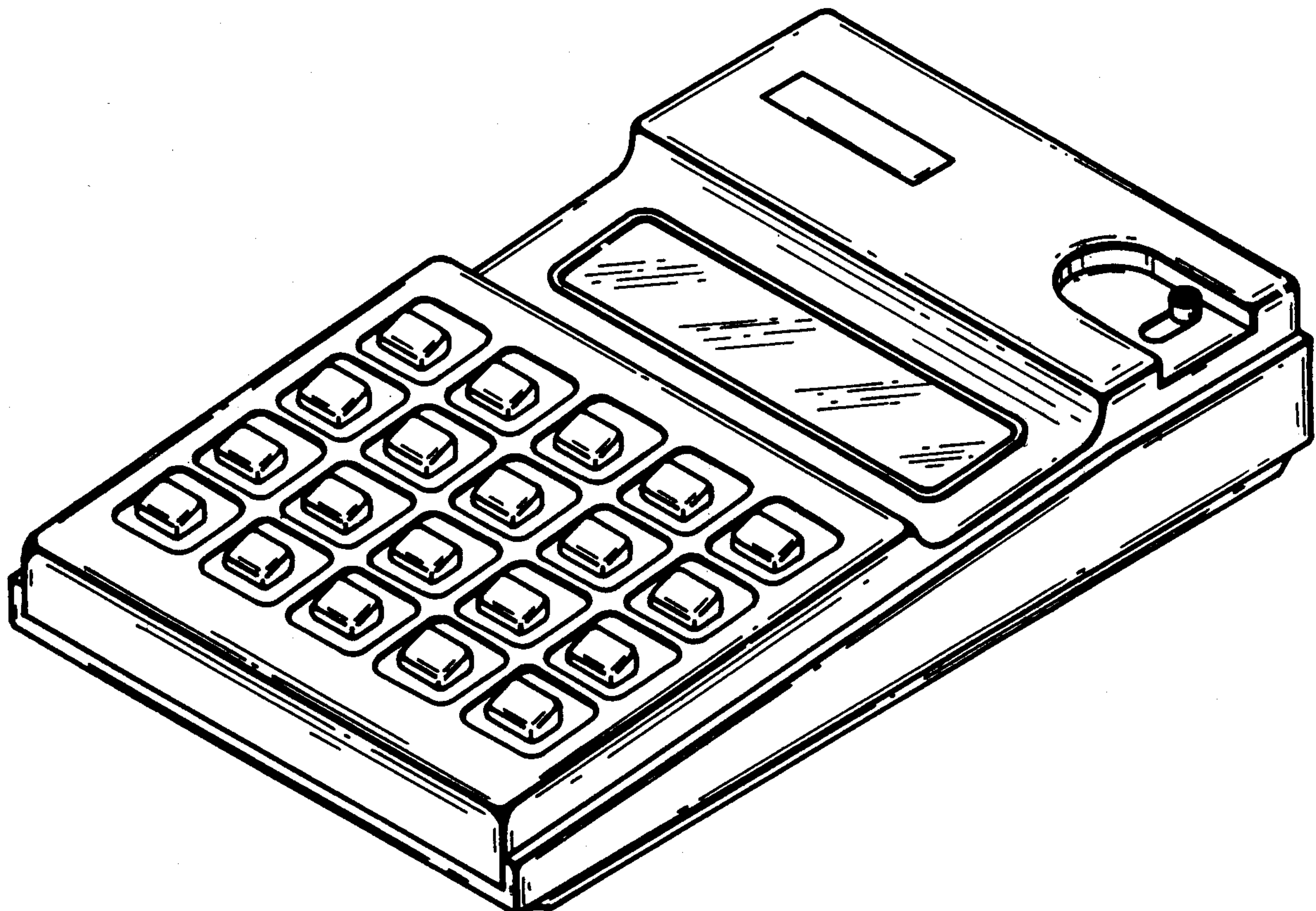

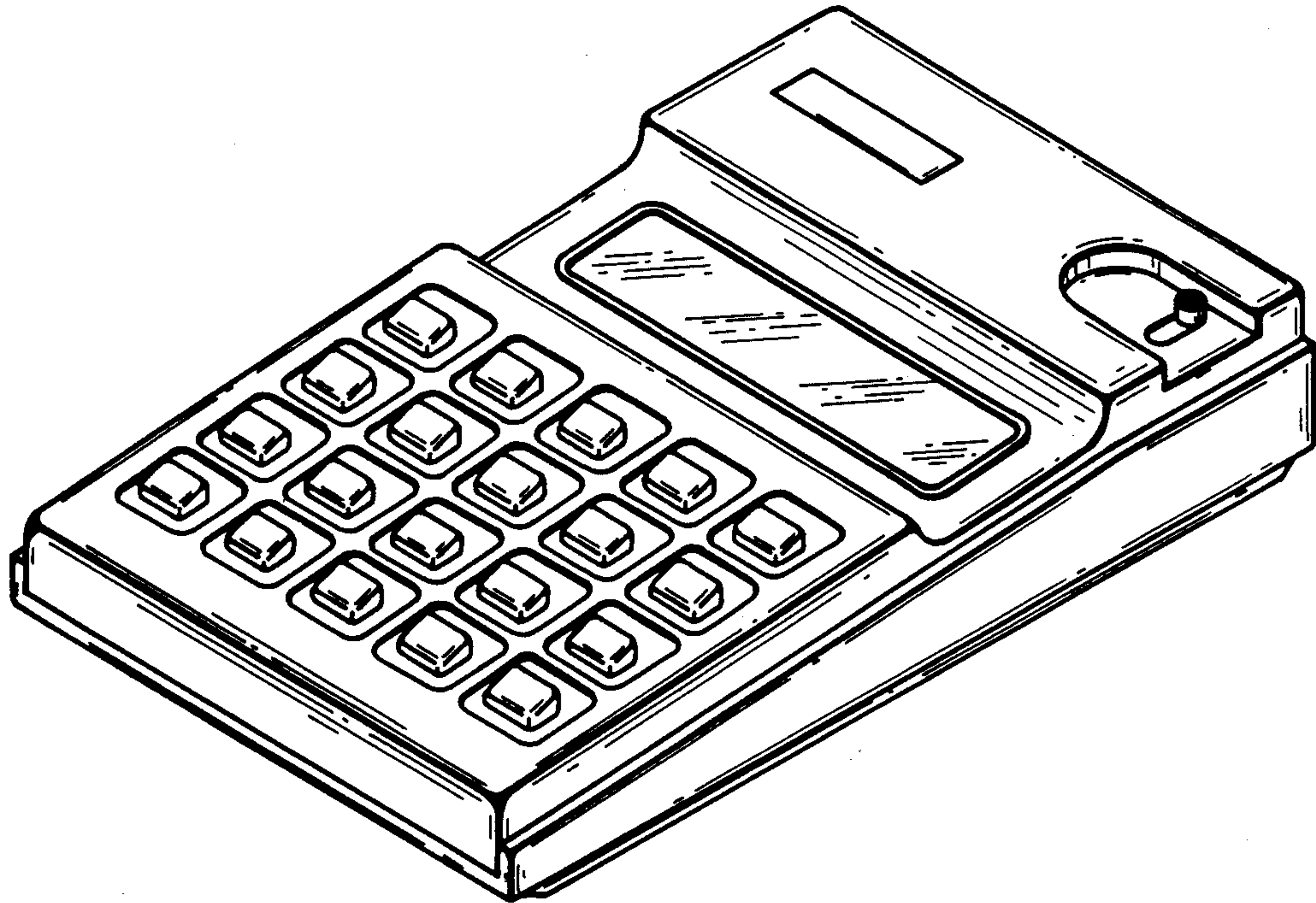

The ornamental design for an electronic calculating machine, as shown and described.

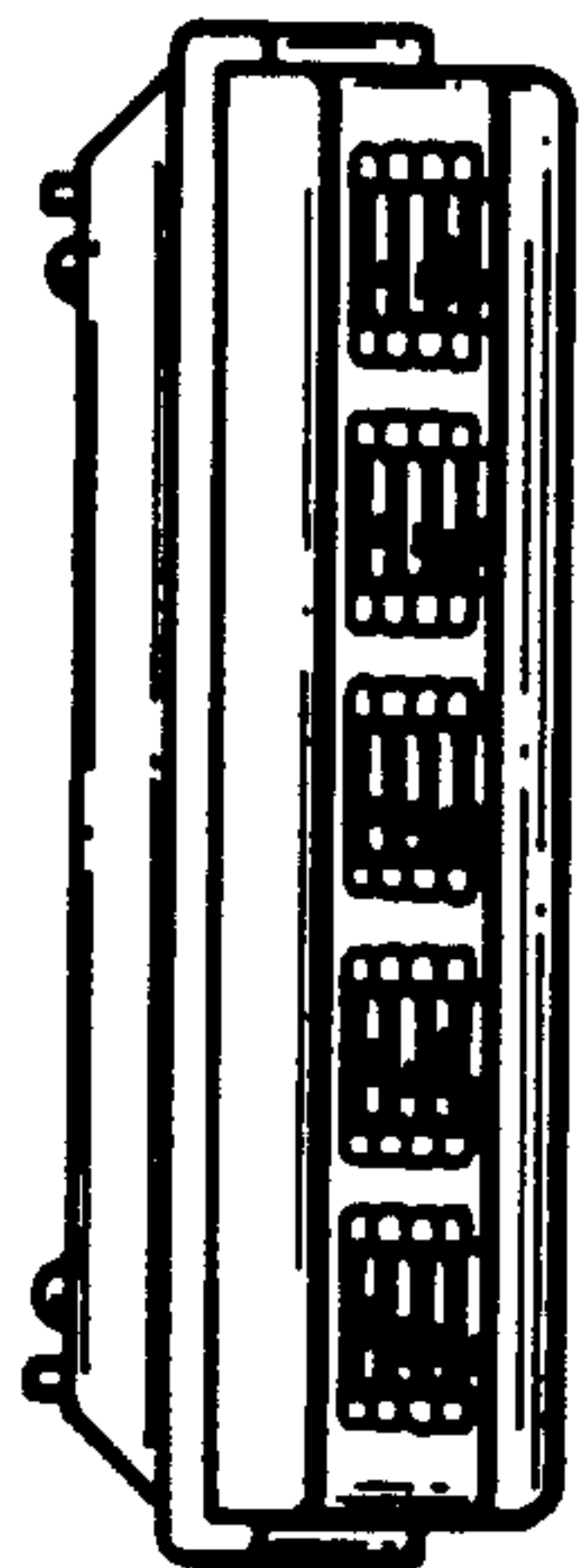
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

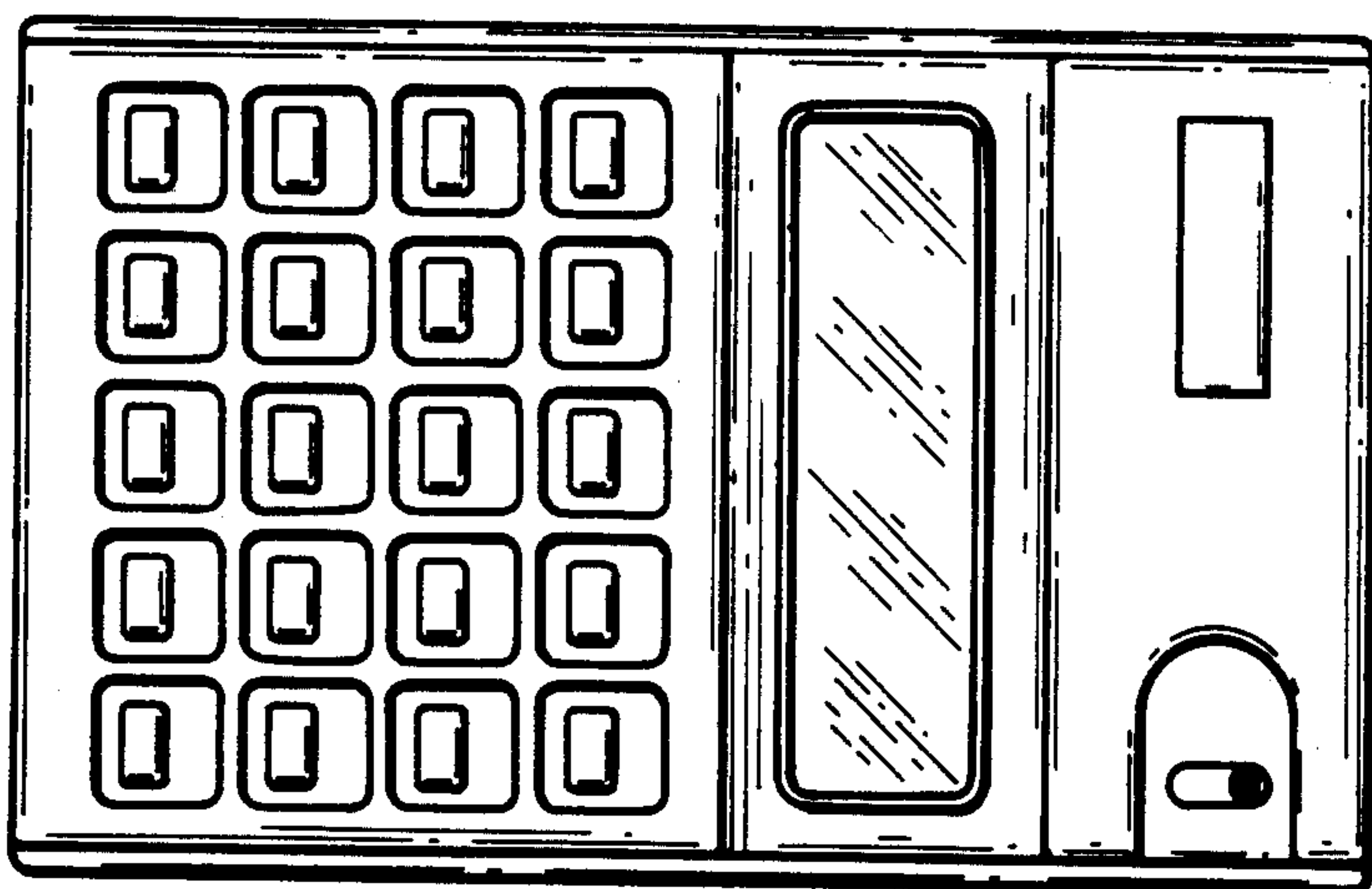




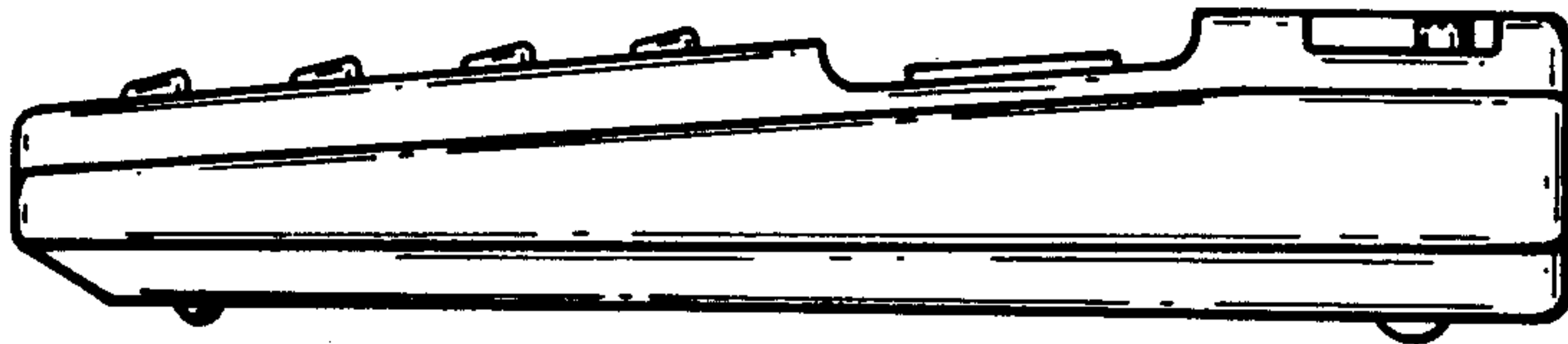

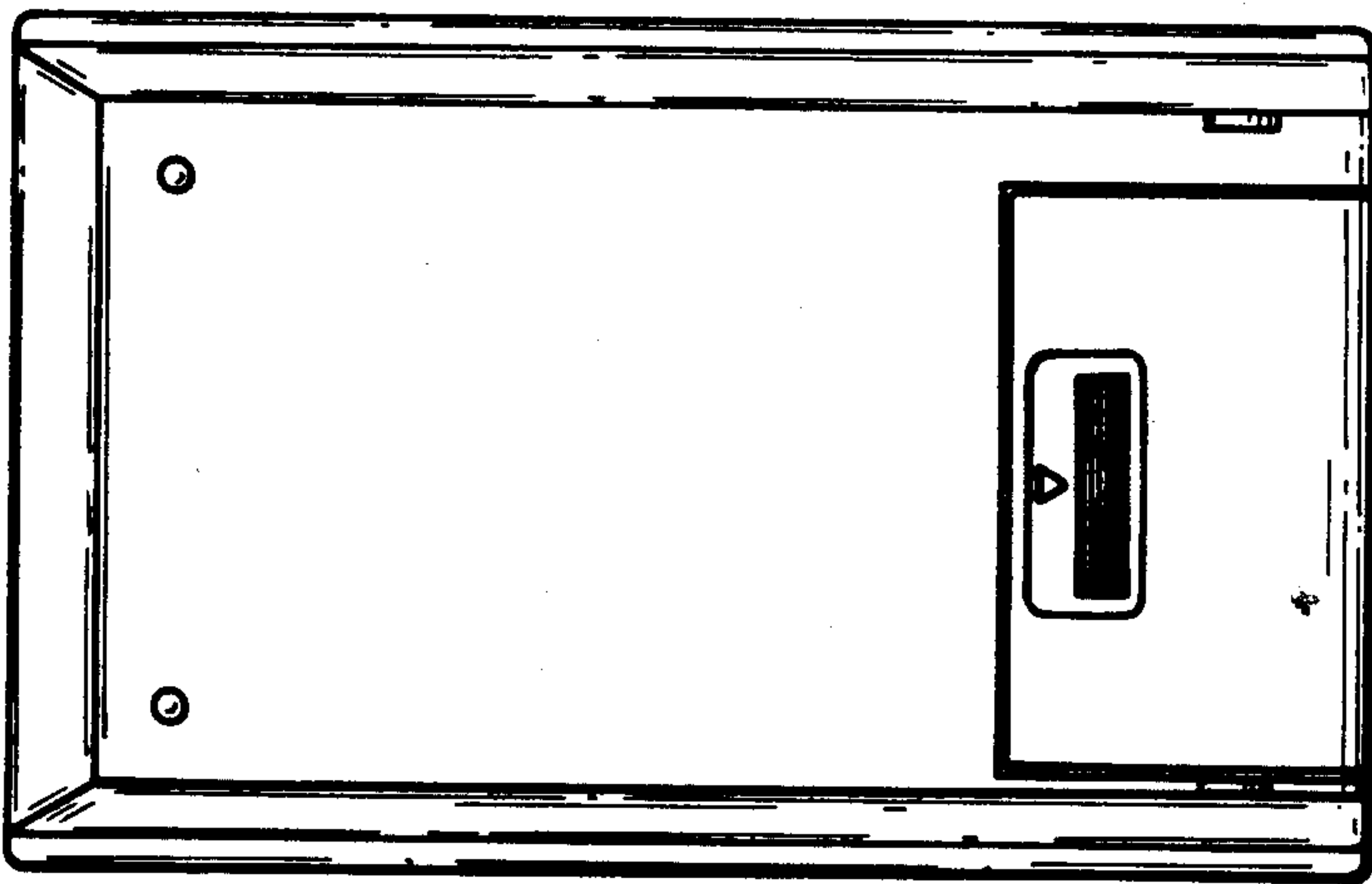

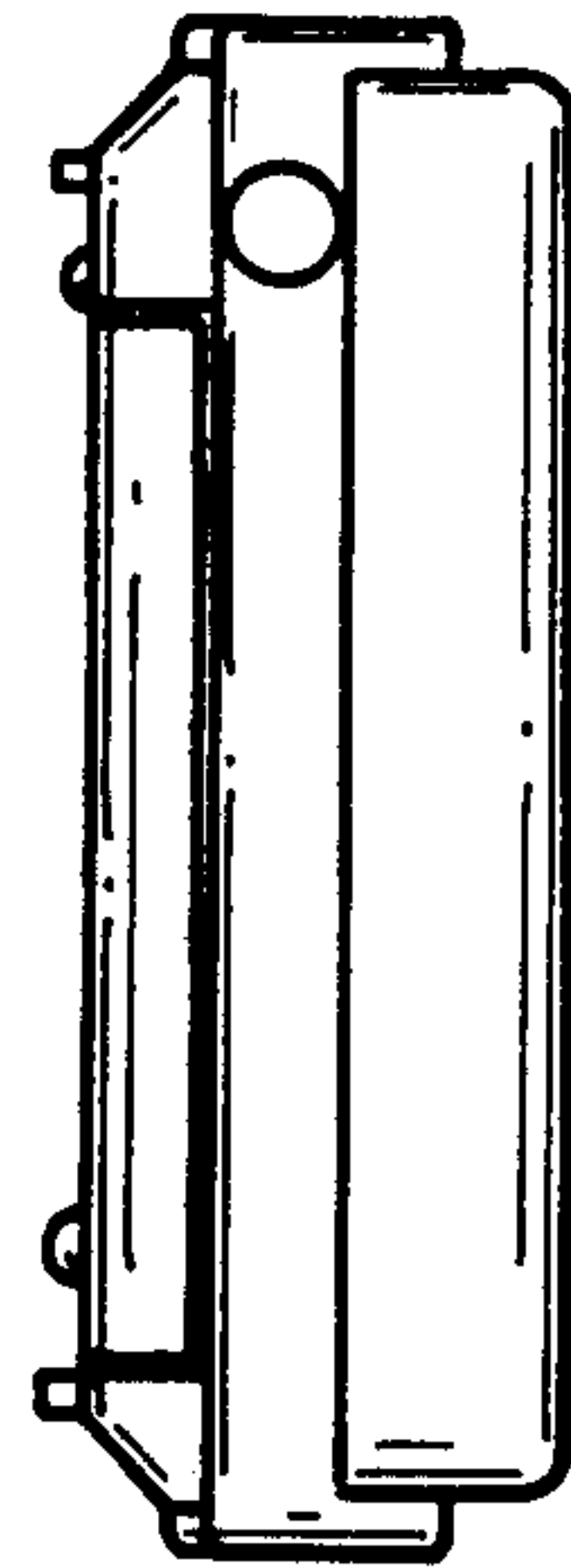

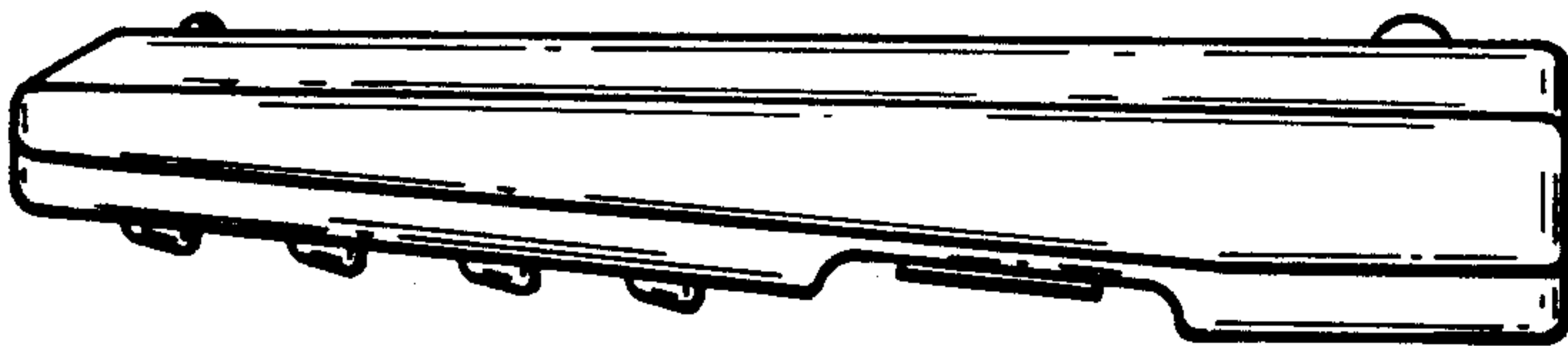
