DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a surgical dilator showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of my new design;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of my new design;

FIG. 5 is an end view of my new design as viewed from the right as seen in FIG. 1.

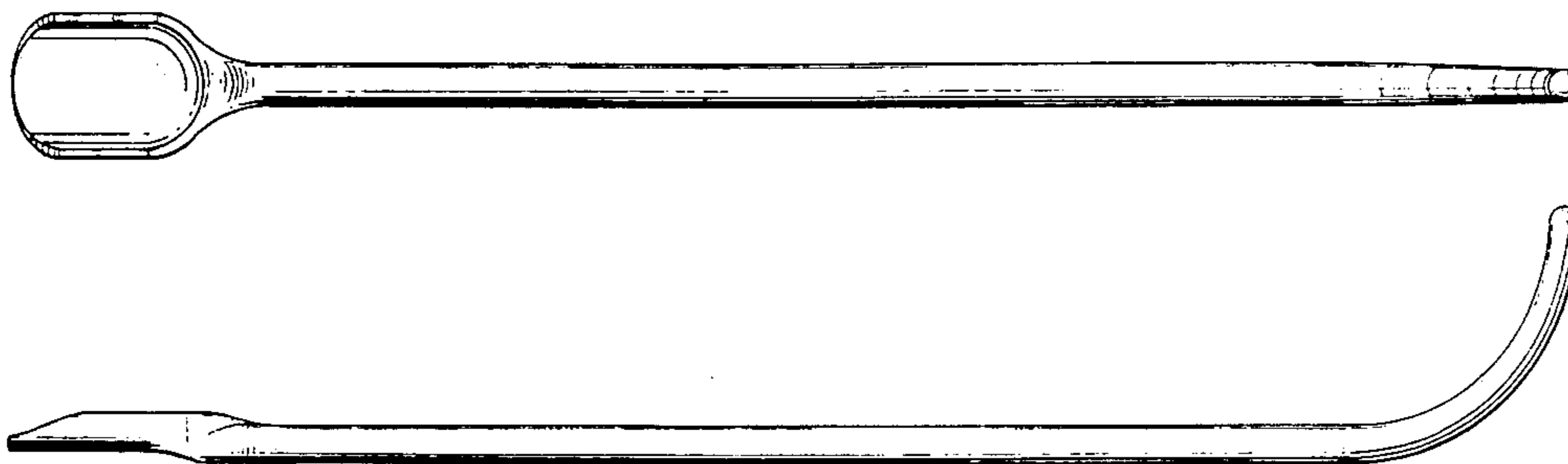

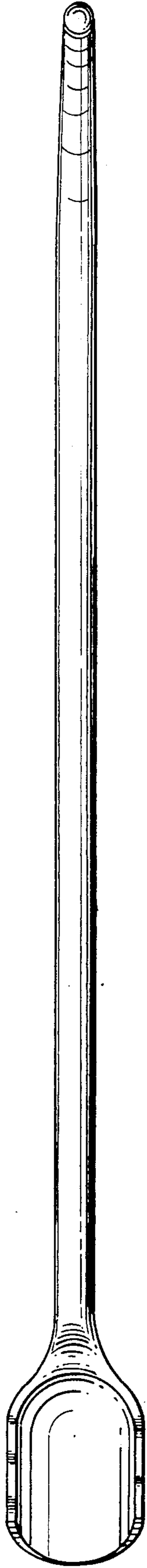

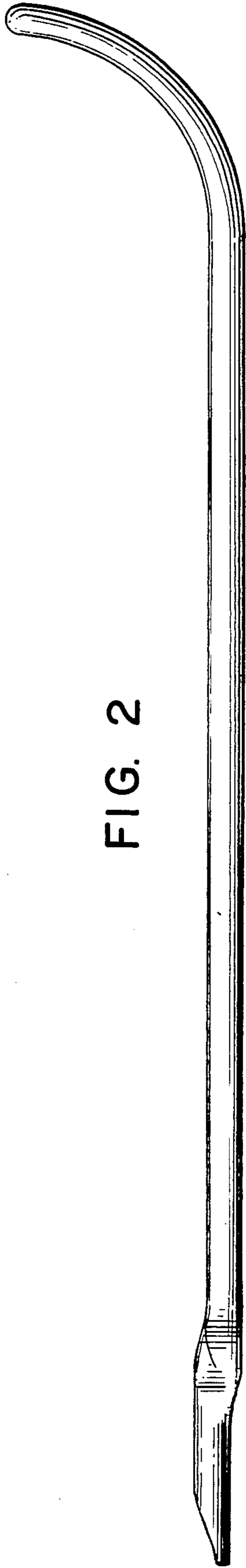

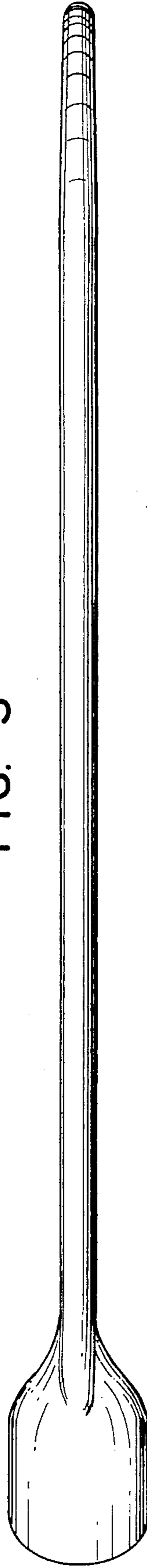

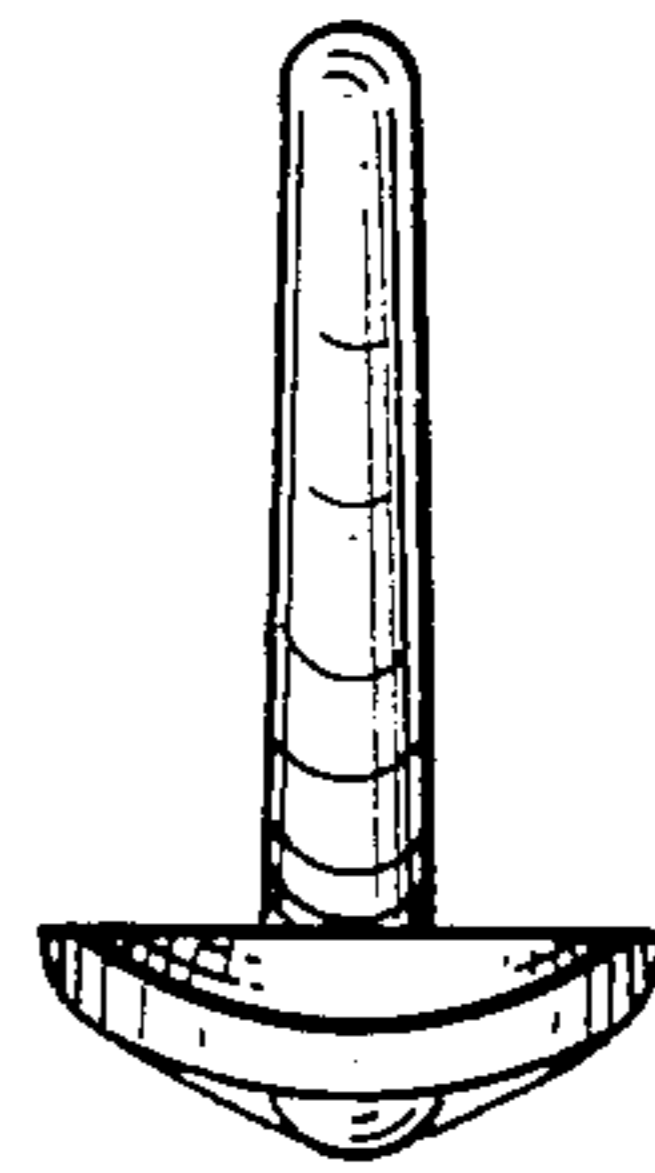
