57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a miniature candlestick for dollhouses and the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a miniature candelstick for dollhouses and the like showing my new design, the opposite side being identical to the side shown;

FIG. 2 is a top view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of a second embodiment of my design, the opposite side being identical;


FIG. 5 is a top view of FIG. 4;

FIG. 9 is a bottom view of FIG. 7.


















