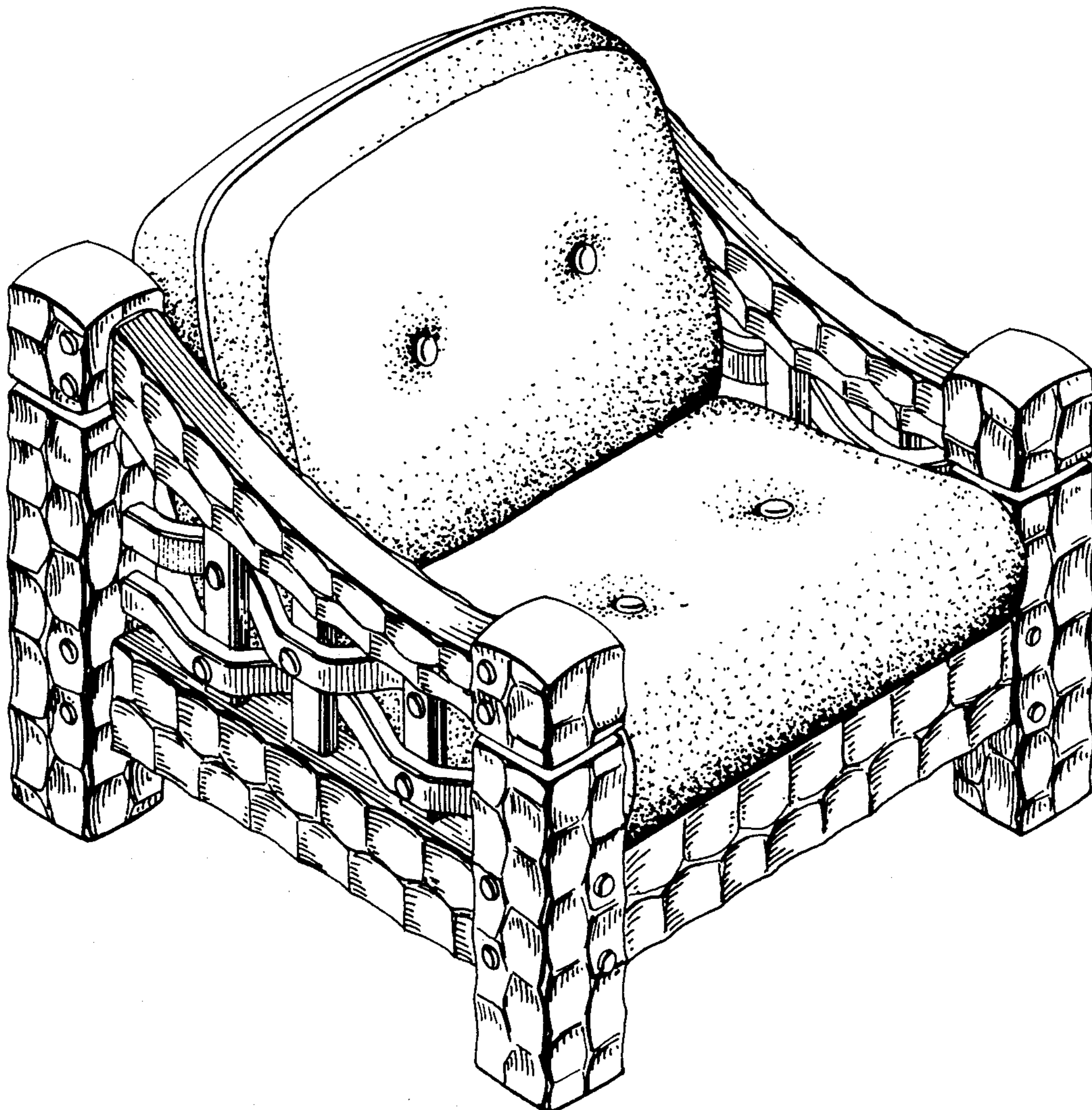

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing our new design incorporated in a chair;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of a seat showing our new design incorporated in a love seat; and
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of a seat showing our new design incorporated in a sofa.



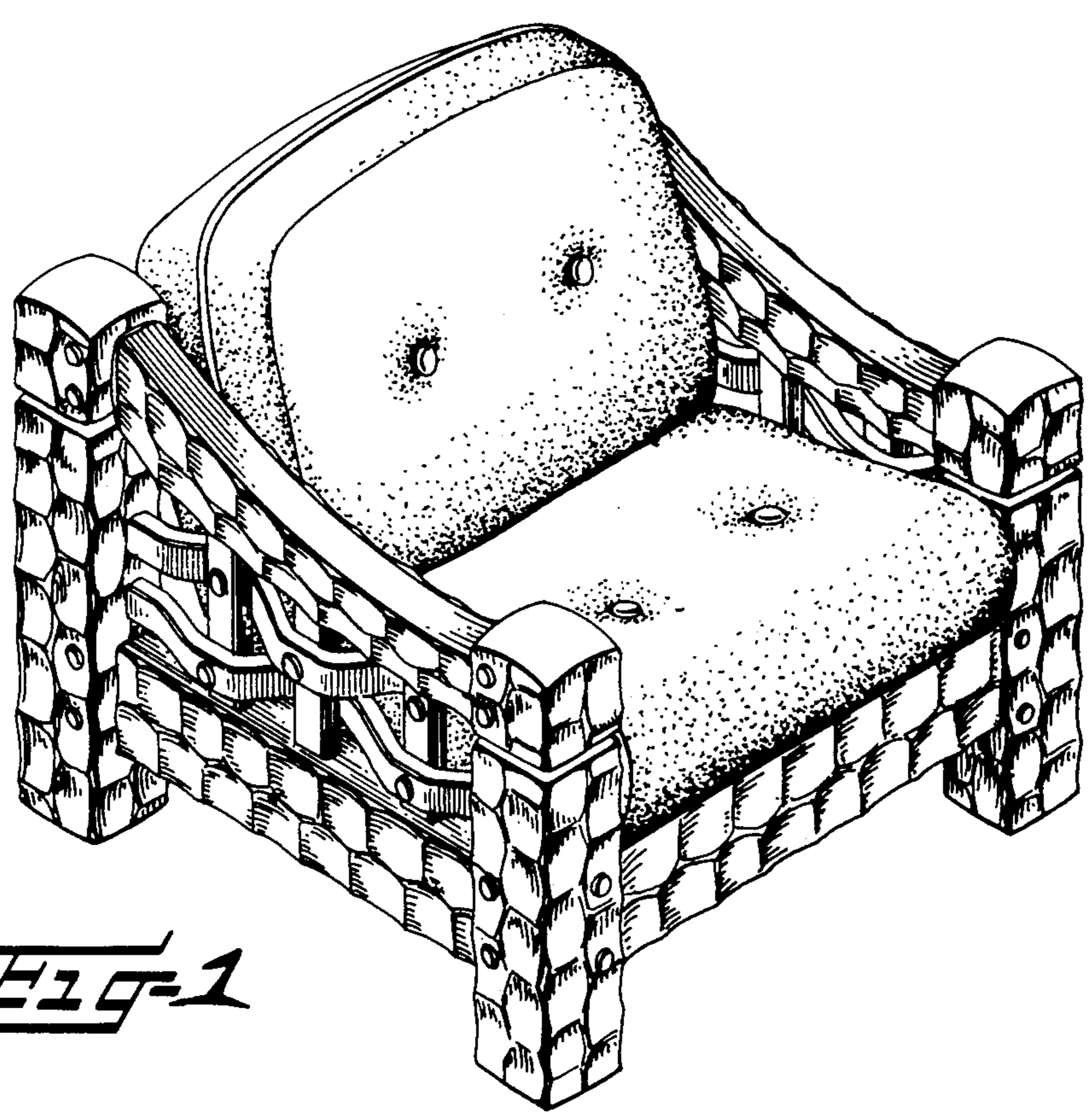

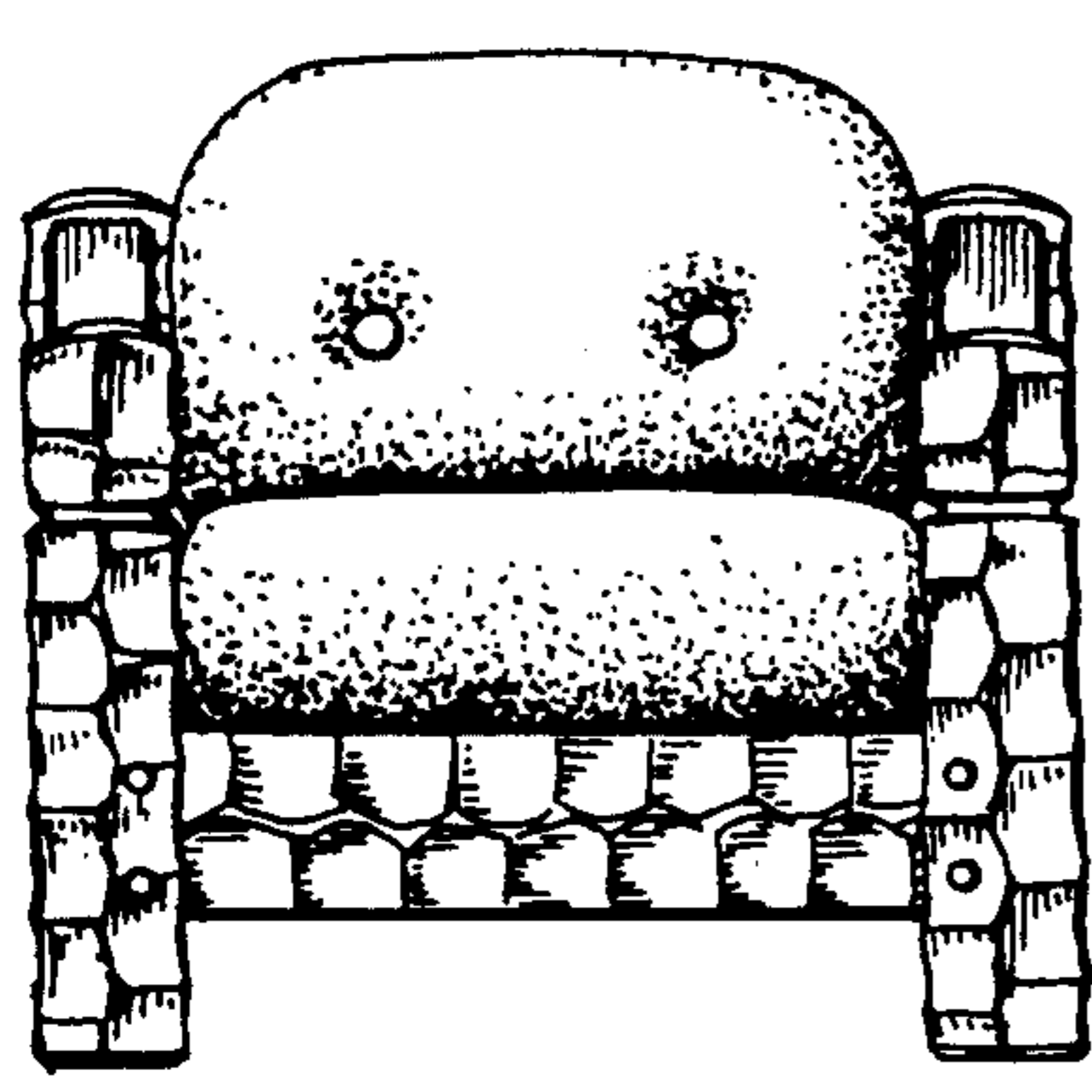

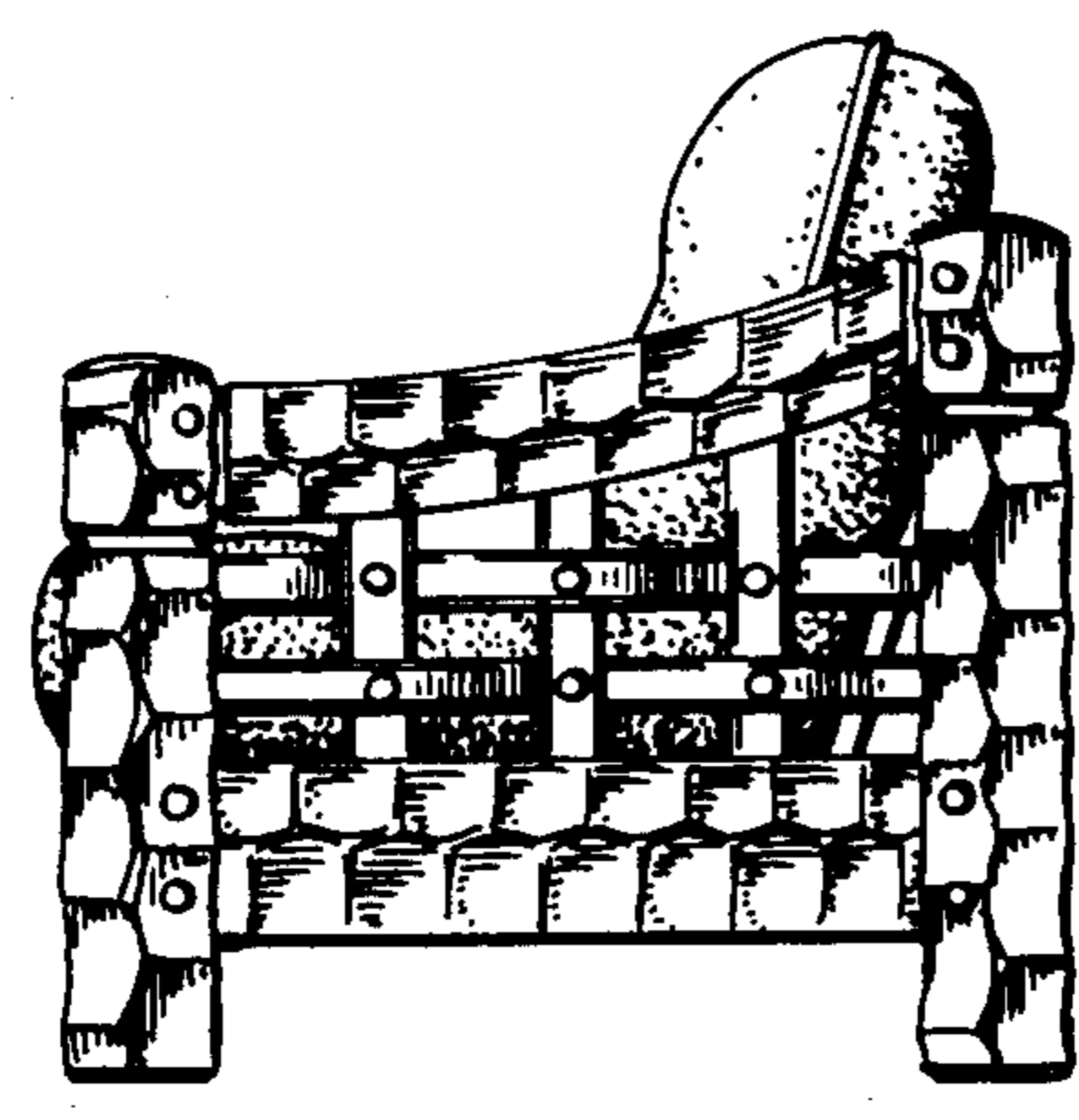

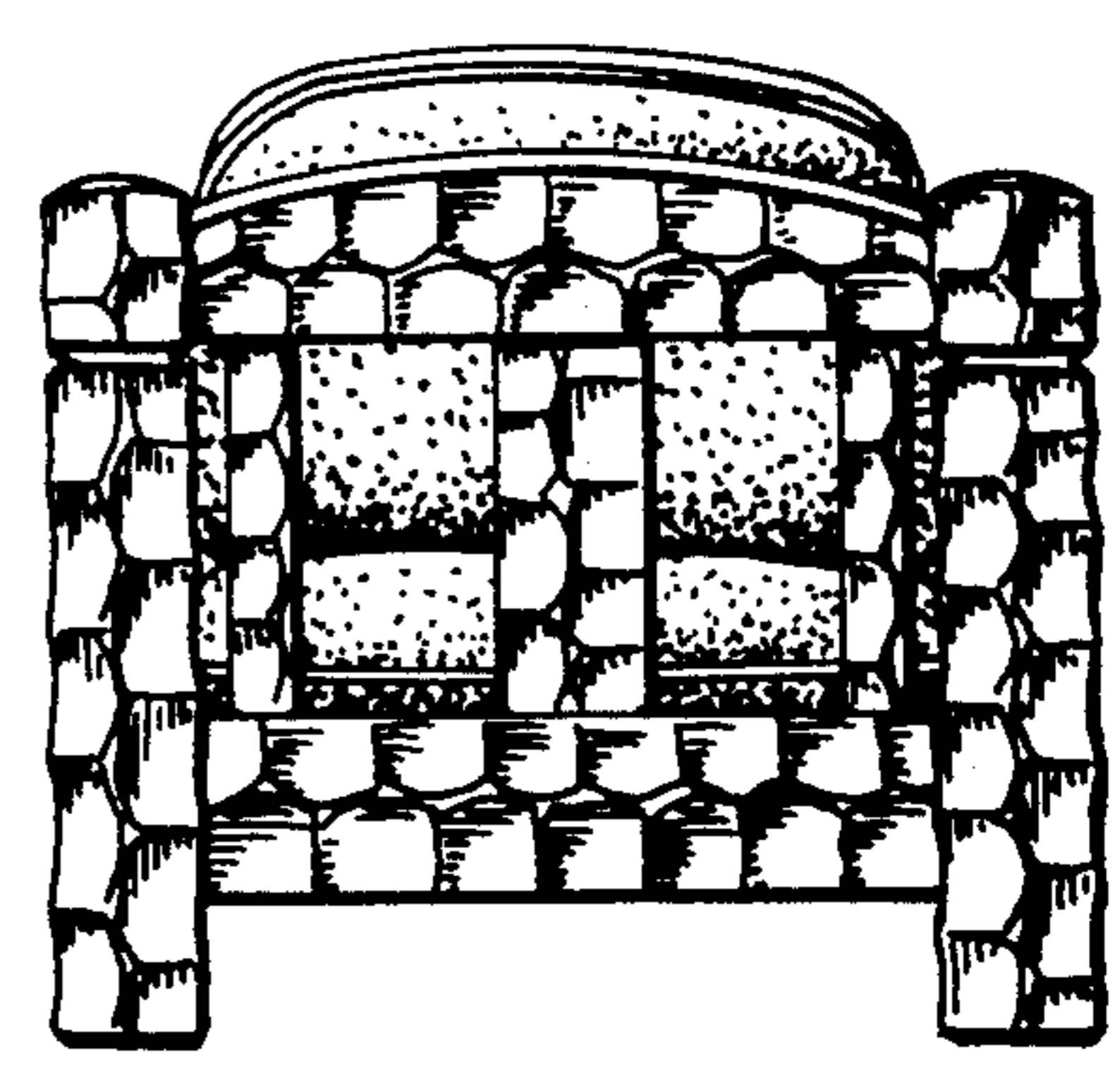

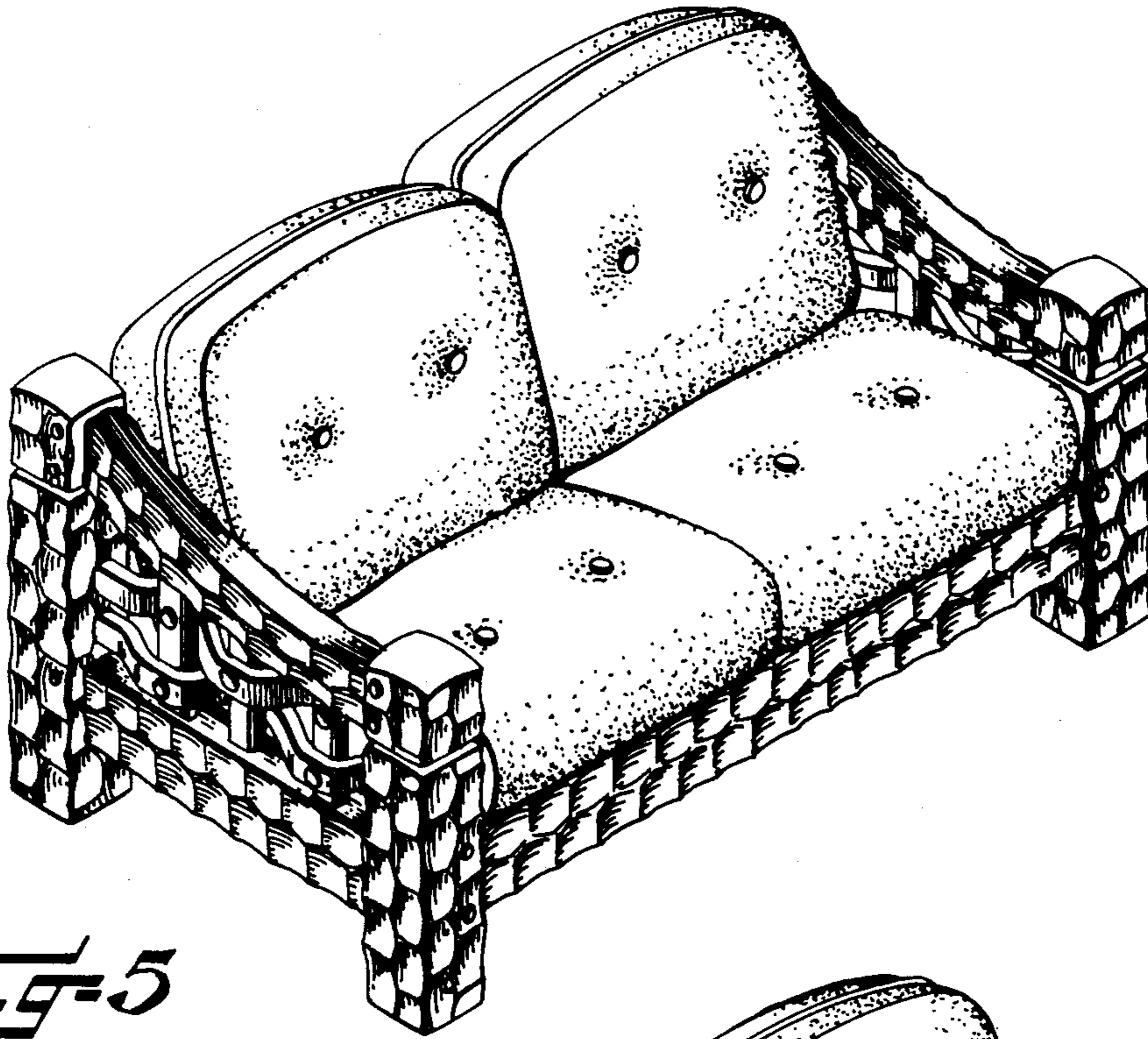

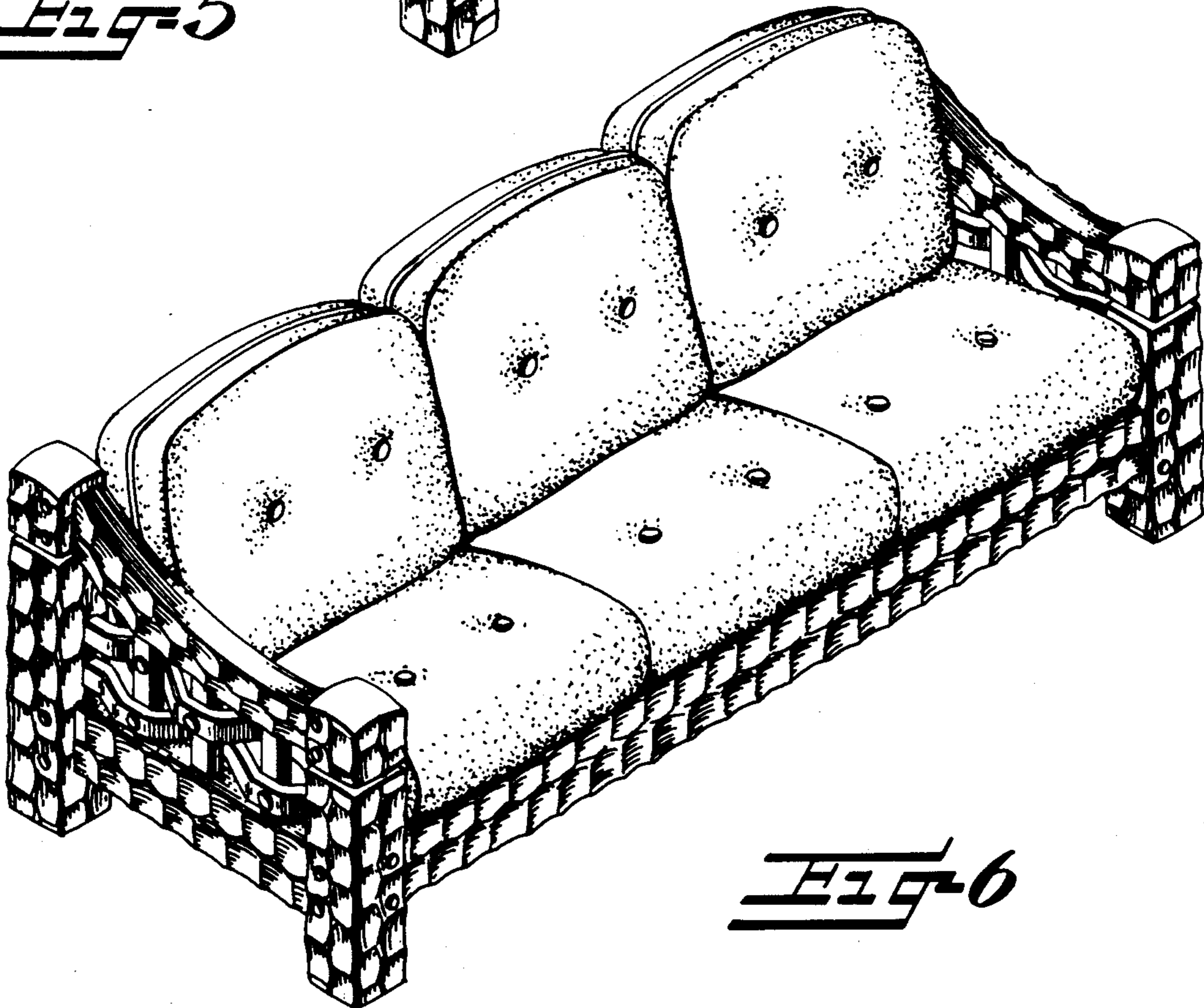
