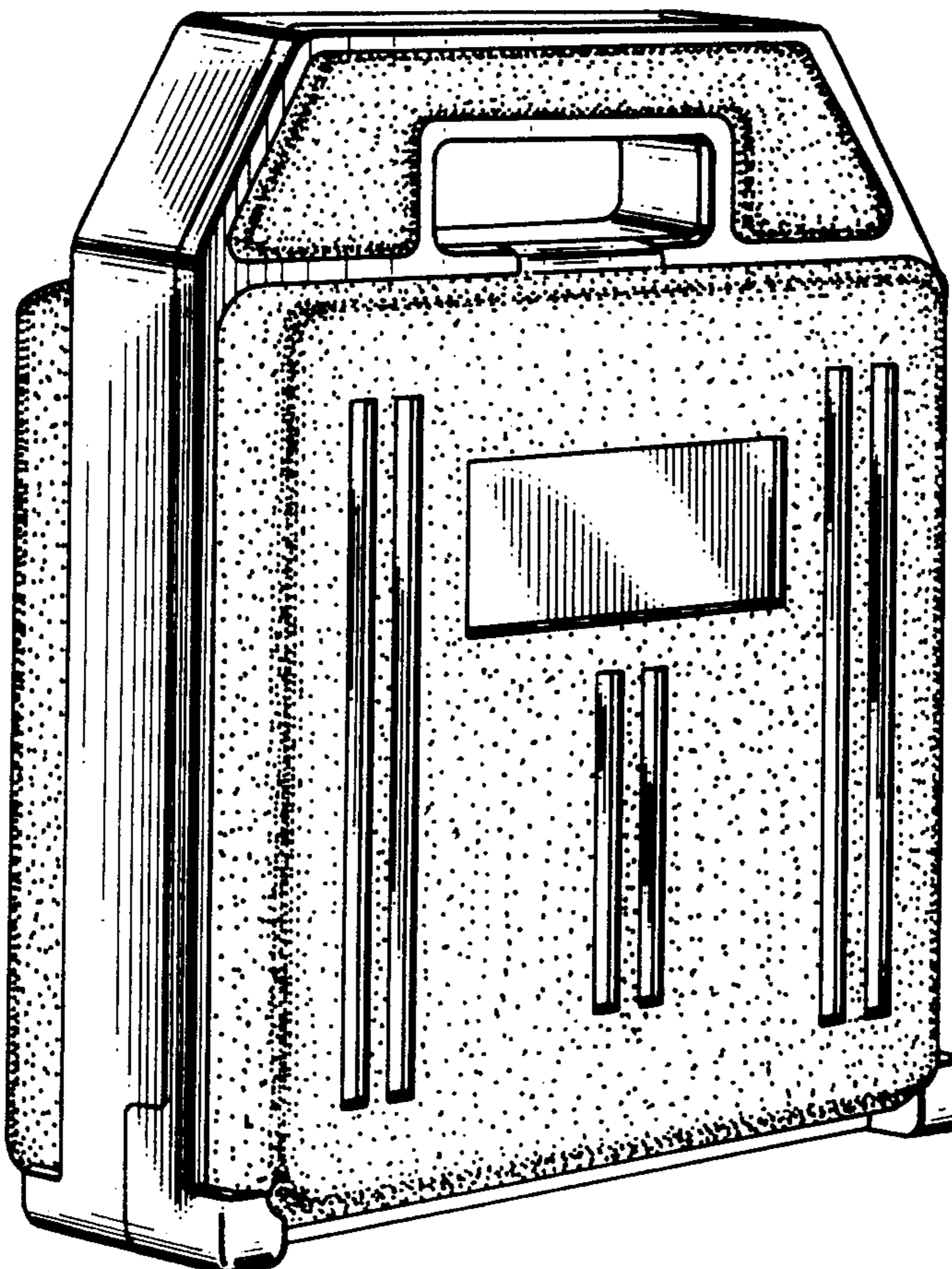

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a carrying case for circular saw blades, substantially as shown and described.

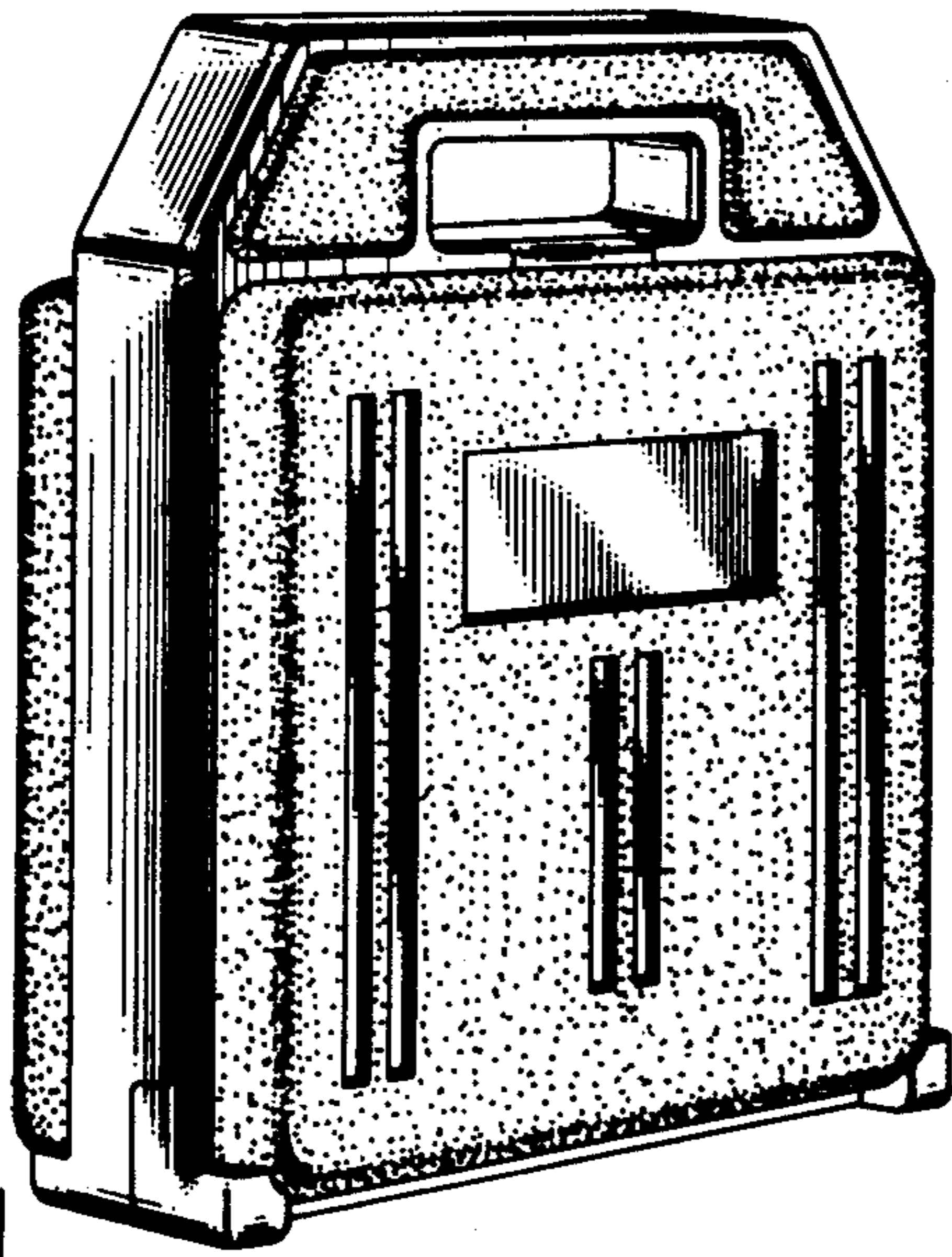

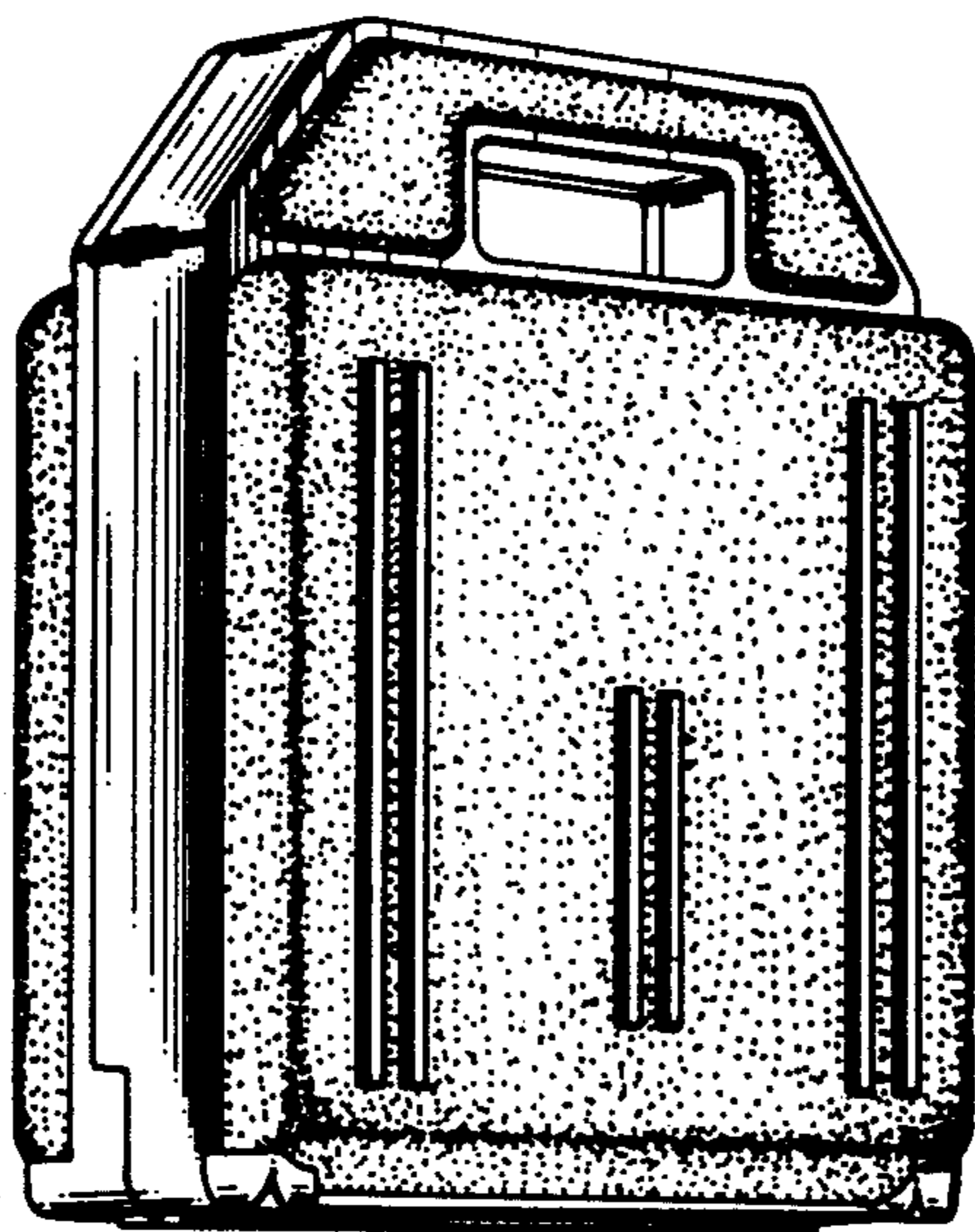

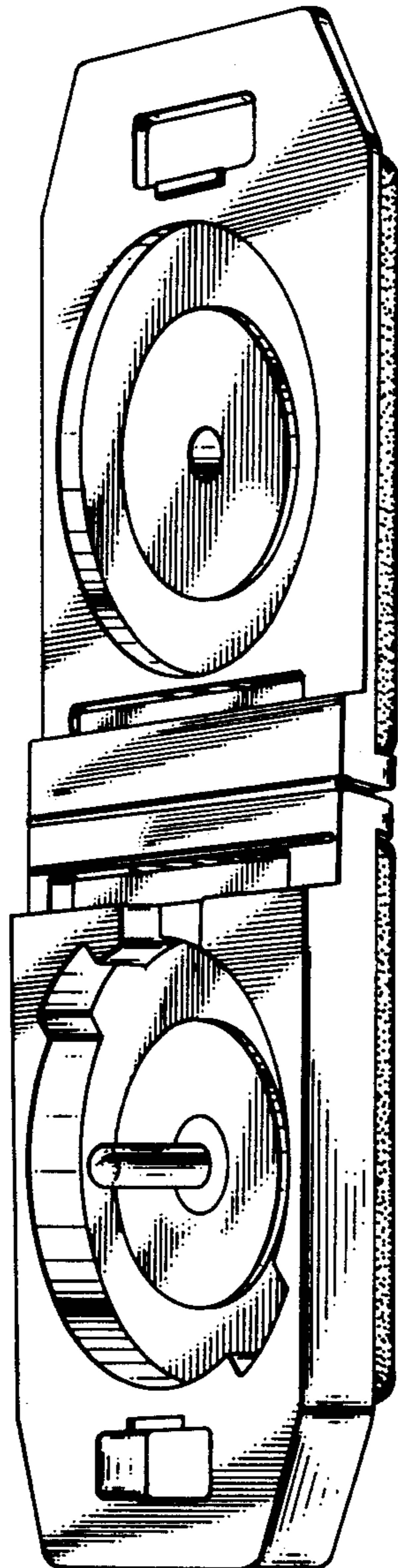
