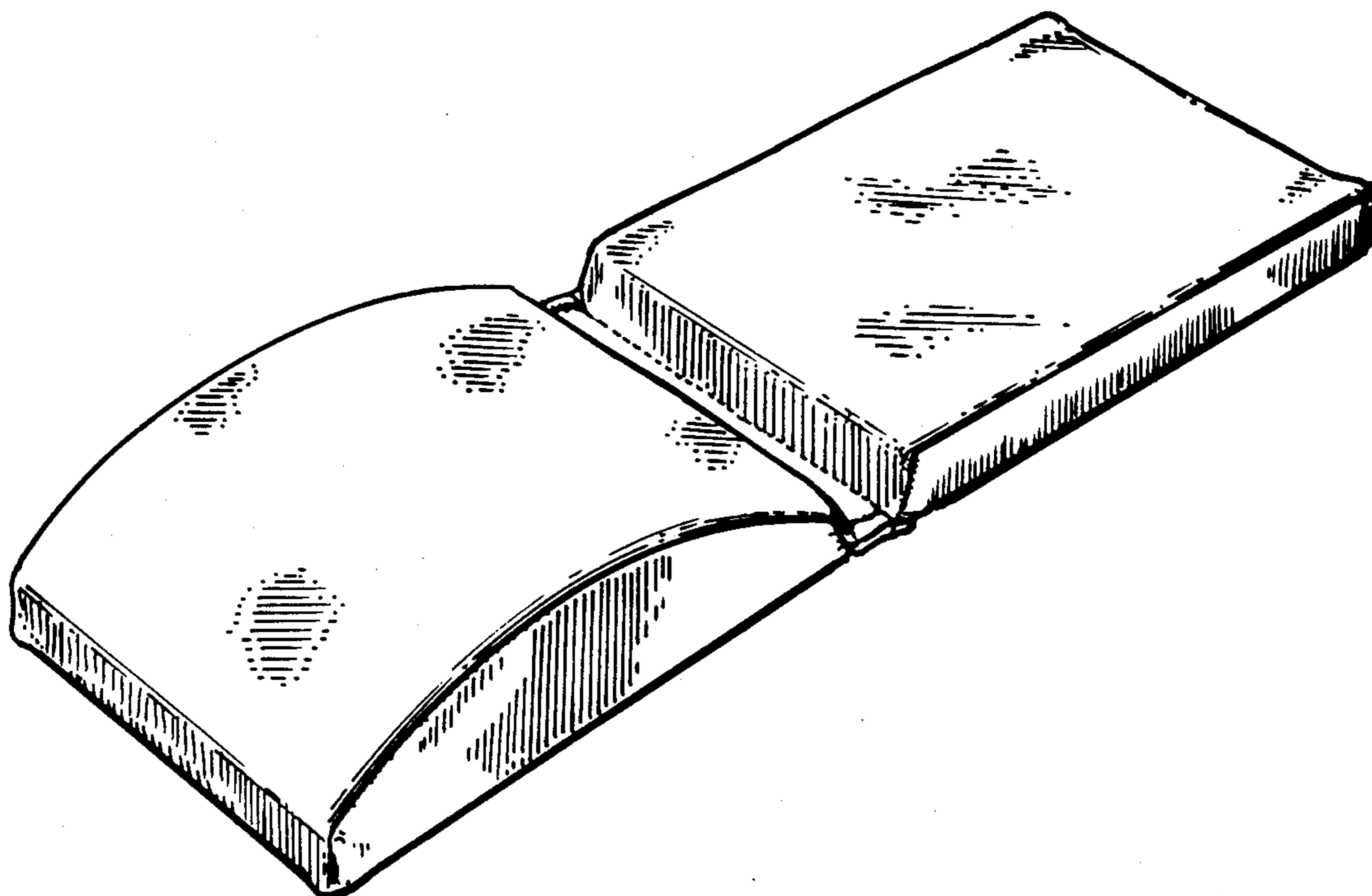

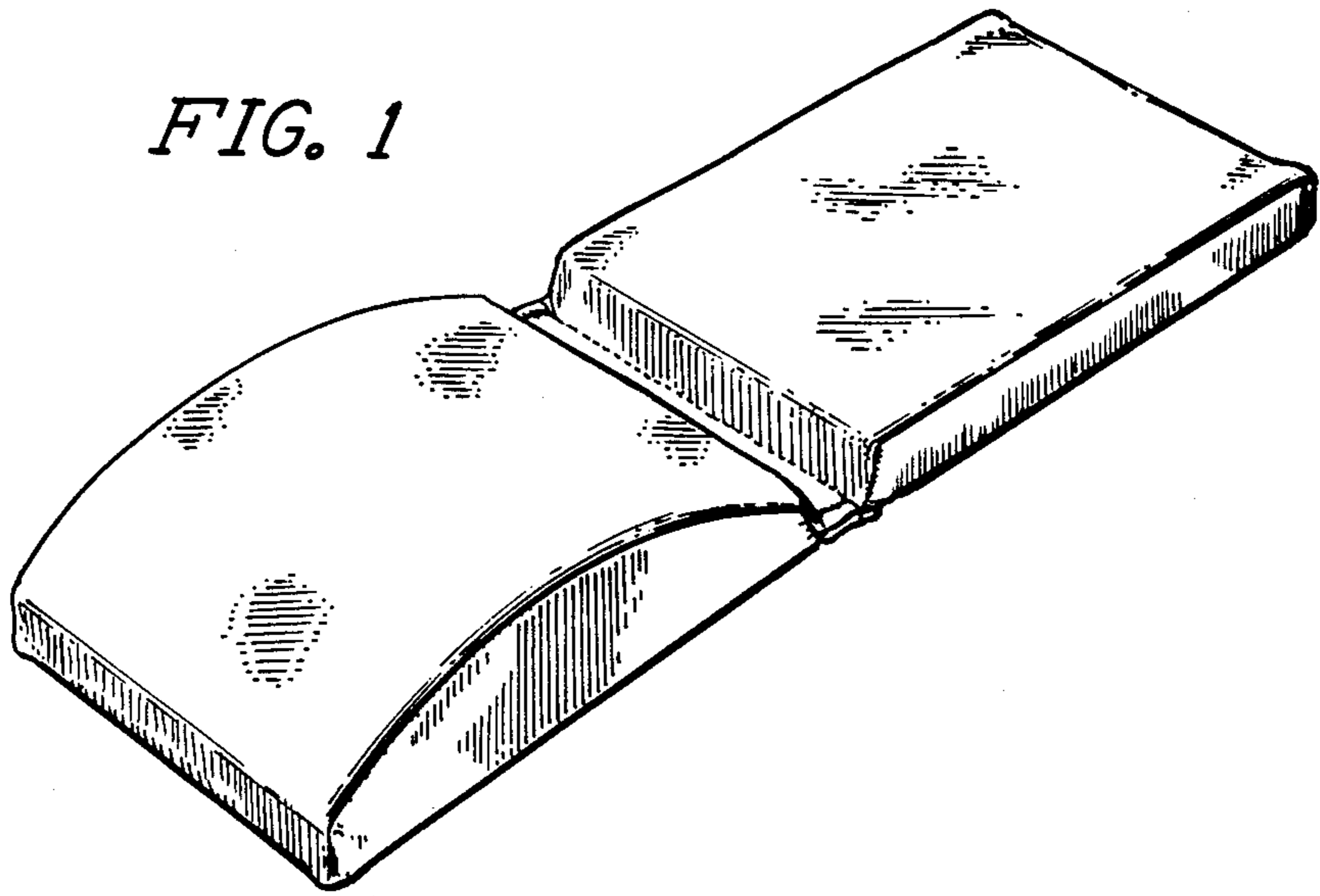

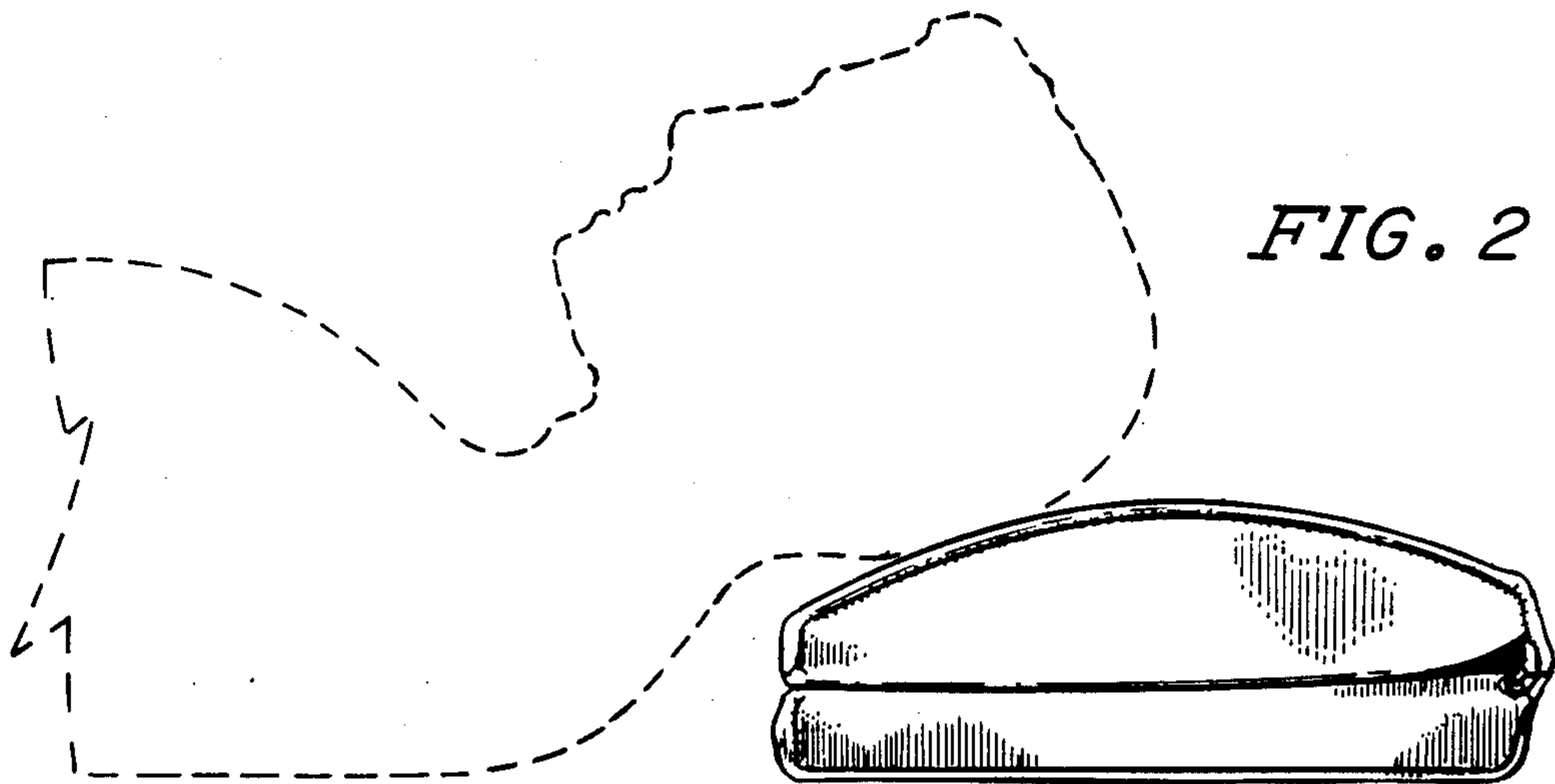

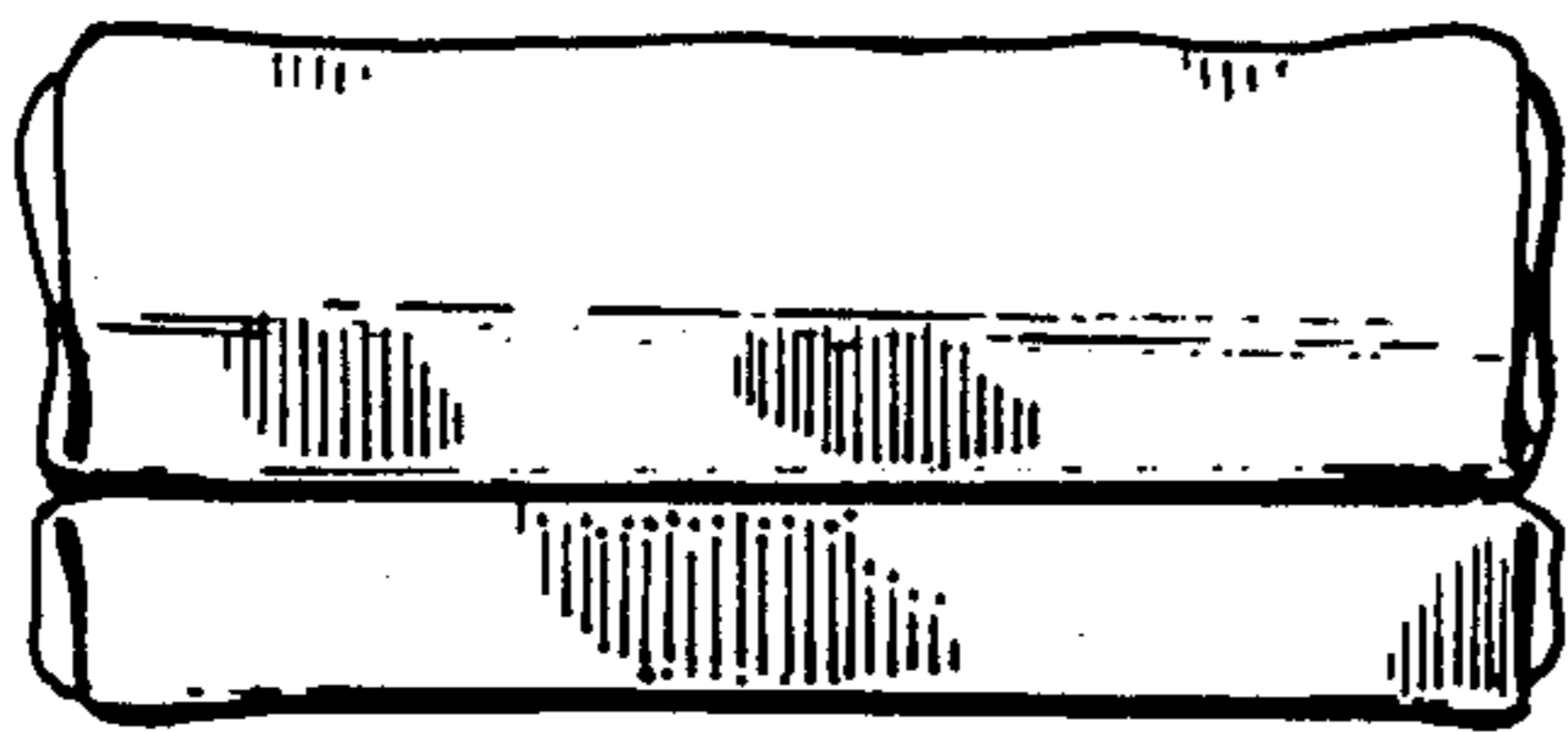

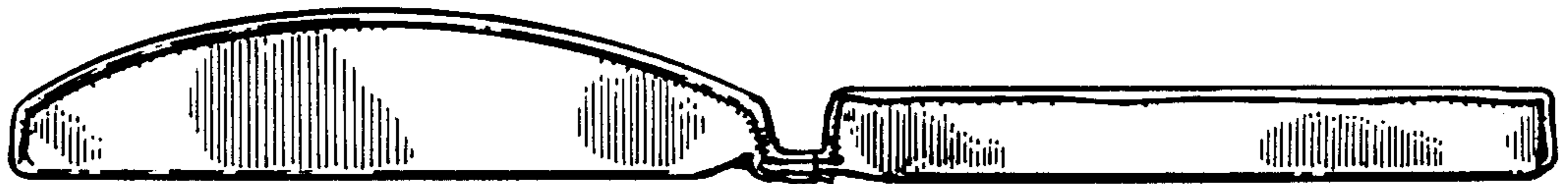
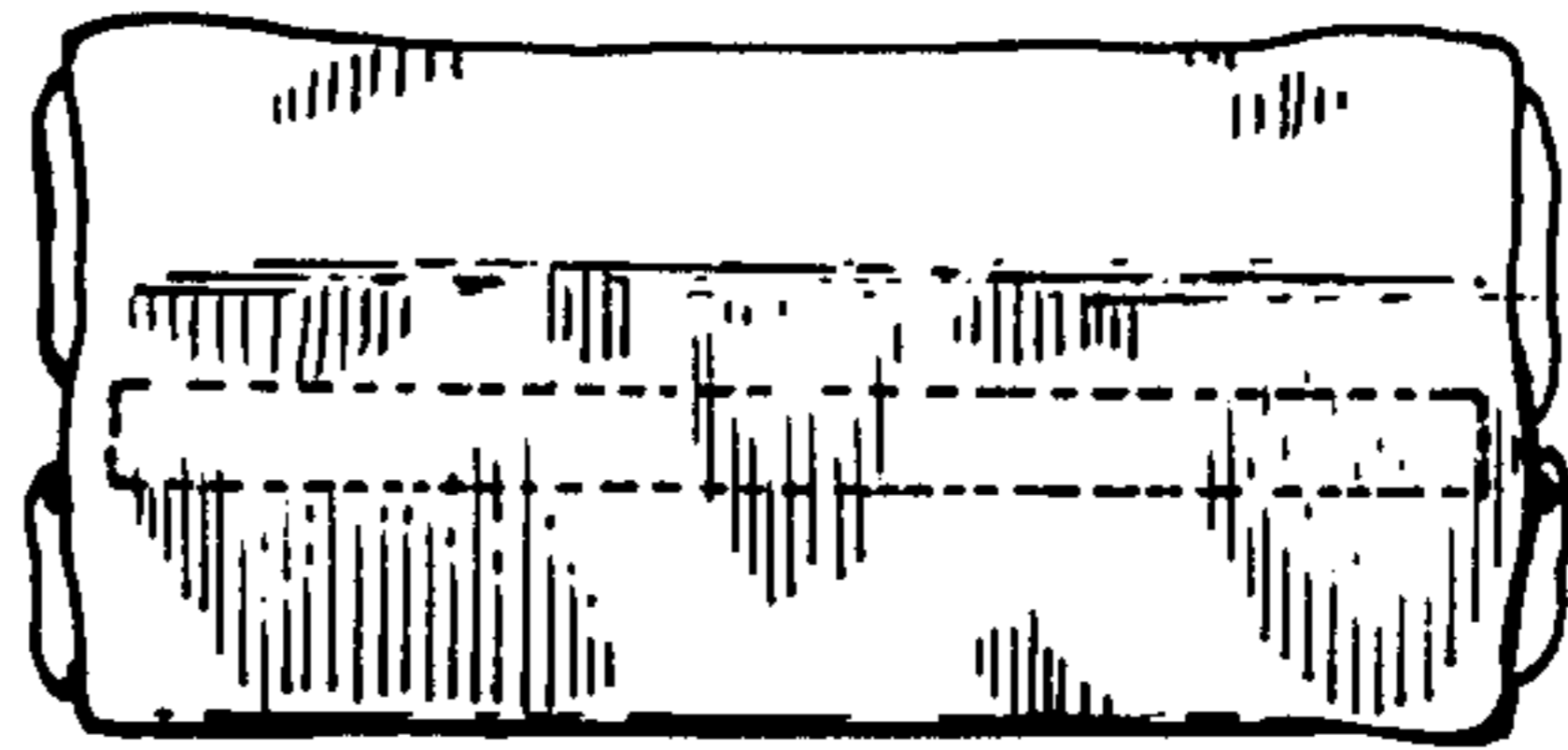
