[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a holder for a scouring implement, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a holder for a scouring implement, showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 4 is an enlarged sectional view thereof, taken along the line 4-4 in FIG. 2.
