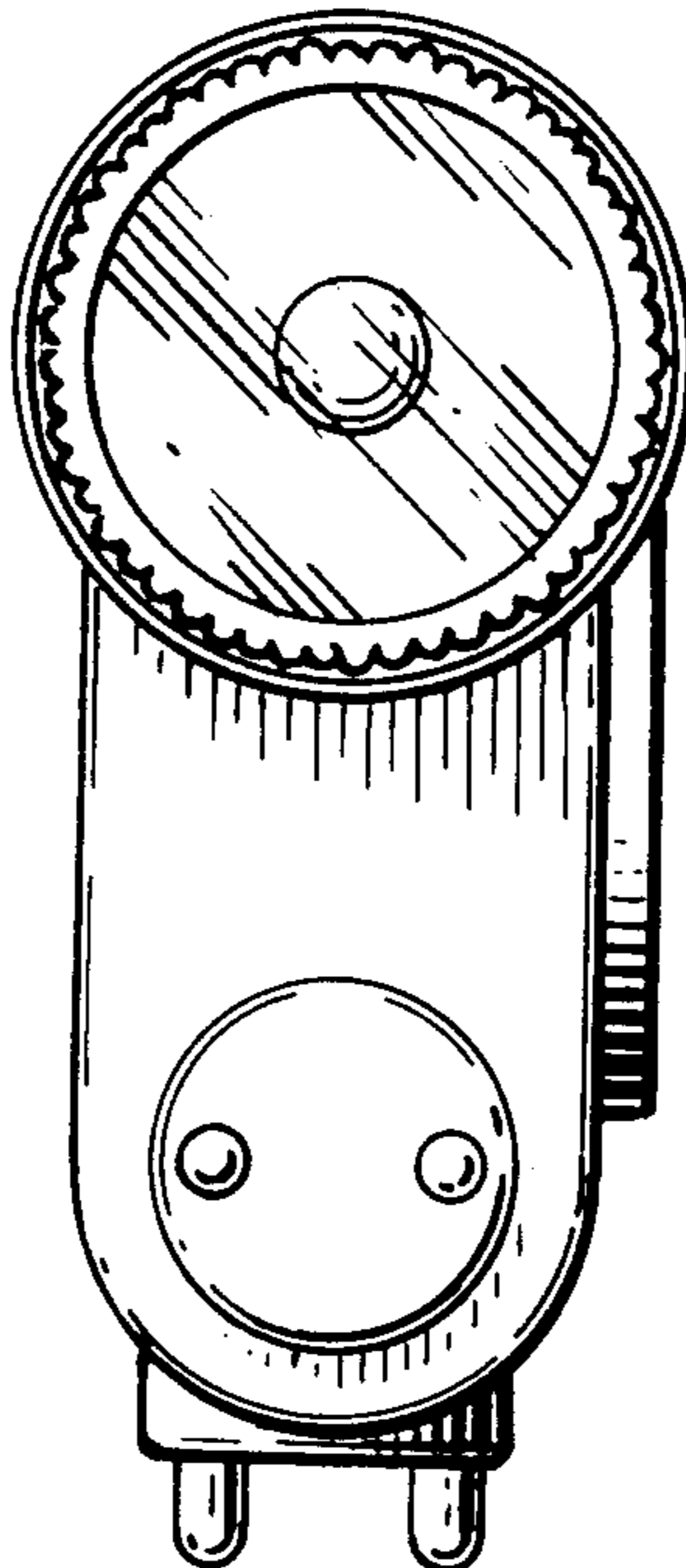

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined flashlight alarm and defensive electric prod, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an end view of a combined flashlight alarm and defensive electric prod showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof viewing from the end opposite to that depicted in FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof viewing from the side opposite to that depicted in FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



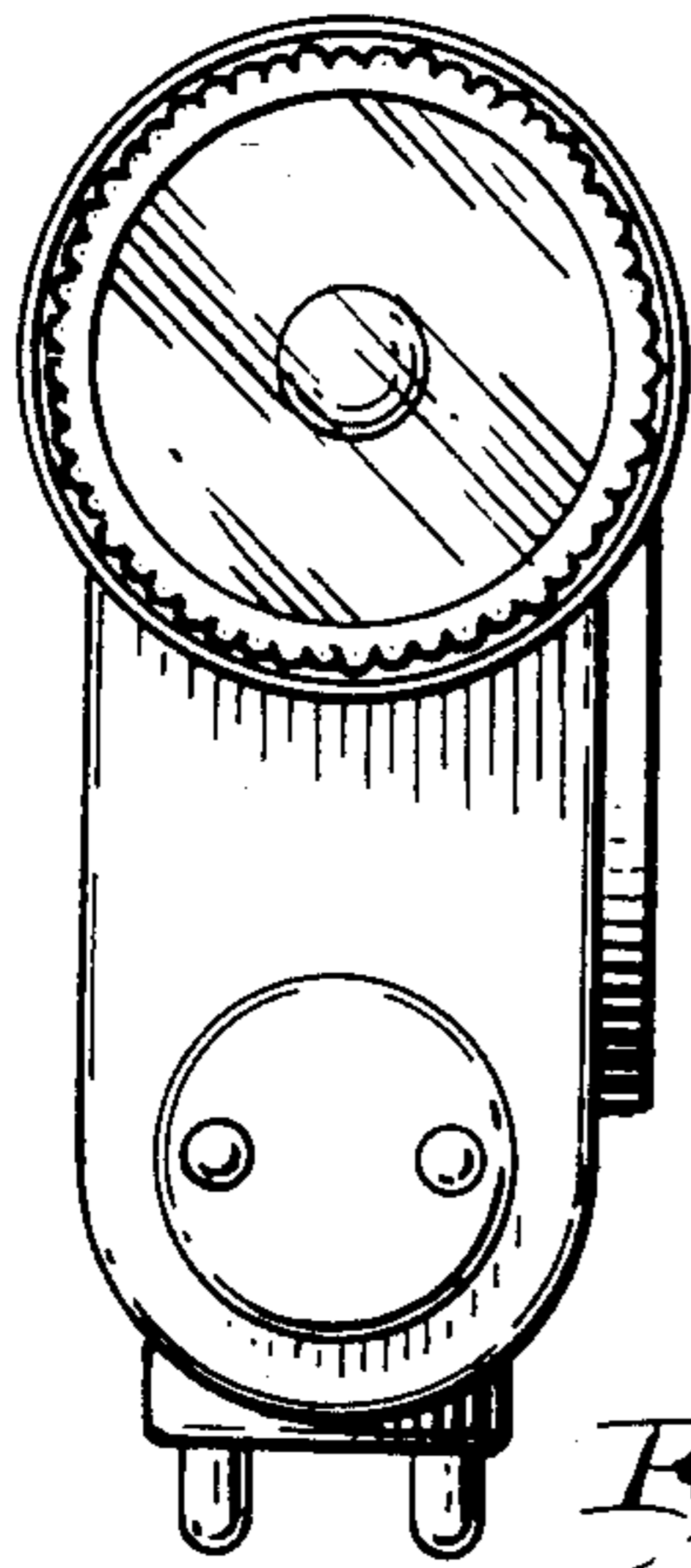

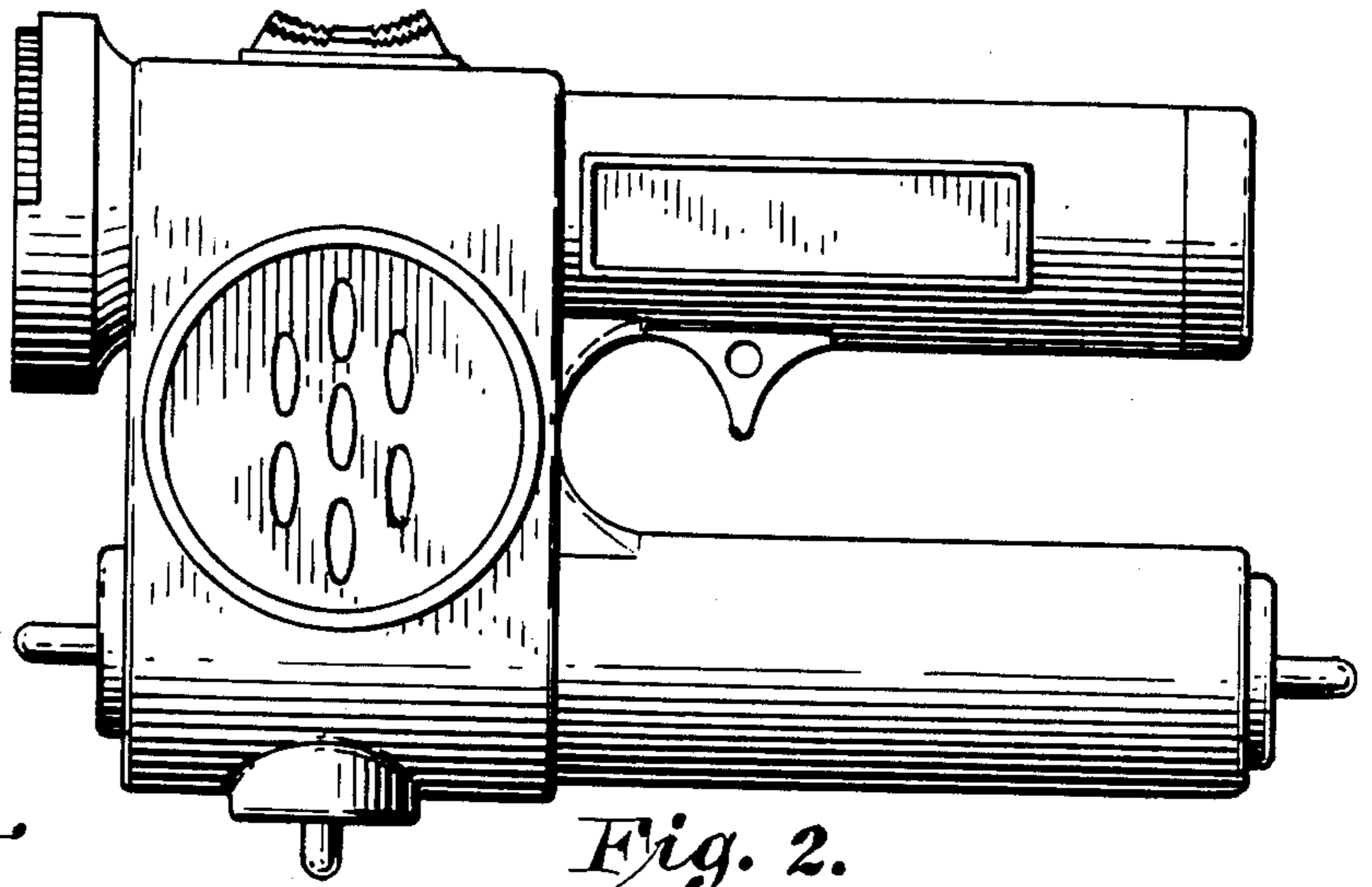

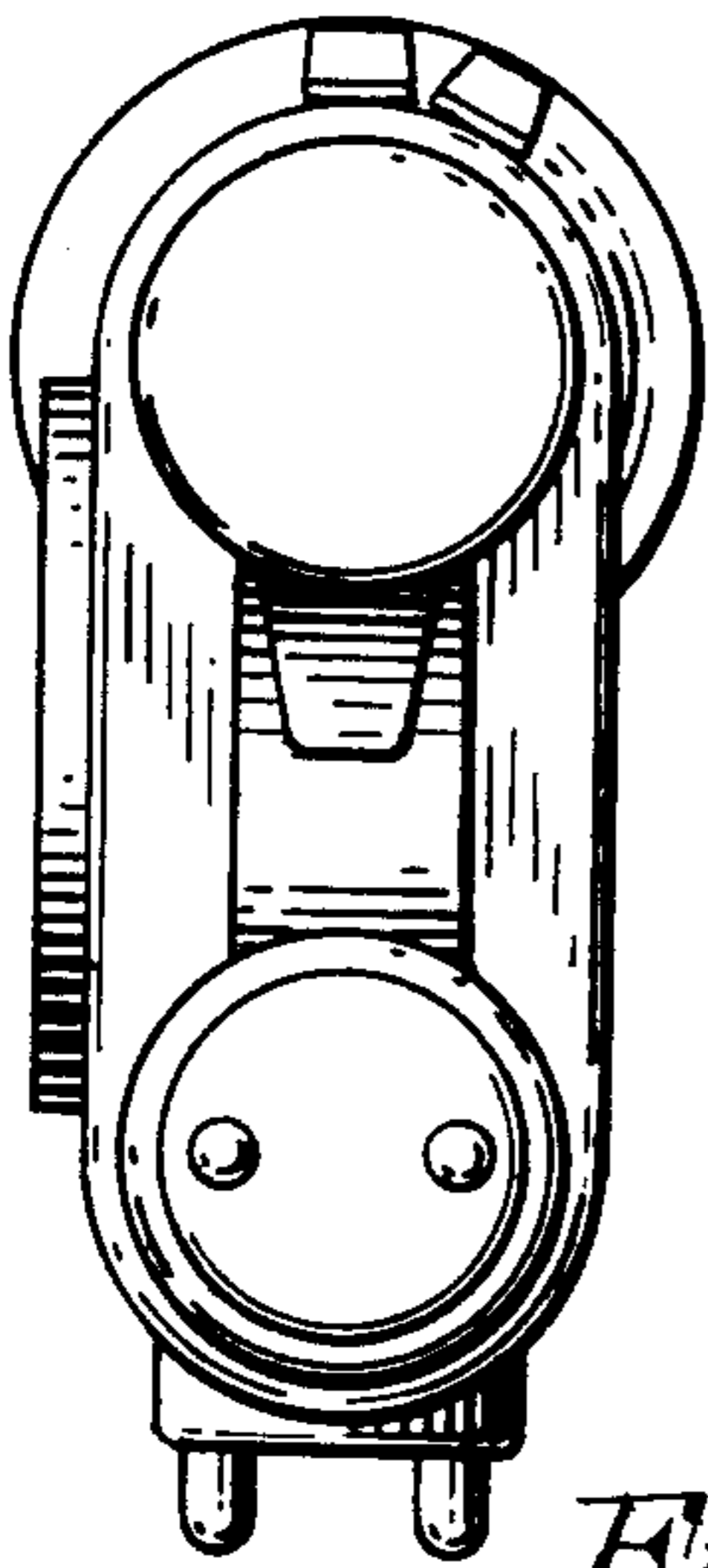

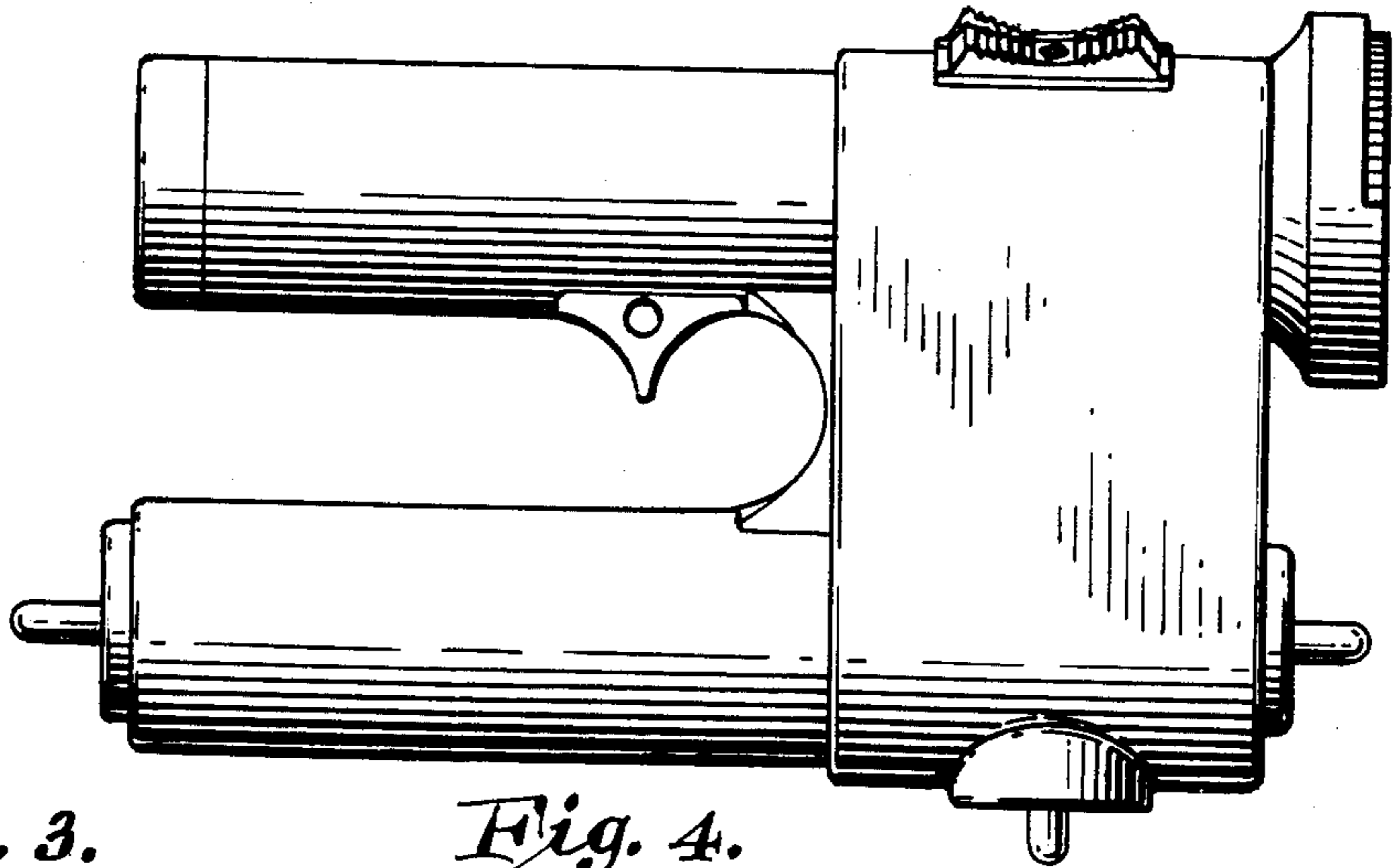

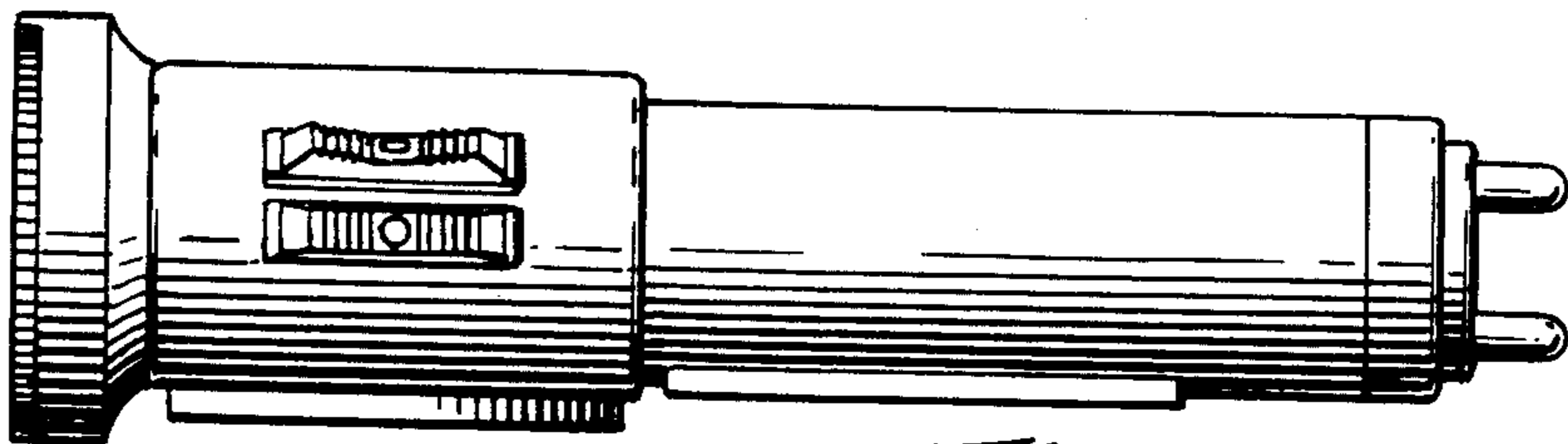

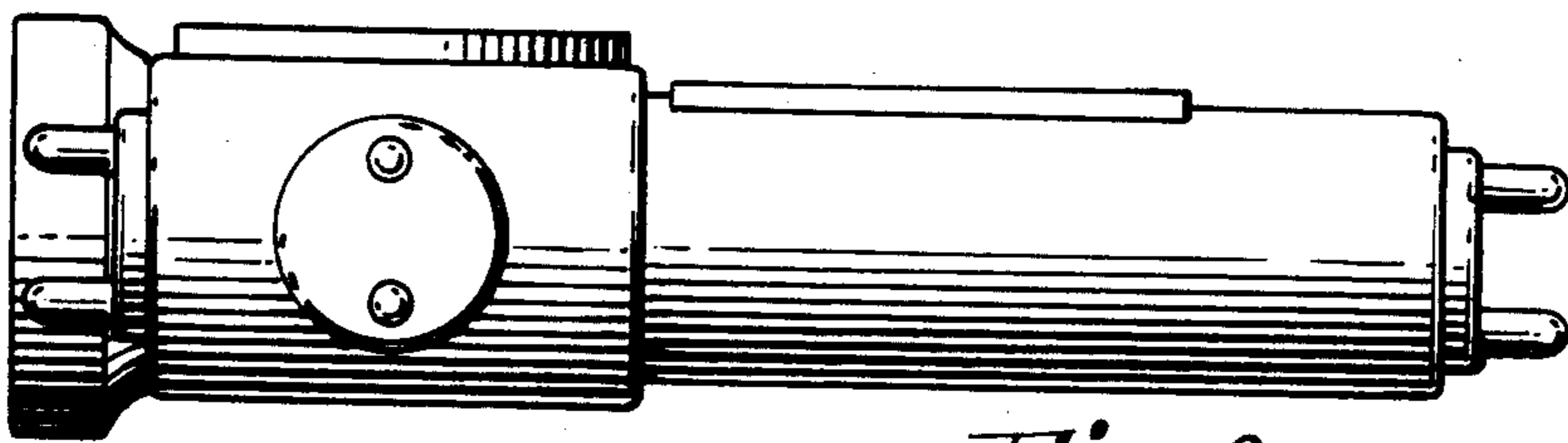
