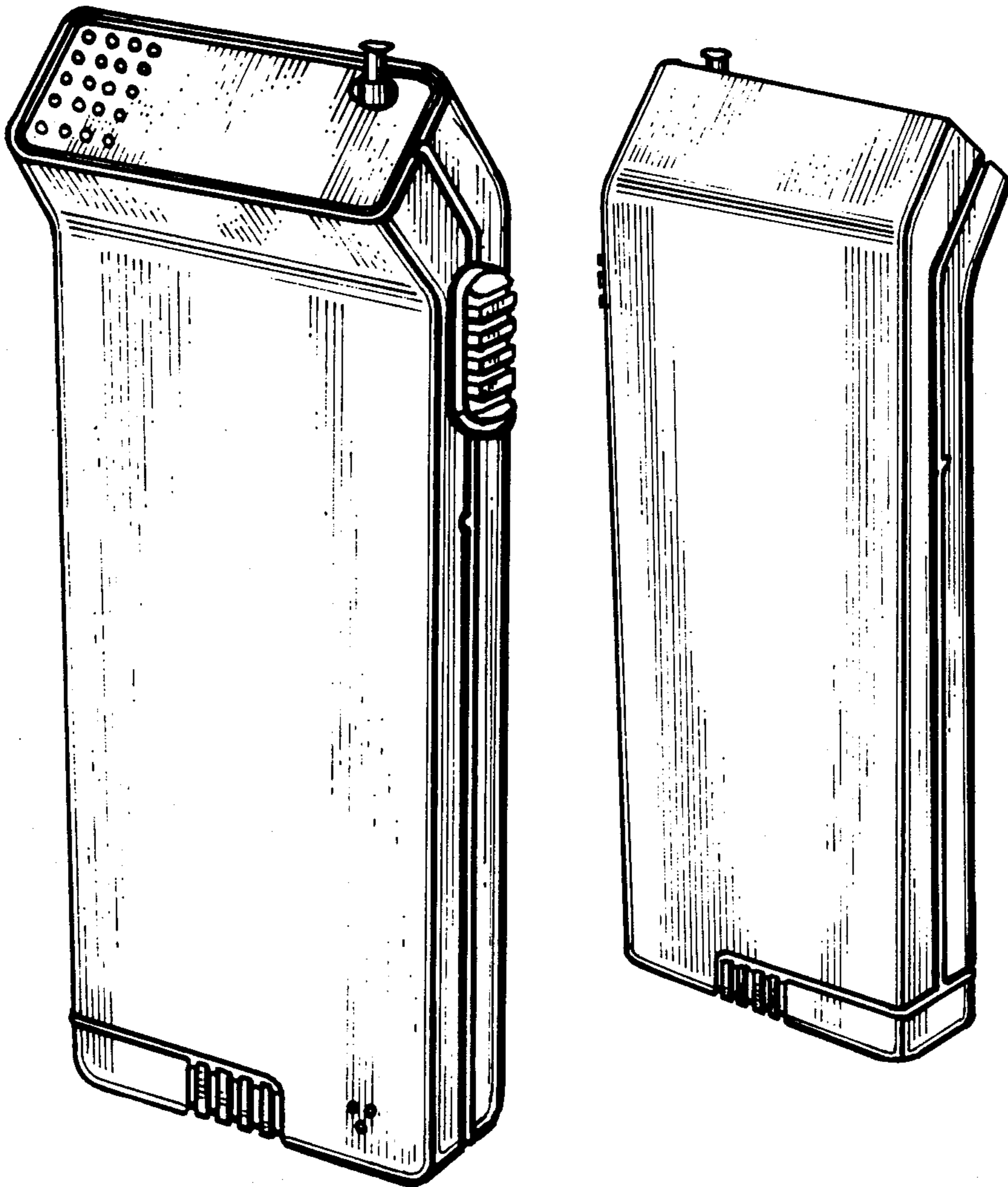

FIGS. 1 and 2 are perspective front and rear views of the staff locator showing my new design obliquely from above, the bottom of the locator being flat and unornamented.



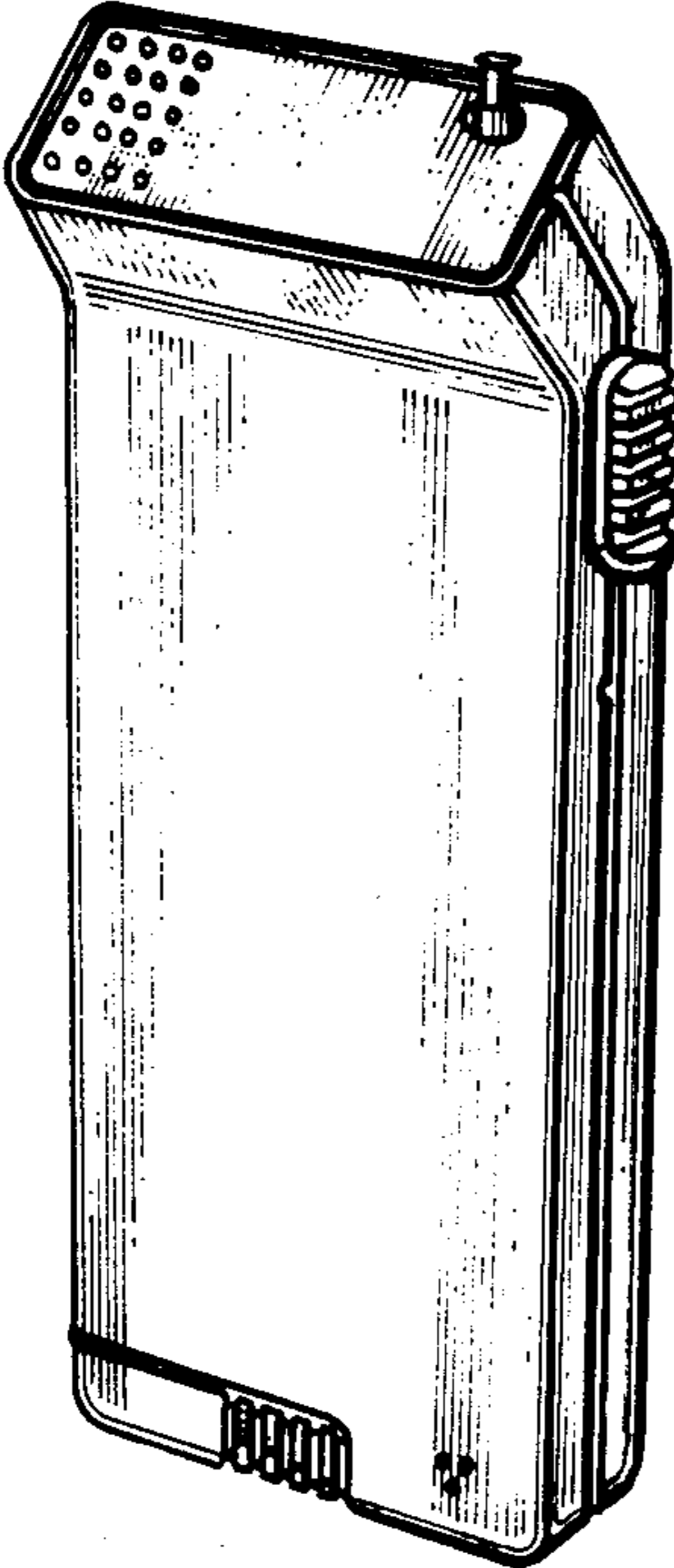

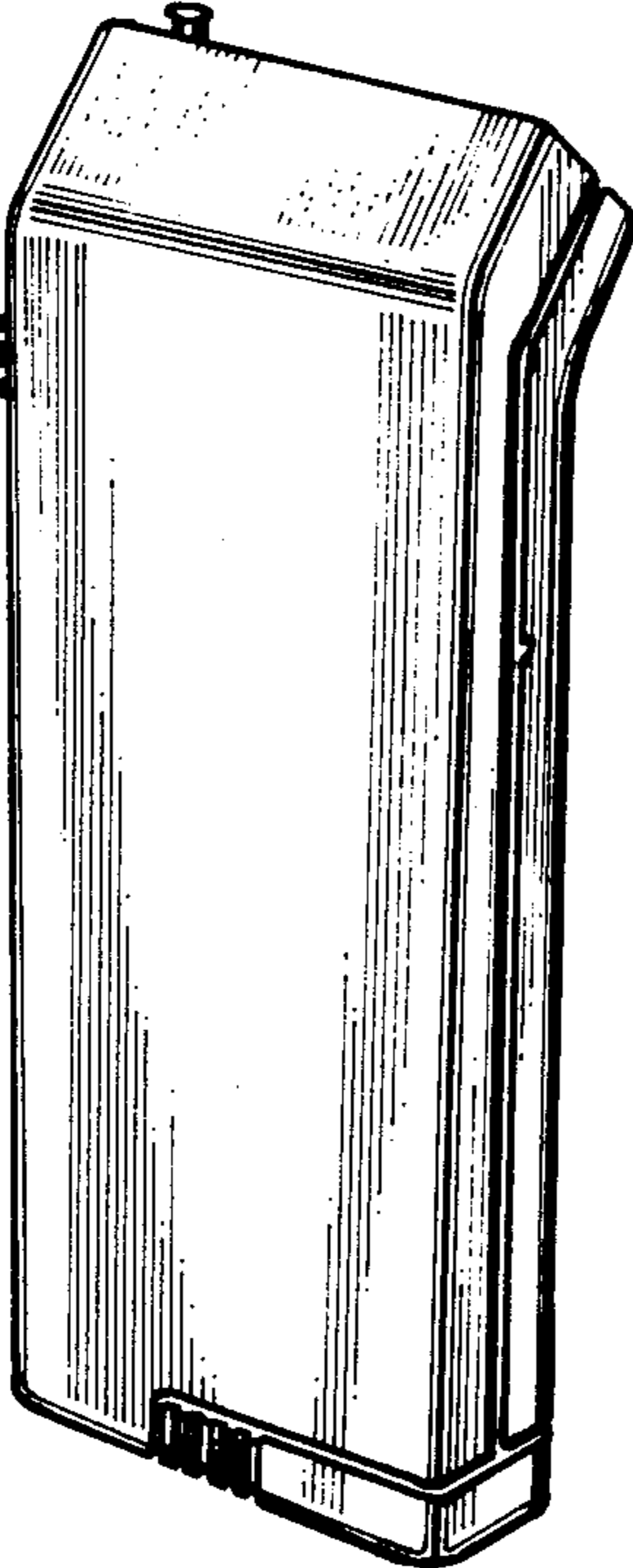
