FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an illuminated sign showing my new design;

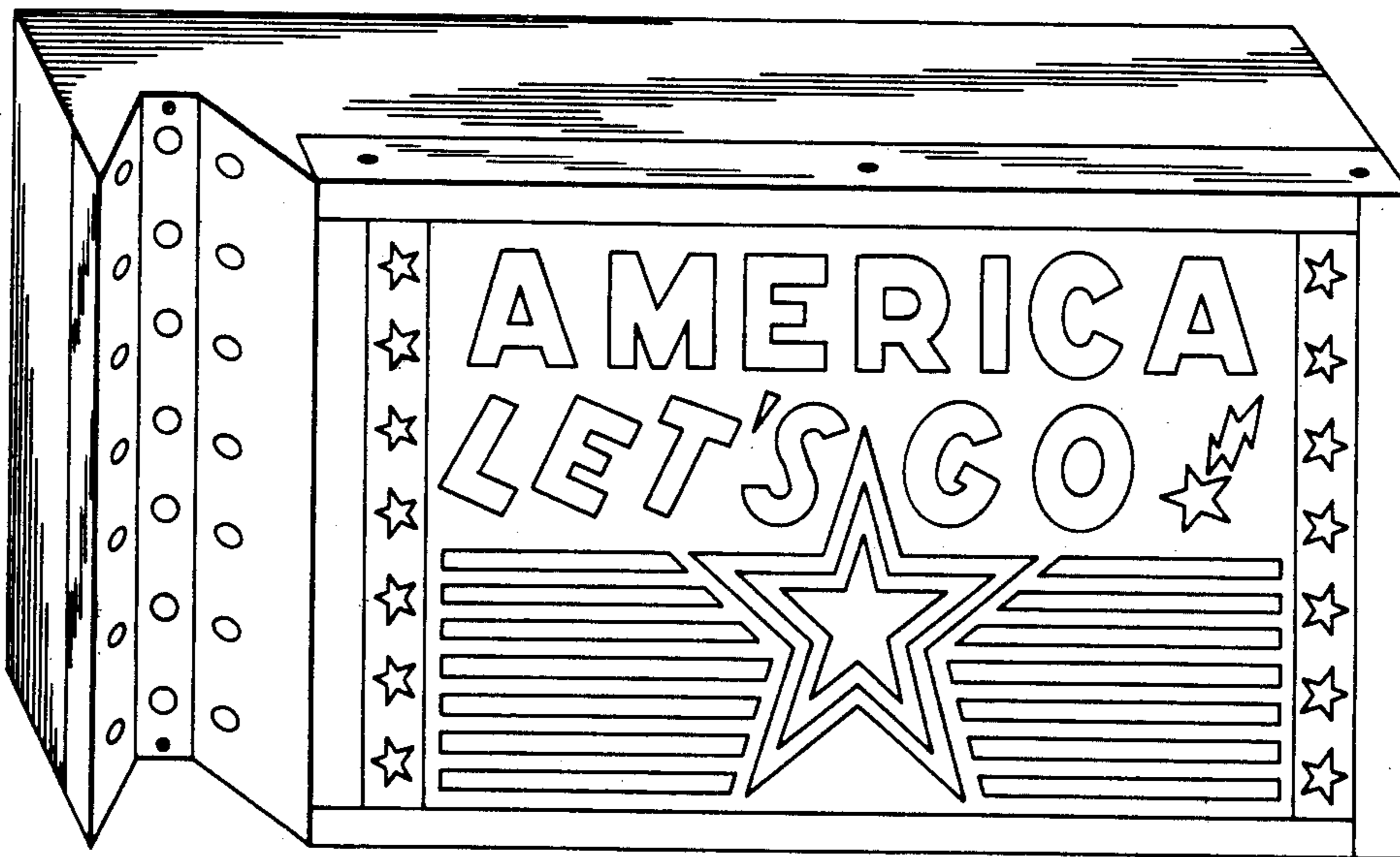

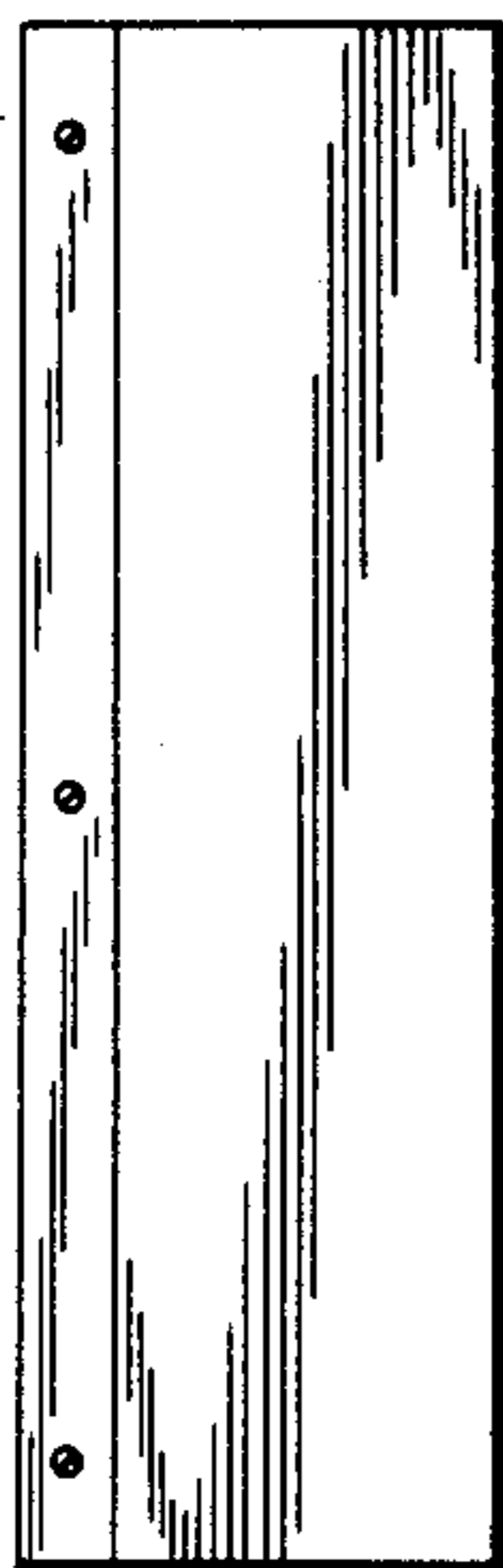

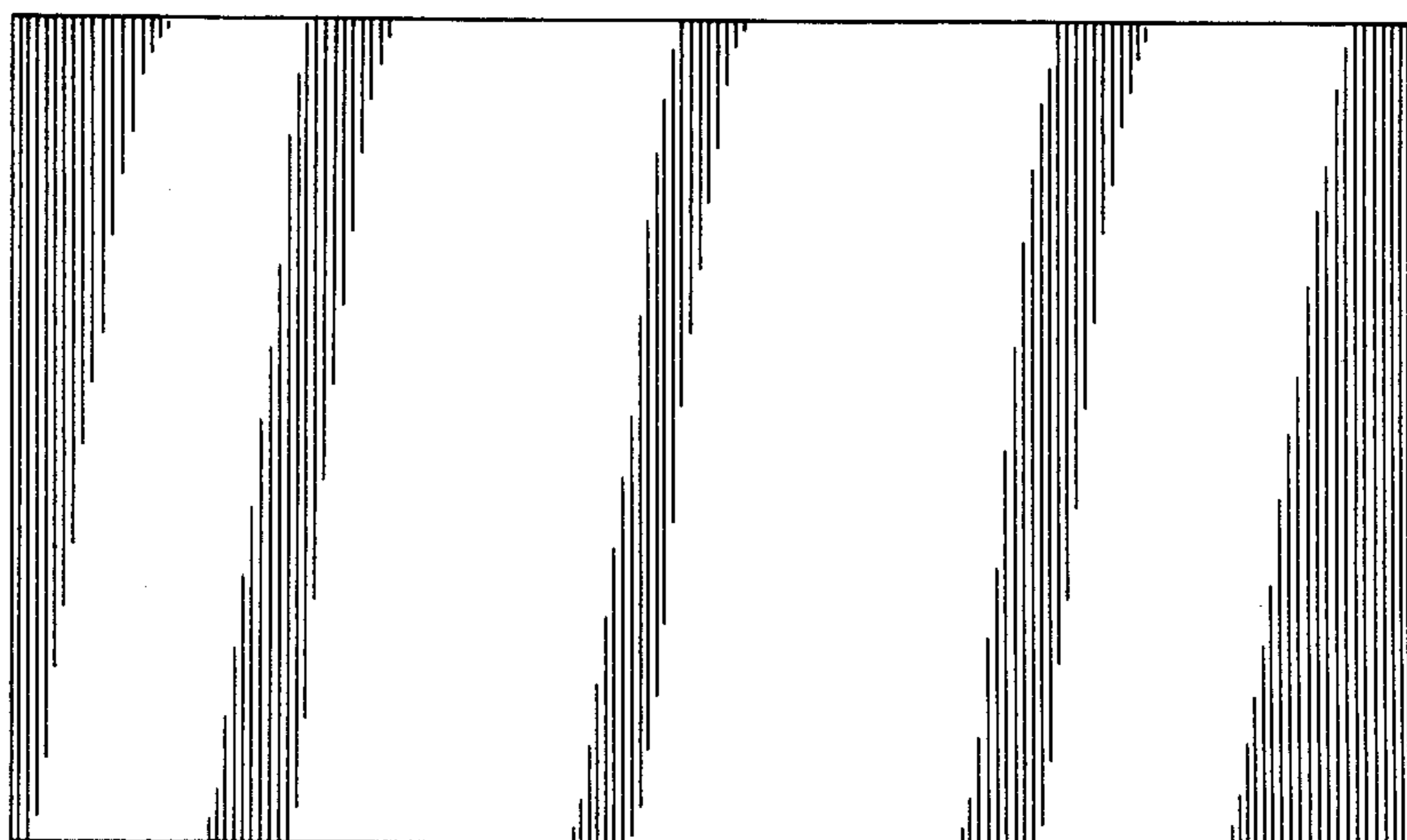

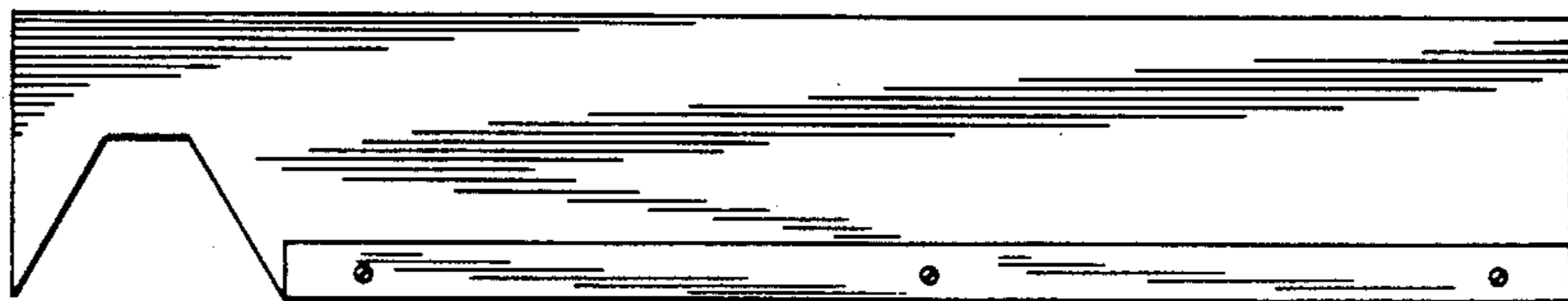

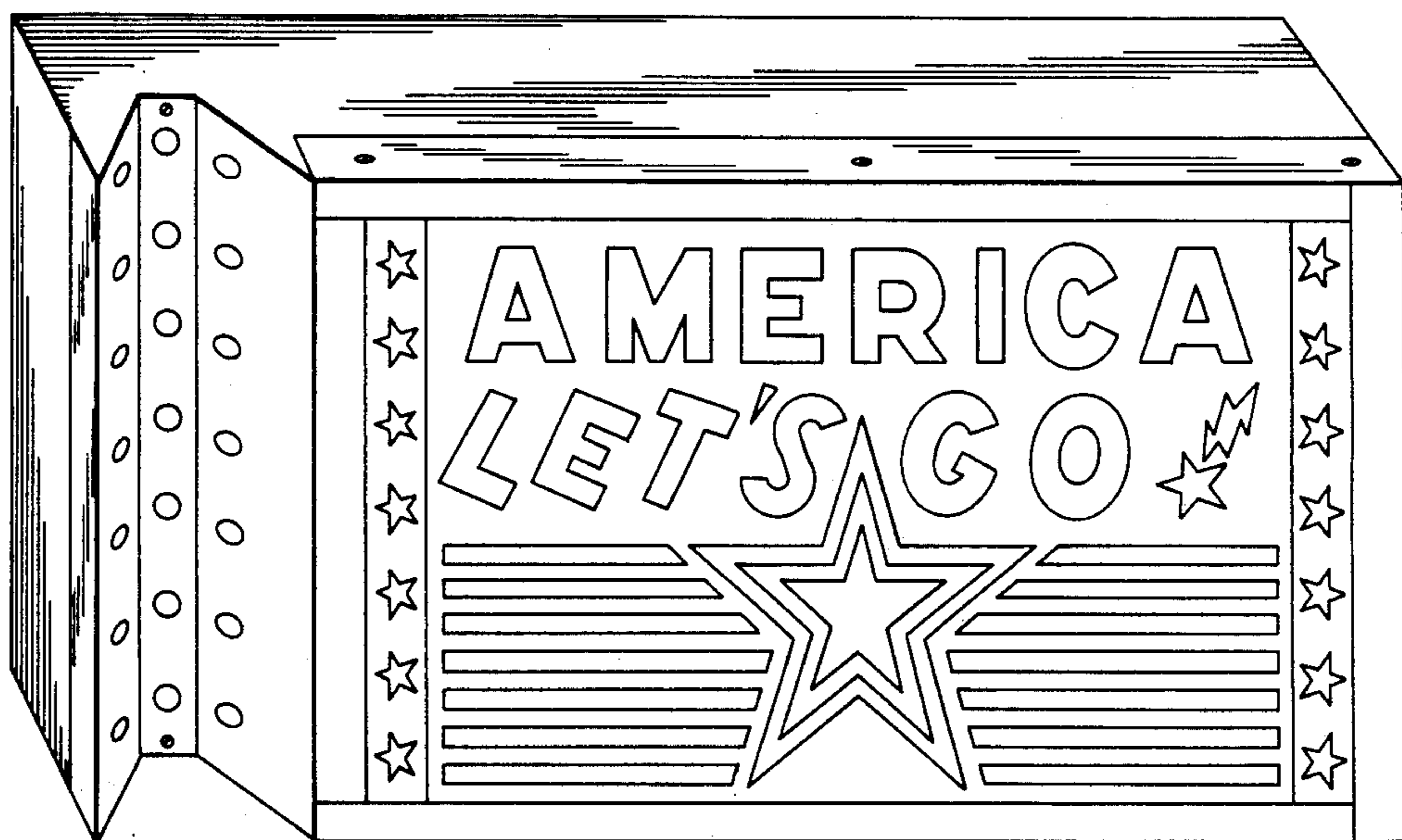
