[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a separable magnetic lock

for a purse or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a separable magnetic lock for a purse or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the male portion of the separable magnetic lock for a purse or similar article;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view;

FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 10—10 of FIG. 6:

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the female portion of the separable magnetic lock for a purse or similar article;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a left side elevational view; and

FIG. 15 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 15—15 of FIG. 11.


























